 The Aztecs will be back at Viejas for the next two games. First, they will host the San José State on Saturday at 1:00 p.m. for Girls and Women in Sports Day. Then on Wednesday, SDSU takes on New Mexico at 11:00 a.m. Field Trip Day.

Both games will be streamed on the Mountain West Network with Chris Ello (12th season) on the call.

• SDSU lost at Air Force 75-66 Wednesday evening. Mallory Adams led the Aztecs with 15 points and 12 rebounds.

It was Mallory Adams' sixth double-double of the year and her ninth game with 10 or more rebounds.

 Sophomore Najé Murray recorded her 31st career game with 10 or more points last Saturday. She has scored in double-figures in 15 of the Aztecs' 18 games this season.

 Mallory Adams is averaging 8.5 rebounds per game, the most for an Aztec freshman since Ashlee Dunlap in the 2002-03 season. She is bringing in 9.9 boards per game in conference play, the second most in the league.

 Sophia Ramos leads all Mountain West freshmen in points, assists, free throw percentage, assist-to-turnover ratio and minutes played. In conference play, she is shooting 89.5 percent from the free throw line, third most accurate in the Mountain West.

Ramos is the only true freshman in the nation to average 14 points, 4.5 assists and 4.5 rebounds per game.

 Zayn Dornstauder is averaging 8.3 points per game in conference play while shooting 55 percent from the floor and 82 percent from the free throw line.

 The Aztecs already have more blocks (76) than they did all last season (64). They are 57th in the nation with 4.4 blocks per game.

SDSU is making 75.7 percent of their free throws in conference play, the second best rate in the Mountain West.

Last Time Out (66-75 at Air Force, 1-30-19)

The Aztec women's basketball team (6-12, 1-6) fell at Air Force (8-12, 4-5) 75-66 Wednesday evening. Mallory Adams led the Aztecs with 15 points and 12 rebounds, her sixth double-double of the year.

Three Aztecs joined Mallory Adams in double-digits scoring: Najé Murray had 11, Sophia Ramos had 10 points with seven assists and Zayn Dornstauder also added 10 points.

The Aztecs have struggled mightily this season in the opening minutes of the game. Air Force was able to convert a couple SDSU turnovers in to fast break points and Coach Terry took a timeout after just 1:30 had elapsed in attempt to avoid a big first quarter deficit — it worked. Sophia Ramos nailed a three on the next possession and shortly after SDSU went on a 12-2 run to open a 21-14 lead.

SDSU had less than 10 bench points in each of their last four games but had 11 in the first quarter Wednesday evening led by Zayn Dornstauder's six. Ramos also had six first quarter points on a pair of three-pointers and the Aztecs held a 21-18 lead at the end of one.

Air Force forced six SDSU turnovers in the first five minutes of the second quarter and worked the ball inside as part of a 13-4 run to go up 27-25. 20 of the Falcons' first 27 points came in the paint.

Both teams had 12 turnovers in the first half and Air Force held a 32-31 lead at the halftime break. The Aztecs made their first three pointers but then missed their next six. They ended the game 5-for-17 from deep.

The Falcons began to pull away in the third quarter with an 8-0 and 13-2 run. The Aztecs had more turnovers (six) in the quarter than field goals (four) and the Falcons shot 55 percent in the third and took a 49-42 lead in to the final frame.

Early in the fourth quarter, the Falcons pushed their lead to double-digits and SDSU couldn't get closer than eight points because Air Force went 12-for-13 from the free throw line down the stretch.

Air Force had four players in double-digits, led by Kaelin Immel's 16 points. Riley Snyder had 15 while Emily Conroe had 13 and Haley Jones added 12.

Noting the Air Force Game

- The Aztecs hit their first three three-pointers and then made just two of the next 14 attempts.
- The Aztecs were 9-for-13 From the free throw line. Last time they played Air Force they were 26-for-37, setting season-highs for free throws made and attempted.
- SDSU forced 25 Air Force turnovers, a season-high
- The Aztecs committed a season-high 22 fouls, which led to 25 Air Force free throws, also a new season-high.
- Mallory Adams finished with 15 points and 12 rebounds. This was her sixth doubledouble of the year and her ninth game with 10 or more rebounds.
- Adams is now averaging 9.9 rebounds per game in MW play, just one rebound shy of averaging a double-double.
- Sophia Ramos and Najé Murray have both scored 10 or more points in 15 of SDSU's 18 games
- Najé Murray led the Aztecs with three steals. Murray has led the Aztecs in steals in 15 of their 18 games (including ties).

• Freshman Sophia Ramos led the team with seven assists and Mallory Adams had a team-high 12 rebounds. They each have led the team in their respective categories in 13 of the team's 18 games.

Scouting the Spartans

- The Spartans are 2-17 overall and 1-7 in conference play.
- They are coming off a 68-59 home win over Utah State, their first MW win of the season.
- They are 0-10 on the road.
- They are last in the conference in rebound margin (-15.4) and scoring defense (76.2).
- They lead the conference in three-pointers attempted, are third in threes made and seventh in three-point percentage (.305(
- SJSU has three players averaging between 9.1 and 9.5 points (Raziva Potter).
- Head Coach Jamie Craighead (sixth season) came to SJSU after four years at Sacramento State where she was their winningest coach in 20 years.

All-Time Series vs. Spartans

- The Aztecs lead the all-time series 22-8
- SDSU swept the Spartans last year, but SJSU beat them three times the year prior.
- SDSU is 12-3 at home vs. SJSU.
- They first met December 3, 1977, an 89-83 SDSU win.

Fab Frosh

Mallory Adams

- Mallory Adams is averaging 8.5 rebounds per game, the most for an Aztec freshman since Ashlee Dunlap in the 2002-03 season. She is bringing in 9.9 boards per game in conference play, the second most in the league.
- Mallory Adams is one of six true freshmen nationally to average 11 points and eight rebounds per game.
- She leads the Mountain West in rebounding for freshmen.
- She is top ten in the nation in free throws made and attempted per game among true freshmen.
- Mallory Adams set a career-high with 13 rebounds at New Mexico two weeks ago.
- Adams has six double-doubles on the year. She has brought in nine rebounds or more in 11 of her last 15 games. She has nine games with 10 or more rebounds.
- Adams had 10 or more rebounds in three straight games earlier this year. The last Aztec to do that was SDSU legend and current pro Chelsea Hopkins, who did it in the 2011-12 season.
- Adams averaged a double-double at the SDSU Thanksgiving Classic and was named to the All-Tournament Team. Sophia Ramos
- Sophia Ramos leads the Aztecs in scoring with 14.4 points per game, this is seighth in the conference and best among freshmen.
- Ramos is the only true freshman in the nation averaging at least 14 points, 4.5 rebounds and 4.5 assists per game.
- She leads all freshmen in the Mountain West in points, assists, assist-to-turnover ratio, free throw percentage and minutes.
- She is third in the conference with an .827 free throw percentage
- Sophia Ramos scored a career-high 28 points at CSUN (12-9-18) with seven three-pointers including six in the fourth quarter.
- Her 28 points and 10 made field goals in that game were the most by an Aztec this season.
- Her seven three-pointers tie her for the second most in school history and her she became the first Aztec to hit six three-pointers in a quarter
- Despite being 5'9", she is second on the team in rebounds (4.7 per game). She had a career-high 10 vs. Arizona (12-2-18).

Earning it at the Line

- The Aztecs lead are second in the conference in made free throws and third in attempts.
- Mallory Adams is second in the conference in made free throws and is top ten in the nation in free throws made and attempted per game among true freshmen.
- The Aztecs are up to fourth in the conference in free throw percentage.

Block Party

- The Aztecs are fourth in the conference in blocked shots per game.
- They have already eclipsed their total for blocks from last year (79-64).
- Zayn Dornstauder is second in the conference with 1.4 blocks per game.

Youth Movement

• The Aztecs started two freshmen, two sophomores and one junior in the season opener against Hawai'i. That group had a combined 33 career starts entering the game.

• The freshmen duo of Sophia Ramos and Mallory Adams earned the starting nod in the season opener, marking the first time two freshmen started the season opener for the Aztecs since 2003 (Michelle Elliott and Courtney Fritz).

Aztecs Ink Isabela

• Head Coach Stacie Terry and her staff announced the signing of Isabela Hernandez to a letter of intent in November.

• Last month, she hit seven three-pointers in a game and scored 25 points.

• Hernandez, a four-star recruit according to Prospects Nation, helped Lynden Christian High School (Bellingham, Wash.) to a perfect 29-0 record and state championship last season.

• A 6'2" wing, Hernandez averaged 13 points per game last season along with 5.3 rebounds. She knocked down 50 percent of her shots from the field and was 88 percent from the free-throw line.

 Hernandez was an all-state selection last year and earned all-league and all-county recognition as both a sophomore and as a junior. She was heavily recruited and received offers from Gonzaga, Colorado, Washington State and Colorado State among others.

Preseason Notes

• The Aztecs were picked to finish ninth in the Mountain West preseason poll.

• The Aztecs lost four starters and six players total from a year ago. The Aztecs return just 34.6 percent of their scoring from last season.

 Najé Murray (Stockton, Calif.), who was named to the Mountain West all-freshman team last year, is the Aztecs' leading returning scorer (9.3 ppg). She led all MW freshmen in three-pointers made per game and was fourth overall in scoring among freshmen.

• The support from the community was record-breaking a season ago. The Aztecs had 22,069 fans over their 16 home games for an average of 1,379. That broke the total and average attendance records set in 2007-08, when the Aztecs drew 14,730 fans for an average of 1,133 per game.

• The Aztecs have had a winning record at home in 10 of the past 12 seasons.

• The Aztecs shot 71.4 percent from the free throw line last year, their best mark since the 1988-89 season and the fourth best rate in program history.

• The Aztecs made 200 three-pointers last season, the second most in program history (204, 2016-17). They made 33.7 percent of their three-point attempts, their best percentage since the 2009-10 season and the fourth best rate in program history

For the second straight season San Diego State's incoming freshman class is
nationally ranked. The Aztecs' 2018 recruiting class is ranked 59th nationally
(according to Prospects Nation), fourth in the Mountain West. G/F Mallory Adams
(Frisco, Texas), G Jayden Perez (Las Cruces, N.M.) and G Sophia Ramos (San
Antonio, Texas) comprise the freshmen class.

• Transfers Zayn Dornstauder (Ball State) and Taylor Kalmer (Oregon State) will also join the Aztecs this year, although Kalmer will sit out the 2018-19 season due to NCAA transfer rules. Dornstauder, a 6'3" center from Canada, redshirted at Ball State last year after playing two years at San Francisco as a reserve. Kalmer, a 5'8" guard, spent her past three years at Pac-12 powerhouse Oregon State where she averaged a career-high 6.0 points per game last season.


