### NO. 13 TIGERS HEAD TO FAYETTEVILLE TO FACE NO. 4 ARKANSAS

The No. 13 Auburn gymnastics team is set to travel to No. 4 Arkansas to take on the Razorbacks Friday night, January 25. The two teams will go head-to-head at 7 p.m. CT in Barnhill Arena and the meet will be streamed on SEC Network+.

"Arkansas is going to have a great crowd and have proven they are a great team early in the season," head coach Jeff Graba said. "However, at the end of the day it's all about us and doing what we know we are capable of doing. If we do a good job on Friday, I think we can compete with anybody in the country."

The Tigers are closing out the month of January having faced a gauntlet of opponents. Not a single meet in the season-opening month was against a team outside the top 10.

"We're in a really good spot right now," Graba said. "Physically, I think we're doing really good gymnastics. All top 10 matchups with a young team has been a good thing, but it's all starting to hit them right now that it doesn't matter who the other team is. What matters is who we are."

The Minnesota native was named SEC Coach of the Year in 2014 and 2015 and SEC co-Coach of the Year in 2012.

In 2023, Auburn saw big performances from upperclassmen. Cassie Stevens was a first team All-American on vault and won a share of the event title at the SEC Championship. Derrian Gobourne earned All-America honors on floor, was named SEC Specialist of the Year for the third-straight season and reached the NCAA Championships as an individual in the event, while Sunisa Lee was an All-American on bars and in the all-around.

In addition, Stevens was named the SEC Scholar Athlete of the Year.

The 2022 season was one for the record books as the team broke or tied every single record possible – overall and home score (198.575), road score (197.8375), vault (t-49.500), bars (49.675), beam (49.725) and floor (49.800). Eleven of the program's top 12 scores came in 2023.

In addition, the Tigers set or tied all individual records – vault: Drew Watson and Stevens (9.975); bars: Lee (2x, 10.0); beam: Lee (3x, 10.0); floor: Gobourne (10.0); all-around: Lee (39.825).

Lee, the 2021 Olympic Gold Medalist in the all-around, finished with eight All-America honors, was NCAA champion on beam and SEC champion on bars. She was named the 2022 SEC Freshman of the Year and a finalist for the Honda Award.

Gobourne finished with three All-America honors and was named the SEC Co-Specialist of the Year for the second season in a row. Sophia Groth earned two All-America honors, while freshman Sara Hubbard and Watson finished as All-Americans on vault.

As a team, the Tigers secured the program's best finish as the squad reached the Final Four and finished fourth overall. Auburn's third-place finish at the SEC Championship was also the program's best in the eight-team format.

Gobourne was the 2021 SEC Co-Specialist of the Year as she excelled on vault, bars, and floor. She was a first team All-American and All-SEC on floor as well.

A pair of Tigers earned All-America honors in 2020. Watson picked up first team recognition on vault and her selection marked the first All-America honor for a Tiger in the category since 2016.

Gobourne was placed on the second team for her efforts on bars in 2020. Her All-America honor in the event is the first for any Tiger on bars at the conclusion of the regular season.

Auburn's performances in 2019 were big for the program as the squad reached the sport's first-ever Sweet Sixteen and finished 16th in the final rankings.

The program saw its first national champion in 2019 when Gobourne came in a tie for first on vault. The then-freshman scored a career-best 9.95, picking up All-America honors along the way.

In addition, Samantha Cerio secured the SEC Scholar Athlete of the Year for the sport.

Graba and the 2016 team added to the list of firsts for the program under his guidance. The Tigers snapped the 117-meet losing skid to Alabama, defeating the Crimson Tide at home (197.275-197.250). Auburn also defeated Georgia in Athens for the first time in program history, setting a new program-high road score on the way (197.325).

In addition, the Tigers earned the program's first No. 1 NCAA regional seed and captured the NCAA Ann Arbor Regional title with a 196.525.

Auburn enjoyed a breakout season in 2015 as Graba led the Tigers to the NCAA Championship Super Six for the first time in 22 years. Auburn's sixth place finish at the Super Six was the Tigers' third best in history and highest since 1993 with a score of 197.075. The Tigers finished with a score of 195.625.

In 13 seasons, Graba has led his student-athletes to 35 All-America honors (both WCGA and NCAA) and 40 All-SEC recognitions. Among those is Caitlin Atkinson who amassed nine All-America nods and named SEC Gymnast of the Year in 2016.

Graba and the Tigers have enjoyed growth when it comes to home attendance. The team's attendance has reached its peak after averaging just 3,583 fans in his first season.

The 2022 Tigers increased attendance in Neville Arena and sold out all five home meets (9,121). The Tigers have enjoyed 20 sellouts.

Academically, Graba's teams have also been outstanding in the classroom. In total, the Tigers have totaled 65 NACGC/W Scholastic All-America nods and 138 SEC Academic Honor Roll recognitions.

Graba was named Auburn head coach on August 16, 2010. He came to The Plains after spending five years as an assistant coach at Utah. While with the Utes, he earned the 2009 West Region Assistant Coach of the Year.

Graba is a native of Forest Lake, Minn., and graduated from the University of Minnesota in 1992 with a bachelor's degree in economics and earned his M.B.A. from Salem International University in 2011. He and his wife, Bridget, have five children: Bryan, Jaymie, Jason, Kyla and Shayla.

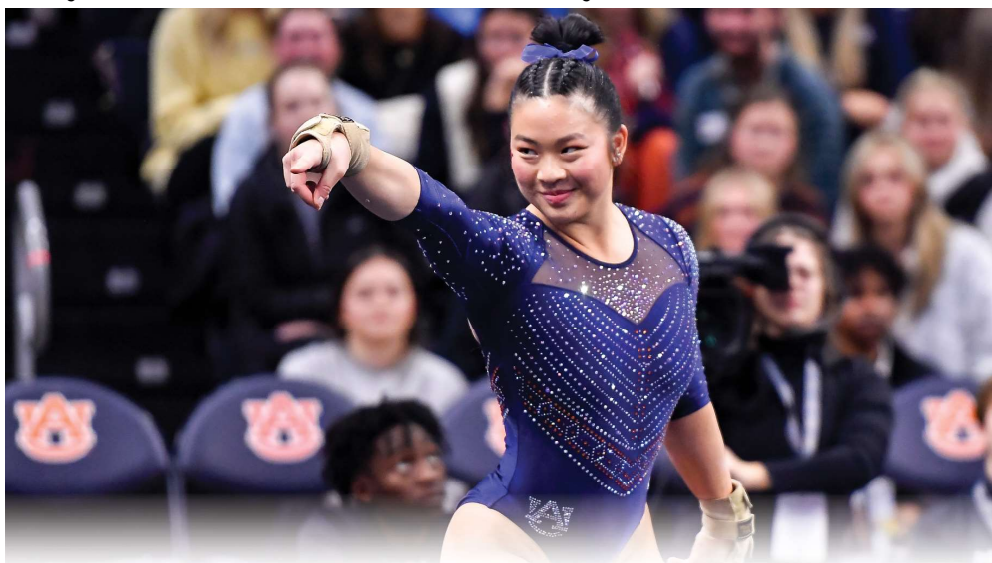

**AUBURN POTENTIAL LINEUPS**

Auburn will take to the road for a true dual for the first time this season.

The Tigers will kick off the meet on bars and a plethora of upperclassmen are set to lead the charge in the event as five of the top eight are fifth years, seniors or juniors.

Senior Gabby McLaughlin is coming off back-to-back meets where she tied her career high in the event with a 9.875.

Fifth year Stevens kicked off the year with a 9.925 in the event and has anchored the first three meets. Senior Olivia Hollingsworth and junior Sophia Groth each earned 9.9s at the start of the season.

Fifth year Aria Bruschi is also among the top eight and has 39 starts in the event in her career.

Joining the experienced crew in the top eight on bars will be sophomore Hannah Hagle as well as freshmen Emma Grace Boyd and Julianne Huff. Boyd secured the first start of her career last week against Florida, scoring a 9.775.

The second rotation will have the Tigers go to vault and the squad is hoping to see a handful of 10.0 vaults from the top eight.

Leading the way is Stevens, who has a pair of 9.975s under her belt and was SEC Co-Champion in the event last year.

Groth is coming off a 9.9 vs. Florida last week, setting a season best and winning the event title.

Joining them in the top eight is Hollingsworth and senior Sydney Schumaker. Both earned career bests at home against Kentucky two weeks ago. Schumaker, a transfer from SUNY Brockport, earned a share of the vault title with a 9.9 against the Wildcats, while Hollingsworth followed with a 9.875 to tie a career best.

Junior Sara Hubbard led the Tigers at the

Super 16 on the opening weekend, scoring a team-best 9.875 on her Yurchenko 1.5. Huff, fellow freshman Jersie Woolsey and junior transfer Anna Hill are also among the team's top eight.

Auburn moves on to floor in rotation three and have been building over the last three meets.

The Tigers are coming off a season-best 49.450 against the Gators, seeing four student-athletes earn a 9.9 or better.

Stevens and McLaughlin each set career bests, earning a 9.925 apiece. Bruschi and Groth were awarded 9.9s, which was a career best for Bruschi.

Also among the top eight are Hollingsworth, Huff, Hubbard and Hagle.

Auburn concludes the night on beam and had a season-best showing against Florida.

McLaughlin earned the beam title last week with a season-best 9.95. Stevens chipped in a 9.9, while Hollingsworth had a 9.85.

Freshman Paige Zancan earned a spot in the lineup last week and remains in the top eight for the Tigers. Groth, Bruschi, Huff and Hagle are all in the top eight as well.

**AUBURN IN THE RANKINGS**

The Auburn gymnastics team is currently ranked No. 13 in this week's RoadToNationals.com rankings.

The Tigers improved their average to 196.883 after scoring another 197.025 last Friday vs. Florida in Neville Arena.

Auburn's floor squad is ranked 12th nationally with a 49.375 average, while the bars and beam lineups are both ranked 14th. Auburn has a 49.233 average on bars and beam stands at 49.133. The vault team is ranked 19th at 49.142.

Individually, fifth year Cassie Stevens is No. 23 in the all-around with a 39.425 average. She is in the top 50 on floor with a 9.892 average after

tying her career high with a 9.925 vs. Florida last week.

Senior Gabby McLaughlin is ranked 16th on beam after scoring a 9.950 on Friday, having a 9.9 average.

### PLETHORA OF ALL-AROUNDERS

Auburn has a handful of student-athletes capable of repping the Tigers in the all-around this season.

Leading the way is fifth year Cassie Stevens. The Phoenix, Arizona product has competed in all four events 39 times for the Tigers with four titles in her career.

In addition, Stevens finished third in the all-around at the SEC Championship to earn All-SEC honors in the category.

Senior Olivia Hollingsworth and junior Sophia Groth are also candidates in the all-around for the Tigers this year.

Hollingsworth earned a spot in the all-around in all but one meet in 2023, while Groth has been in the all-around 20 times over the course of two years.

Freshman Julianne Huff is also a favorite to compete in the all-around this season. The Hoover, Alabama product is a three-time regional champion in the all-around and was the 2022 national runner-up in the category.

### THE YEAR OF CASSIE

Fifth year Cassie Stevens had quite the year in 2023.

The Phoenix, Arizona product picked up the first All-America honor of her career, finishing on the vault first team with a 9.925 NQS. That score finished tied for eighth nationally. She had five scores of 9.925 or better on the year, including a career-best 9.975 on the road at Kentucky.

Stevens earned All-SEC recognition on vault, bars, beam, floor and in the all-around. She was SEC vault co-champion after scor-

ing a 9.95 in the event and finished third in the all-around at the conference meet with a season-best 39.650.

In addition, she scored a 9.9 on bars, beam and floor for the Tigers on her way to All-SEC in those events.

Academically, Stevens was named a CSC Academic All-American, earning a spot on the first team with a 4.00 grade-point average. She was named the 2023 SEC Gymnastics Scholar Athlete of the Year, a WCGA Scholastic All-American and a SEC Academic Honor Roll honoree.

### NEW FACES

The 2024 edition of Auburn gymnastics has 10 new faces to the squad as six freshmen and four transfers came to the Plains in the offseason.

Freshmen Bryn Bartman, Emma Grace Boyd, Sophia Greaves, Julianne Huff, Jersie Woolsey and Paige Zancan bring big routines and athleticism to the team this season.

Huff is a four-time Development Program National Championship qualifier and was national runner-up in the all-around, vault and floor. She also competed at the 2023 Nastia Liukin Cup.

Bartman, Boyd, Greaves and Zancan have all competed at the national championship during their club years. Zancan was a national champion on floor, while Boyd has state titles on bars and beam.

Transfers Madelynn Crow, Anna Hill, Sydney Schumaker and Lila Smith are all expected to provide much-needed depth for the Tigers the season.

Schumaker came to Auburn after three seasons at SUNY Brockport. There, she was a two-time National Collegiate Gymnastics All-American on vault and a national runner-up on vault.

Hill had a successful first two years at Temple,

earning All-EAGL First Team honors on vault.

### AWARD-WINNING UPPERCLASSMEN

Auburn has a wealth of award winners returning to the lineup despite losing big routines from graduated Derrian Gobourne and Olympic gold medalist Suni Lee.

Three Tigers in fifth year Cassie Stevens and juniors Sophia Groth and Sara Hubbard have All-American honors under their belt.

Stevens picked up first team recognition in 2023 on vault, while Groth had a pair of All-America honors on beam in 2022. Hubbard secured vault All-America recognition for her performance at the 2022 NCAA Championships.

Stevens and Groth are joined by fifth year Aria Brusch and seniors Olivia Hollingsworth and Gabby McLaughlin with All-SEC honors. Stevens secured All-SEC on all four events and the all-around in 2023, while Hollingsworth earned it on floor and McLaughlin on beam.

Brusch has earned All-SEC on bars in back-to-back seasons (2022, 2023) and Groth was All-SEC on beam as a freshman in 2022.

### A LOT OF ROUTINES

Fifth years Aria Brusch and Cassie Stevens have more than enough experience competing for the Tigers.

Stevens has competed in the all-around 41 times for Auburn and has over 40 starts on bars, beam and floor throughout her career, having 183 routines under her belt.

Brusch has been a mainstay on the bars, beam and floor for Auburn. She's earned a spot in the lineup 39 times on bars and beam and 38 on floor.

### UP NEXT

Auburn returns to Neville Arena on February 2, hosting its first-ever quad meet in the regular season. The Tigers will welcome Temple, Fisk and Talladega to the Plains and the meet will kick off at 7 p.m. CT.
