**GAMEDAY EXPERIENCE: AUBURN ARENA**

>> Neville Arena is in its seventh season as home of Auburn volleyball. The Tigers are 60-56 since moving to the Arena in 2013. The facility seats approximately 2,000 fans for volleyball and 9,121 for basketball.



**FIRST SERVE**

» Along with Rath, Jackie Barrett, Jordan Sinness, Fallan Lanham and Cassidy Tanton all return to the Plains for another year. Tanton redshirted 2021 while Barrett and Sinness each saw time at setter. Lanham played in all 28 matches, starting 19 of them.

» Crouch also welcomes two new assistants to his staff this season. Keith Smith joins the fray after a wealth of success with Grand Canyon's men's team as well as some work with USA Volleyball.

» Rachel Corbelli arrives in Auburn after seven years with Austin Juniors, one of the top club volleyball programs in the country. Her coaching lineage runs deep as Rachel is the daughter of John and Laurie Corbelli, long-time coaches at Texas A&M. Her brother, Russell, is also an assistant at Missouri.

» Auburn will be eyeing a similar start to 2021. Last season, the Tigers began the year 6-0 matching the program's best mark since 2012 and tied the record for most sweeps to start a year with five.

**LAST TIME OUT**

» Auburn fans haven't seen the Tigers suit up since Nov. 26 of last year when they rounded out the 2021 against Mississippi State. Rebekah Rath added 12 kills to her record-setting season and despite extra points in the third set, Auburn couldn't muscle past the Bulldogs, 0-3 (23-25, 23-25, 26-28).

**SCOUTING BELMONT**

» Head coach Katelyn Harrison enters her fourth year at the helm of the Bruin Volleyball program. In 2021, Harrison's squad garnered nine wins, the most since 2017. This season marks a different milestone for Belmont athletics, moving from the Ohio Valley Conference to the Missouri Valley Conference.

» Junior outside hitting Laura Shoopman has already shown her prowess in the preseason. The Salem, Wisconsin native stacked up 20 kills with a .485 hitting percentage in an exhibition against fellow SEC member Tennessee over the weekend.

» Like Auburn, the Bruins bring an abundance of youth to the matchup. Six freshmen and Syracuse transfer Peyton O'Brien will all compete for pivotal roles on the team.

**AUBURN-BELMONT SERIES**

» Friday morning marks the second meeting between the two programs. The Tigers and Bruins met for the first time last season at Neville Arena. Auburn swept Belmont 3-0, (25-8, 25-12, 25-12) in mid-September of 2021.

**SCOUTING GEORGIA STATE**

» It's a new era in Atlanta for Georgia State Volleyball. Terry Hutchinson makes his debut as head coach for the Panthers after five years serving under Don Metil at Towson. Hutchinson's Tiger teams made three straight

NCAA Tournament appearances and a handful of 20-win seasons.

» The Panthers graduated standout middle blocker Meisheia Griffin but return the likes of Isabelle Percoco, Julianna Truscott and Laura Ehieze in the front row along with the 2021 dig leader Ava Vlkovic, who ranked eighth in the Sun Belt in total digs a season ago.

**AUBURN-GEORGIA STATE SERIES**

» Auburn and Georgia State have met 18 times across the history of the two schools. However, the Tigers and Panthers haven't locked horns since Aug. 28 of 2007 when Auburn swept Georgia State 3-0, (30-23, 30-25, 30-16).

**SCOUTING MARIST**

» Thirteenth-year head coach Sean Byron brings a Marist team to Atlanta that was picked to finish fourth in the MAAC preseason coaches poll. The Red Foxes also bolstered two players named to the Preseason All-MAAC team.

» Sophomore Jordan Newblatt led Maris in kills a season ago and finished second in digs. The Clarkston, Michigan native also reset her own single-match kills record with 34 against Niagara.

» Setter McKinley Fox returns for her senior campaign. Last season, Fox piled up 25 aces, 261 digs and 48 blocks to go with her 1,096 assists.

» As a team, Byron's Red Foxes ranked inside the top five in the MAAC in nearly every statistical category but particularly excelled in digs. Marist ranked No. 32 nationally in total digs in 2021 with 1,902.

**AUBURN-MARIST SERIES**

» Auburn's only matchup with Marist came in 2002 when the Tigers bested the Red Foxes, 3-1 (34-32, 19-30, 30-20, 30-23) in Hartford, Connecticut. However, the two schools haven't met since the dawn of the 25-point rally scoring era.

**SEC KEEPS CONFERENCE SCHEDULING FORMAT FOR 2022 CAMPAIGN**

» The Southeastern Conference announced a new scheduling format for its conference slate ahead of the 2021 campaign and will continue the format in 2022.

» The SEC schedule consists of 18 matches in which each member institution will play each other at least once. The order of opponents for each team was determined by a random computer draw.

» Two-match series may be played Wednesday/Thursday, Thursday/Friday, Friday/Saturday or Saturday/Sunday per the league office.

» In his first full season at the helm of the Auburn Volleyball program, head coach Brent Crouch showed glimpses to the Tiger Faithful of what his teams might be

able to accomplish in the years to come.

» Under his watch, Rebekah Rath set the single-season kills record with 438 and was No. 1 in the SEC in kills per set at 4.25.

» The team secured its highest blocks per set average at 2.44 in 21 years.

» Auburn's 6-0 start to the 2021 season was its best since 2012.

» The Tigers' five sweeps to begin the year were tied for the most in Auburn history.

» Crouch guided Auburn to its first win over Missouri since 1996 and the first-ever win in College Station over Texas A&M.

**FEEL THE RATH AGAIN?**

» Rebekah Rath returns for her senior season on the Plains. The Altamonte Springs, Florida product reset the record book last season in total kills (438) and kills per set (4.25). Rath led the SEC in kills per set and was second overall in total kills.

**FRESH WHAT? FRESHMEN**

» Seven freshmen have made their way to Auburn this fall and each of them are vying for pivotal roles this season. Brent Crouch enters his second season as the head coach of the Auburn volleyball team after guiding the program through the challenges of the COVID-19 pandemic during his first season on The Plains.

Crouch made his Auburn coaching debut against No. 4 Florida on Oct. 21, 2020, to open the shortened fall volleyball schedule. Crouch led the Tigers on the court for eight total matches.

The fall season was highlighted by Auburn setting the program record for blocks in a four-set match as the Tigers recorded 17 at South Carolina on Oct. 29, 2020. The previous mark of 14 was set on Nov. 9, 2014 against Tennessee. The total tied for the second-most blocks in a match in Auburn program history as was the most by the Tigers since 2009.

Due to injuries and opt-out, the Tigers were unable to compete in the spring portion of the amended 2020-21 schedule.

Crouch previously served as the head coach at the University of Southern California. In two seasons at USC, Crouch led the program to consecutive NCAA second round appearances, including a second-place finish in the Pac-12, and a No. 21 ranking in the season's final AVCA poll in his first season on campus in 2018. This past season, the Trojans were 18-14, while outside hitter Kholia Lanier became the fifth player in Pac-12 history to record 2,000 kills and 1,000 digs in career.

Under Crouch in 2018, the Trojans finished 22-11 overall with a 13-7 record in Pac-12 matches. USC played one of the toughest schedules in the nation and faced 18 ranked opponents in the regular season and were awarded the No. 11 overall seed in the NCAA Tournament. Setter Raquel Lázaro was named the Pac-12 Freshman of the Year and outside hitter Brooke Borikin was chosen for second-team AVCA All-America honors. Lázaro and Lanier were each tabbed for All-America honorable mention.

Under Crouch's tutelage, outside hitter Emilia Weske was tabbed to the Pac-12's All-Freshman Team while middle blocker Jasmine Gross added All-Pac 12 honors.

Prior to arriving at Troy, Crouch was the 2016 West Coast Conference Coach of the Year. He inherited a winless Portland program and within two seasons guided the Pilots to their winningest season in 25 years. Crouch first took over at Portland in 2014 after the Pilots went 0-27 the previous season. After going 7-23 in his debut season, he guided the Pilots to a 16-15 mark in 2015 (its most victories since 1991) and then improved upon that in 2016 with a 17-13 mark. His 2017 team, which was hampered by injuries, was 15-15, with five losses coming in five-set matches. His overall four-year record at Portland was 55-66.

The 48 victories in his final three years was Portland's best three-season total since 1984-86. The Pilots' 10-8 third place WCC finish in 2016 was its most league wins since 1985 and highest conference finish since 1989. He led Portland to the program's first-ever victories over Top 10, Top 15, and Top 25 opponents. Crouch coached three All-WCC first team players and a WCC All-Freshman team pick, along with three WCC All-Academic first teamers. He also helped establish beach volleyball as a varsity sport at Portland in 2016.

Crouch arrived at Portland after four seasons (2010-13) at Saint Mary's College, where he was an assistant with the indoor program and head coach of the beach team.

During his time at SMC, the Gaels' indoor team went 73-40 overall, finished in the top three in the WCC standings each season by winning 73.4 percent of its league matches (47-17) and earned a berth into the NCAA Tournament in 2012, advancing to the second round. Besides being involved in the team's offense and defense, recruiting, scouting, practice planning, statistical and video analysis and scheduling, he provided academic support, as he mentored several WCC All-Academic honorees and helped the team to the athletic department's highest grade point average, an NCAA Public Recognition Award, and an AVCA academic award.

Crouch also coached the inaugural Saint Mary's beach team in 2013, guiding the Gaels to an 8-2 record, the best mark among all Northern California teams, as well as a No. 9 national ranking and a bid to the AVCA national championship for the program's top pairs team.

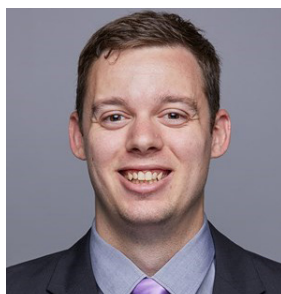
