- The Aztecs will head across town to take on the University of San Diego Wednesday evening at 6:00 p.m.
- The game will be streamed on TheW.tv. Additionally, Chris Ello (12th season) will be calling the game courtside. A link to the audio-only broadcast is located on the women's basketball schedule page on GoAztecs.com
- Freshman Mallory Adams averaged a double-double last week and was the Aztecs' representative on the SDSU Thanksgiving Classic All-Tournament Team. She had double-digit rebounds in each of her last two games, becoming the first Aztec to accomplish that since Khristina Hunter in December of 2014.
- The Aztecs have had four players score in double figures in three of their last four games.
- Despite being undersized compared to TCU, the Aztecs had 41 rebounds to the Horned Frogs' 37 last Saturday. They haven't been outrebounded in a game all season.
- The Aztecs shot over 30 free throws in their last two games. As a team, they rank in the top 30 nationally in both free throws made and attempted.
- The Aztecs had 23 second chance points against TCU, the most they have had all season and more than their last three games combined.
- The Aztecs' backcourt trio of Téa Adams, Najé Murray and Sophia Ramos are all averaging more than 30 minutes per game. This group is responsible for 57 percent of the Aztecs' points and 72 percent of their assists.
- The Aztecs set program-highs for total attendance and average attendance last season and are on pace to break that again after averaging 1,391 fans per game so far this season.

Last Time Out (81-38, Incarnate Word 11-18-18)

The San Diego State women's basketball team (4-2) had their three-game winning streak snapped with an 81-64 loss to TCU (4-1) in the final game of the SDSU Thanksgiving Classic Saturday evening.

TCU, who went to the WNIT final four a season ago, used their size and length to make things difficult for the Aztecs offensively. SDSU was held to 33 percent shooting while the Horned Frogs connected on 48 percent of their field goals.

The Aztecs were led in scoring by Najé Murray and Sophia Ramos, who each had 14 points. Mallory Adams had another big game on the glass, collecting double-digit rebounds (10) for the second game in a row while scoring nine points. She averaged a double-double over the past two games and represented the Aztecs on the SDSU Thanksaiving Classic All-Tournament Team.

TCU jumped out to an early lead after a 10-2 run gave them a 15-7 advantage. The Aztecs were whistled for five fouls in the first four minutes, including two on their leading scorer, Téa Adams. Between the fouls and eight turnovers, SDSU found themselves down 25-16 at the end of the first quarter. This was the most points the Aztecs have allowed in the first quarter this season.

SDSU fared better in the second quarter but were still bothered by the size and length of the TCU defenders. The Aztecs were aggressive and got in to lane but were either fouled or forced to take tough shots. SDSU made just five of their 10 free throws in the second quarter and were down 12 at the half.

The Aztecs couldn't cut their deficit to single digits the rest of the game, although they cut it to ten a couple times, including with six minutes left in the fourth quarter. However, TCU responded with a 7-0 run to put the game out of reach.

TCU was led by Kianna Ray, who scored 23 points on 8-for-12 shooting. Jordan Moore had 17 points and Amy Okonkwo added 12.

The Aztecs had 19 rebounds which amounted to a season-high 23 second-chance points.

Noting the TCU Game

- The Aztecs had 23 second chance points, the most they have had all season and more than their last three games combined.
- Nine Aztecs scored, the third straight game that has occured.

Scouting the Toreros

- San Diego is 2-3 on the season and 2-1 at home.
- They went 1-1 in their Thanksgiving tournament last week. They beat Cleveland State (83-82) and lost to Cal (53-70).
- Patricia Brossmann is leading the team in points (13.6) and rebounds (6.4). She leads the WCC with a 59.2 field goal percentage.
- Myah Pace is averaging a team-high 4.6 assists per game.
- The Toreros are second in the WCC with a +4.6 rebound margin.
- They have topped 60 points just once.
- SDSU has one opponent in common with the Toreros; both teams beat Hawai'i.
- Head Coach Cindy Fisher (14th season) has over 300 career wins.

All-Time Series vs. the Toreros

- San Diego State is 29-12 all-time against USD.
- The Aztecs are 9-6 when playing at USD.
- SDSU beat San Diego 77-76 last season after McKynzie Fort hit a driving shot in the final 10 seconds.
- Before that win, the Toreros had won four games in a row.
- The Aztecs are 2-6 in their last eight games at the Jenny Craig Pavilion.
- SDSU won the first 17 meetings between the two schools.
- The first meeting was February 28, 1978, an 83-31 SDSU win.
- The Aztecs are 77-67 all-time against the WCC and 0-1 on the year (43-60 at Santa Clara).

With a W

- The Aztecs will improve to 5-2 on the season, marking the second consecutive year they have won five of their first seven games.
- SDSU will be 2-1 on the road. The Aztecs won just two road games all of last season.
- The Aztecs would move to 30-12 all-time against USD and 10-6 in road games.

Fab Frosh

Mallory Adams

- Adams averaged a double-double last week and was the Aztecs' representative on the SDSU Thanksgiving Classic All-Tournament Team.
- She had double-digit rebounds in each of her last two games, becoming the first Aztec to accomplish that since Khristina Hunter in December of 2014.
- Adams made 11 free-throws last Friday vs. California Baptist, which tied for the fifth most in a single-game in program history.
- She is now second in the Mountain West in both free throws made and attempted as well as rebounds.
- She leads the team with 7.7 rebounds per game and with 2.3 offensive rebounds per game.
- She has committed just three turnovers in 169 minutes played, the best rate on the team.
- She is shooting 40 percent from three-point territory (4-10).

Sophia Ramos

- Ramos leads the team with 27 assists (4.5 per game) and has a +1.7 assist to turnover ratio, the best on the team.
- She is shooting 48 percent from the floor, also the best on the team (minmum four field goal attempts per game).
- She had career-highs in assists (9) and steals (5) against California Baptist last Friday.
- She leads the team in minutes played (32.7 per game).
- Despite being 5'9", she is second on the team in rebounds (5.2 per game).

Dornstauder the Denier

- Zayn Dornstauder had six blocks last weekend including a career-high four against TCU on Saturday.
- She is second in the Mountain West with 11 blocks and 42nd in the country.
- She is averaging a block every nine minutes on the floor.

Earning Free Throws

- The Aztecs attempted more than 30 free-throws in both their games last week.
- They rank in the top 30 nationally in both free-throw makes and attempts. However, they are 176th in free-throw percentage (.674).
- Mallory Adams is second in the Mountain West in both free throws made and attempted.

Cleaning the Glass

- The Aztecs have yet to be outrebounded in a game so far this season and have a +4.3 rebound margin on the year.
- Freshman Mallory Adams leads the team with 7.7 rebounds per game and has a team-high 14 offensive boards.

Téa Party!

- Téa Adams, who entered the year with zero career starts, leads the Aztecs with 13.7
 points per game. She had a career-high 21 points at Cal State Fullerton.
- Adams showed flashes of brilliance last year but was inconsistent from the field and shot just 28 percent. However, this year her field goal percentage is up to 47 percent and she is scoring in a variety of ways at the rim and in the paint.
- With Geena Gomez and McKynzie Fort graduated, an increase in minutes was expected for Adams. In fact, her playing time has nearly doubled from a season ago. After averaging 16.6 minutes last year, she is now playing 30.2

Youth Movement

- The Aztecs started two freshmen, two sophomores and one junior in the season opener against Hawai'i. That group had a combined 33 career starts entering the game.
- The freshmen duo of Sophia Ramos and Mallory Adams earned the starting nod in the season opener, marking the first time two freshmen started the season opener for the Aztecs since 2003 (Michelle Elliott and Courtney Fritz).
- The Aztecs' backcourt trio of Téa Adams, Najé Murray and Sophia Ramos are all averaging more than 30 minutes per game. This group is responsible for 57 percent of the Aztecs' points and 72 percent of their assists so far.

Taking a Different Approach

- With the Aztecs losing four starters and six players total from a year ago, this year's team was bound to look different The Aztecs returned just 34.6 percent of their scoring from last season.
- With sharpshooters Geena Gomez and Lexy Thorderson, the Aztecs averaged 19
 three-point attempts per game, which accounted for 33 percent of their field goal
 attempts. This season, the Aztecs are putting the ball on the deck and creating off
 the dribble and averaging 14 three-point shots per game, which is just 24 percent of
 their total FG attempts.
- Last season, McKynzie Fort and Geena Gomez led the Aztecs in scoring in nearly
 every game. This year, the Aztecs have four players averaging at least ten points a
 game, which gives the offense more balance. Four Aztecs have scored in double-digits
 in three of their last four games.

Aztecs Ink Isabela

- Head Coach Stacie Terry and her staff announced the signing of Isabela Hernandez to a letter of intent earlier this month.
- Hernandez, a four-star recruit according to Prospects Nation, helped Lynden Christian High School (Bellingham, Wash.) to a perfect 29-0 record and state championship last
- A 6'2" wing, Hernandez averaged 13 points per game last season along with 5.3 rebounds. She knocked down 50 percent of her shots from the field and was 88 percent from the free-throw line.
- Hernandez was an all-state selection last year and earned all-league and all-county recognition as both a sophomore and as a junior. She was heavily recruited and received offers from Gonzaga, Colorado, Washington State and Colorado State among others.

Preseason Notes

- The Aztecs were picked to finish ninth in the Mountain West preseason poll.
- The Aztecs lost four starters and six players total from a year ago. The Aztecs return just 34.6 percent of their scoring from last season.
- Najé Murray (Stockton, Calif.), who was named to the Mountain West all-freshman team last year, is the Aztecs' leading returning scorer (9.3 ppg). She led all MW freshmen in three-pointers made per game and was fourth overall in scoring among freshmen.

- The support from the community was record-breaking a season ago. The Aztecs had 22,069 fans over their 16 home games for an average of 1,379. That broke the total and average attendance records set in 2007-08, when the Aztecs drew 14,730 fans for an average of 1,133 per game.
- The Aztecs have had a winning record at home in 10 of the past 12 seasons.
- The Aztecs shot 71.4 percent from the free throw line last year, their best mark since the 1988-89 season and the fourth best rate in program history.
- The Aztecs made 200 three-pointers last season, the second most in program history (204, 2016-17). They made 33.7 percent of their three-point attempts, their best percentage since the 2009-10 season and the fourth best rate in program history
- For the second straight season San Diego State's incoming freshman class is nationally ranked. The Aztecs' 2018 recruiting class is ranked 59th nationally (according to Prospects Nation), fourth in the Mountain West. G/F Mallory Adams (Frisco, Texas), G Jayden Perez (Las Cruces, N.M.) and G Sophia Ramos (San Antonio, Texas) comprise the freshmen class.
- Transfers Zayn Dornstauder (Ball State) and Taylor Kalmer (Oregon State) will also join the Aztecs this year, although Kalmer will sit out the 2018-19 season due to NCAA transfer rules. Dornstauder, a 6'3" center from Canada, redshirted at Ball State last year after playing two years at San Francisco as a reserve. Kalmer, a 5'8" guard, spent her past three years at Pac-12 powerhouse Oregon State where she averaged a career-high 6.0 points per game last season.
