## SCENE SETTER (through the games of Mon., Nov. 19)

- Approximately 15 hours after its quarterfinal round game, San Diego State is back in action on day two of the 2019 Maui Jim Maui Invitational with a contest against Big East member Xavier.
- San Diego State is playing in its fourth Maui event (1989, 2003, 2014 and 2018) and owns a 5-5 record in the event. The Aztecs are 5-3, with three straight wins, when not playing a team ranked in the AP top three at the time of the game.
- Brian Dutcher owns a 3-0 record on the second day of consecutive games, with neutral site wins over Georgia, No. 22 Nevada and New Mexico.
- SDSU has performed well in eight-team in-season tournaments since 2008-09. The Aztecs had advanced to the championship game of eight-team events in each of their last six appearances (that streak snapped with yesterday's loss) posting a 15-4 record (includes yesterday) during that span.
- San Diego State is now 11-2 in its last 13 games dating back to last season. It is the best 13-game stretch since the 2015-16 squad posted 11 consecutive wins from Dec. 30, 2015 through Feb. 6, 2016 (streak snapped Feb. 10, 2016). That squad finished the campaign 28-10.
- Since Feb. 14, 2018, San Diego State's 11-2 record is tied for the ninth-highest winning percentage in the country (Michigan leads during that period of time (18-1).

## LAST TIME OUT (through the games of Mon., Nov. 19)

- San Diego State suffered its first loss of the 2018-19 campaign, with a 90-64 loss to top-ranked Duke.
- Duke connected on six of its first eight three-point attempts and ended the game with 10 treys and 40.0 percent from bonus distance. In Division I basketball, teams that yield those minimums this season are 60-208.
- San Diego State placed four players in double figures, led by senior guard Devin Watson who tallied 15 points on the strength of 3-of-6 from three-point range.
- San Diego State forced Duke into 25 personal fouls. It marks just the 19th time since the 2009-10 season that Duke has committed at least that many fouls. More impressively, the Devils have done it just nine times in wins (in losses that total could be inflated due to intentional fouls down the stretch).
- Sophomores Jalen McDaniels and Matt Mitchell both drew five fouls against the Blue Devils.

- San Diego State has advanced to postseason play in 12 of the last 13 seasons (2006 NCAA, 2007-09 NIT, 2010-15 NCAA, 2016 NIT, 2018 NCAA).

Scored in double-figures for the third time this season and 21st time of his career... Reached double-figures in scoring for the fourth straight game... Led the team in rebounding for the third time this year and 21st time of his career (SDSU is 18-3 in those games). Has nine assists this season (3.0 avg)... Blocked 2 shots in the game giving his six blocks through three games.
- **Matt Mitchell** – 11 points, 3 rebounds  
Reached double-figures for the third straight game and for the 23rd time of his career... The current three-game streak is just two off his career-high of five games... Made 5-of-6 free throw attempts and is tied for the team lead with 17 attempts through three games.


