- The Aztecs return home to host Air Force Saturday afternoon at 1:00 p.m.
- The game will be streamed on the Mountain West Network as well on Stadium Channel 1 (check your local listings).
- After starting 4-1, the Aztecs have lost seven of their last eight games.
- The Aztecs are coming off a tough loss at Wyoming which saw them give up a season-high 87 points.
- The Aztecs have the second best rebound margin in the conference (+2.1).
- SDSU has the third best three-point field goal percentage (.330) in the Mountain West.
- Sophia Ramos leads all Mountain West freshmen in points, assists, assist/turnover ratio and minutes played. Overall, she is sixth in the conference in scoring and fifth in assists per game. She is also top ten in field goal, three-point and free throw percentage.
- Mallory Adams leads all Mountain West freshmen in rebounding. After scoring a career-high 17 points against UC Santa Barbara, she topped that with 20 points and a career-high 12 rebounds against Boise State last Saturday. Adams has scored in double-digits in four of her last five games.
- Sophomore Najé Murray is second in the Mountain West in steals per game and is third in three-pointers made.
- After scoring eight points with a career-high eight rebounds against Boise State, Zayn Dornstauder was inserted in to the starting lineup at Wyoming.
- The Aztecs lead the conference in made free throws and are third in free throw attempts. However, they are sixth in free throw percentage (.698).

### Last Time Out (45-87 at Wyoming, 1-9-19)

The San Diego State women's basketball team fell at Wyoming 87-45 Wednesday evening. The Cowgirls shot 44 percent from three and outscored the Aztecs 28-12 in the second quarter and maintained a double-digit lead for the entire second half.

The Aztecs, who had struggled in the first quarter their past three games, held a two point lead midway through the first quarter only to see the Cowgirls go on an 9-0 run. The Aztecs trailed 18-12 at the end of the first quarter, but Wyoming scored the first nine points of the second quarter and made their first eight shots and quickly pushed their lead to double-digits.

Wyoming outscored San Diego State 28-12 in the second quarter and made 11 of their 15 shots. They committed just one turnover in the first half and took a 46-24 lead in to the halftime break. Najé Murray led the Aztecs with seven first half points.

The Aztecs scored the first four points of the second half, but then Wyoming scored 10 unanswered points in a two minute span to push their lead to 56-28.

They would lead by at least 20 points for the remainder of the game.

Wyoming had three players in double-digits and were led by Karla Erjavec's 17 points.

### Noting the Wyoming Game

- The Aztecs had three assists, a season-low.
- The 87 points allowed were a season-high for the Aztecs. This was also the first time a SDSU opponent shot over 50 percent from the field.
- SDSU is now 0-4 when being outrebounded and 5-4 when they have the same or more rebounds than their opponent.
- Wyoming had 14 steals Wednesday, tied for the most the Aztecs have given up (UC Irvine).
- SDSU attempted just 48 field goals, tying their lowest total of the year (UC Irvine).
- The Cowgirls committed just six turnovers in the game. They entered the game with the fewest turnovers in the nation.
- The Cowgirls had 23 points off turnovers to the Aztecs' four.
- Junior Baylee Vanderdoes made her first career three-pointer.
- Freshman Mallory Adams did not attempt a free throw, the first time that has happened since the season opener against Hawai'i.
- Zayn Dornstauder earned her second career start.

### Scouting the Falcons

- Wyoming is 5-9 overall and 1-2 in conference.
- They earned their first conference win on Wednesday, beating Colorado State 63-48 at home.
- Prior to their win Wednesday, they had lost six games in a row.
- They are 1-6 on the road.
- The Falcons are first in the conference in free throws made and attempted but last in free throw percentage (.605).
- They have committed the most turnovers in the league and are last in field goal percentage (.347) and second to last in three point field goal percentage (.275).
- Air Force has four players averaging between 9.4 and 11.2 points per game. Kaelin Immel leads the team with 11.2 ppg.
- Head Coach Chris Gobrecht is in her fourth year at Air Force and her 39th year overall. She has been a head coach since 1979 and has previous stops at Cal State Fullerton (1979-85), Washington (1985-96), Florida State (1996-97), USC (1997-2005), and Yale (2005-15).

### All-Time Series vs. Falcons

- The Aztecs lead the all-time series 34-9.
- The Falcons won both meetings last year, which was the first time they had done that since the 2005-06 season.
- SDSU is 16-4 all-time at home against the Falcons.
- SDSU has won 13 of the past 16 and 19 of the last 23 meetings with Air Force.
- They first met January 11, 1997, a 70-41 SDSU win.

### Fab Frosh

#### Mallory Adams

- Mallory Adams had a career-high 20 points last Saturday against Boise State.
- Adams has four double-doubles on the year. She has brought in nine rebounds or more in seven of her last ten games and just hauled in a career-best 12 boards against Boise State last Saturday.
- Adams has scored in double-digits in four of her last five games.
- She is averaging 7.6 rebounds per game, which is fifth in the conference and most among freshmen.
- She leads the conference in free throw attempts and is second in free throws made.
- Adams had 10 or more rebounds in three straight games earlier this year. The last Aztec to do that was SDSU legend and current pro Chelsea Hopkins, who did it in the 2011-12 season.
- She has committed just 16 turnovers in 396 minutes played, by far the best rate on the team.
- Adams averaged a double-double at the SDSU Thanksgiving Classic and was named to the All-Tournament Team.

#### Sophia Ramos

- She leads the Aztecs in scoring with 14.8 points per game, this is sixth in the conference and best among freshmen.
- She leads all freshmen in the Mountain West in points, assists, assist/turnover ratio and minutes.
- She is top ten in the conference in free throw, three-point and field goal percentage.
- Sophia Ramos scored a career-high 28 points at CSUN (12-9-18) with seven three-pointers including six in the fourth quarter.
- Her 28 points and 10 made field goals in that game were the most by an Aztec this season.
- Her seven three-pointers tie her for the second most in school history and her she became the first Aztec to hit six three-pointers in a quarter
- Despite being 5'9", she is second on the team in rebounds (5.2 per game). She had a career-high 10 vs. Arizona (12-2-18).

### Building a Perimeter

- The Aztecs are third in the conference in three-point field goal percentage (.330).
- Sophia Ramos is shooting 41.3 percent from three, tied for the sixth best rate in the conference.
- Najé Murray is third in the conference in three-pointers made and attempted.

### Earning it at the Line

- The Aztecs lead the conference in made free throws and are third in free throw attempts.
- However, SDSU is just sixth in free throw percentage (.698).
- Mallory Adams leads the conference in free throw attempts and is second in free throws made.

### Master Thief

- Najé Murray had a career-high six steals earlier this year at San Diego
- She is second in the conference in steals per game and third in total steals.

## Youth Movement

- The Aztecs started two freshmen, two sophomores and one junior in the season opener against Hawai'i. That group had a combined 33 career starts entering the game.
- The freshmen duo of Sophia Ramos and Mallory Adams earned the starting nod in the season opener, marking the first time two freshmen started the season opener for the Aztecs since 2003 (Michelle Elliott and Courtney Fritz).

## Aztecs Ink Isabela

- Head Coach Stacie Terry and her staff announced the signing of Isabela Hernandez to a letter of intent in November.
- Last month, she hit seven three-pointers in a game and scored 25 points.
- Hernandez, a four-star recruit according to Prospects Nation, helped Lynden Christian High School (Bellingham, Wash.) to a perfect 29-0 record and state championship last season.
- A 6'2" wing, Hernandez averaged 13 points per game last season along with 5.3 rebounds. She knocked down 50 percent of her shots from the field and was 88 percent from the free-throw line.
- Hernandez was an all-state selection last year and earned all-league and all-county recognition as both a sophomore and as a junior. She was heavily recruited and received offers from Gonzaga, Colorado, Washington State and Colorado State among others.

## Preseason Notes

- The Aztecs were picked to finish ninth in the Mountain West preseason poll.
- The Aztecs lost four starters and six players total from a year ago. The Aztecs return just 34.6 percent of their scoring from last season.
- Najé Murray (Stockton, Calif.), who was named to the Mountain West all-freshman team last year, is the Aztecs' leading returning scorer (9.3 ppg). She led all MW freshmen in three-pointers made per game and was fourth overall in scoring among freshmen.
- The support from the community was record-breaking a season ago. The Aztecs had 22,069 fans over their 16 home games for an average of 1,379. That broke the total and average attendance records set in 2007-08, when the Aztecs drew 14,730 fans for an average of 1,133 per game.
- The Aztecs have had a winning record at home in 10 of the past 12 seasons.
- The Aztecs shot 71.4 percent from the free throw line last year, their best mark since the 1988-89 season and the fourth best rate in program history.
- The Aztecs made 200 three-pointers last season, the second most in program history (204, 2016-17). They made 33.7 percent of their three-point attempts, their best percentage since the 2009-10 season and the fourth best rate in program history.
- For the second straight season San Diego State's incoming freshman class is nationally ranked. The Aztecs' 2018 recruiting class is ranked 59th nationally (according to Prospects Nation), fourth in the Mountain West. G/F Mallory Adams (Frisco, Texas), G Jayden Perez (Las Cruces, N.M.) and G Sophia Ramos (San Antonio, Texas) comprise the freshmen class.
- Transfers Zayn Dornstauder (Ball State) and Taylor Kalmer (Oregon State) will also join the Aztecs this year, although Kalmer will sit out the 2018-19 season due to NCAA transfer rules. Dornstauder, a 6'3" center from Canada, redshirted at Ball State last year after playing two years at San Francisco as a reserve. Kalmer, a 5'8" guard, spent her past three years at Pac-12 powerhouse Oregon State where she averaged a career-high 6.0 points per game last season.

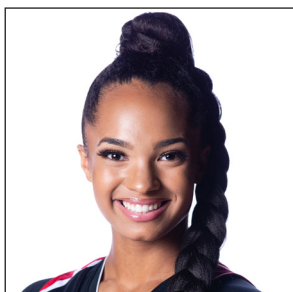

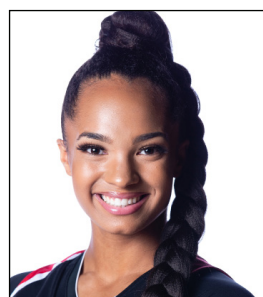
