NO. 12 AUBURN HOSTS NO. 13 MISSOURI IN HOME FINALE

The No. 12 Auburn gymnastics team will host No. 13 Missouri on Friday, February 23 in Neville Arena. The two Tiger teams will face off at 6 p.m. CT on SEC Network.

"We want a good home meet with it being our last this year," head coach Jeff Graba said. "The score is the most important thing for us this Friday so we are hoping to get a good score against a really good Missouri team in front of our home crowd. Missouri is going to be extremely tough and will be ready to go so we need to have a great night on all four events."

Friday's meet will be the last home meet for the squad in 2024. The team will recognize it's six seniors at the conclusion of the meet. Those being honored are Ananda Brown, Olivia Hollingsworth, Gabby McLaughlin, Sydney Schumaker, Aria Brusca and Cassie Stevens.

"It's going to be a good celebration," Graba said. "We have a lot of seniors that have contributed so much to this program. We're looking forward to a big crowd in the best environment in collegiate gymnastics to send these seniors out in style."

In addition, the Tigers will welcome almost 30 alumni for the annual Alumni Meet celebration weekend. Those in attendance will be recognized during the pre-meet activities.

The Minnesota native was named SEC Coach of the Year in 2014 and 2015 and SEC co-Coach of the Year in 2012.

In 2023, Auburn saw big performances from upperclassmen. Cassie Stevens was a first team All-American on vault and won a share of the event title at the SEC Championship. Derrian Gobourne earned All-America honors on floor, was named SEC Specialist of the Year for the third-straight season and reached the NCAA Championships as an individual in the event, while Sunisa Lee was an All-American on bars and in the all-around.

In addition, Stevens was named the SEC Scholar Athlete of the Year.

The 2022 season was one for the record books as the team broke or tied every single record possible – overall and home score (198.575), road score (197.8375), vault (t-49.500), bars (49.675), beam (49.725) and floor (49.800). Eleven of the program's top 12 scores came in 2023.

In addition, the Tigers set or tied all individual records – vault: Drew Watson and Stevens (9.975); bars: Lee (2x, 10.0); beam: Lee (3x, 10.0); floor: Gobourne (10.0); all-around: Lee (39.825).

Lee, the 2021 Olympic Gold Medalist in the all-around, finished with eight All-America honors, was NCAA champion on beam and SEC champion on bars. She was named the 2022 SEC Freshman of the Year and a finalist for the Honda Award.

Gobourne finished with three All-America honors and was named the SEC Co-Specialist of the Year for the second season in a row. Sophia Groth earned two All-America honors, while freshman Sara Hubbard and Watson finished as All-Americans on vault.

As a team, the Tigers secured the program's best finish as the squad reached the Final Four and finished fourth overall. Auburn's third-place finish at the SEC Championship was also the program's best in the eight-team format.

Gobourne was the 2021 SEC Co-Specialist of the Year as she excelled on vault, bars, and floor. She was a first team All-American and All-SEC on floor as well.

A pair of Tigers earned All-America honors in 2020. Watson picked up first team recognition on vault and her selection marked the first All-America honor for a Tiger in the category since 2016.

Gobourne was placed on the second team for her efforts on bars in 2020. Her All-America honor in the event is the first for any Tiger on bars at the conclusion of the regular season.

Auburn's performances in 2019 were big for the program as the squad reached the sport's first-ever Sweet Sixteen and finished 16th in the final rankings.

The program saw its first national champion in 2019 when Gobourne came in a tie for first on vault. The then-freshman scored a career-best 9.95, picking up All-America honors along the way.

In addition, Samantha Cerio secured the SEC Scholar Athlete of the Year for the sport.

Graba and the 2016 team added to the list of firsts for the program under his guidance. The Tigers snapped the 117-meet losing skid to Alabama, defeating the Crimson Tide at home (197.275-197.250). Auburn also defeated Georgia in Athens for the first time in program history, setting a new program-high road score on the way (197.325).

In addition, the Tigers earned the program's first No. 1 NCAA regional seed and captured the NCAA Ann Arbor Regional title with a 196.525.

Auburn enjoyed a breakout season in 2015 as Graba led the Tigers to the NCAA Championship Super Six for the first time in 22 years. Auburn's sixth place finish at the Super Six was the Tigers' third best in history and highest since 1993 with a score of 197.075. The Tigers finished with a score of 195.625.

In 13 seasons, Graba has led his student-athletes to 35 All-America honors (both WCGA and NCAA) and 40 All-SEC recognitions. Among those is Caitlin Atkinson who amassed nine All-America nods and named SEC Gymnast of the Year in 2016.

Graba and the Tigers have enjoyed growth when it comes to home attendance. The team's attendance has reached its peak after averaging just 3,583 fans in his first season.

The 2022 Tigers increased attendance in Neville Arena and sold out all five home meets (9,121). The Tigers have enjoyed 20 sellouts.

Academically, Graba's teams have also been outstanding in the classroom. In total, the Tigers have totaled 65 NACGC/W Scholastic All-America nods and 138 SEC Academic Honor Roll recognitions.

Graba was named Auburn head coach on August 16, 2010. He came to The Plains after spending five years as an assistant coach at Utah. While with the Utes, he earned the 2009 West Region Assistant Coach of the Year.

Graba is a native of Forest Lake, Minn., and graduated from the University of Minnesota in 1992 with a bachelor's degree in economics and earned his M.B.A. from Salem International University in 2011. He and his wife, Bridget, have five children: Bryan, Jaymie, Jason, Kyla and Shayla.

AUBURN POTENTIAL LINEUPS

Auburn is once again at home this week and will once again start on vault.

The Tigers are hoping to see a handful of 10.0 vaults from the top eight.

Fifth year Cassie Stevens and freshman Julianne Huff as each are among the top 50 nationally in the event with their Yurchenko 1.5s.

Huff finished second last week at LSU with a career-best 9.925, while Stevens added a 9.9 to the team score.

Joining the pair with 10.0 start values are seniors Olivia Hollingsworth and Sydney Schumaker and junior Sara Hubbard.

Hollingsworth and Schumaker have both hit 9.9s this season, while Hubbard has been a consistent contributor week in and week out.

Junior Sophia Groth along with junior transfer Anna Hill and freshman Jersie Woolsey all have a spot in the top eight for the squad.

The team's top eight on bars remains the same this week.

Leading the way are graduates Stevens and Aria Bruschi, while seniors Hollingsworth and Gabby McLaughlin as well as Groth are all among the top eight.

Stevens, Hollingsworth and Groth each have a 9.9 or better twice this year, while McLaughlin has been steady all season long.

Joining the upperclassmen in top eight will be sophomore Hannah Hagle, redshirt freshman Olivia Greaves and freshman Emma Grace Boyd.

Greaves has three starts to her name with a career-high 9.875. Boyd and Hagle have both competed in the event this season for the Tigers.

The Tigers will go to beam where the team ranks sixth nationally with a 49.279.

Stevens set a career best two weeks with a 9.975, earning the event title against Alabama.

McLaughlin and Groth each had a 9.925 on the road at LSU last week for the squad and McLaughlin is among the nation's best with a 9.892 average.

Joining the three in the top eight will Hollingsworth, Bruschi, Hagle, Boyd and freshman Paige Zancan.

Hollingsworth and Zancan each have a 9.9 to their credit this year, while Bruschi has been a steady contributor all season long.

The Tigers will go to floor for the final rotation and have been a solid team this season in the event, averaging a 49.393.

The top eight includes Stevens, Bruschi, Hollingsworth, McLaughlin and Groth.

Hollingsworth won the event title against Alabama with a season-best 9.925, while Stevens, McLaughlin and Groth all had 9.9s vs. the Crimson Tide

Hagle has competed in the last three meets on floor for Auburn and scored a career-best 9.9 two weeks ago.

Also in the top eight are Hubbard and Zancan.

AUBURN IN THE RANKINGS

The Auburn gymnastics team remains at No. 12 in this week's RoadToNationals.com rankings.

The team's current average bumped up to 197.082 after scoring a season-high road score of 197.100 last Friday in Baton Rouge against LSU.

Auburn's beam squad is ranked sixth nationally with a 49.279 average after scoring a 49.450 on Friday. The floor crew is 13th with a 49.393. The vault team is 13th with a 49.239 and bars 18th with a 49.171 average.

Individually, fifth-year Cassie Stevens moved up to 17th in the all-around with a 39.496 aver-

age and is 14th nationally in vault with a 9.882 average. In addition, she's ranked 30th on beam, averaging 9.871. Senior Olivia Hollingsworth is also within the top 50 overall with an all-around average of 39.336.

Senior Gabby McLaughlin is 14th nationally on beam, holding a 9.896 mark.

SENIOR STARS

Auburn will recognize its six seniors after the meet Friday as part of Senior Night ceremonies.

The six seniors are - Ananda Brown, Olivia Hollingsworth, Gabby McLaughlin, Sydney Schumaker, Aria Bruschi and Cassie Stevens.

Hollingsworth, McLaughlin, Bruschi and Stevens will all finish their careers as All-SEC performers.

Stevens was the 2023 SEC Vault Co-Champion and earned first team All-America in the event last season.

Bruschi has earned All-SEC on bars for the past two seasons, while Hollingsworth earned it on floor last year with McLaughlin picking conference honors on beam in 2023.

Brown has been a key reserve on vault and floor throughout her time on the Plains and has served in numerous officer capacities for the Black Student Athlete Advisory Committee.

Schumaker joined the Tigers this season after a successful three years at SUNY Brockport. She was a two-time All-American on vault at her previous stop.

AAI AWARD NOMINEES

Fifth years Cassie Stevens and Aria Bruschi along with senior Olivia Hollingsworth were named AAI Award nominees, the WCGA announced this week.

The award goes to the top senior gymnast and is voted on by the coaches.

Bruschi is a two-time All-SEC performer as well as a three-time CSC Academic All-District student. She's earned four WCGA Scholastic All-America awards and was named a 2023 CSC Academic All-American.

Hollingsworth earned All-SEC last year and is a two-time WCGA Scholastic All-American for the Tigers.

Stevens was the 2023 SEC Co-Champion on vault and secured first team All-America honors in the event. She also secured All-SEC accolades in all five categories last season.

In addition, Stevens was the 2023 SEC Scholar Athlete of the Year. She earned CSC Academic All-American as a senior and is a four-time WCGA Scholastic All-American.

BEAM QUEENS

Auburn has turned it on as a beam squad this season, having been ranked in the top 10 nationally for the past four weeks.

The Tigers got as high as No. 5 and currently rank No. 6 with a 49.279 average.

Leading the charge are upperclassmen Gabby McLaughlin, Cassie Stevens and Sophia Groth. Between the three, 11 scores of 9.9 or better have been counted.

McLaughlin leads the way with a 9.896 average to rank 14th nationally.

Stevens has a career-high 9.975 under her belt, while Groth picked up a season-best 9.925 at LSU last weekend.

As a team, the Tigers have scored a 49.425 or better three times. That includes a season-best 49.475 against Alabama (Feb. 9) and a 49.450 last week at LSU.

HAVING FUN ON FLOOR

Auburn is among the nation's best on floor, ranking 13th with a 49.393 average.

The squad reached a season-best 49.525

against Alabama two weeks ago and have four scores of 49.425 or better four times.

Senior Olivia Hollingsworth leads the team with a 9.889 average and has a season-best 9.925 to her credit.

VAULT SQUAD ASSEMBLE

Auburn's vault team has really picked it up as of late and are ranked 13th nationally at 49.239.

Fifth year Cassie Stevens is tied for 14th nationally with a 9.882 average, having four scores of 9.9 or better on the year.

Freshman Julianne Huff is continuing to improve her Yurchenko 1.5 and has three-straight sticks for the squad, earning a 9.925 two of the three times. She holds a 9.85 overall average.

Auburn tied a program best in the event against Alabama two weeks ago, scoring a 49.500 collectively. That score included 9.925s from Stevens and Huff and a 9.9 from Olivia Hollingsworth.

A LOT OF ROUTINES

Fifth years Aria Bruschi and Cassie Stevens have more than enough experience competing for the Tigers.

Stevens has competed in the all-around 45 times for Auburn and has over 50 starts on bars, beam and floor throughout her career, having 199 routines under her belt.

Bruschi has been a mainstay on the bars, beam and floor for Auburn. She's earned a spot in the lineup 43 times on bars and beam and 42 on floor.

Auburn will be road warriors the rest of the 2024 season, starting March 1 with a trip to Georgia. The Tigers and the Bulldogs will face off at 6 p.m. CT in Stegeman Coliseum. The meet will be broadcast on SEC Network.
