San Diego State Postgame Notes vs. Chaminade

Notes

- * San Diego State won its 26th consecutive exhibition game.
- * San Diego State's starting lineup consisted of returning players Jeremy Hemsley, Jalen McDaniels, Matt Mitchell, Jordan Schakel and Devin Watson.
- * Although the starting lineup is made up of returning players, only two are seniors. The other three players in the lineup were starting their sophomore campaigns.
- * The first substitution for the Aztecs came at 15:20 when junior Nolan Narain entered the game.

Game Notes

- * San Diego State scored the first seven points of the game and held Chaminade without a point until the 15:46 mark of the first half (no point the first 4:14 of the game).
- * Dating back to the end of the first half, San Diego State used an 18-0 run over a period of 8:43 (last 1:28 of first half and first 7:15 of second half) to turn an 11-point deficit (37-26) into a 7-point lead (44-37).
- * Over the 18-0 run, Chaminade was 0-for-10 with six turnovers, while calling three timeouts.
- * After trailing, 37-31, at the half, SDSU tied the game at 37-37 just 2:56 into the second half.
- * The Aztecs overcame a halftime deficit to win tonight. SDSU was just 1-5 last season when trailing at intermission.
- * SDSU overcame an 11-point deficit to win (Aztecs trailed, 37-26, with 1:28 left in the first half). Last season SDSU was 2-8 when trailing by double-digits with its largest comeback coming from 12 down against Georgia on Nov. 24 at the Wooden Legacy.
- * San Diego State outscored Chaminade, 36-20, in the paint.
- * After committing 11 turnovers in the first half, SDSU committed only five in the second half.
- * SDSU forced 11 turnovers in the second half after forcing six in the first half.
- * SDSU's three leading scorers (Matt Mitchell 16, Jordan Schakel 16 and Jalen McDaniels 14) were all sophomores.

Player Notes

Matt Mitchell - 16 points, 5 rebounds, 4 assists

Reached double-figures in scoring, something that happened 20 times last season... Led the team in scoring, which he did three times in 2017-18.

Jordan Schakel - 16 points, 1 rebound, 1 assist, 1 steal

Scored in double-figures, something he only did once last season... Tied for the team lead in scoring. Last season, he did not lead SDSU in scoring in any game... Had 11 of his 16 points in the second half... Made all three of his 3-pointers. Last season, he was 2-for-2 once (Jan. 13 at Boise State), but did not make more than two without a miss all year.

Jalen McDaniels - 14 points, 7 rebounds, 1 blocked shot

Reached double-figures in scoring, something he did 18 times last season... Led the team in rebounding (tied), something that occurred 18 times last season.

Jeremy Hemsley - 11 points, 1 rebound, 1 blocked shot, 1 assist, 1 steal

Scored in double-figures, something that happened 10 times last year and 57 times over his career.
