AUBURN HEADS WEST FOR NCAA LOS ANGELES REGIONAL

The No. 12 Auburn gymnastics team kicks off the NCAA postseason this week, competing at the 2023 NCAA Los Angeles Regional Championship, March 30-April 1. The three-day meet will be held in Pauley Pavilion on the campus of UCLA.

"We have our work cut out for us this week as we are going against historical programs," head coach Jeff Graba said. "If we do our job, I feel very confident we can move through. Everyone has to be really good from now on because it's an elimination tournament. You can't make mistakes and we're up against some of the best teams in the country."

The afternoon session will begin at 4 p.m. CT and will include the No. 3 seed Tigers, No. 2 seed Utah, Southern Utah and Washington

The evening session of round two will begin at 9 p.m. CT and will feature No. 1 seed UCLA, No. 4 seed Missouri, Stanford and Boise State.

The top two teams from each session will advance to the Sweet Sixteen at 7 p.m. CT on Saturday, April 1. The top two teams from that session will then advance to the NCAA Championships, April 13-15, in Fort Worth, Texas.

Head coach Jeff Graba has put the Auburn gymnastics program on the map throughout his 10+ years on the Plains. Now entering his 13th season at the helm in 2023, Graba is poised to lead the Tigers through another record-breaking year.

The Minnesota native was named SEC Coach of the Year in 2014 and 2015 and SEC co-Coach of the Year in 2012.

The 2022 season was one for the record books. The team broke or tied every single record possible – overall and home score (198.575), road score (197.8375), vault (t-49.500), bars (49.675), beam (49.725) and floor (49.800). Eleven of the program's top 12 scores came in 2023.

In addition, the Tigers set or tied all individual records – vault: Drew Watson and Cassie Stevens (9.975); bars: Sunisa Lee (2x, 10.0); beam: Sunisa Lee (3x, 10.0); floor: Derrian Gobourne (10.0); all-around: Sunisa Lee (39.825).

Lee, the 2021 Olympic Gold Medalist in the all-around, finished with eight All-American honors, was NCAA champion on beam and SEC champion on bars. She was named the 2022 SEC Freshman of the Year and a finalist for the Honda Award.

Gobourne finished with three All-America honors and was named the SEC Co-Specialist of the Year for the second season in a row. Sophia Groth earned two All-America honors, while freshman Sara Hubbard and Watson finished as All-Americans on vault.

As a team, the Tigers secured the program's best finish as the squad reached the Final Four and finished fourth overall. Auburn's third-place finish at the SEC Championship was also the program's best in the eight-team format.

Gobourne was the 2021 SEC Co-Specialist of the Year as she excelled on vault, bars, and floor. She was a first team All-American and All-SEC on floor as well.

The coaching staff guided a pair of Tigers to All-America honors in 2020. Watson picked up first team recognition for her performances on vault. Her selection marked the first All-America honor for a Tiger in the category since 2016.

Gobourne was placed on the second team for her efforts on bars in 2020. Her All-America honor in the event is the first for any Tiger on bars at the conclusion of the regular season.

Auburn's performances in 2019 were big for the program as the squad reached the sport's first-ever Sweet Sixteen and finished 16th in the final rankings.

The program saw its first national champion in 2019 when Gobourne came in a tie for first at that 2019 National Championship on vault. The then-freshman scored a career-best 9.95, picking up All-America honors along the way.

In addition, Samantha Cerio secured the SEC Scholar Athlete of the Year for the sport.

Graba and the 2016 team added to the list of firsts for the program under his guidance. The Tigers snapped the 117-meet losing skid to Alabama, defeating the Crimson Tide at home (197.275-197.250). Auburn also defeated Georgia in Athens for the first time in program history, setting a new program-high road score on the way (197.325).

In addition, the Tigers earned the program's first No. 1 NCAA regional seed and captured the NCAA Ann Arbor Regional title with a 196.525.

Auburn enjoyed a breakout season in 2015 as Graba led the Tigers to the NCAA Championship Super Six for the first time in 22 years. Auburn's sixth place finish at the Super Six was the Tigers' third best in history and highest since 1993 with a score of 197.075. The Tigers finished the Super Six with a score of 195.625.

In 12 seasons, Graba has led his student-athletes to 31 All-America honors (both WCGA and NCAA) and 30 All-SEC recognitions. Leading the way was Caitlin Atkinson who amassed nine All-America nods and named SEC Gymnast of the Year in 2016.

Graba and the Tigers have enjoyed growth when it comes to home attendance. The team's attendance has reached its peak after averaging just 3,583 fans in his first season.

The 2022 Tigers increased attendance in Neville Arena and sold out all five home meets (9,121). The Tigers have enjoyed 15 sellouts.

Away from competition, Graba's teams have also been outstanding in the classroom. In total, the Tigers have totaled 54 NACGC/W Scholastic All-America nods and 122 SEC Academic Honor Roll recognitions.

Graba was named Auburn head coach on August 16, 2010. He came to The Plains after spending five years as an assistant coach at Utah. While with the Utes, he earned the 2009 West Region Assistant Coach of the Year.

Graba is a native of Forest Lake, Minn., and graduated from the University of Minnesota in 1992 with a bachelor's degree in economics and earned his M.B.A. from Salem International University in 2011. He and his wife, Bridget, have five children: Bryan, Jaymie, Jason, Kyla and Shayla.

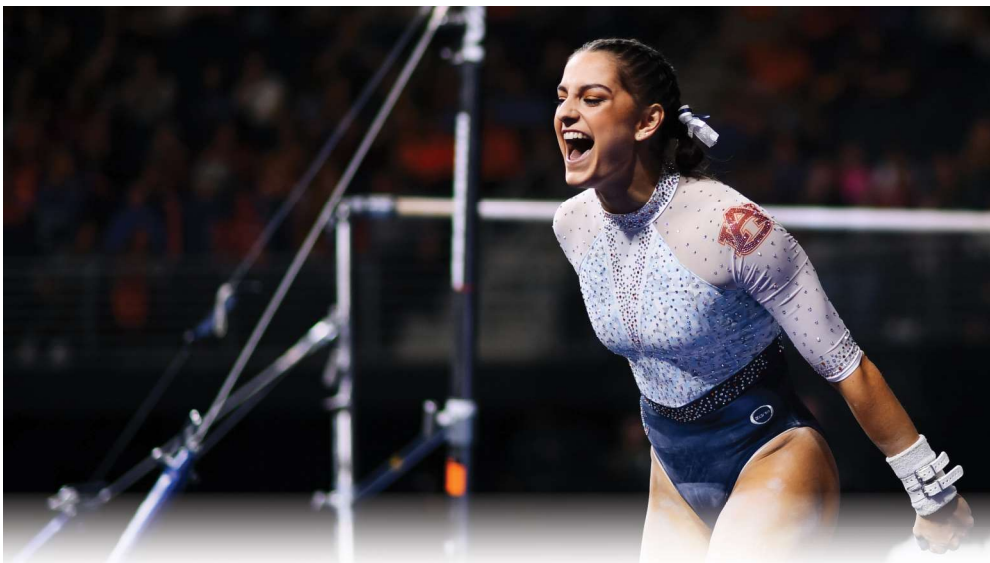

AUBURN POTENTIAL LINEUPS

The 2023 Auburn gymnastics squad heads into the postseason with a similar lineup from last week, featuring a fifth year, five seniors, two juniors, three sophomores and one freshman

The Tigers will go floor, vault, bars and beam.

Fifth year Derrian Gobourne is set to headline the event as she is a back-to-back All-American in the event. She holds a 9.940 NQS and was All-SEC in the event.

Seniors Aria Bruschi, Morgan Leigh Oldham and Cassie Stevens, juniors Olivia Hollingsworth and Gabby McLaughlin and sophomores Sophia Groth and Sara Hubbard all have earned a spot in the top eight.

Stevens and Hollingsworth were All-SEC in the event for the Tigers. Hollingsworth reached a career-high in the regular season finale with a 9.95.

The Tigers will move on to vault for rotation two. Stevens is coming off a huge performance in the event at SECs, earning a share of the conference crown with a 9.95. She picked up first team All-America on vault with a 9.925 NQS.

Gobourne has also put up big numbers in the event for the Tigers and finished the regular season with a 9.9 NQS.

Joining the pair in the team's top eight will be senior Adeline Sabados, Hollingsworth, Groth, Hubbard, sophomore Caroline Leonard and freshman Hannah Hagle.

Hollingsworth has a handful of 9.875s to her credit, while Leonard competed in the event for the first time in her career at SECs and scored a 9.8.

Auburn will move on to bars for rotation three

and had three Tigers earn All-SEC in the event.

Guiding the squad will be Gobourne, Stevens and Bruschi. The trio all scored a 9.9 at the conference meet for the squad.

Sabados, Hollingsworth, McLaughlin and Groth along with senior Anna Sumner are all in the team's top eight.

The squad will head to beam for the last rotation. McLaughlin, Stevens and All-American Groth are set to lead the way for the squad. McLaughlin has a 9.95 under her belt and was All-SEC in the event.

Hollingsworth and Bruschi have been mainstays in the lineup, while Hagle has earned her way into the top eight.

Oldham and Sumner have also secured a spot in the potential lineup.

Auburn will be without Sunisa Lee. The sophomore is sitting out as she's going through non-gymnastics health issues.

THREE TIGERS NAMED ALL-AMERICA

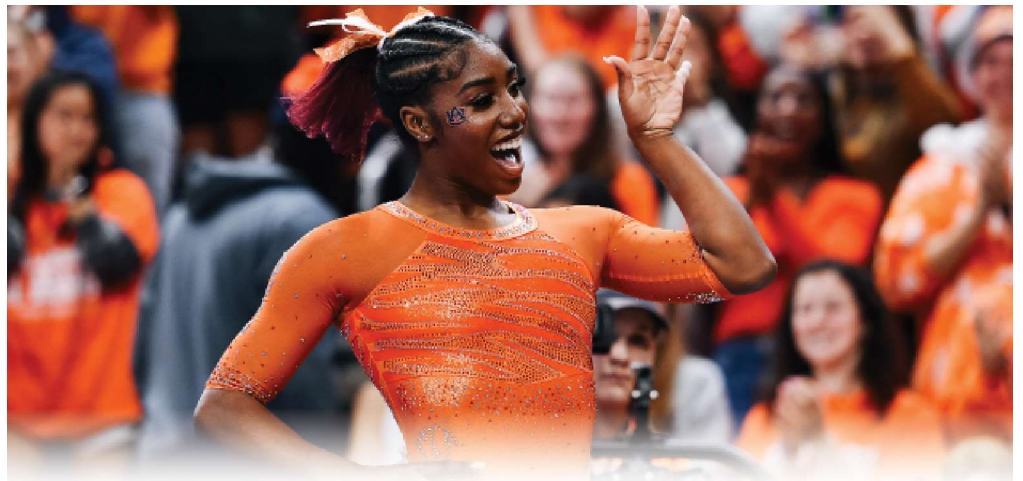
Fifth year Derrian Gobourne, senior Cassie Stevens and sophomore Sunisa Lee of the No. 12 Auburn gymnastics team added to their lists of accolades as the three were named regular season All-Americans, the Women's Collegiate Gymnastics Association announced.

Lee earned two honors, while Gobourne and Stevens earned one a piece. Lee was named First Team All-American on bars and picked up second team in the all-around. Gobourne was second team on floor, while Stevens earned first team on vault.

Lee's two awards moved her career total to 10 overall. That is the most by any gymnast in program history. Caitlin Atkinson (2013-16) held the record at nine prior to this year.

GYMNAST TO WATCH: DERRIAN GOBOURNE

» Fifth year Derrian Gobourne was named the SEC Specialist of the Year for the third-straight season. She became the first SEC gymnast to win the award three times.



Lee finished the regular season tied for fourth on bars with a 9.965 NQS. The St. Paul, Minnesota product totaled two 10.0s this season as well as one 9.975 and four 9.95s. She earned six titles in the event for the Tigers.

She secured second team recognition in the all-around, having a 39.655 NQS that came in ninth nationally. Lee finished with one of the highest all-around totals on the year, having a 39.825 on the road at Alabama (Feb. 3). She had three other all-around scores of 39.75 or better. Overall, Lee had four all-around wins on the year.

Gobourne's second team selection is the seventh of her career and third on floor. The 2023 SEC Specialist of the Year finished with a 9.940 NQS on floor, having three titles in the event on the year.

The Sarasota, Florida native had two scores of 9.975 on the season as well as three 9.95s for the Tigers.

Stevens picked up the first All-America honor of her career, finishing on the vault first team with a 9.925 NQS. That score finished tied for eighth nationally.

Stevens, of Phoenix, Arizona, had five scores of 9.925 or better on the year, including a career-best 9.975 on the road at Kentucky (March 4). Stevens earned a share of the SEC Vault Champion crown, scoring a 9.95 at the conference meet.

ALL-SEC AWARDS

Fifth year Derrian Gobourne of the No. 12 Auburn gymnastics team was named the Southeastern Conference Specialist of the Year for the third-straight season.

In addition, Gobourne was placed on the All-SEC team and was joined by seniors Cassie Stevens and Aria Brusch and juniors Olivia

Hollingsworth and Gabby McLaughlin.

Gobourne is the only gymnast in the league's history to win Specialist of the Year more than twice since the award began in 2014.

Gobourne has put an exclamation on a great career at Auburn, helping the Tigers once again earn big scores this season. She guided the Tigers to three team scores that finished in the program's top 10 and helped the squad tie a program record on vault earlier this year (49.500).

The Sarasota, Florida product was named SEC Specialist of the Week twice this season following big performances against rivals LSU and Georgia that led to Auburn wins.

Gobourne has competed on vault, bars and floor in her final year on the Plains and the squad has counted all 33 of her scores. She has won two floor and two bars titles as well as one vault crown this season.

To add to her recognition total, Gobourne earned All-SEC recognition in two events – bars and floor. She scored a 9.9 on bars and a 9.875 on floor to help the Tigers finish fifth with a 197.100.

Stevens earned All-SEC recognition on vault, bars, beam, floor and in the all-around. She was SEC vault co-champion after scoring a 9.95 in the event and finished third in the all-around at the conference meet with a season-best 39.650.

The senior from Phoenix scored a 9.9 on bars, beam and floor for the Tigers on her way to All-SEC in those events.

Brusch, a senior from Cincinnati, earned All-SEC on bars for the second-consecutive season. She scored a 9.9 to finish second in the afternoon session in the event.

Hollingsworth, a junior from Seabrook, Texas, earned the first All-SEC honor of her career after a solid performance on floor. She scored a 9.875 for the squad to finish tied for second at the conclusion of the first session.

McLaughlin also earned the first All-SEC honor of her career with a solid routine on beam. The junior from Irving, Texas anchored the beam squad with a 9.9 in the event to come in a tie for second overall in the afternoon session.

SCHOLAR-ATHLETE OF THE YEAR

Senior Cassie Stevens of the Auburn gymnastics team was named the Southeastern Conference Scholar-Athlete of the Year for gymnastics.

Stevens earned the program's seventh scholar honor from the conference. That ties Alabama for the most by any program in the sport.

Stevens, a Phoenix, Arizona product owns a 4.00 grade-point average in information systems management. She is a three-time Women's Collegiate All-American and is a CoSIDA Academic All-District honoree. She has earned a spot on the Winter SEC Academic Honor Roll twice and on the 2019-20 First-Year SEC Academic Honor Roll.

As an athlete, Stevens has been one of the most consistent gymnasts on the team's roster since she arrive on campus. This season, she has competed in the all-around in all but one meet and is among the top 20 nationally in the category. She has earned three all-around titles this season along with three on vault, one on bars and one on beam.

During her senior campaign, Stevens has set or tied career highs on vault (9.975), bars (9.925), beam (9.950) and floor (9.925). She has scored a 39.500 or higher in the all-around six times this season, including a season-high 39.600. Her scores have counted 37 times out of a possible 39 routines this year.

In addition, Stevens is a member of the 2020 SEC All-Freshman Team and the 2021 All-SEC team.
