TEAM STORYLINES

2022 SEC QUALITY QUARTERFINAL: No. 30 Auburn entered the SEC Tournament quarterfinal round as major underdogs against No. 9 South Carolina.

Spencer Gray, who was moved into the lineup on line six, tied the match for the Tigers with a decisive 7-6 (5), 6-2 victory over Carter Morgan to make the team score 2-2 with all remaining matches heading into a third set. Freshman Will Nolan gave the Tigers a 3-2 advantage as he took down the Gamecocks' Casey Hoole 6-4, 4-6, 6-2 on court five, setting up junior Tyler Stice for a dramatic finish on court one. Facing the nation's second ranked player, Daniel Rodrigues, Stice came up short in the first set 6-4, but kept fighting to steamroll through the second set with a 6-1 score. With the match tied 3-3, Stice kept at his craft to post a 6-3 win in the third set and send the Tigers to the semifinals. The 4-2 victory was the first win over a top-10 team for Head Coach Bobby Reynolds and the win gave Auburn its 20th victory of the season, which was the most wins in a year since 2002.

BLUE-GRAY BALL: In February, Auburn claimed its first title since 1984 at the 2023 Blue-Gray National Tennis Classic in Montgomery. The annual Montgomery tournament featured a very impressive field this season, as the Tigers defeated No. 44 Texas Tech in the first round, shut out No. 25 Middle Tennessee in the semifinals, and took down No. 14 Arizona late on Friday night to take the title.

STEADY STICE: Auburn's Tyler Stice holds a 17-14 singles record and an 18-10 doubles record overall this season. Stice has reached a 13-10 singles mark as well as a 12-8 doubles mark in dual matches this season. The two-time first-team all-SEC selection, who has played at the top of the Auburn singles lineup in every appearance this season, has picked up six singles victories over ranked opponents (five in dual matches). Stice's most notable ranked win was a 1-6, 6-3, 6-4 comeback victory over then-No. 3 Toby Samuel that helped Auburn knock off then-No. 4 South Carolina by a 4-3 score. The Atlanta, Georgia native finished the regular season ranked 57th in the nation in singles and was ranked 9th in singles during the fall.

MAGNIFICENT MURGETT: Auburn senior Finn Murgett has come back from being named a doubles All-American in 2022 by teaming up with new doubles partner Raul Dobai to be the regular Tiger duo on court one. Murgett and Dobai have posted an 11-9 overall record on the doubles court and picked up seven wins over ranked opponents during dual matches this season, including over the then-21st ranked team of Michael Minasyan and Gabriel Huber of Wisconsin as well as the then-35th ranked team of Siim Troost and Jeremie Casabon of Vanderbilt On the singles court, Murgett has also been very impressive. The Englishman holds a 11-6 dual singles record and was named the 2023 Blue-Gray National Tennis Classic MVP and SEC Player of the Week on March 1st.

AWESOME ALEJANDRO: In his first season on the Plains, Auburn freshman Alejandro Moreno has a 17-9 singles record and an 18-9 doubles record overall this season. Moreno regularly played at No. 3 in the Tigers' singles lineup, where he has accumulated a 9-3 record including a ranked victory over Joshua Lapadat of Kentucky, the 47th ranked singles player in the nation. The Knoxville, Tennessee native finished the regular season ranked 155th in singles by the ITA. Moreno and partner Tyler Stice posted a 10-8 dual match record on the doubles court as well.

BEEN-THERE BOBBY: The 2023 season marks head coach Bobby Reynolds' seventh season on the Plains. As a player, Reynolds was the 2003 SEC player of the year and NCAA tournament Most Outstanding Player, leading Vanderbilt to the NCAA finals that season. He played 12 seasons of professional tennis, appearing in 17 grand slam main draws for singles and 20 for doubles, and was the 2012 MVP of World Team Tennis for the Washington Kastles.
