OPENING TIP

- » Auburn plays its second of two exhibition contests Thursday, Nov. 2, as the Columbus State Cougars visit Neville Arena.
- » Auburn finished the 2022-23 season 16-15 overall, 5-11 in SEC play, and advanced to the second round of the WNIT.
- » Columbus State finished 15-12 overall, 9-10 in Peach Belt Conference play last season.

ON THE AIR

- » Brit Bowen and Larry DiChiara will have the radio call on WAUE 100.3 FM beginning at 6:45 p.m. CT. The broadcast can also be heard on AuburnTigers.com and the Auburn Athletics app.
- » There will be no live video stream available.

LAST TIME OUT

- » Taylen Collins led four Tigers in double figures as Auburn unofficially opened the 2023-24 women's basketball season with a 77-49 exhibition win over West Georgia Monday night at Neville Arena.
- » Along with her 15 points, Collins posted five rebounds, two steals and an assist. Another newcomer, junior college transfer Celia Sumbane, was a perfect 7-for-7 from the field for a 14-point night that also included four rebounds and four steals.
- » Honesty Scott-Grayson poured in 13 points, and Sydney Shaw added 10 with a pair of 3-pointers. Kaitlyn Duhon was a force defensively with six rebounds and a team-best six steals, and JaMya Mingo-Young made the most of her first appearance in orange and blue with a team-best eight rebounds.
- » Mar'Shaun Bostic finished with a team-best five assists to go along with eight points. Freshman Yakiya Milton had a pair of blocks in her Tiger debut.

UP NEXT

- » Auburn opens the 2023-24 regular season Monday, Nov. 6, when the Tigers host Jacksonville State. Game time is 7 p.m. CT at Neville Arena for Tipoff on the Plains.

AN AUBURN WIN WOULD...

- » Improve the Tigers to 24-9 all-time in exhibition games.

AUBURN-COLUMBUS STATE SERIES

- » Despite being separated by just a little over 40 miles, this is the first meeting between Auburn and Columbus State in women's basketball.

SCOUTING COLUMBUS STATE

- » Columbus State finished 15-12 overall last year, 9-10 in Peach Belt Conference play.
- » Last season, the Cougars averaged 72.2 points per game while allowing 69.7.
- » CSU was picked to finish second in the Peach Belt for 2023-24. Senior Olonna Rawls was a preseason all-PBC selection; she averaged 13.3 points and 6.8 rebounds to rank in the conference top 10 in both categories.

SCOUTING AUBURN

- » Auburn returns two starters and six total letterwinners from 2022-23, when the Tigers finished 16-15 overall, 5-11 in SEC play. Auburn made its first postseason appearance and secured

its first winning record since 2019 last season, when they advanced to the second round of the WNIT.

- » Graduate student Honesty Scott-Grayson is Auburn's leading returning scorer, averaging 12.7 points, 3.6 rebounds, 2.3 assists and 2.3 steals last season as a redshirt senior. She started 27 games last season and was Auburn's top 3-point shooter, hitting 45-of-122 attempts (36.9%). She also finished third in the SEC in steals per game with 2.3.
- » Scott-Grayson enters her final year at Auburn with 1,065 career points, good for 34th all-time in program history.
- » Sophomore Sydney Shaw started 25 games last season, averaging 7.6 points, and 2.6 rebounds. Possibly the Tigers' best pure shooter, she moves from playing significant minutes at point guard last year to exclusively at the 2-guard spot this season. She was second on the team in 3-point shooting last year, hitting 40-of-118 (33.9%) from deep.
- » Junior Mar'Shaun Bostic was a breakout star in the Tigers' final game of the season, scoring a career-high 23 points in the WNIT second round matchup at Clemson. She played in all 31 games last year, averaging 5.6 points and 1.9 rebounds. Bostic, one of the fastest players in the SEC, looks to play significant minutes at point guard and can be one of the SEC's top defenders.
- » Sophomore Kaitlyn Duhon played in 30 games last season, earning six starts. She averaged 3.8 points and 2.3 rebounds and will likely see significant minutes this season at the 3 or the 4.
- » Eight new players will take the court for Auburn this season - three true freshmen, two junior college transfers and three Division I transfers.
- » Among the Tigers' newcomers, senior Taylen Collins (Oklahoma State) averaged 9.5 points and 9.1 rebounds last year to finish fourth in the Big 12 in rebounding. JaMya Mingo-Young (Alabama/Mississippi State) averaged 5.4 points and 4.4 rebounds in 14 games at Alabama before missing the second half of the season with injury; in 2021-22, she started all 34 games and averaged 11.6 points, 6.7 rebounds, 2.5 assists and finished second in the SEC with 80 steals.
- » JUCO All-Americans Celia Sumbane and McKenna Eddings have been impressive in preseason practice and will likely play significant minutes.
- » Auburn's three freshmen add much-needed size in the post - Yakiya Milton (6-4), Savannah Scott (6-4) and Timya Thurman (6-5).

AUBURN IN EXHIBITIONS

- » This is the third straight season for Auburn to play at least one exhibition game. Last year, the Tigers defeated Tuskegee 81-59 at Neville Arena.
- » The Tigers played three exhibition contests in Europe over the summer, winning all three games.

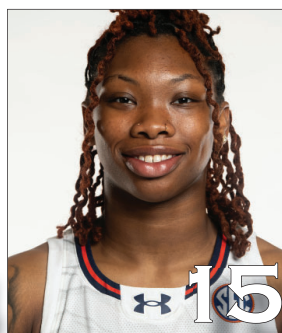

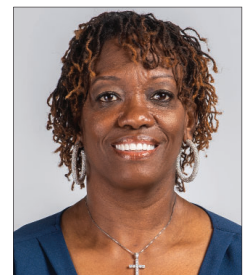
