## QUICK HITS

- Hitting the road for its second midweek of the season, Auburn treks to Georgia State. Auburn is looking for its 12th consecutive victory over the Panthers and its seventh straight win of the 2022 season.
- After hitting .667 behind 12 hits and 10 runs scored over Auburn's last six contests, sophomore Makayla Packer was tabbed SEC Co-Player of the Week. She is the first Tiger to win the award since Alyssa Rivera in 2020.
- With a 1.34 career earned run average, sophomore Shelby Lowe ranks third among all active, qualifying pitchers in Division I Softball for lowest ERA. Lowe has allowed just five earned runs in 43.2 innings pitched in 2022.
- The tale of the tape doesn't lie as Auburn's offensive output is staggering compared to a season ago. Auburn has totaled 22 home runs through its first 16 games of 2022, matching its 2021 season home run output of 22. The Tigers played 51 total games in 2021.
- A perfect 26-for-26 in stolen base attempts over her career, sophomore Makayla Packer has moved into a tie for 15th in program history with Tiffany Howard (2013-16).
- The only two pitchers in the SEC with 70 or more strikeouts this season, Maddie Penta leads the league with 73 while Shelby Lowe ranks second in the league with 70.
- The Tigers currently lead the SEC in both total home runs (22) and home runs per game (1.38). Auburn's 1.38 home runs per game average ranks 14th in the country. Auburn's freshman class has slugged 10 of Auburn's 22 homers.
- Behind three consecutive shutouts, Auburn has outscored its opponents 45 to 5 over its seven game winning streak.

## BY THE NUMBERS

**9** A total of nine different Tigers have slugged home runs during the first month of the 2022 season with six student-athletes recording two or more. Makayla Packer and Bri Ellis are tied for the team lead with five.

**7** With help of her SEC Co-Player of the Week Performance, Makayla Packer enters Wednesday's midweek with a seven-game hit streak. Packer stands eighth overall in the league with 22 hits.

**20** Behind another undefeated performance at the plate, Auburn rose one spot to No. 20 in three of the four major softball polls.

**INTERVIEW POLICY**

Coach Dean, assistant coaches and select student-athletes are available for interviews by contacting Taylor Shirey in the communications office. All interviews during the week will be conducted via phone or through ZOOM. Weekly media availabilities will be conducted approximately prior to Tuesday practices throughout the season unless otherwise specified. ZOOM information will be emailed to the media on Mondays. Specific interview request should be made at least 24 hours in advance to ensure availability.

Postgame interviews with Coach Dean and requested players will be conducted in-person following a brief cool-down period. Media will be directed to enter the stands behind home plate to conduct socially-distanced interviews. Student-athletes and coaches will remain on the field. No media will have field access.

Due to Auburn University's current COVID-19 policies, all persons must wear masks indoors regardless of vaccine status, including the press box at Jane B. Moore Field. Windows inside the press box will be open at all times, regardless of weather. Please dress accordingly. No media will have access to field level at any time. All media policies are subject to change throughout the regular season based on the university's COVID-19 policies and procedures.

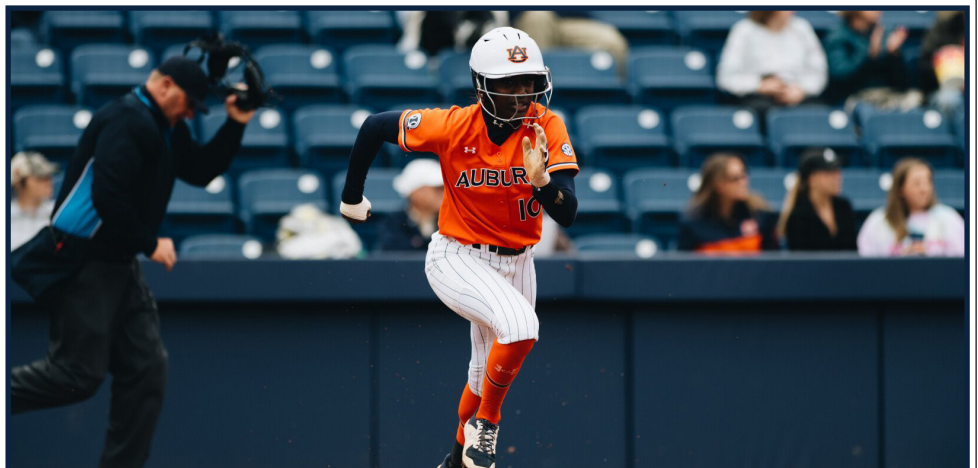

### FIRST PITCH

» After sweeping the Plainsman Invite, Auburn softball hits the road for its second midweek tilt of the season as No. 20 Auburn travels to Atlanta, Ga., to face Georgia State.

» First pitch on Wednesday is scheduled for 5 p.m. CT and will currently not feature any stream. Fans can hear JJ Jackson with the radio call on the Auburn Sports Network.

### AN AUBURN WIN WOULD...

» Extend Auburn's win streak to eight consecutive games.  
» Be Auburn's 12th straight victory over Georgia State, dating back to the 2014 season.

### INSIDE THE SERIES: GEORGIA STATE

» A familiar non-conference foe for the Tigers, Auburn holds a 20-5 overall record against Georgia State. The Tigers have won 12 straight meetings, a streak that began in 2014.

» Auburn traveled to Georgia State last season, taking down the Panthers by a 4-1 final. Auburn holds an 8-1 overall record in games played in Atlanta. Auburn's last loss to Georgia State on the road came on Feb. 17, 2010 as the Panthers won 6-5 in eight innings.

### PACK ATTACK: PACKER TABBED SEC CO-PLAYER OF THE WEEK

» Behind four multi-hit performances and ridiculous numbers at the plate, Makayla Packer was selected as the Southeastern Conference Co-Player of the Week.

» Packer shared the award with Missouri's Cassidy Chaumont and marks Packer's first SEC weekly of her career. Packer is the first Tiger to be named SEC Player of the Week since Alyssa Rivera on March 2, 2020.

» The Chattanooga, Tennessee, native started all six contests in centerfield for the Tigers and was a threat to opposing teams from the top spot in the lineup.

» Packer held a .667 average at the plate over Auburn softball's 6-0 week. She led the Tigers with 10 runs scored, 12 hits and four steals. Packer drove in four runs and slugged three doubles and her team-leading fifth home run to record a 1.000 slugging percentage. The sophomore also added a team high .700 on-base percentage.

» With multi-hit performances in four of Auburn's six contests, Packer extended her hit streak to seven consecutive games. Defensively, Packer was perfect with nine putouts.

» On the base paths, Packer swiped four bases and now stands a perfect 26-for-26 in stolen base attempts in

her career. She stands tied for 15th in program history in career steals with Tiffany Howard (2013-16).

### BOMBS AWAY

» Through just 16 games, Auburn softball has already matched its 2021 season home run total of 22 as the Tigers work in the weight room has been on display at the plate.

» Auburn's 22 home runs through 16 games is the most by an Auburn team since the 2019 season. Auburn slugged 23 home runs through the first 16 games that season.

» The Tigers currently lead the SEC in both total home runs and home runs per game (1.38). Auburn's home runs per game mark is good for 14th in the country. The Tigers also currently rank third in the SEC and seventh in all Division I softball with a .626 slugging percentage.

» Nine different Tigers have gone yard this season with six student-athletes hitting multiple home runs. Freshman Bri Ellis and sophomore Makayla Packer led the team with five home runs each -- a mark that would have tied Aspyr Godwin for the team lead at the end of the 2021 season. Auburn's freshman class has combined for 10 of Auburn's 22 home runs this season. The Tigers are also currently undefeated with a 14-0 record in games that Auburn hits at least one home run.

### PENTA-THLETE: MADDIE PUTS THE LEAGUE ON NOTICE

» The hard-throwing Maddie Penta returned for her sophomore season with better control and a masterful change up. It's lead to a hot start to the 2022 season.

» Penta has earned a victory in seven of her eight starts as her and fellow sophomore Shelby Lowe lead the SEC and rank fourth in the country with seven victories.

» Penta leads the SEC and ranks ninth in the country with 73 strikeouts this season. Penta currently ranks fourth in the league in strikeouts per seven innings (10.8), strikeout-to-walk ratio (7.30) and shutouts (2).

### IN THE POLLS: TIGERS ON THE RISE AS WIN STREAK EXTENDS TO SEVEN STRAIGHT

» With its wins streak extending to seven games with help of three consecutive shutouts, Auburn softball rose a spot in three of the four major softball polls.

» Auburn jumped to No. 20 in the USA Today/NFCA, the ESPN.com/USA Softball Top 25 and D1 Softball's Top 25.

» Rounding out its rankings, Auburn held steady No. 22 in the latest Softball America's Top 25.

### BY THE NUMBERS: TIGER OFFENSE SEES DRAMATIC IMPROVEMENT

» Struggles at the plate last season proved costly for the Tigers, as Auburn lost 11 games by one run and was at the bottom of the SEC in virtually every offensive category.

» Through the first 16 games of the season, Auburn leads the league in home runs while ranking second in triples and doubles, third in runs scored and slugging percentage and fourth in hits, RBI and batting average. Auburn has outscored its 2022 opponents 117 to 24.

### LOWE EARNS FIRST SEC PITCHER OF THE WEEK HONOR

» Picking up right where she left off, Shelby Lowe turned in a dominating performance in the circle to jump start her sophomore campaign, earning Southeastern Conference Co-Pitcher of the Week honors in the process.

» The league office announced Lowe as co-winner of the award with Tennessee's Ashley Rogers on Monday. The award is Lowe's first Pitcher of the Week accolade. Lowe was a two-time SEC Freshman of the Week winner last season. Lowe is Auburn's first SEC Pitcher of the Week honoree since her teammate Samantha Yarbrough won the award on March 2, 2020.

» The Carrollton, Ala., native started three games in the circle, picking up victories in each. Lowe did not allow a single earned run over opening weekend to post a 0.00 earned run average. In her 13.0 total innings of work, Lowe allowed just five hits and one unearned run. Lowe struck out a total of 23 batters and did not issue a walk. She held opponents to a .109 average at the plate.

» Her weekend performance was highlighted by her season debut against St. John's on Feb. 11. Lowe tossed her first collegiate no-hitter and the 28th no-hitter in Auburn softball history. Lowe's no-hitter was Auburn's first since Maddie Penta versus IUPUI on Feb. 27, 2021.

**PACK THE PLAINS**

» Returning to full capacity for the first time since 2020, Jane B. Moore Field and the Auburn Family was in full force the first two home weekends of the season.

» Auburn ranks fifth in the country in accumulated attendance with a mark of 12,864. Four of the top five teams in the country in accumulated attendance totals.

» The Tigers rank seventh overall in the country in average attendance with a 1,429 mark in its 10 home contests. The total is the second highest in the SEC behind only Alabama.

**LOWE DOWN: SHELBY CONTINUES TO LEAVE MARK ON RECORD BOOK**

» After turning in one of the best freshman campaign by a pitcher in program history, Shelby Lowe picked up right where she left off, tossing her first collegiate no-hitter and the 28th no-hitter in program history in her sophomore season debut versus St. John's on Feb. 11.

» Starting three games over opening weekend, Lowe solidified herself as one of the top arms in the league and earned Co-SEC Pitcher of the Week honors following opening weekend after no allowing a single earned run to score.

» Lowe continued her dominance over the St. Pete Clearwater Elite, picking up two wins and save before turning in a dominating performance at the Plainsman Invite with two shutout victories and a pair of saves. Lowe has not allowed a run to score in 17.1 consecutive innings.

» Along with her meteoric rise as one of the top pitchers in league as a true freshman, Lowe solidified herself as one of the most dominating pitchers Auburn has seen in over a decade. Lowe recorded the most total strikeouts by any Tiger since 2010 and was just the fifth freshman in program history to surpass 100 strikeouts in a season. Lowe surpassed 200 career strikeouts on Feb. 13 versus UMass Lowell. She is just the 15th Tiger in program history to surpass the milestone.

» Etching her name on both freshman and single-season records, Lowe is also on pace to move into top 10 in several career rankings during her sophomore campaign after putting up monster numbers as a freshman. Lowe needs 141.2 additional innings pitch to qualify for certain career categories (earned run average, walks per seven

innings etc.).

» The speedster has returned is already wrecking havoc on the base paths. Makayla Packer has opened her sophomore campaign a perfect 10-for-10 in stolen base attempts. Packer currently ranks fourth in the SEC in total stolen bases and fifth in stolen bases per game (0.62).

» Last season, Packer's 16 steals were the second most recorded by a Tiger freshman and ranks seventh overall in program single-season history. Packer set the program record for highest stolen base percentage (min. 15 attempts) with a flawless 1.000.

**YOUTH MOVEMENT: NEW KIDS ON THE BLOCK**

» Boasting the youngest roster in the SEC, Auburn will rely heavily on a group of talented underclassmen during the 2022 season.

» The Tigers lead the SEC with the highest total of

true freshmen and sophomore with 16 total. Auburn's underclassmen accounts for over 69 percent of its roster make-up, that percentage also leads the league.

» Auburn returns eight members of its sophomore class with the quartet of Makayla Packer, Sydney Cox, Maddie Penta and Shelby Lowe leading the charge. The foursome were tabbed to the 2021 SEC All-Freshman team last season. Auburn led the league with its four selections.

» The freshman class has thrived at the plate, slugging 10 of Auburn 22 home runs. The freshman class has also solidified themselves in starting rolls, combining for 57 starts.

» Bri Ellis is one of just 10 SEC student-athletes to slug at least five home runs this season. Ellis ranks eighth in the SEC in home runs per game (.33). Fellow freshmen Nelia Peralta (3) and Jessie Blaine join Ellis with multiple home runs this season.

» Leading the team with 16 RBI, Peralta ranks 12th in the SEC in runs batted in per game (1.00). Blaine currently ranks as the seventh toughest player in the Southeastern Conference to strike out as she has done so just twice in her 38 at bats.

**FOR JANE: SEASON DEDICATED TO LONG-TIME SUPPORTER DR. JANE B. MOORE**

» Dr. Jane B. Moore, one of the most influential women in Auburn Athletics history, passed away on July 9, 2021. Auburn's softball complex was named Jane B. Moore Field in her honor in 2002 and dedicated on April 26, 2003, in recognition of Moore's service to athletics at Auburn.

» Born in 1935 in Dozier, Alabama, Moore came to Auburn in 1969 after earning her Doctorate of Education in physical education from the University of Alabama. In 1975, Moore became the first woman to serve on the Auburn University Committee on Intercollegiate Athletics. She served on multiple athletics committees for men's and women's sports for more than 40 years.

» Moore was instrumental in the establishment of WINGS (Women Inspiring and Nurturing Greatness in Student-Athletes), which promotes and supports women's athletics at Auburn by creating programs for female student-athletes.

» Moore made significant professional contributions to Auburn University over a 28-year career on the faculty of the College of Education and the Department of Health and Human Performance (now the School of Kinesiology).

» Her service to Auburn has been recognized with the Lifetime Achievement Award, the Algernon Sydney Sullivan Award and the Pamela Wells Sheffield Award, which recognizes Auburn women exemplifying grace, character and a selfless service and commitment to Auburn University and the Auburn family.

» Throughout the 2022 season, Auburn softball will wear helmet stickers in honor of Dr. Moore and will host the inaugural Jane B. Moore Memorial tournament on Mar. 4-6. During the tournament, Auburn softball plans to unveil the Jane B. Moore Endowment Fund. More details on the endowment will be released leading into the tournament.

## AT THE HELM: DEAN ENTERS FIFTH SEASON ON THE PLAINS

» Head coach Mickey Dean enters his fifth season on the Plains. Dean has guided to several firsts during his tenure, adding to his lofty coaching resume in the process.

» The 2021 campaign feature two major milestone victories. Dean earned his 100th career victory as head coach of the Tigers as Auburn knocked off No. 19 South Carolina, 5-4 on Feb. 21. Dean also recorded his 600th career victory as a Division I head coach on April 25 as Auburn defeated Ole Miss, 3-1.

» Behind Auburn's 10-0 road victory at Jacksonville State, Dean led Auburn to its 900th program victory.

» During his tenure on the Plains, Mickey Dean continues to overhaul the program's culture to return to the Tigers back to the top of the SEC and gathered a long list of honors and firsts along the way:

## LIGHTS! CAMERA! ACTION: TIGERS ON THE TUBE

» Once again, Auburn will be a feature in the national spotlight as the Tigers are set to appear in 13 nationally televised broadcasts in 2021.

» Auburn will have four games at Jane B. Moore Field broadcasted nationally, including games from its SEC series against Texas A&M, South Carolina and Florida.

Nine of Auburn's road contests will also air on ESPN's family of networks, including three of Auburn's contests at the St. Pete Clearwater Elite Invitational.

» The Tigers will be featured on the SEC Network 11 times and on both ESPNU and the Longhorn Network once.

» Also available to stream on the ESPN app, Auburn will have 22 additional home games on SEC Network+.

## TIGERS SELECTED 11TH IN PRESEASON SEC COACHES POLL

» Auburn was tabbed to finish 11th in the Southeastern Conference in the annual preseason coaches' poll. The Tigers collected 36 points from the league's 13 coaches.

» Receiving seven first-place votes, Alabama was selected as the preseason favorite to win the league with Florida coming in at second with three first-place votes.

» With a pair of first-place votes, Arkansas was tabbed to finish third in the league. Tennessee, also earning one first-place vote, rounded out the top four.

## IN REVIEW: 2021 CAMPAIGN

» Auburn closed the 2021 season with a 27-24 overall record with a 7-17 mark in SEC play. The Tigers punched their ticker for its 16th overall NCAA regional with an appearance in Tallahassee.

» Auburn earns its first victories in Columbia, Mo., College Station, Texas and Baton Rouge, La., all for the first time since 2015. The 2021 season was also highlighted by Auburn's upsetting No. 12 Kentucky, taking the series in two games at Jane B. Moore Field.

» The 2021 season was highlighted by the breakout performances from pitching freshman duo Shelby Lowe and Maddie Penta as the pair combined for five SEC Freshman of the Week honors. Lowe and Penta both surpassed 100 strikeouts during their freshman campaigns, marking the first time in school history that Auburn had two freshman pitchers surpass 100+ strikeouts in the same season.

» The duo was honored alongside fellow freshmen Makayla Packer and Sydney Cox as members of the 2021 SEC All-Freshman Team, setting Auburn's program record with the four selections. Lowe added All-SEC Second Team honors to become the only freshman pitcher in program history to be honored with all-conference honors during their debut season. Maddison Kopeke rounded out the SEC accolades with a selection to the SEC All-Newcomer Team.

- Throughout the 2022 season, Auburn is celebrating 25 years of softball in honor of the program's inaugural 1997 season. The team will sport 25th anniversary patches on its uniforms throughout the season and is set to host its alumni weekend March 11-13 during Auburn's SEC-opening series versus Texas A&M.
- Auburn softball launched a social media campaign that will run throughout the season to highlight major program milestones as well as spotlight numerous alumni from the past 25 seasons. To coincide with the social campaign, our 2022 game notes will feature weekly updates on the milestones and alumni we're celebrating as part of 25 Years of Auburn Softball.

### MILESTONE MOMENTS

- **August 8, 1994:** Auburn Athletic Director David Housel announces that Auburn will institute fastpitch softball as a varsity sport, beginning competition in 1997.
- **August, 1995:** Auburn announces the hiring of Tina Deese, formerly of Huntingdon College, as the first head coach in the school's history.
- **November 13, 1995:** Auburn announces that Lindsay Burke of Pelham, Ala., has signed a national letter of intent to play softball, becoming the program's first signee.
- **September 20, 1996:** Despite overcast skies and the threat of rain, the Auburn softball team holds its first practice in preparation for the 1997 season.
- **February 18, 1997:** The Auburn Tigers travel to Birmingham to face Samford in their first ever game. The Tigers sweep the doubleheader from the Bulldogs, 4-2 and 4-3, to begin their history at 2-0.

## HEAD COACH MICKEY DEAN

Mickey Dean enters his fifth season as the head coach of the Auburn softball program. In 14 years at the collegiate level, Dean has coached 10 NCAA Tournament teams, including one super regional participant, and won nine conference championships. He is one of four active head coaches to led three different programs to the NCAA Tournament.

A native of Elkton, Va., Dean has guided 79 all-conference players, 44 all-region honorees and eight all-Americans, including 2017 National Player of the Year, Megan Good. He has also been touted as the conference coach of the year eight times.

During his time on the Plains, Dean has guided the Tigers to a 123-73 overall record and three NCAA Regional appearances. Dean's resume at Auburn also includes four NFCA All-Region selections and three All-SEC selections. He also guided slugger Kendall Veach to All-America honors from Softball America in 2019.

In his fourth season at Auburn, Dean navigated the Tigers through the uncertainties of playing a season during the heart of COVID-19 pandemic. He carried Auburn to 27 victories, highlighted by the program's first victories in Columbia, Mo., College Station, Texas, and Baton Rouge, La., since 2015. The Tigers also upset No. 12 Kentucky picking up the series win at Jane B. Moore Field.

Dean would earn his 100th victory as head coach of the Tigers on Feb. 20, 2021, as Auburn upset No. 10 South Carolina 5-4 in non-conference competition during the Osprey/Dolphin Invitational in Jacksonville, Fla. Dean would add his 600th career head coaching victory on April 25, 2021, when Auburn took a 3-1 victory over Ole Miss in Oxford, Miss.

The 2021 season was highlighted by the breakout performances from pitching freshman duo Shelby Lowe and Maddie Penta. The pair combined for a total of five SEC Freshman of the Week honors becoming just the second and third Auburn freshman pitchers to win the award multiple times in a season. Penta set the program record with three freshman weekly honors from the league office.

After becoming the first Auburn freshman pitcher to toss a no-hitter in a season opener in Auburn's 8-0 win over Southeast Missouri State, Penta would close her debut season with a pair of no-hitters. Penta would toss Auburn's first seven-inning no-hitter since 2012 in a 5-0 victory over IUPUI. She was the first Auburn pitcher since Marcy Harper in 2014 to pitch multiple no-hitters in the same season.

Lowe turned in one of the most dominating pitching performances by an Auburn freshman in school history. Lowe closed the year setting Auburn's single-season record for fewest walks allowed per seven innings (1.18), while also ranking sixth in single-season history for earned run average (1.48), eighth for longest scoreless innings streak (24.1) and 10th in strikeouts (179) and complete games (15). Her 179 strikeouts were the most by an Auburn pitcher in over a decade. Lowe recorded the second most strikeouts and second lowest ERA by an Auburn freshman pitcher in program history.

Lowe and Penta both surpassed 100 strikeouts during their freshman campaigns, marking the first time in school history that Auburn had two freshman pitchers surpass 100+ strikeouts in the same season.

The duo was honored alongside fellow freshmen Makayla Packer and Sydney Cox as members of the 2021 SEC All-Freshman Team, setting Auburn's program record with the four selections. Lowe added All-SEC Second Team honors to become the only freshman pitcher in program history to be honored with all-conference honors during their debut season. Maddison Kopeke rounded out the SEC accolades with a selection to the SEC All-Newcomer Team.

Lowe would go on to be one of 15 finalists for the Schutt Sports/

NFCA Division I National Freshman of the Year award and would secure NFCA All-Southeast Region Third Team honors.

Dean's third season at Auburn was shortened due to the COVID-19 pandemic. Before the 2020 season was halted, Dean helped the Tigers to 16 wins, highlighted by victories over No. 25 Northwestern and No. 16 Minnesota. The Tigers made program history on March 2, 2020, when Alyssa Rivera (Player), Samantha Yarbrough (Pitcher) and Carlee McCondichie (Freshmen) swept the SEC's weekly awards. It marked the first time Auburn has swept all three SEC awards.

Auburn closed the 2019 season with a 39-21 overall record, earning its sixth straight NCAA Tournament bid. The Tigers closed the conference slate with a 10-14 mark and earned a spot in the 2019 SEC Softball Tournament semifinals. Dean guided Kendall Veach to All-SEC and NFCA All-Region team honors. The program made history as the senior class was drafted in the 2019 National Pro Fastpitch Draft.

Dean led Auburn to a 15-0 start to open the 2018 season, which tied the best start in program history and were the most wins in SEC history among first-year head coaches. He earned his 500th career win during the Wilson/DeMarini Classic when Auburn earned a shutout win over Western Illinois on Mar. 4. He led the Tigers to their 800th win in program history with a 2-1 victory over Kennesaw State on April 4.

Dean came to Auburn after five seasons as the head coach at James Madison. During his five-year stint at James Madison, Dean compiled a record of 237-56 (.809). He amassed five 40-win seasons, including the final two campaigns with 52 and 50 victories, respectively. The Dukes broke 104 program records, including over 40 pitching records while boasting one of the nation's top staffs under Dean's guidance.

Prior to his reign in Harrisonburg, Va., Dean spent six seasons as the head coach at Radford where he took the Highlanders to their first-ever NCAA Tournament appearances in 2009 and 2010. Before taking the position at Radford, Dean served as an assistant coach at Akron (2001-02), Indiana (2002-04) and Longwood (2005-06).

In addition to his collegiate coaching experience, Dean has also worked on the professional and international level.

He was the pitching coach for the Venezuelan National Team (2002-08) and the head coach for the Chicago Bandits (2004-10) that finished as the National Pro Fastpitch regular season champions five times and won the title in 2008.

Dean was named NPF Manager of the Year three times and coached world-renowned pitcher Jennie Finch, who was the NPF's Co-Pitcher of the Year in 2005 and has a gold and silver medal from her two Team USA Olympic appearances.

A 1987 graduate of Elon University, Dean was a pitcher on the baseball team where he was a four-year letterwinner.

Dean and his wife, Liz, have one son, Isaac, and one daughter, Caroline.

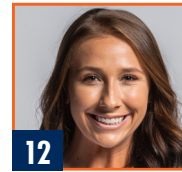

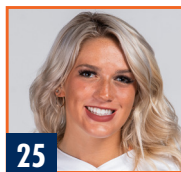

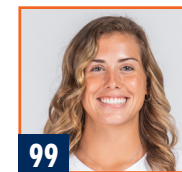
