Auburn Women's Basketball Quick Hitters

- This is the fourth meeting between Auburn and Little Rock in women's basketball
- Auburn leads the series 2-1, but Little Rock won the only previous meeting on their home court in 2021
- Auburn won 70-48 at Neville Arena last year
- Auburn is 10-2 all-time against current members of the Ohio Valley Conference
- The Tigers' 72-62 win at UAB Dec. 3 was Auburn's second road win of the year
- Auburn clinched a 7-7 tie in the ACC/SEC Challenge with an 83-53 win over Clemson Nov. 30
- The Tigers' 30-point win over Clemson was its largest over a Power 5 opponent since a 77-38 win over Alabama in 2019
- Auburn's 30-point win over Clemson was the largest margin of victory by any team, men or women, in the ACC/SEC Challenge
- Honesty Scott-Grayson leads the Tigers with 15.6 points/game
- Scott-Grayson scored a season-high 22 points in the win at UAB Dec. 10
- Scott-Grayson matched her then-season high with 18 points in the win over Clemson; she also had 5 assists and 5 steals
- Sophomore Sydney Shaw scored a career-high 17 points at UCF, then led the Tigers in scoring with 15 vs. Alabama AGM
- Shaw has scored in double-figures in five of eight games so far in 2023-24
- Mar'Shaun Bostic had a career-high 5 steals along with tying her career high with 4 assists in the win over Clemson
- Taylen Collins had a huge second half in the win over ULL with all nine of her points and 8 of her 14 rebounds coming after halftime
- Collins recorded her first Auburn double-double with 10 points and 10 rebounds vs. Alabama AGM
- JaMya Mingo-Young made her Auburn debut with a team-leading 5 assists vs. Cal, then had 7 points and 4 assists at UCF
- Mingo-Young scored a season-high 16 points and went 9-of-11 at the free-throw line in the win over Clemson
- Mingo-Young has averaged 3.6 assists in the five games where she has appeared
- Auburn rallied from 12 points behind to defeat Louisiana-Lafayette on Nov. 9; it was the largest deficit overcome by Auburn since coming back from 14 points down to Ole Miss to win 77-76 in overtime on Jan. 22, 2023
- Three days later, the Tigers were down 13 at Rutgers in the first quarter and went on a 41-5 run over the next 15 minutes to take as much as a 23-point lead; Auburn would win 76-56
- In three of Auburn's four other wins, the Tigers have never trailed
- Savannah Scott was named SEC Freshman of the Week after her first double-double at Rutgers (21 pts, 11 rebs)

- **Honesty Scott-Grayson** has 1,248 career points (1,174 at Auburn + 74 at Baylor)
- **Honesty Scott-Grayson** is 10th in Auburn history in career scoring average (13.5 ppg)
- **Honesty Scott-Grayson** has 93 career made 3-pointers; needs 10 to tie for 10th at Auburn (Carolyn Jones, 103)
- **Honesty Scott-Grayson** is 5th among active scoring leaders in the SEC (1,174)
- **Honesty Scott-Grayson** is 3rd among active steals leaders in the SEC (163)
- **Honesty Scott-Grayson** is 9th among active assists leaders in the SEC (177)
- **Honesty Scott-Grayson** is 16th among active rebounds leaders in the SEC (391)

LAST TIME OUT

» Honesty Scott-Grayson scored a season-high 22 points, and the Auburn women's basketball team held off a late UAB run for a 72-62 win Sunday at Bartow Arena.

» Trailing by one after 10 minutes, the Tigers (6-2) went on a 14-2 run in the second quarter to open a double-digit lead, and UAB (6-2) would never get any closer than seven points the rest of the way.

» Scott-Grayson hit for double figures for the sixth time this season, scoring her game-high 22 points on 9-of-16 shooting. She was 3-of-4 at the free-throw line and made the only 3-pointer she attempted. Scott-Grayson also led the Tigers with four assists.

» Mar'Shaun Bostic was Auburn's only other player in double figures with 12 points; she also had four steals, four rebounds and a pair of assists. Taylen Collins had one of her better games of the year, scoring eight points with a team-best eight rebounds, along with three assists and two blocked shots. Sydney Shaw also added eight points, and Kaitlyn Duhon - in limited minutes because of foul trouble - had six points and six rebounds.

» Pinch-hitting for Auburn head coach Johnnie Harris, who was ill, associate head coach Damitria Buchanan led the Tigers to victory for the second time this season with a 70-48 win vs. Little Rock

Wednesday afternoon at Neville Arena.

» Veterans Honesty Scott-Grayson and Romi Levy led the way, combining for 38 points. Scott-Grayson led Auburn with 20 points on 8-of-11 shooting while Levy scored 18 points and grabbed a game-high 13 rebounds, notching her second career double-double.

» Making her first career start, Jakayla Johnson scored the first four points of the third quarter. Levy's jumper and free throw gave the Tigers a 20-point lead on their way to leading by as many as 26. Kaitlyn Duhon populated the box score in multiple categories, scoring eight points on 3-of-4 shooting while contributing three rebounds, three steals and three blocked shots.

AUBURN-LITTLE ROCK SERIES

» This is the fourth meeting between Auburn and Little Rock in women's basketball, but the third season in a row the two programs have played.

» Auburn is 2-1 all-time against the Trojans but lost the only previous meeting in Little Rock in 2021.

HOMECOMING FOR COACH J, SCOTTIE

» Auburn head coach Johnnie Harris (Pine Bluff) and freshman Savannah Scott (Conway) return to their home state for the first of two times this season.

» Harris makes her return to the place that launched her collegiate coaching career. She was assistant coach at Little Rock from 1999-2001 as the program restarted after an 11-year hiatus.

SCOUTING THE TROJANS

» Little Rock is 0-6 on the year but has played a brutal schedule - 45th most difficult nationally, according to RealTimeRPI.com. The Trojans have faced SEC opponents Arkansas, Ole Miss and Alabama, along with Big 12 foe Kansas State in their first six games.

» The Trojans average 44.0 points per game and allow 65.0 per game.

» Faith Lee leads the Trojans with 12.7 points/game.

SCOUTING AUBURN

» Auburn is 6-2 after a road win at UAB last Sunday. It was the Tigers' third straight victory to go along with wins over Alabama A&M and Clemson at home.

» Graduate student Honesty Scott-Grayson scored a season-high 22 points in the win at UAB. She also had 18 points, 5 assists and 5 steals against Clemson. She leads the team with 15.6 points/game and also averages 4.4 rebounds and 2.9 assists.

» Sophomore Sydney Shaw scored a career-high 17 points at UCF and has hit double-figures in five of eight games. Shaw also led the Tigers with 15 points in the Alabama A&M win and scored 11 against Clemson. She is second on the team with 10.4 points/game and leads the outside attack with 13 3-pointers. Possibly the Tigers' best pure shooter, she moves from playing significant minutes at point guard last year to mostly at the 2-guard spot this season, although she has run the point at times this year.

» Senior Taylen Collins had a huge second half to spark the comeback win over UL-Lafayette on Nov. 9 with all nine of her points and 8 of 14

rebounds coming after halftime. She also reached double-figures for the first time with 11 points and 8 rebounds at UCF, then recorded her first Auburn double-double with 10 points and 10 rebounds vs. Alabama A&M. She averages 7.8 points and a team-leading 7.3 rebounds. Collins, a transfer from Oklahoma State, was fourth in the Big 12 in rebounding last year with 9.5 points and 9.1 rebounds per game.

» Junior Mar'Shaun Bostic had a huge game in the opener with 12 points, 4 assists, 4 steals and 3 rebounds. She then had another huge game against Clemson with 7 points, 4 assists and a career-high 5 steals, then matched a season-high with 12 points at UAB. She was a breakout star in the Tigers' final game of the season last year, scoring a career-high 23 points in the WNIT second round matchup at Clemson. Bostic, one of the fastest players in the SEC, looks to play significant minutes at point guard and can be one of the SEC's top defenders.

» Sophomore Kaitlyn Duhon started the season off with a bang, scoring 13 points along with 3 rebounds and 2 steals in the opener vs. JSU. She showed off her speed against Clemson, especially late in the first half, as she scored 10 points with 3 rebounds and 3 steals.

» Celia Sumbane and McKenna Eddings, both JUCO All-Americans last season, have played significant minutes in the first several games. They both had their best games at Rutgers as Eddings had 4 points, 3 rebounds, 3 assists, a steal and a block in 24 minutes of action, and Sumbane was a beast at both ends of the floor with 5 points, 2 rebounds, 3 steals, 2 assists and 2 blocks. Eddings made her first Division I start vs. California, and Sumbane started for the first time against Alabama A&M.

» JaMya Mingo-Young made her Auburn debut with a team-leading 5 assists vs. Cal after missing the first three games with injury, then racked up 7 points and 4 assists at UCF. She then scored a season-high 16 points against Clemson, hitting 9-of-11 free throw attempts. Mingo-Young leads Auburn with 3.6 assists/game in the five games she has played, and she is fifth on the team with 7.4 points/game.

» Freshman Savannah Scott made a splash under the basket through the early part of the season, averaging 7.8 points and 5.0 rebounds. She led the Tigers with 16 points in the win over ULL, then posted her first career double-double with 21 points and 11 rebounds in the win at Rutgers. At 6-4, she adds much-needed size in the post, as do fellow freshmen Timya Thurman (6-5) and Yakiya Milton (6-4) along with sophomore Oyindamola Akinbolawa (6-5).

UP TO THE CHALLENGE

» Auburn's 83-53 win over Clemson Nov. 30 in the final game of the inaugural ACC/SEC Challenge clinched a 7-7 tie in the 14-game event.

» Auburn's 30-point margin of victory was also the largest by any team, men or women, in the three-day Challenge.

» With wins by the Auburn men over Virginia Tech Nov. 29 and the women over Clemson Nov. 30, Auburn was one of just four SEC schools to win both the men's and women's contests in the Challenge (Arkansas, Kentucky, South Carolina were the others).

POWER OVER POWER

» Blowout wins over Power 5 opponents have been rare. The 83-53 win over Clemson Nov. 30 was the largest margin of victory for Auburn against a major conference opponent since a 77-38 win over Alabama during the 2018-19 season.

» The Clemson win, along with a 76-56 win over Rutgers, has given Auburn two wins of 20+ points over a major conference opponent this season; that hasn't happened since the 2008-09 season when the SEC Champion Tigers did it four times.

» DeWanna Bonner, a 2009 Auburn graduate, completed her 14th season in the WNBA in 2023, her fourth with the Connecticut Sun. A five-time WNBA All-Star, Bonner helped lead the Sun to the WNBA semifinals, where they fell to the Las Vegas Aces.

» Former Tiger Charlene Thomas-Swinson, who played at Auburn from 1984-87, was an assistant coach for the Las Vegas Aces, who won the 2022 and 2023 WNBA title.

» Unique Thompson, a 2021 graduate, is currently playing for Nadezhda Orenburg in Russia. Thompson was the No. 19 pick in the 2021 WNBA Draft by the Indiana Fever, and she signed a training camp contract with the Dallas Wings in 2022, but has not played in a WNBA regular-season game.

» Auburn women's basketball will retire DeWanna Bonner's No. 24 prior to the Auburn-Alabama game on Sunday, Jan. 21.

» Bonner is Auburn's all-time leading scorer with 2,162 points and third in career rebounds with 1,047. She was the 2009 SEC Player of the Year and a two-time All-American.

» Bonner's No. 24 will be the fifth jersey retired by Auburn women's basketball, joining Carolyn Jones (No. 21), Ruthie Bolton (No. 25), Becky Jackson (No. 34) and Vickie Orr (No. 50).

WELCOME TO THE FAMILY

» Two top in-state prospects signed National Letters of Intent with Auburn during the early signing period in November.

» The Tigers will welcome Jordan Hunter (5-8, G, Trussville, Ala./Hewitt-Trussville HS) and Syriah Daniels (6-0, G, Auburn, Ala./Auburn HS) to the Plains for the 2024-25 season. Daniels is the daughter of Marquis Daniels, former Auburn men's basketball player and current director of player development, and the late Shana Askew Daniels, a former Auburn women's basketball standout.

Third Season at Auburn • 25th Season in college coaching

Johnnie Harris enters her third year as head coach for Auburn women's basketball in 2023-24. A long-time Southeastern Conference assistant and 2018 WBCA National Assistant Coach of the Year, Harris was named Auburn women's basketball head coach on April 3, 2021.

In year two at Auburn, Harris led the Tigers to their first winning record and postseason appearance in four years, finishing with a 16-15 overall record and five SEC wins. Auburn won a postseason game for the first time since 2016, defeating Tulane in the WNIT first round. In addition, the Tigers tied a school record for steals in a game with 24 against Samford, defeated Texas A&M for the first time, and won a road game in the SEC for the first time since the 2019-20 season.

Her first season on the Plains saw Auburn double its win total from the previous season and pick up three victories over nationally ranked opponents. Her first top-25 win came Nov. 21 with a 59-51 win at Georgia Tech, Auburn's first road win over a ranked foe since 2014. The biggest win of the season, and one of Auburn's biggest in decades, came Jan. 27 when the Tigers shocked No. 4 Tennessee 71-61 at home for their first SEC win of the season and their first win over a top-5 opponent since 1997. The Tigers added one more top-25 win, a 65-60 victory over No. 21 Georgia on Feb. 20. Sophomore Aicha Coulibaly was named to the All-SEC Second Team, and the Tigers landed a consensus top-25 recruiting class for 2022-23.

Prior to her arrival at Auburn, Harris spent 16 years combined at Arkansas, Texas A&M and Mississippi State, and spent the 2020-21 season as the Associate Head Coach at the University of Texas. She helped Texas to an Elite Eight appearance during the 2020-21 season, and she worked alongside Longhorn head coach Vic Schaefer the previous 10 years assisting Mississippi State to a pair of NCAA Championship game appearances. She was a central part of Mississippi State's success those eight seasons and is considered one of the nation's top recruiters.

Harris helped lead Mississippi State to a 221-62 [.781] record and five NCAA Tournament berths, including NCAA Championship Game appearances in 2017 and 2018. During that time, the Bulldogs also won the program's first Southeastern Conference regular-season championship and SEC Tournament Championship.

Harris' pupils in the past were some of the best in Mississippi State school history, led by Teaira McCowan, who Harris mentored during McCowan's record-setting junior and senior campaigns from 2017-19. The 2019 SEC Player of the Year and a consensus First-Team All-American, McCowan finished her career as Mississippi State's leader in rebounds and field-goal percentage, while ranking second in blocks and fourth in points and field-goals made.

The individual development McCowan showed during Mississippi State's run to a second consecutive national title game caught the attention of the coaching community, as Harris was tabbed the WBCA National Assistant Coach of the Year for the 2017-18 season.

In 2018-19, Harris helped transfer forward Anriel Howard combine with McCowan to create one of the best front courts in the country. In her lone season with the Bulldogs, Howard earned first-team All-SEC recognition by the AP and league coaches after averaging 16.4 points and 8.4 rebounds per game. Both McCowan [No. 3, Indiana Fever] and Howard [No. 24, Seattle Storm] were selected in the 2019 WNBA Draft.

Another Harris product, Chinwe Okorie, was an integral part of the Bulldogs' runs to the Final Four and 2016 Sweet 16 and finished her MSU career sixth in program annals in field-goal percentage, shooting 52.1 percent over 109 games. She raised her scoring average and field goal percentage each season of her three-year career, capped by her 7.5 ppg average on 56.4 percent shooting as a senior.

Harris helped guide Texas A&M to four Sweet 16 appearances in her five seasons, including the program's first national championship in 2010-11. During her tenure with the Aggies, Harris helped sign and mentor junior college All-Americans Danielle Adams and Tanisha Smith.

Prior to her stop in College Station, Harris spent three seasons at Arkansas, landing some of the Lady Razorbacks' top recruiting classes in program history. She signed Laura Ervin, a junior college All-American who went on to garner Second Team All-SEC accolades, as well as Freshman All-SEC selection Donica Cosby.

Harris has had the opportunity to learn from some of the game's top coaches, including Hall of Famer Kay Yow at N.C. State. She joined the program in the 2003-04 season and assisted the squad to the NCAA Tournament for the first time in two years. Her first recruiting class in Raleigh was rated as one of the best in the nation. She also garnered a commitment from Gillian Goring, the nation's No. 1 post player who went on to play for the Washington Mystics.

The Arkansas-Fort Smith position kept the Pine Bluff native in her home state after she started her coaching career as a graduate assistant at Little Rock. Her hard work at UALR earned her a promotion to a full-time assistant position in 2000.

Harris is the mother of two children, Marcus and Kiera, and the legal guardian of Lily. She also has two grandchildren, Samarah and Kaiden.

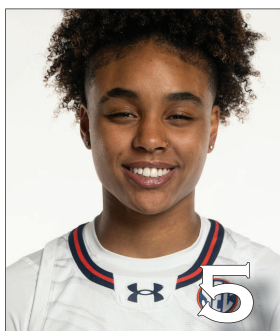

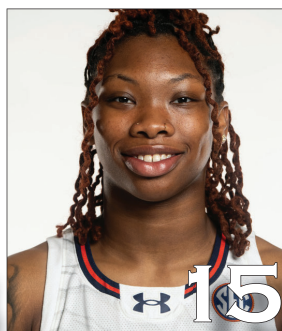
