• The Aztecs will host TCU, BYU and California Baptist for the SDSU Thanksgiving Classic this weekend. The Aztecs face California Baptist Friday at 5:00 p.m. and they take on their old Mountain West foe, TCU, Saturday evening at 7:15 p.m.

Chris Ello (12th season) will have the call courtside for both games. A link to the audio-only broadcast is located on the women's
 basketball schedule page on GoAztecs.com

• The Aztecs are have scored 80 points or more in their last two games and most recently beat Incarnate Word 81-38, their first 40 point win since the 2012-13 season.

• For the second game in a row, at least four Aztecs scored in double-digits. Téa Adams and Sophia Ramos had a game-high 13 points, Monique Terry had a career-high 12 and Najé Murray and Jayden Perez each had 11. The freshman Perez hadn't yet scored entering the game.

• The Aztecs scored 21 fast break points against Incarnate Word last Sunday, their most since scoring 23 at New Mexico on February 6, 2016.

• SDSU ranks in the top 100 nationally in ten team statistics. Their +5.5 rebound margin is their highest ranking stat, which is 42nd in the nation.

• The Aztecs' backcourt trio of Téa Adams, Najé Murray and Sophia Ramos are all averaging more than 31 minutes per game. This group is responsible for 59 percent of the Aztecs' points and 69 percent of their assists so far.

The Aztecs set program-highs for total attendance and average attendance last season and are on pace to break that again
after averaging 2,019 fans per game so far this season.

#### Last Time Out (81-38, Incarnate Word 11-18-18)

Behind a dominant second quarter, the Aztecs (3-1) cruised to an 81-38 win over Incarnate Word Sunday afternoon. Five Aztecs scored at least ten points and ten players total scored.

SDSU played stifling defense all game and held the Cardinals to 21 percent shooting and forced 24 turnovers, which led to 25 Aztec points. The Aztecs gave up just one field goal to Incarnate Word in the second and third quarters combined.

"We played a little more zone than we have in the past," Head Coach Stacie Terry said after the game. "I think we got better at that. We take pride in our defense and that's something that's going to be constant for us all year in order to give us a chance to win. Anytime you can hold a team to less than 40 points, you've done a great job."

Sophia Ramos and Téa led the Aztecs in scoring with 13 points each. Ramos also had a team-high five assists. Also scoring in double-digits was Monique Terry (12), Najé Murray (12) and freshman Jayden Perez (11). Terry and Perez both notched career-highs.

Aside from a rocky start in the first three minutes of the game, the Aztecs held a comfortable lead for the entire game. They fell behind 12-7, but then outscored the Cardinals 37-3 for the rest of the first half, including a 26-2 advantage in the second quarter.

SDSU once again held the Cardinals at bay in third quarter, outscoring them 13-2. Incarnate Word shot a combined 1-31 in the second and third quarters.

The Aztecs held a commanding 46-32 advantage on the glass and were led by Mallory Adams' nine rebounds. Baylee Vanderdoes collected eight rebounds, her second straight game with at least eight boards.

SDSU scored 21 fast break points, many of those coming off turnovers, and had 44 points in the paint.

11 Aztecs played at least ten minutes and ten scored.

#### Noting the Incarnate Word Game

 The Aztecs outscored the Cardinals 39-5 in the second and third quarters and held UIW to 1-for-31 shooting in that span.

 Both Jayden Perez (11) and Monique Terry (12) had career-highs today. For Perez, it was her first collegiate points. Terry bested her previous best of eight points and knocked down two three-pointers, the first of her career.

• It was the second consecutive game SDSU has had at least four scorers in doubledigits.

• This was the first time the Aztecs have scored 80 points or more in back-to-back games since January 2017 when they did it three times in a row.

• This is the second straight year the Aztecs have started the season 3-1.

 This is the first time the Aztecs have won by at least 40 points since March 9, 2013, an 86-45 win over Boise State.

• The Aztecs outrebounded the Titans 46-32. They have outrebounded their opponent in every game so far this season.

• The Aztecs scored 21 fast break points against Incarnate Word last Sunday, their most since scoring 23 at New Mexico on February 6, 2016.

• Téa Adams has led the Aztecs in scoring in every game and is averaging a teamhigh 14.8 points per game.

#### Téa Party!

• Téa Adams, who entered the year with zero career starts, has been the Aztecs' leading scorer in all four of their games (five if you count their exhibition vs. Biola). She had a career-high 21 points at Cal State Fullerton.

• Adams showed flashes of brilliance last year but was inconsistent from the field and shot just 28 percent. However, this year her field goal percentage is up to 49 percent and she is scoring in a variety of ways at the rim and in the paint.

• With Geena Gomez and McKynzie Fort graduated, an increase in minutes was expected for Adams. In fact, her playing time has doubled from a season ago. After averaging 16.6 minutes last year, she is now playing 31.0.

 An aggressive playmaker, Adams has done a great job of not only getting to the line, but also knocking down her free-throws. Last Thursday at Cal State Fullerton, she was a perfect 7-for-7 from the charity stripe and is 13-for-15 on the season.

#### Youth Movement

• The Aztecs started two freshmen, two sophomores and one junior in the season opener against Hawai'i. That group had a combined 33 career starts entering the game.

• The freshmen duo of Sophia Ramos and Mallory Adams earned the starting nod in the season opener, marking the first time two freshmen started the season opener for the Aztecs since 2003 (Michelle Elliott and Courtney Fritz).

• The Aztecs' backcourt trio of Téa Adams, Najé Murray and Sophia Ramos are all averaging more than 31 minutes per game. This group is responsible for 59 percent of the Aztecs' points and 69 percent of their assists so far.

• Freshman point guard Sophia Ramos (San Antonio, Texas) has scored in doubledigits in three of the Aztecs' four games. A high IQ player, she is leading the team in assists as well as assist to turnover ratio, while shooting a team-high 55 percent from the floor.

• Her freshman sidekick, Mallory Adams (Frisco, Texas) had a career-high nine rebounds against Incarnate Word and leads the team with 6.3 rebounds per game. Most impressively, Adams has just two turnovers in 103 minutes played so far this season.

#### **Taking a Different Approach**

• With the Aztecs losing four starters and six players total from a year ago, this year's team was bound to look different The Aztecs returned just 34.6 percent of their scoring from last season.

• With sharpshooters Geena Gomez and Lexy Thorderson, the Aztecs averaged 19 three-point attempts per game, which accounted for 33 percent of their field goal attempts. This season, the Aztecs are putting the ball on the deck and creating off the dribble and averaging 13 three-point shots per game, which is just 23 percent of their total FG attempts.

This year, the Aztecs have four players averaging at least nine points a game, which gives the offense more balance. This was on full display Sunday vs. Incarnate Word when five Aztecs had at least 10 points.

• Head Coach Stacie Terry and her staff announced the signing of Isabela Hernandez to a letter of intent earlier this month.

• Hernandez, a four-star recruit according to Prospects Nation, helped Lynden Christian High School (Bellingham, Wash.) to a perfect 29-0 record and state championship last season.

• A 6'2" wing, Hernandez averaged 13 points per game last season along with 5.3 rebounds. She knocked down 50 percent of her shots from the field and was 88 percent from the free-throw line.

• Hernandez was an all-state selection last year and earned all-league and all-

county recognition as both a sophomore and as a junior. She was heavily recruited and received offers from Gonzaga, Colorado, Washington State and Colorado State among others.

#### **Preseason Notes**

• The Aztecs were picked to finish ninth in the Mountain West preseason poll.

• The Aztecs lost four starters and six players total from a year ago. The Aztecs return just 34.6 percent of their scoring from last season.

• Najé Murray (Stockton, Calif.), who was named to the Mountain West all-freshman team last year, is the Aztecs' leading returning scorer (9.3 ppg). She led all MW freshmen in three-pointers made per game and was fourth overall in scoring among freshmen.

• The support from the community was record-breaking a season ago. The Aztecs had 22,069 fans over their 16 home games for an average of 1,379. That broke the total and average attendance records set in 2007-08, when the Aztecs drew 14,730 fans for an average of 1,133 per game.

• The Aztecs have had a winning record at home in 10 of the past 12 seasons.

• The Aztecs shot 71.4 percent from the free throw line last year, their best mark since the 1988-89 season and the fourth best rate in program history.

• The Aztecs made 200 three-pointers last season, the second most in program history (204, 2016-17). They made 33.7 percent of their three-point attempts, their best percentage since the 2009-10 season and the fourth best rate in program history

• For the second straight season San Diego State's incoming freshman class is nationally ranked. The Aztecs' 2018 recruiting class is ranked 59th nationally (according to Prospects Nation), fourth in the Mountain West. G/F Mallory Adams (Frisco, Texas), G Jayden Perez (Las Cruces, N.M.) and G Sophia Ramos (San Antonio, Texas) comprise the freshmen class.

• Transfers Zayn Dornstauder (Ball State) and Taylor Kalmer (Oregon State) will also join the Aztecs this year, although Kalmer will sit out the 2018-19 season due to NCAA transfer rules. Dornstauder, a 6'3" center from Canada, redshirted at Ball State last year after playing two years at San Francisco as a reserve. Kalmer, a 5'8" guard, spent her past three years at Pac-12 powerhouse Oregon State where she averaged a career-high 6.0 points per game last season.
