Auburn Women's Basketball Quick Hitters

- · In eight previous meetings, Auburn and Clemson are tied 4-4
- The teams last met in March when Clemson edged Auburn 56-55 in the second round of the WNIT
- Auburn is 45-26 all-time against current members of the ACC and has faced 13 of 15 member schools (have not played Boston College or Pitt)
- Mar'Shaun Bostic scored a career-high 23 points in the WNIT game at Clemson last year
- Freshman Savannah Scott leads Auburn in field goal percentage at .735
- Scott was named SEC Freshman of the Week after her first career double-double at Rutgers (21 points, 11 rebounds)
- Scott scored 16 points in Auburn's comeback win over Louisiana-Lafayette
- Honesty Scott-Grayson leads the Tigers with 13.8 points/game
- · Scott-Grayson led Auburn with 14 points in the season opening win vs. Jacksonville State, then scored season-highs in back-to-back games with 18 points against both Rutgers and California
- · Sophomore Sydney Shaw scored a career-high 17 points at UCF, then led the Tigers in scoring with 15 vs. Alabama
- Mar'Shaun Bostic matched career highs in assists (4) and steals (4) in the opener vs. JSU, then had a career-high 9 rebounds vs. UL-Lafayette
- · Taylen Collins had a huge second half in the win over ULL with all nine of her points and 8 of her 14 rebounds coming
- Collins recorded her first Auburn double-double with 10 points and 10 rebounds vs. Alabama A&M
- · JaMya Mingo-Young made her Auburn debut with a team-leading 5 assists vs. Cal, then had 7 points and 4 assists at
- Mingo-Young has averaged 4.0 assists in the three games where she has appeared
- · Auburn rallied from 12 points behind to defeat Louisiana-Lafayette on Nov. 9; it was the largest deficit overcome by Auburn since coming back from 14 points down to Ole Miss to win 77-76 in overtime on Jan. 22, 2023
- · Three days later, the Tigers were down 13 at Rutgers in the first quarter and went on a 41-5 run over the next 15 minutes to take as much as a 23-point lead; Auburn would win 76-56
- · Eight players made their Auburn debuts in the win over Jacksonville State Collins, Scott, Milton, Sumbane, Eddins, Gaines, Young and Thurman; Mingo-Young played for the first time as a Tiger vs. Cal
- Auburn is in its 53rd season of women's basketball and has 982 program wins
- Auburn won two exhibitions in late October/early November, beating West Georgia 77-49 and Columbus State 94-65
- · Auburn returns two starters and six letterwinners from the 2022-23 season; the Tigers welcome eight newcomers and one redshirt for this season

- Auburn will look for some payback Thursday night when the Clemson Tigers visit Neville Arena for an 8 p.m. CT tip. The game is part of the inaugural ACC/SEC Challenge.
- » Auburn is 4-2 after snapping a two-game skid with a 68-45 win over Alabama A&M Sunday at home.
- Clemson is 5-3 on the year. The Tigers went 1-2 last weekend at the Van Chancellor Classic in Katy, Texas, defeating Arkansas-Pine Bluff 92-66 in the final game of the tournament.
- Thursday's game is a rematch from what turned out to be Auburn's final game of 2022-23, a 56-55 loss at Clemson in the second round of the WNIT

LAST TIME OUT

- Auburn regained its winning ways Sunday, leading from start to finish in a 68-45 victory over Alabama A&M at Neville Arena.
- Leading by a dozen at the half, Auburn exploded for 24 points in the third quarter to take a 56-34 lead to the final 10 minutes, affording Harris an opportunity to distribute minutes throughout the roster.
- » Fourteen Tigers participated with 10 scoring points, including Sydney Shaw's team-high 15, and 10 for Taylen Collins, who also grabbed 10 rebounds for her first Auburn double-double.

- » Mar'Shaun Bostic scored a career-high 23 points, but a back-and-forth game saw Auburn unable to score on its final possession as Clemson won 56-55 in the second round of the WNIT.
- Without two starters who suffered injuries in the fourth quarter, Auburn led 55-54 with less than a minute to go but was called for an offensive foul to give Clemson an opportunity to take the lead. The host Tigers did just that with 21 seconds to play as Daisha Bradford banked in a short jumper to move Clemson ahead.

- Auburn had the ball for a final possession but was called for a second offensive foul in as many trips down the court with less than three seconds to play, and Clemson inbounded the ball into the backcourt and Auburn was unable to foul.
- The teams were nearly even from the field
 Auburn 23-of-55 (42%) and Clemson 23-of-54
 (43%). Both teams made seven free throws, and
 Clemson hit one more 3-pointer than Auburn.
 Auburn turned 21 Clemson turnovers into 17 points,
 but Clemson dominated the glass with 42 rebounds
 to Auburn's 28.

AUBURN-CLEMSON SERIES

This is the ninth meeting between Auburn and Clemson in women's basketball. The two teams have won four times apiece. Auburn is 1-1 in two previous meetings at home.

SCOUTING THE OTHER TIGERS

- Clemson is 5-3 on the year with wins over Winthrop, Charleston Southern, Mercer, Longwood and Arkansas-Pine Bluff.
- >> The Tigers average 77.8 points per game while holding opponents to 69.4. Clemson also is one of the top 3-point shooting teams in the ACC, hitting 8.0 per game.
- Amari Robinson leads Clemson with 17.4 points/game, and Dayshanette Harris is one of the ACC's top point guards, averaging 5.2 assist per game to rank third in the ACC and 40th nationally.

SCOUTING AUBURN

- Auburn is 4-2 after bouncing back from two straight losses to pick up a 68-45 win over Alabama A&M at home Sunday.
- " Graduate student Honesty Scott-Grayson led the Tigers with 14 point in the opener vs. JSU, then hit two clutch 3-pointers late in the win over UL-Lafayette and finished with 15 points. Her seasonhigh came in her "homecoming" game at Rutgers Nov. 12 when she scored 18 points. She leads the team with 13.8 points/game and also averages 5.2 rebounds and 2.2 assists.
- » Sophomore Sydney Shaw scored a careerhigh 17 points at UCF and has hit double-figures in four of six games. Shaw also led the Tigers with 15 points in the Alabama A&M win. She is second on the team with 10.7 points/game and leads the outside attack with nine 3-pointers. Possibly the Tigers' best pure shooter, she moves from playing significant minutes at point guard last year to mostly at the 2-guard spot this season, although she has run the point at times this year.
- » Freshman Savannah Scott has been a force under the basket through the early part of the season, averaging 10.0 points and 5.7 rebounds. She led the Tigers with 16 points in the win over ULL, then posted her first career double-double with 21 points and 11 rebounds in the win at Rutgers. At 6-4, she adds much-needed size in the post, as do fellow freshmen Timya Thurman (6-5) and Yakiya Milton (6-4) along with sophomore Oyindamola Akinbolawa (6-5).
- Senior Taylen Collins had a huge second half to spark the comeback win over UL-Lafayette on Nov. 9 with all nine of her points and 8 of 14 rebounds coming after halftime. She also reached double-figures for the first time with 11 points and 8 rebounds at UCF, then recorded her first Auburn double-double with 10 points and 10 rebounds vs. Alabama A&M. She averages 8.0 points and 7.5

She was a breakout star in the Tigers' final game of the season last year, scoring a careerhigh 23 points in the WNIT second round matchup at Clemson. She played in all 31 games last year, averaging 5.6 points and 1.9 rebounds. Bostic, one of the fastest players in the SEC, looks to play significant minutes at point guard and can be one of the SEC's top defenders.
- Sophomore Kaitlyn Duhon started the season off with a bang, scoring 13 points along with 3 rebounds and 2 steals in the opener vs. JSU. In the two exhibition games, she had 6 steals in each and recorded a 10-point, 10-rebound double-double vs. Columbus State.
- >> Celia Sumbane and McKenna Eddings, both JUCO All-Americans last season, have played significant minutes in the first six games. They both had their best games at Rutgers as Eddings had 4 points, 3 rebounds, 3 assists, a steal and a block in 24 minutes of action, and Sumbane was a beast at both ends of the floor with 5 points, 2 rebounds, 3 steals, 2 assists and 2 blocks. Eddings made her first Division I start vs. California, and Sumbane started for the first time against Alabama

Johnnie Harris enters her third year as head coach for Auburn women's basketball in 2023-24. A long-time Southeastern Conference assistant and 2018 WBCA National Assistant Coach of the Year, Harris was named Auburn women's basketball head coach on April 3, 2021.

In year two at Auburn, Harris led the Tigers to their first winning record and postseason appearance in four years, finishing with a 16-15 overall record and five SEC wins. Auburn won a postseason game for the first time since 2016, defeating Tulane in the WNIT first round. In addition, the Tigers tied a school record for steals in a game with 24 against Samford, defeated Texas A&M for the first time, and won a road game in the SEC for the first time since the 2019-20 season.

Her first season on the Plains saw Auburn double its win total from the previous season and pick up three victories over nationally ranked opponents. Her first top-25 win came Nov. 21 with a 59-51 win at Georgia Tech, Auburn's first road win over a ranked foe since 2014. The biggest win of the season, and one of Auburn's biggest in decades, came Jan. 27 when the Tigers shocked No. 4 Tennessee 71-61 at home for their first SEC win of the season and their first win over a top-5 opponent since 1997. The Tigers added one more top-25 win, a 65-60 victory over No. 21 Georgia on Feb. 20. Sophomore Aicha Coulibaly was named to the All-SEC Second Team, and the Tigers landed a consensus top-25 recruiting class for 2022-23.

Prior to her arrival at Auburn, Harris spent 16 years combined at Arkansas, Texas A&M and Mississippi State, and spent the 2020-21 season as the Associate Head Coach at the University of Texas. She helped Texas to an Elite Eight appearance during the 2020-21 season, and she worked alongside Longhorn head coach Vic Schaefer the previous 10 years assisting Mississippi State to a pair of NCAA Championship game appearances. She was a central part of Mississippi State's success those eight seasons and is considered one of the nation's top recruiters.

Harris helped lead Mississippi State to a 221-62 [.781] record and five NCAA Tournament berths, including NCAA Championship Game appearances in 2017 and 2018. During that time, the Bulldogs also won the program's first Southeastern Conference regular-season championship and SEC Tournament Championship.

Harris' pupils in the post were some of the best in Mississippi State school history, led by Teaira McCowan, who Harris mentored during McCowan's record-setting junior and senior campaigns from 2017-19. The 2019 SEC Player of the Year and a consensus First-Team All-American, McCowan finished her career as Mississippi State's leader in rebounds and field-goal percentage, while ranking second in blocks and fourth in points and field-goals made.

The individual development McCowan showed during Mississippi State's run to a second consecutive national title game caught the attention of the coaching community, as Harris was tabbed the WBCA National Assistant Coach of the Year for the 2017-18 season.

In 2018-19, Harris helped transfer forward Anriel Howard combine with McCowan to create one of the best front courts in the country. In her lone season with the Bulldogs, Howard earned first-team All-SEC recognition by the AP and league coaches after averaging 16.4 points and 8.4 rebounds per game. Both McCowan [No. 3, Indiana Fever] and Howard [No. 24, Seattle Storm] were selected in the 2019 WNBA Draft.

Another Harris product, Chinwe Okorie, was an integral part of the Bulldogs' runs to the Final Four and 2016 Sweet 16 and finished her MSU career sixth in program annals in field-goal percentage, shooting 52.1 percent over 109 games. She raised her scoring average and field goal percentage each season of her three-year career, capped by her 7.5 ppg average on 56.4 percent shooting as a senior.

Harris helped guide Texas A&M to four Sweet 16 appearances in her five seasons, including the program's first national championship in 2010-11. During her tenure with the Aggies, Harris helped sign and mentor junior college All-Americans Danielle Adams and Tanisha Smith.

Prior to her stop in College Station, Harris spent three seasons at Arkansas, landing some of the Lady Razorbacks' top recruiting classes in program history. She signed Laura Ervin, a junior college All-American who went on to garner Second Team All-SEC accolades, as well as Freshman All-SEC selection Donica Cosby.

Harris has had the opportunity to learn from some of the game's top coaches, including Hall of Famer Kay Yow at N.C. State. She joined the program in the 2003-04 season and assisted the squad to the NCAA Tournament for the first time in two years. Her first recruiting class in Raleigh was rated as one of the best in the nation. She also garnered a commitment from Gillian Goring, the nation's No. 1 post player who went on to play for the Washington Mystics.

The Arkansas-Fort Smith position kept the Pine Bluff native in her home state after she started her coaching career as a graduate assistant at Little Rock. Her hard work at UALR earned her a promotion to a full-time assistant position in 2000.

Harris is the mother of two children, Marcus and Kiera, and the legal guardian of Lily. She also has two grandchildren, Samarah and Kaiden.
