• The Aztecs are hosting the University of Arizona (5-1) on Sunday at 1:00 p.m. These two teams met last year in Tucson with the Aztecs earning a 78-67 win.

• The game will be streamed on the Mountain West Network with Chris Ello (12th season) calling the action.

• The Aztecs are coming off a 72-71 loss at San Diego. It was a back and forth game, but the Aztecs led for the entire fourth quarter except for the final four seconds after the Toreros' Myah Pace made a pair of free throws.

• Freshman Mallory Adams has had 10 or more rebounds in each of her last three games. The last Aztec to do that was SDSU legend and current pro Chelsea Hopkins, who did it in the 2011-12 season.

• Freshman Sophia Ramos scored a career-high 24 points at USD on Wednesday. This is the highest point total for an Aztec this season.

• Najé Murray had a career-high six steals at San Diego earlier this week. She currently leads the Mountain West in steals and is second in three-pointers made.

• Wednesday's game at San Diego was the first time the Aztecs were outrebounded this season.

- The Aztecs have had four players score in double figures in four of their last five games.
- Téa Adams, the Aztecs' leading scorer entering the USD game, left in the first quarter with an injury to her right foot.

• The Aztecs are in the top 30 in the nation in both free throws made and attempted, but 197th in free throw percentage (66.7%).

• The Aztecs set program-highs for total attendance and average attendance last season and are on pace to break that again after averaging 1,391 fans per game so far this season.

Last Time Out (71-71 at San Diego 11-28-18)

The San Diego State women's basketball team (4-3) lost a nail biter at USD 72-71 Wednesday evening at the Jenny Craig Pavilion. In a game that featured 16 ties and 12 lead changes, the Toreros took their first lead of the fourth quarter after Myah Pace hit two free throws with four seconds left.

Freshman Sophia Ramos had a career-high 24 points on 10-for-17 shooting. She scored 16 of her points in the second half and dished out a team-high five assists. Najé Murray had 16 points and a career-high six steals. Mallory Adams had another monster game on the glass and finished with 10 rebounds and 12 points. It was Adams' third consecutive game with at least 10 rebounds and her second doubledouble in the past three games. Zayn Dornstauder also chipped in 11 points.

The Aztecs used a 12-2 run to build a 16-8 lead with two minutes left in the first quarter. However, the Toreros then hit three-pointers on three consecutive possessions to close the gap to 18-17 at the end of the first quarter.

SDSU started slow in the second quarter and scored just two points in the first 5:30 minutes of the second and fell behind 24-20. The Aztecs would finish the first half strong however and took a 31-29 lead in to the break.

The third quarter was tightly-contested throughout and had six lead changes and neither team led by more than three points.

The Aztecs scored the first bucket of the fourth quarter to take a one point lead and didn't trail again until the final seconds of the game.

The Aztecs held a four point lead with 31 seconds remaining, but then the Toreros hit a three to cut the deficit to one. Following a SDSU timeout, the Aztecs turned the ball over on the in-bounds pass.

SDSU then stopped USD twice. First, they got a tie-up on the rebound, but a jump ball was called, which led to the Toreros retaining possession. After SDSU stopped USD again, Mallory Adams hauled in the rebound. With multiple Toreros at her feet, she tripped and was called for a travel, which gave USD a third chance with nine seconds left. That's when Myah Pace drew a foul and knocked down the game-winning freethrows.

Four Toreros scored in double-digits and they were led by Sydney Hunter's 16 points.

Noting the USD Game

 Mallory Adams has had 10 or more rebounds in each of her last three games. The last Aztec to do that was SDSU legend and current pro Chelsea Hopkins, who did it in the 2011-12 season.

- Sophia Ramos' 24 points were the most an Aztec has had in a game this season.
- Najé Murray had six of the Aztecs' eight steals, this was a career-high for her.
- This was the second year in a row the SDSU-USD game came down to the final seconds and the home team escaped with a one-point victory.
- This was the fourth time in the last five games that at least four Aztecs scored in double-digits.

• This was the first game the Aztecs have been outrebounded.

 Téa Adams, the Aztecs' leading scorer entering the night, left the game in the first quarter with an injury to her right foot.

 The Toreros shot 40 percent from three-point land and had 21 assists, both were the season-highs for an Aztec opponent.

Scouting the Wildcats

- Arizona is 5-1 on the year. Their lone loss was against Loyola Marymount (64-66) on Nov. 13.
- They are outscoring their opponents by average margin of 26.3 points.
- This will be their first road game of the season.
- Redshirt sophomore guard Aari McDonald is averaging 26.2 points per game, which is second in the nation.
- McDonald is 46-54 from the free-throw line (85.2%). She is top five in the nation in free throws made and attempted.
- Cate Reese is averaging 9.7 rebounds per game, third in the Pac-12.
- Semaj Smith is averaging 1.8 blocks per game, tops in the Pac-12.
- As a team, the Wildcats are allowing 51.7 points per game (17th in the nation) and opponents are shooting just 32.2 percent (20th).
- Arizona is shooting 77.1 percent from the free throw line.

• Head Coach Adia Barnes (3rd season) is a San Diego native and is Arizona's all-time leading scorer. Prior to coming to Arizona, she was an assistant coach at Washington where she worked with current Aztec assistant Kevin Morrison.

All-Time Series vs. the Wildcats

- San Diego State is 14-4 all-time against Arizona.
- The Aztecs are 7-2 vs. Arizona at home.
- SDSU is also 7-2 in Tucson.
- They have only played twice in the last 20 years, both were Aztec wins.
- They faced off last year at Arizona and SDSU won 78-67 behind 26 points from McKynzie Fort, who earned Mountain West Player of the Week honors for her efforts.
- SDSU won the first 12 meetings between the two schools.
- The first meeting was January 25, 1980, a 66-65 SDSU win.
- The Aztecs are 68-113 all-time against the Pac-12
- Arizona is one of four current Pac-12 schools the Aztecs have a winning record against (Arizona State, California & Washington State)

With a W

- The Aztecs will improve to 5-3 on the season, marking the second consecutive year they would have won five of their first eight games.
- SDSU will improve to 4-1 at home.
- The Aztecs would move to 15-4 all-time against Arizona and 8-2 in road games.

Fab Frosh

Mallory Adams

- Mallory Adams has had 10 or more rebounds in each of her last three games. The last Aztec to do that was SDSU legend and current pro Chelsea Hopkins, who did it in the 2011-12 season.
- Adams' 39 defensive rebounds leads the Mountain West.
- She is averaging 8.0 rebounds per game, which is fourth in the conference.
- She is tied for second in the MW in free throws made and third in free throws attempted.
- She has committed just five turnovers in 204 minutes played, the best rate on the team.
- Adams averaged a double-double last week and was the Aztecs' representative on the SDSU Thanksgiving Classic All-Tournament Team.

Sophia Ramos

- Sophia Ramos scored a career-high 24 points at San Diego on Wednesday.
- Her 24 points and 10 made field goals were the most by an Aztec this season.
- She now leads the Aztecs in scoring with 14.4 points per game.
- Ramos leads the team with 32 assists (4.6 per game) and has a +1.7 assist to turnover ratio, the best on the team. She is fifth in the Mountain West in both categories.
- She is shooting 50 percent from the floor, also the best on the team and tied for third in the conference.
- She leads the team in minutes played (33.3 per game).
- Despite being 5'9", she is second on the team in rebounds (5.0 per game).

Building a Perimeter

- The Aztecs are third in the conference in three-point field goal percentage (.337) and three-point field goal percentage defense (.276)
- Najé Murray has made 20 of the Aztecs' 35 three-pointers, which is second in the conference.

• Murray is averaging 2.9 made three-pointers per game, which puts on her pace to break the Aztecs' single-season record of 77 set by Jamey Cox (2003) and Courtney Clements (2013).

• The Aztecs are second in the conference with 4.6 blocks per game.

• Zayn Dornstauder, the 6'3" Canadian who transferred from Ball State, is third in the MW in total blocks (12) and blocks per game (1.7).

Master Thief

• Najé Murray had a career-high six steals at San Diego on Thursday.

• She is tied for third in the conference in total steals (19) and steals per game (2.7).

Youth Movement

• The Aztecs started two freshmen, two sophomores and one junior in the season opener against Hawai'i. That group had a combined 33 career starts entering the game.

• The freshmen duo of Sophia Ramos and Mallory Adams earned the starting nod in the season opener, marking the first time two freshmen started the season opener for the Aztecs since 2003 (Michelle Elliott and Courtney Fritz).

Aztecs Ink Isabela

• Head Coach Stacie Terry and her staff announced the signing of Isabela Hernandez to a letter of intent earlier this month.

 Hernandez, a four-star recruit according to Prospects Nation, helped Lynden Christian High School (Bellingham, Wash.) to a perfect 29-0 record and state championship last season.

• A 6'2" wing, Hernandez averaged 13 points per game last season along with 5.3 rebounds. She knocked down 50 percent of her shots from the field and was 88 percent from the free-throw line.

 Hernandez was an all-state selection last year and earned all-league and all-county recognition as both a sophomore and as a junior. She was heavily recruited and received offers from Gonzaga, Colorado, Washington State and Colorado State among others.

Preseason Notes

• The Aztecs were picked to finish ninth in the Mountain West preseason poll.

• The Aztecs lost four starters and six players total from a year ago. The Aztecs return just 34.6 percent of their scoring from last season.

• Najé Murray (Stockton, Calif.), who was named to the Mountain West all-freshman team last year, is the Aztecs' leading returning scorer (9.3 ppg). She led all MW freshmen in three-pointers made per game and was fourth overall in scoring among freshmen.

• The support from the community was record-breaking a season ago. The Aztecs had 22,069 fans over their 16 home games for an average of 1,379. That broke the total and average attendance records set in 2007-08, when the Aztecs drew 14,730 fans for an average of 1,133 per game.

• The Aztecs have had a winning record at home in 10 of the past 12 seasons.

• The Aztecs shot 71.4 percent from the free throw line last year, their best mark since the 1988-89 season and the fourth best rate in program history.

• The Aztecs made 200 three-pointers last season, the second most in program history (204, 2016-17). They made 33.7 percent of their three-point attempts, their best percentage since the 2009-10 season and the fourth best rate in program history

• For the second straight season San Diego State's incoming freshman class is nationally ranked. The Aztecs' 2018 recruiting class is ranked 59th nationally (according to Prospects Nation), fourth in the Mountain West. G/F Mallory Adams (Frisco, Texas), G Jayden Perez (Las Cruces, N.M.) and G Sophia Ramos (San Antonio, Texas) comprise the freshmen class.

• Transfers Zayn Dornstauder (Ball State) and Taylor Kalmer (Oregon State) will also join the Aztecs this year, although Kalmer will sit out the 2018-19 season due
