AUBURN OPENS 2023 SEASON AT SUPER 16

The No. 5 Auburn gymnastics team kicks off the 2023 season at the inaugural Super 16 in Las Vegas Saturday night. The Tigers will face No. 1 Oklahoma, No. 4 Michigan and No. 10 UCLA in a quad meet in the Orleans Arena at 8 p.m. CT.

"This is full speed for us to start the season," head coach Jeff Graba said. "We're hitting the ground running against three former national champions. We're looking forward to being a part of the big match up on Saturday. It just says a lot about how far this program has come and showcases all the hard work this team has put in."

Head coach Jeff Graba has put the Auburn gymnastics program on the map throughout his 10+ years on the Plains. Now entering his 13th season at the helm in 2023, Graba is poised to lead the Tigers through another record-breaking year.

The Minnesota native was named SEC Coach of the Year in 2014 and 2015 and SEC co-Coach of the Year in 2012.

The 2022 season was one for the record books. The team broke or tied every single record possible – overall and home score (198.575), road score (197.8375), vault (t-49.500), bars (49.675), beam (49.725) and floor (49.800). Eleven of the program's top 12 scores came in 2023.

In addition, the Tigers set or tied all individual records – vault: Drew Watson and Cassie Stevens (9.975); bars: Sunisa Lee (2x, 10.0); beam: Sunisa Lee (3x, 10.0); floor: Derrian Gobourne (10.0); all-around: Sunisa Lee (39.825).

Lee, the 2021 Olympic Gold Medalist in the all-around, finished with eight All-American honors, was NCAA champion on beam and SEC champion on bars. She was named the 2022 SEC Freshman of the Year and a finalist for the Honda Award.

Gobourne finished with three All-America honors and was named the SEC Co-Specialist of the Year for the second season in a row. Sophia Groth earned two All-America honors, while freshman Sara Hubbard and Watson finished as All-Americans on vault.

As a team, the Tigers secured the program's best finish as the squad reached the Final Four and finished fourth overall. Auburn's third-place finish at the SEC Championship was also the program's best in the eight-team format.

Gobourne was the 2021 SEC Co-Specialist of the Year as she excelled on vault, bars, and floor. She was a first team All-American and All-SEC on floor as well.

The coaching staff guided a pair of Tigers to All-America honors in 2020. Watson picked up first team recognition for her performances on vault. Her selection marked the first All-America honor for a Tiger in the category since 2016.

Gobourne was placed on the second team for her efforts on bars in 2020. Her All-America honor in the event is the first for any Tiger on bars at the conclusion of the regular season.

Auburn's performances in 2019 were big for the program as the squad reached the sport's first-ever Sweet Sixteen and finished 16th in the final rankings.

The program saw its first national champion in 2019 when Gobourne came in a tie for first at that 2019 National Championship on vault. The then-freshman scored a career-best 9.95, picking up All-America honors along the way.

In addition, Samantha Cerio secured the SEC Scholar Athlete of the Year for the sport.

Graba and the 2016 team added to the list of firsts for the program under his guidance. The Tigers snapped the 117-meet losing skid to Alabama, defeating the Crimson Tide at home (197.275-197.250). Auburn also defeated Georgia in Athens for the first time in program history, setting a new program-high road score on the way (197.325).

In addition, the Tigers earned the program's first No. 1 NCAA regional seed and captured the NCAA Ann Arbor Regional title with a 196.525.

Auburn enjoyed a breakout season in 2015 as Graba led the Tigers to the NCAA Championship Super Six for the first time in 22 years. Auburn's sixth place finish at the Super Six was the Tigers' third best in history and highest since 1993 with a score of 197.075. The Tigers finished the Super Six with a score of 195.625.

In 12 seasons, Graba has led his student-athletes to 31 All-America honors (both WCGA and NCAA) and 30 All-SEC recognitions. Leading the way was Caitlin Atkinson who amassed nine All-America nods and named SEC Gymnast of the Year in 2016.

Graba and the Tigers have enjoyed growth when it comes to home attendance. The team's attendance has reached its peak after averaging just 3,583 fans in his first season.

The 2022 Tigers increased attendance in Neville Arena and sold out all five home meets (9,121). The Tigers have enjoyed 15 sellouts.

Away from competition, Graba's teams have also been outstanding in the classroom. In total, the Tigers have totaled 54 NACGC/W Scholastic All-America nods and 122 SEC Academic Honor Roll recognitions.

Graba was named Auburn head coach on August 16, 2010. He came to The Plains after spending five years as an assistant coach at Utah. While with the Utes, he earned the 2009 West Region Assistant Coach of the Year.

Graba is a native of Forest Lake, Minn., and graduated from the University of Minnesota in 1992 with a bachelor's degree in economics and earned his M.B.A. from Salem International University in 2011. He and his wife, Bridget, have five children: Bryan, Jaymie, Jason, Kyla and Shayla.

Auburn’s opponents on Saturday night have won the last four national titles. The Sooners took the crown in 2019 and 2022, while Michigan won it all in 2021 and the Bruins finished first in 2018.

“The last three teams to win the national champion will be on the floor with us,” Graba said. “However, it’s still our first meet. We want to win and score high, but there are still things that need to happen in the first meet that we don’t want to forget about. We’re excited to be a part of this and to see where we line up against these historic programs.”

The Tigers will compete in the fourth of four sessions spread over two days and the meet will be televised on Big Ten Network.

AUBURN POTENTIAL LINEUPS

The 2023 Auburn gymnastics squad brings a wealth of experience to the table this season as the team lost just two routines from 2022. The tentative lineup features one fifth year, five seniors, two juniors and four sophomores.

Auburn will start the Super 16 final session on bars in the first rotation. The Tigers return all routines from a 2022 team that finished fifth in the regular season with an NQS of 49.490.

All-Americans Derrian Gobourne and Sunisa Lee will bring a wealth of talent to the lineup as Gobourne was national runner-up in the event and Lee was the SEC bars champion. Seniors Adeline Sabados and Cassie Stevens have been mainstays on bars throughout their careers and are among the top eight.

Juniors Olivia Hollingsworth and Gabby McLaughlin have also worked their way into the potential bars lineupe, while sophomore Sophia Groth and senior Anna Sumner are also vying for a spot.

The Tigers will move to beam for rotation two and also return all routines from last year. Auburn finished fourth nationally with an NQS of 49.485.

The squad will be led by All-Americans Lee and Groth. Lee is the NCAA champion in the event, while Groth is a two-time All-American and All-SEC performer on beam. McLaughlin, Hollingsworth, Stevens and senior Aria Brusch all return from last year’s lineup with big scoring potential, while senior Morgan Leigh Oldham and sophomore Sara Hubbard have earned a spot in the top eight.

Auburn heads to floor for the third rotation and return all but one routine from the previous season. Gobourne headlines the floor lineup after finishing second nationally and earning two All-America honors in the event last year.

Brusch, Lee and Stevens also return from the lineup that was sixth nationally with a 49.500 NQS. Hollingsworth, Hubbard, McLaughlin and Oldham have earned a spot in the top eight as well for the squad.

The Tigers finish the meet on vault – an event that had them finish fifth in the nation with a 49.400. Looking to bring solid 10.0 vaults this year will be All-American Gobourne and Hubbard as well as Lee and Stevens. Joining them in the top eight is sophomore Ananda Brown as well as Groth, Hollingsworth and Sabados.

NEW FACES

The Auburn coaching staff welcomed two new members this past summer in associate head coach Sara Carver-Milne and volunteer assistant Rachael Donovan.

Carver-Milne came to the Plains after spending the last 21 seasons at Brown University. She was named ECAC Conference Head Coach of the

Year twice during her career and improved Brown's RQS by seven points since taking over the program, breaking every individual and team record during her tenure.

She guided her 2022 team to school records in overall score, vault, bars and floor.

She is no stranger to recruiting and coaching some of the world's top gymnasts as she coached Olympian and World Champion Alicia Sacramone in 2007.

Donovan joins the Tiger staff after spending a year as volunteer assistant for Illinois women's gymnastics. She'll be working with all aspects of the program, including floor and beam coaching and choreography.

Donovan is a former Illini gymnast who competed from 2016-19. After graduating, she coached at Hills Gymnastics and at the Parkettes Gymnastics Training Center, working with Level 10 and elite gymnasts.

As a gymnast, Donovan was a consistent bars worker throughout her career. In addition, she was an Academic All-Big Ten honoree.

RECORD NUMBER OF AWARDS

The Tigers brought in a wealth of awards throughout the 2022 season and at the conclusion of the year. Five gymnasts combined for a program record 15 All-America honors, including 11 from the freshmen class.

Sunisa Lee led the way with eight All-America recognitions. She picked up four regular season honors and four at the NCAA Championships, including two first team finishes in the all-around and beam. She secured first team honors on bars at the end of the regular season and first team on floor at NCAAs.

Derrian Gobourne was first team on floor both in the regular season and at NCAAs.

She also secured first team recognition on bars at the national meet. Sophia Groth earned a pair of All-America honors on beam, while Drew Watson and Sara Hubbard earned first team on vault at nationals.

In addition, Lee and Gobourne were awarded by the Southeastern Conference at the end of the season as Lee was named Freshman of the Year and Gobourne earned her second-straight Specialist of the Year honor.

Lee, Gobourne, Groth and junior Aria Brusch all were placed on the All-SEC team.

To add to her long list of accolades, Lee was named the WCGA Regional Gymnast of the Year and was a Honda Award finalist.

Lee was named SEC Gymnast of the Week three times and SEC Freshman of the Week twice. Groth earned four weekly awards, while Gobourne secured SEC Specialist of the Week once.

RECORD SETTERS

The 2022 season was one for the record books. The team broke or tied every single record possible – overall and home score (198.575), road score (197.8375), vault (t-49.500), bars (49.675), beam (49.725) and floor (49.800). Eleven of the program's top 12 scores came in 2023.

PRESEASON RANKING

The Auburn gymnastics team is picking up where it left off last season, setting another program best as the Tigers were picked No. 5 in the Women's Collegiate Gymnastics As-

sociation's Preseason Poll. The ranking is the highest preseason ranking in program history.

The team's previous preseason ranking record was No. 8 heading into the 2017 season.

"This is an exciting time for Auburn gymnastics," head coach Jeff Graba said. "I'm very happy that our peers see us as being talented enough for this ranking and we're looking forward to what 2023 will bring."

Five Southeastern Conference teams are ranked in the top 10, while all eight league schools rank in the top 20.

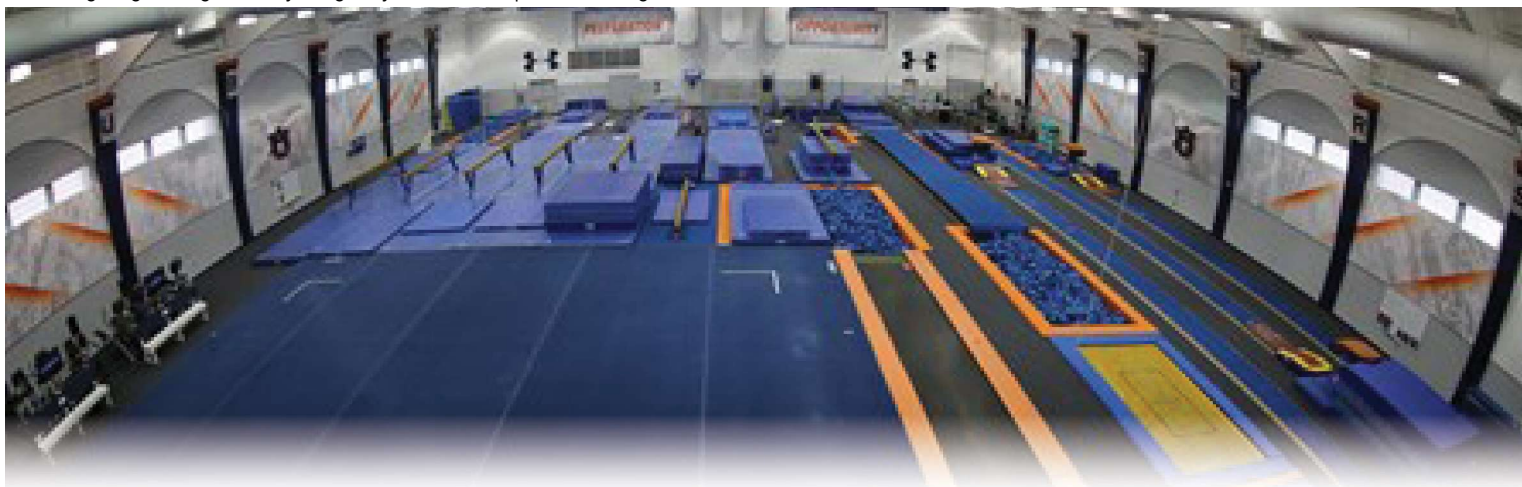
Oklahoma is ranked No. 1 with Florida (2), Utah (3), Michigan (4) and Auburn rounding out the top five. LSU and Alabama are ranked Nos. 6 and 7, while Missouri came in at ninth. Kentucky (11), Arkansas (15) and Georgia (20) rounded out the rest of the SEC.
