PLAYER NOTES

MAGNIFICENT MEGAN: Megan Schofill earned an exemption into the field thanks to her top-25 World Amateur Golf Ranking (WAGR) and will make her third appearance in the prestigious event since coming to Auburn. The Auburn fifth-year senior made it to the match play round of 16 in her first appearance in 2019.

Schofill had a memorable season and was awarded first team All-American honors by WGCA and Golfweek as well as first team All-SEC honors by the conference. Schofill was the individual champion of the Mason Rudolph Championship with a 207 (-9) for her third career individual victory in September, which puts her in a tie for sixth in Auburn program history and posted a runner-up individual finish at the 2023 SEC Championship.

The Monticello, Florida native shot a 205 (-11) at the Illini Women's Invitational at Medinah to tie herself for the second all-time lowest 54-hole round in program history and her second round 65 (-7) at the Illini Women's Invitational tied the second lowest 18-hole score in program history. Schofill broke the program record for most rounds under par in 2023, as she has recorded 43. She has lowered her career

scoring average to 72.14, which is currently the lowest scoring average in program history (minimum 60 rounds).

CASEY CLUTCH: Casey Weidenfeld will being making her second consecutive appearance in the tournament, as she qualified for the event after firing a 64 to take the top spot at the qualifying event in Salisbury, North Carolina. The redshirt sophomore finished the stroke play portion of the 2022 U.S. Women's Amateur at 6-under (140), which placed her in a tie for 7th which advanced her to match play. The Penbroke Pines, Florida native earned SEC All-Freshman Team honors this season after playing in all 10 team events for the Tigers and recording five top-20 finishes.

Weidenfeld received national attention during the 2022 East Lake Cup, when her match was the deciding factor in sending Auburn to the East Lake Cup finals. She was three holes down through 10 holes against Oregon's Cynthia Lu, then came roaring back with wins on holes 11 and 12, a loss on 14 and wins on 16 and 17 to tie the match. After the match went to extra holes, Weidenfeld then parred the par-3 15th hole to take the match and secure the team victory over Oregon.

CANADIAN CRUSHER: Katie Cranston is set to make her second career appearance at the event this year. The Oakville, Canada native punched her ticket to Los Angeles by shooting a 70 (-2) at the qualifying event at Hawk Point Golf Club in Washington, New Jersey. Cranston will be one of nine Canadians in this year's field.

In her six tournaments representing the Tigers, Cranston has tied the second-best 18-hole round in program history with a 7-under 65 during round two of the Moon Golf Invitational and recorded a top-5 finish at the Liz Murphey Collegiate Classic which led to SEC Freshman of the Week honors.

Cranston arrived on the Plains from Oakville, Canada in January with an impressive resume as a true freshman. Cranston was the winner of the 2022 Porter Cup Women's Amateur, the 2022 Dustin Johnson World Junior and the 2022 Scott Robertson Memorial. Additionally, the freshman qualified for the 2022 US Junior Championship, the 2021 US Women's Amateur and participated in the 2022 LPGA CP Canadian Women's Open.
