SCENE SETTER (through the games of Sun, Nov. 26)

- Following a stretch of three games in three days in Maui, San Diego State returns to action for its first game in six days when the Aztecs play host to Jackson State on Tuesday at Viejas Arena.
- The game marks the annual Nike N7 game for San Diego State. This marks the fifth straight season that SDSU has taken part in the event that celebrates Native American Heritage Month. The Aztecs will wear turquoise uniforms on Tuesday.
- The Aztecs are playing their third opponent from the SWAC this season, having recorded victories over Arkansas-Pine Bluff and Texas Southern.
- The Aztecs are 8-0 in program history against current members of the SWAC.
- SDSU has won eight consecutive home games and own a 16-2 in its last 18 home games played at Viejas Arena.
- San Diego State is now 12-3 in its last 15 games regardless of location dating back to last season.

LAST TIME OUT (through the games of Sun, Nov. 26)

- San Diego State falls to 3-2 on the season. Its two losses, to Duke and Iowa State, have come against teams that are a combined 10-1 (pending Duke-Gonzaga outcome) this season.
- San Diego State struggled offensively today, setting season lows for points (57), field goals (18), field goal percentage (35.3 percent), free throws (14) and free throws attempted (17). Despite that, at the end of the game KenPom still had SDSU rated the adjusted offense as 68th nationally. If the Aztecs ended the season with that ranking it would be the school's highest ranking since 2010-11 NCAA Sweet 16 team finished 28th in the country.
- San Diego State's streak of 10 consecutive wins against teams not ranked in the AP Top 25 at game time came to an end. Iowa State is receiving top 25 votes in both major pulls.
- San Diego State committed a season-low 11 turnovers, with the starting backcourt of Devin Watson and Jeremy Hemsley only accounting for two of those turnovers.
- This is the first time in the Brian Dutcher era that SDSU has lost a game after playing the previous day. The Aztecs entered the contest with a 4-0 record dating back to the start of last season.
- Matt Mitchell team-high 14 points, 6 rebounds, 6-6 FTs, 1 turnover, 28 minutes Following his first game this season in single digits, Mitchell scored a team-high 14 points... He has reached double figures in four of the five games this season... Has 24 career double-figure scoring games... After a 6-for-6 performance from the line tonight, he is 21-of-25 for the season (84.0 percent).
- Jeremy Hemsley 10 points, 2 assistss, 4-4 FTs, 1 turnover, 31 minutes After failing to reach double figures the game before, Hemsley scored 10 points and has reached that plateau four times in five games this season... Has connected on 10 consecutive free throw attempts (over the last three games)... Has 61 career doubledigit scoring games, with 10 of those coming in games in which he did not make a three-point field goal.

■ Jalen McDaniels — 10 points, team-high 7 rebounds

One day after scoring a career-high 26 points, McDaniels scored 10 points to reach double-figure scoring for the fifth straight time this season... That streak is six games dating back to last season (one short of his career high).

SAN DIEGO STATE SNAPSHOT

- In its first five games, San Diego State has started two seniors and three sophomores.
- The Aztecs have a wealth of experience in the backcourt with a pair of seniors. **Devin Watson**, who is in his third year with the program after playing two seasons at the Univ. of San Francisco, leads the team this season in minutes played (34.8), scoring (15.6), assists (4.4) and has connected on 16-of-37 attempts from beyond the arc (43.2 percent). **Jeremy Hemsley**, has played extensively for San Diego State the last four seasons logging 106 games and 68 starts. He is averaging 30.2 minutes (second on the team) and 10.0 points, and is considered the team's best defender.
- The other three starters come from the Aztecs' sensational sophomore class of Jalen McDaniels, Matt Mitchell and Jordan Schakel. Through five games the group has averaged 38 points and 79.2 minutes The three players also have chipped in 80 rebounds, 22 assists and 11 steals to date.
- San Diego State currently has four players in double figures all of whom start. In addition to the two seniors, sophomore forward **McDaniels** (15.2) and sophomore forward **Mitchell** (13.0).
- To date, the Aztecs defense has been very impressive. SDSU's four opponents shot a combined 42.4 percent from the field, 33.1 percent from three-point distance and are averaging 12.8 turnovers and 75.0 points.

BRIAN DUTCHER

Head Coach

2nd Season • 20th Season Overall at SDSU • Minnesota, 1982

Brian Dutcher, a long-time San Diego State men's basketball assistant coach, is entering his second season as head coach after a first year in which he led the Aztecs to their Mountain West-high 11th conference title and back to the NCAA tournament for the first time since 2015. Dutcher, who took over the helm of the program following Steve Fisher's retirement announcement on April 11, 2017, was on The Mesa for all of Fisher's 18 seasons. He held the title of associate head coach/head coach in waiting for six years and is the program's 15th head coach.

Over the course of his time at San Diego State, Dutcher helped the Aztecs reach the postseason 14 times, including nine trips to the NCAA tournament, win a conference-best 11 Mountain West titles and record 13 seasons of at least 20 victories.

Since 2008-09, Dutcher and SDSU twice advanced to the NCAA Sweet 16 (2011, 2014) and NIT semifinal round (2009, 2016), won at least 25 games seven times and captured eight MW championships (five regular season, three tournament).

Dutcher arrived at SDSU shortly after Fisher was hired on March 26, 1999. In his first year in "America's Finest City," the Aztecs won only five games, but improved upon their win total from the season before. After that, San Diego State posted a 14-14 record in 2000-01, before winning the 2002 MW Championship, earning an NCAA tournament bid and finishing with a 21-12 record. The 2002-03 campaign saw SDSU receive an NIT invitation, which culminated in the program's first Division I postseason victory.

After helping attract the first McDonald's All-American to the 2002-03 squad, Dutcher assisted in securing the signatures of future starters and all-league performers Brandon Heath and Marcus Slaughter. The duo started their first two seasons on The Mesa, leading to the 2005-06 season that produced the school's first Mountain West regular-season and tournament title sweep.

The Aztecs advanced to the NCAA tournament and ultimately won a then-school-record 24 games. That appearance led to a string of 10 consecutive postseason berths.

From the 2006-07 campaign through 2008-09, San Diego State registered 20 or more wins and went to three straight NITs. In 2009, the Aztecs advanced to the NIT semifinals and broke the previous school record with 26 victories.

The run to the NIT semifinals was a springboard to the most successful run in SDSU basketball history. Led by future NBA first-round draft pick and NBA champion Kawhi Leonard, the 2009-10 Aztecs won the MW Championship, advanced to the NCAA tournament and fell four points shy of moving on to the second round before finishing with a 25-9 record.

The NCAA experience from the 2009-10 squad proved fruitful in 2010-11 when it returned all five starters, including Leonard, and a freshman named Jamaal Franklin, who would turn out to be a future MW Player of the Year and NBA draft selection. With Dutcher on staff, SDSU won its first 20 games of the year, shared the MW regular-season title and captured the MW tournament crown. The Aztecs moved on to the NCAA tournament as a No. 2 seed and won the program's first Division I NCAA tournament game. San Diego State, which was ranked as high as No. 4 and received first-place votes at one point in the season, advanced to the Sweet 16 and fell to the eventual national champion, finishing with a school-record 34 wins, a mark that still stands today. The Aztecs' also found themselves in the final top-25 polls, ranking sixth in the AP and 11th in the USA Today Coaches Poll.

Five months after SDSU's record-setting 2010-11 campaign, the University elevated Dutcher from associate head coach to associate head coach/head coach in waiting.

In his first season with his new title, Dutcher and the Aztecs advanced to the 2011-12 NCAA tournament as an at-large team and recorded 26 wins. The next season, SDSU was again an at-large selection to the 2013 NCAA tournament, moved on to the round of 32 for the second time in three years and finished with 23 victories.

Another NCAA Sweet 16 run was in the cards in Dutcher's third season as the head coach in waiting. The Aztecs opened the season by winning 21 of their first 22 games, including 20 in a row at one point, and were led by seniors Xavier Thames, who would become an NBA draft pick, and Josh Davis. SDSU won the program's second outright Mountain West regular-season title and later swept through two games in Spokane, Washington, to secure its second Sweet 16 appearance in four seasons. San Diego State compiled 31 wins and finished the season ranked 13th in the AP and 12th in the Coaches after rising to as high as fifth nationally in both polls.

The 2014-15 campaign saw the Aztecs spend their fifth straight season in the top 25. In the process of winning 27 games, San Diego State grabbed its second straight MW regular-season crown and earned an atlarge invitation to the NCAA tournament where they defeated St. John's in the round of 64. One season later, the Aztecs found themselves in the NIT after winning the MW by three games with a 16-2 record. Nevertheless, San Diego State won three games and qualified for the NIT national semifinals, eventually logging 28 victories.

Last season, SDSU won six consecutive games to end the regular season and all three in the MW tournament to capture the program's 11th league crown to return to the NCAA tournament. Despite the NCAA first-round exit, SDSU finished the campaign with a 22-11 record, with the 22 wins representing the most by a first-year Aztec men's basketball head coach and the second-most among first-year coaches last season. Before Dutcher arrived at San Diego State, he served as assistant coach and later associate head coach at Michigan under Fisher. He spent 10 seasons on the Wolverine staff, establishing himself as one of the nation's top assistant coaches. His first year in Ann Arbor was 1989 and resulted in a national title for Michigan as he assisted then-interim head coach Fisher on the bench.

The Bloomington, Minn., native led UM's recruiting efforts in 1990-91 when the Wolverines inked Juwan Howard, Ray Jackson, Jimmy King, Jalen Rose and Chris Webber. The "Fab Five" is considered perhaps the best recruiting class in NCAA history. Dutcher helped lead that group to nearly 100 wins, two berths in the NCAA championship game and a regional final over a four-year period. He was also on the Michigan staff for an NIT championship (1997).

Dutcher's recruiting prowess, however, was demonstrated by more than just the "Fab Five" haul. Michigan had the nation's top-ranked recruiting class in 1993-94 and in 1994-95, with a group that included Maurice Taylor and Jerod Ward. The accomplishment marked the first time that a university had the nation's top class in consecutive years, according to recruiting analyst Bob Gibbons.

Dutcher was born Oct. 30, 1959, in Alpena, Mich. He attended Jefferson High School in Bloomington, Minn., and went on to earn a bachelor's degree in physical education from Minnesota in 1982. While an undergraduate, he worked for his father, then-Gopher head coach Jim Dutcher. He then spent one season in the prep ranks at Apple Valley (Minn.) High School before becoming a graduate assistant at Illinois, where he earned his master's degree in physical education and athletic administration.

While in Champaign, Dutcher helped Lou Henson lead the Illini to a Big Ten championship, two appearances in the Sweet 16 and one regional final.

Dutcher's first full-time coaching job came at South Dakota State, where he spent three seasons helping turn around the Division II program before departing in 1988 for Michigan.

His final season in Ann Arbor ended with the Wolverines claiming the first-ever Big Ten Tournament championship.







San Diego State 76 Arkansas-Pine Bluff 60

SAN DIEGO - Senior guard Devin Watson connected on a careerhigh six three-point field goals and had a team-high 20 points as San Diego State opened its 2018-19 campaign with a 76-60 victory over Arkansas-Pine Bluff at Viejas Arena.

It was the sixth straight season-opening win for SDSU and the Aztecs have now won 14 consecutive home openers (regardless of the game being a season opener).

San Diego State led 39-36 with 17:38 to play when the Aztecs went on a 15-2 run to open up a comfortable 16-point lead. Senior guard Jeremy Hemsley had seven points during the spurt and was one of three Aztecs (Jordan Schakel and Watson) to connect on a trey during the decisive run.

The lead grew to 23 points (following a 30-10 run) before the Aztecs settled for the 16-point final margin.

San Diego State's trademark stellar defense on full display, limited Arkansas-Pine Bluff to 35.7 percent field goal shooting and forced the Golden Lions into 18 turnovers.

Watson recorded his fifth game with the Aztecs with at least 20 points, a figure he has reached 24 times in his career. His six treys are the fourth most by an Aztec player in Viejas Arena history.

Hemsley added 14 points, three assists and three steals. Sophomore forward Jalen McDaniels narrowly missed a double-double with 15 points and team highs with nine rebounds and five assists. Sophomore forward Matt Mitchell rounded out four Aztec players in double figures with 10 points and five rebounds.

McDaniels became just the fourth Aztec player in the last 22 seasons to record at least 15 points, nine rebounds, five assists and three steals in a game, joining Jamaal Franklin, Kawhi Leonard and Chase Tapley.

SAN DIEGO - Six San Diego State players scored in double figures, including all five starters, as the Aztecs never trailed and cruised to a 103-64 victory over Texas Southern.

San Diego State, which improved to 2-0 for the first time in four seasons, received a game-high 21 points from Matt Mitchell. The sophomore also added five rebounds and three assists.

Classmate Jordan Schakel had a career-high 16 points on 3-of-3 three-point field goal shooting and 7-of-7 from the charity stripe, and had seven rebounds.

Sophomore Jalen McDaniels added 14 points and a game-high nine rebounds, while Devin Watson poured in 14 points and had eight assists for SDSU. Senior Jeremy Hemsley scored 10 points and freshman Nathan Mensah came off the bench to score 11 points and pull down five rebounds.

San Diego State scored the first eight points of the game and led by as many as 41 points in claiming the team's eighth straight home win.

The Aztecs produced its highest point total in nearly five years (118 vs. Saint Katherine College, Dec. 27, 2013) connected on 52.3 percent from the field and was 27-of-36 from the free throw line.

Meanwhile, SDSU limited the Tigers to 33.3 percent field goal shooting and forced 14 turnovers on the evening.

San Diego State won for the 68th straight time when shooting at least 50 percent from the field and has won 71 consecutive contests when shooting 50 percent and committing 13 or fewer turnovers

LAHAINA, Hawaii - Duke made five of its first seven attempts from beyond the arc to build a 13-point advantage in the opening 10 minutes of the game and the top-ranked Blue Devils defeated San Diego State, 90-64, in the opening day of the Maui Jim Maui Invitational

San Diego State held Duke without an opening possession and quickly got a transition follow basket from sophomore Matt Mitchell to put the Aztecs on top, 2-0. It was the only lead of the day for SDSU.

The Blue Devils feature one of the nation's most dangerous lineups and on this day that fearsome unit made nine first-half three-point field goals to build a 49-32 halftime advantage.

Senior Jeremy Hemsley and sophomore Jalen McDaniels made consecutive lay ups early in the second half to cut the deficit to 13, but the Aztecs were not able to draw any closer.

Despite the loss, there were plenty of positive takeaways for SDSU. The Aztecs made 27 trips to the line and drew 25 fouls on the Blue Devils. McDaniels and Mitchell tied for team-high honors by drawing five fouls apiece.

San Diego State was led by senior guard Devin Watson's 15 points. Hemsley added 12 points and McDaniels and Mitchell each chipped in with 11 points apiece.

Duke was led R.J. Barrett who had 20 points and five assists. The Aztecs held Zion Williams, a projected NBA lottery pick, to 13 points on 5-of-11 attempts from the line.

The game marked just the fourth all-time matchup for the Aztecs against the nation's top ranked team. On two occasions, the opponent has been the Blue Devils.

San Diego State 79 Xavier 74

LAHAINA, Hawaii - San Diego State made one of the most dramatic comebacks in school history, overcoming a 19-point deficit, to defeat Xavier, 79-74, on the second day of the Maui Jim Maui Invitational.

The Aztecs trailed 32-13 with 9:21 to play in the first half against a Musketeers' program that is the defending Big East Conference champions, was a No. 1-seed in the NCAA tournament and finished the campaign 29-6.

SDSU scored the next seven points as part of a 27-5 run to cut the deficit to three points at half.

After allowing the opening basket of the second half, the Aztecs went on a 17-2 run to open up a nine-point advantage. In all, SDSU outscored Xavier, 45-17, over approximately a 20-minute period in the middle of the game.

San Diego State was led by sophomore sensation Jalen McDaniels. McDaniels scored a career-high 26 points on the strength of 9-of-14 shooting, including a career-high three three-point field goals. He added eight rebounds and three blocked shots

Senior guard Devin Watson tallied 21 points, including four three-point field goals, and added a game-high seven assists. Sophomore guard Jordan Schakel made three three's en route to a 13-point, five-rebound performance.

San Diego State shot 53.8 percent from the field and ran its winning streak to 68 games when shooting at least 50 percent from the floor. Equally impressive was the fact the Aztecs outre-bounded their bigger Big East opponent, 33-29.

The comeback was the third largest in SDSU recorded history and the largest in Brian Dutcher's tenure as SDSU's head coach.

Xavier raced out to the big lead by making eight of its first 10 and 13 of its first 19 field goal attempts. As if that was not bad enough, the Musketeers converted on five of its first seven attempts from beyond the arc.
