### San Diego State Postgame Notes at Boise State

#### Team Notes

- San Diego State's nine-game win streak against Mountain West Conference competition comes to an end.
- San Diego State's six game regular-season conference win streak, tied for the eight-longest streak in school history is snapped.
- For the third straight meeting against Boise State, San Diego State committed less than 10 turnovers (last three games: 8, 8, 9).
- In the last 16 meetings between Boise State and San Diego State, the team with the higher field goal percentage has won 15 times (one time the teams had the exact same field goal percentage).
- The San Diego State bench played 76 minutes against the Broncos. That is the second-highest total of the season trailing only the game against Cal State Dominguez Hills (89 minutes).

#### Player Notes

##### **Devin Watson – season-high 24 points, 3 rebounds, 3 assists**

Scored a season-high 24 points on 7-of-14 shooting from the field... It is his sixth 20-plus scoring game of the season, 10<sup>th</sup> while at San Diego State and 29<sup>th</sup> of his career... He led the Aztecs in scoring for the sixth time this season and the 15<sup>th</sup> time in his career... He now has 56 points in three games against the Broncos (18.7 ppg) and is 17-of-21 from the free throw line.

##### **Jalen McDaniels – 14 points, 5 rebounds**

Scored 14 points and added a team-high five rebounds for SDSU... He has 53 points in his last three games (18.3 ppg).

**Joel Mensah** tied a career-high with four points.

#### Look Ahead Note

- San Diego State has won its last 10 home games against Wyoming, dating back to a Jan. 3, 2007 defeat.
