BIG OPPORTUNITY AWAITS NO. 6 AUBURN VS. NO. 3 FLORIDA

The No. 6 Auburn gymnastics team has a chance to make history once again on Friday night as the squad hosts No. 3 Florida in Auburn Arena.

With a win over the Gators, the Tigers can clinch a share of the SEC regular-season championship for the first time in program history.

"There hasn't been a bigger home meet ever than Friday," head coach Jeff Graba said. "Our athletes come to Auburn for moments like to and for a chance to win a championship. We're really excited to see what Friday brings."

Florida has already clinched the other half of the shared conference crown and a win would snap a 38-match skid to the Gators, dating back to 2004.

"Florida comes to town with a ton of experience and not that much pressure," Graba said. "It's just another meet, but it is a big opportunity to show who we are and to make a lot of history."

The meet itself is scheduled to begin at 7 p.m. CT and will be streamed live on SEC Network+.

The Tigers are also set to recognize four seniors at the end of the meet in Jada Glenn, Derrian Gobourne, Allie Riddle and Drew Watson. In addition, the meet is the team's Alumni Meet and over 80 former Tiger gymnasts are set to attend.

Head coach Jeff Graba has put the Auburn gymnastics program on the map throughout his 10+ years on the Plains. Now entering his 12th season at the helm in 2022, Graba and the Tigers are looking to build on their accomplishments to reach bigger feats in the sport.

The Minnesota native was named SEC Coach of the Year in 2014 and 2015 and SEC co-Coach of the Year in 2012.

Most recently, Graba and his staff guided Derrian Gobourne to the 2021 SEC Co-Specialist of the Year as she excelled on vault, bars, and floor. She was a first team All-American and All-SEC on floor as well. In addition, they helped Drew Watson and Cassie Stevens to All-SEC recognition.

The coaching staff guided a pair of Tigers to All-America honors in 2020. Watson picked up first team recognition on vault and finished with an NQS of 9.92 in the event to finish in a tie for seventh nationally. Her selection marked the first All-America honor for a Tiger in the category since 2016.

Gobourne was placed on the second team on bars in 2020. Her All-America honor in the event is the first for any Tiger on bars at the conclusion of the regular season. Gobourne finished tied for 14th nationally with a 9.905.

The 2020 squad enjoyed a wealth of accomplishments throughout the season, including a win over Alabama in Auburn Arena to kick off the home schedule.

Auburn's performances in 2019 was one for the books as they reached the sport's first-ever Sweet Sixteen and finished 16th in the final rankings. Auburn reached the second round of the NCAA Regional Championship with a 197.075 in Baton Rouge, marking the highest regional score in program history.

The program saw its first national champion in 2019 when Gobourne came in a tie for first at that 2019 National Championship on vault. The then-freshman scored a career-best 9.95, picking up All-America honors along the way. In addition, Gobourne earned All-SEC and Freshman All-SEC recognition.

Samantha Cerio secured SEC Scholar Athlete of the Year for the sport in 2019.

Graba and the 2016 team added to the list of firsts for the program under his guidance. The Tigers snapped the 117-meet losing skid to Alabama in February of that season, defeating the Crimson Tide at home (197.275-197.250). Auburn also defeated Georgia in Athens for the first time in program history, setting a new program-high road score on the way (197.325).

In addition, the Tigers earned the program's first No. 1 NCAA regional seed and captured the NCAA Ann Arbor Regional title with a 196.525.

Auburn enjoyed a breakout season in 2015 as Graba led the Tigers to the NCAA Championship Super Six for the first time in 22 years. That season, Auburn broke or tied 52 program records that season.

Auburn's sixth place finish at the Super Six was the Tigers' second best in history and highest since 1993 with a NCAA nationals record score of 197.075. The Tigers also had a program record Super Six score of 195.625.

Auburn reached the 2015 NCAA Championship for the first time since 2003 and for only the fourth time overall.

In 11 seasons, Graba has led his student-athletes to 16 All-America honors (both NACGC/W and NCAA) and 22 All-SEC recognitions. Leading the way was Caitlin Atkinson who amassed nine All-America nods and named SEC Gymnast of the Year in 2016.

With the help of continuous progress, Graba and the Tigers have enjoyed growth when it comes to home attendance each season. Each season, the team's attendance average has climbed higher and higher and after averaging just 3,583 fans in his first season, Auburn finished the 2020 season with a new program record average of 6,364 fans. In addition, the Tigers have enjoyed 10 sellouts of Auburn Arena (7,424).

Away from competition, Graba's teams have also been outstanding in the classroom. In total, the Tigers have totaled 45 NACGC/W Scholastic All-America nods and 105 SEC Academic Honor Roll recognitions.

Graba was named Auburn head coach on August 16, 2010 after spending five years as an assistant coach at Utah. While with the Utes, he earned the 2009 West Region Assistant Coach of the Year while coaching bars, collaborating on floor routines and serving as the recruiting coordinator.

During his first four years as an assistant, Utah finished as the NCAA runner-up three times and placed third once. Graba has also coached nine NCAA All-American gymnasts to 20 All-America performances.

As Utah's bars coach, he tutored Kristina Baskett to a 2006 NCAA uneven bars title as a freshman in his first trip to the NCAA Championships.

Prior to his stint at Utah, Graba spent two years as an assistant coach at Utah State. In 2005, he coached the Aggies to their first Western Gymnastics Conference championship and their first regional appearance in three years. In addition to his coaching duties, he served as the head of recruiting and assisted with the strength and conditioning program.

From 1995-2003, Graba was the co-owner and head coach of Midwest Gymnastics Club in Arden Hills, Minn. He had three gymnasts qualify Elite in his last three years with the club and had several level 8, 9 and 10 regional and national competitors.

Graba's collegiate coaching career began at Hamline University from 1992-98. While in St. Paul, Minn., his highlights included six-consecutive trips to the Division III National Championships and a runner-up finish in 1996. Eleven of his gymnasts combined to win 26 National Collegiate Gymnastics Association (NCGA) All-America citations.

Graba is a native of Forest Lake, Minn., and graduated from the University of Minnesota in 1992 with a bachelor's degree in economics and earned his M.B.A. from Salem International University in 2011. He and his wife, Bridget, have five children: Bryan, Jaymie, Jason, Kyla and Shayla.

AUBURN POTENTIAL LINEUPS

Depth and experience with a mix of new talent is what the Tigers will bring to the table in 2022.

Auburn will lead things off on vault where it ranks sixth nationally. Seniors Derrian Gobourne and Drew Watson lead the squad. Watson is among the nation's top 15 in the event, while Gobourne is tied for 17th.

Freshmen Sophia Groth, Sara Hubbard and Sunisa Lee have all done well for the Tigers in the event this season, including a 9.925 from Lee. Sophomores Tara Walsh and Gabby McLaughlin with junior Cassie Stevens are also among the team's top eight.

Rotation two has the team on bars and will be led by experience bar workers. Lee is third nationally with a 9.935 NQS and a 10.0 under her belt. Gobourne, Aria Bruschi, Sabados, Piper Smith and Stevens all add experience and big scores to the team's top eight.

Groth and sophomore Gabby McLaughlin have also worked their way into Auburn's potential lineup for bars.

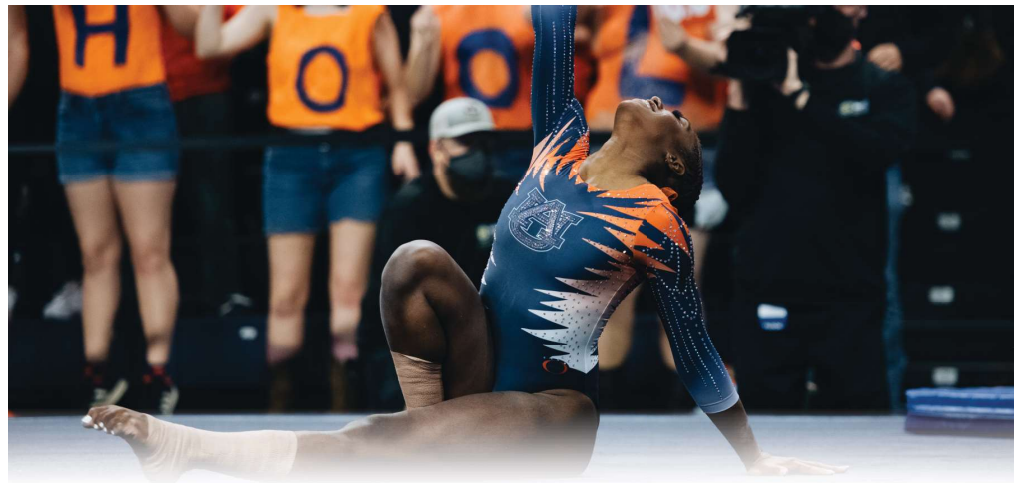
Auburn's beam squad ranks fourth nationally at 49.395. Lee is tied for third in the nation at 9.940 and earned her first 10.0 last week. Groth is also in the top 10 nationally at 9.920.

Sophomore Olivia Hollingsworth with Bruschi, Smith, Stevens and McLaughlin all bring big scoring potential to the lineup. Fifth year Allie Riddle is also once again among the top eight with an opportunity to compete.

Auburn's floor top eight will be highlighted by Lee, Gobourne and Watson. Hubbard and Groth are once again listed among the team's best, while Stevens, Sabados and fellow junior Morgan Leigh Oldham are also pushing for a spot in the lineup.

GYMNAST TO WATCH: DERRIAN GOBOURNE

IN THE RANKINGS

The Auburn gymnastics team stands at No. 6 in this week's RoadToNationals.com rankings with a National Qualifying Score of 197.455.

"We are simply trying to improve every meet as we progress towards the postseason," head coach Jeff Graba said. "We have an opportunity this week to compete for a championship against a juggernaut of a gymnastics program. Being ranked sixth just helps us host yet another top 10 matchup in Auburn Arena."

Auburn's beam squad continues to hold strong to No. 4 nationally with a 49.395. Freshman Sunisa Lee is tied for third in the event at 9.940 after earning her first 10.0 in the event last Friday. Classmate Sophia Groth is tied for eighth at 9.920.

The team is sixth on vault (49.320) and floor (49.415) and is ninth on bars (49.325).

Lee is second nationally on bars at 9.935. Drew Watson is tied for 11th on vault (9.895), while Derrian Gobourne is tied for 17th (9.885). Gobourne is tied for eighth on floor (9.930) with Lee coming in tied for 13th (9.925).

SEC WEEKLY HONORS

Freshmen Sunisa Lee picked up another Southeastern Conference weekly award as she was named the SEC Freshman of the Week, the league office announced.

The weekly honor is her fourth of the season - Freshman (February 1), Gymnast (February 8), Gymnast (February 22), Freshman (March 1).

The St. Paul, Minnesota native won her fifth-consecutive all-around title with a 39.775. In addition, she captured three event crowns on the night.

Highlighting her evening was her first 10.0 on beam as she won her fourth beam title this

season. That perfect score was also a first for an Auburn Tiger in Auburn Arena.

She won her seventh-straight bars title with a 9.975. It was the first time any collegiate gymnast has done the skill in competition.

Lee capped the evening with a career-high 9.975 on floor for her third-straight floor title. Lee and the Tigers went on to break the program record on floor with a 49.625.

SEC TITLE ON THE LINE

Auburn has a chance to win a share of the Southeastern Conference regular season title this Friday vs. Florida.

With a win over the Gators, Auburn will share the league crown with Florida. The conference title will be the first for Auburn.

In addition, a win over Florida would snap a 38-match ski. Auburn's last win vs. UF came in 2004 at home when the Tigers edged visiting Florida, 197.000-196.900.

MOVING ON UP

Auburn continues to improve in all events and the progress has been reflected in its weekly rankings.

The Tigers are holding strong on beam, ranking fourth nationally with a 49.315. Three of the program's top scores in the event have come this season, including a program-best 49.625 vs. Missouri (2/11).

Auburn has moved up to sixth on vault (49.320) and floor (49.415). The squad set a program record on floor last Friday, earning a 49.675 vs. Kentucky.

The team also saw big improvement on bars and currently ranks ninth nationally at 49.325. The squad had a season-best 49.575 vs. Kentucky last week, which ranks

second all time.

LAST TIME VS. FLORIDA - FEB. 26, 2021

The No. 18 Auburn gymnastics team earned a big road score, finishing with a 197.025 in the Stephen C. O'Connell Center in Gainesville. The No. 1 Florida Gators finished with a 198.275 to win the meet.

The road score was the team's highest of the year away from the Plains and the third highest overall in 2021.

Derrian Gobourne was back in the all-around for the Tigers, setting a career-best with a 39.575. The Sarasota, Fla., put together big scores all night, earning a 9.95 on floor with one judge giving her a 10. She kicked things off with a 9.9 on bars and followed with a 9.875 on vault. Her 9.85 on beam to close out the night set a career best.

With 17 of 24 routines coming from sophomores and freshmen, Auburn saw big scores throughout the meet as the squad set or tied 10 season or career highs on the night.

RECORDS FALL VS. KENTUCKY

Sunisa Lee won the all-around with a 39.775 to lead No. 5 Auburn to a 197.925-197.150 win over Kentucky, the highest score in program history and the Tigers' seventh consecutive 197 or better.

Lee performed the Nabieva on bars, earning a 10.0 from one judge and scoring a 9.975.

Aria Brusch returned to the lineup, scoring a career-high 9.95 on bars.

Tied after three rotations, it came down to Auburn's floor vs. Kentucky's beam. The Wildcats applied pressure with two 9.950s

but Auburn answered with five 9.9s or better, totaling a whopping 49.675 – a program record – while Kentucky had to count one of two beam falls.

Freshman Sophia Groth got Auburn off to a strong start on bars, leading off with a career-high 9.875. Junior Cassie Stevens preceded Brusch and earned a career best 9.925, helping Auburn score 49.575.

After a slow start on beam, the Tigers' finished strong with Groth's 9.950, sophomore Gabby McLaughlin's 9.925 and Lee's 10.0 to tie Kentucky 148.250-148.250.

On floor, Sara Hubbard led off with a 9.9, followed by Drew Watson's 9.925 and Stevens' 9.9. Lee and Gobourne each earned a 10.0 from one judge while scoring 9.975s to share the event title and clinch victory for Auburn.

BIG MEET IN BATON ROUGE

It was a fun Saturday afternoon in the Pete Maravich Assembly Center, Feb. 5, as Auburn set a program road record with a 197.750 and freshman Sunisa Lee earned perfect score on bars and a program best in the all-around.

The team's score tied the program's record set on Feb. 27, 2015 in Auburn Arena.

Lee captured the all-around title with a 39.825, setting an Auburn record in the category. That score also tied for the nation's best so far this season.

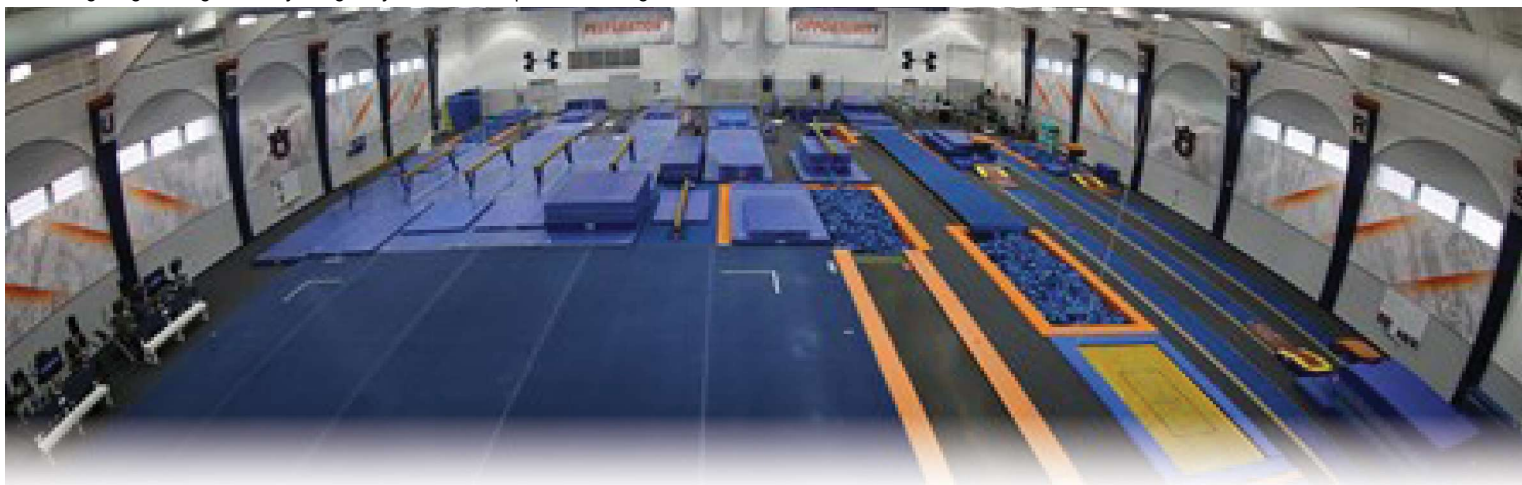
Her 10.0 on bars marked the first time since 2004 that a Tiger was awarded a perfect score. In addition, Lee captured the beam crown with a 9.975. She added career highs on vault and floor, scoring a 9.9 and 9.95.
