## **Aztecs Notes**

- San Diego State continues its 2019 Mountain West Conference schedule this week with a pair of road games at Air Force and Colorado College.
- The Aztecs have played the Falcons 23 times darting back to the 1993 season and lead the all-time series 21-1-1, which includes a 9-1-0 record in games played at Air Force. SDSU has won the last eight meetings in Colorado Springs, including a 4-0 result in 2017, the last time the programs met on the Falcons home field. In the last six games at Cadet Soccer Stadium, San Diego has held the Falcons scoreless while putting 11 balls in the back of the net.
- SDSU and Colorado College have met 10times dating back to the 1992 season with San Diego State holding a 5-2-3
  advantage in the series. The teams have only played three times in Colorado Springs, where the Tigers are 2-1-0 against
  the Aztecs. Colorado College took the last match-up in Colorado Springs 2-1 in 2017 and the teams are tied with 10
  goals apiece in the three matchups on the Tigers home field.
- Laura Fuentes (So., MF, Newark, Calif.) scored both goals for San Diego State last weekend as the team split a pair of
  road games at Boise State and Utah State and was named the Mountain West Offensive Player of the Week. Fuentes'
  goal at Boise State, on a penalty kick, came in the 75th minute and cut the Broncos' lead in half in a 2-1 defeat. Then
  at Utah State, she got the game-winning header in the 68th minute of a 1-0 victory. They were the first two goals of
  the season for the MW's 2019 Newcomer of the Year.
- For her efforts in the Aztecs' two-game sweep the week ending October 6, Brooke Lisowski (Sr., GK, Los Gatos, Calif.)
  was named the Mountain West Defensive Player of the Week. Lisowski was in goal for all 180 minutes, faced 20 shots
  and stopped three of the four that reached her line. Her goals against average was 0.50 and her save percentage was
  .750. It was her first weekly conference award and the first for an Aztec women's soccer player this season.
- The Aztecs ended a six-game winless streak with its 2-0 decision over Colorado State (9/29). The win was the first since a 1-0 victory over LIU (8/25) and at the time marked just the second occurrence this season the team had found the back of the net more than once in a game. The other time was two days prior in a 3-2 loss at Wyoming. San Diego State scored a season-high four goals one week later in a 4-1 decision over Nevada.
- After a tough preseason schedule in which the team went 1-5-1 and scored just three goals versus 13 for the opposition, Mountain West play came at the right time. In its last five games, all conference matchups, the Aztecs are 4-1-0 and have outscored opponents 9-3.

- With decisions over Colorado State (2-0), UNLV (1-0) and Nevada (4-1), from Sept. 29 to Oct. 6, the SDSU enjoyed its longest run of wins, three games, since the program put together six straight victories near the end of the 2017 season.
- The flood gates opened in SDSU's 4-1 victory over Nevada. It was the highest output since a 5-0 win over Air Force (10/22/18) and just the second time it has put up at least three goals since a 3-0 win over New Mexico (11/4/17) in that season's Mountain West Tournament's championship game.
- The Aztecs have gotten balanced scoring from the players who have found the back of the net this season and opponents can't
  focus on one player who can put it in the goal. SDSU has seven players who have scored; one has three goals; five have recorded
  two tallies and another has a single goal.
- Welcome back Darcy Weiser (Sr., F, Huntington Beach, Calif.). Weiser missed the first seven games and didn't make her season debut until the 38th minute at Wyoming (9/27). She scored her first goal of the year in the 82nd minute in Laramie which started a four-goal run for SDSU over the next 98 minutes and sparked a three-game winning streak. The tally started the Aztecs come back from a 3-0 deficit to the Cowgirls to make the final decision 3-2. In the team's next game, against Colorado State (9/29), SDSU was the victor, 2-0. Against UNLV (10/4), Weiser picked up her second goal, the game winner, in a 1-0 win and she assisted on the goal that put the game away in the team's 4-1 win over Nevada (10/6).
- Strikers strike...and along with Weiser's two tallies, Taylor Moorehead (So., F, Valencia, Calif.) got into the goal scoring action in Laramie and against Nevada. Moorehead's goal at Wyoming got the Aztecs to within one, 3-2, with under 10 minutes to play. It was her first goal of the year and the fourth of her career and she added her second goal of the campaign in the 4-1 victory against Nevada. In the Colorado State win, Rachelle Elve (Fr., F, Huntington Beach, Calif.) became the third striker to score this year and she followed that goal with the game winner in the squad's decision against Nevada.
- Kiera Utush (Fr., MF, Rocklin, Calif.) has also scored twice this season, each time on a penalty kick. She is the first Aztecs to have
  multiple successful PKs in a season, since current volunteer assistant coach Victoria Barba put four penalty kicks in the back of the
  net in the 2016 season. Since the 2003 season, an Aztecs has scored multiple PKs in a season eight times. In addition, Utush is
  just the second freshman in the last 10 years to score the team's season-opening goal (vs. No. 22 Texas Tech). The other

freshman to tally a goal in her first collegiate game in that time frame is Taylor Moorehead (So., F, Valencia, Calif.) who had the game-winner in a 1-0 victory over New Mexico State in the 2018 season.

- With 10 shots on goal, Malia Kaleiohi (Jr., MF/F, San Diego, Calif.) ranks second on the team and has already more than doubled
  her single-season high of four, which she set last year. She produced two shots on goal in each of the team's first three games as
  well as against San Diego (9/13), which are single-game highs for her career. In addition, Kaleiohi has produced 17 total shots,
  good for second on the team and a single-season high for the junior. With assists against Colorado State and Nevada, the first two
  of her career, she is tied for second on the squad.
- Brooke Lisowski (Sr., GK, Los Gatos, Calif.), a transfer from California, has played every minute in goal for SDSU and has a 5-7-1 record. In 1,190 minutes, she has surrendered 19 goals (1.44 GAA) and has made 41 saves (.683 save percentage). In the team's victory at Utah State, Lisowski recorded her fourth clean sheet of the year and of her career and third in Mountain West play. Among Mountain West keepers, Lisowski ranks ninth in saves (41) and saves per game at 3.15.
- This season the Aztecs played three Power-5 schools. Over the last 10 years, SDSU has played a minimum of three Power-5 squads per season. In 2011, San Diego State took the pitch a single-season high six times against current Power-5 schools and posted a 4-2 record. Among those four wins, SDSU notched victories over Arizona (1-0), Minnesota (2-1), & Texas (1-0).
- Head Coach Mike Friesen is in his 13th campaign leading the Mountain West's most dominant women's soccer program. Friesen
  has guided his squads to nine Mountain West championships (five tournament and four regular season), and five NCAA Tournament
  appearances. In 12 seasons of conference play, Friesen has a 72-19-15 record. His 72 victories are double that of the next closest
  conference coach...Wyoming's Peter Cuadrado and Boise State's Jim Thomas have won 36 games each in Mountain West play.
- Friesen's 141 victories (141-85-33) since the start of the 2007 season, the year he took control of the program, are the most by any coach in the Mountain West.
- San Diego State is picked to finish fourth in the MW coaches' preseason poll. This marks the first time in 10 seasons the Aztecs
  have been picked to finish lower than second place. The last time SDSU was lower than second place in the preseason poll was at
  the beginning of the 2009 season, a year in which the team went 15-4-5, was undefeated in the Mountain West (5-0-2) and
  reached the second round of the NCAA Tournament.
- Having won four of the last seven regular season titles, SDSU slotted into the No. 4 spot in the Mountain West preseason coaches'
  poll, which snaps a six-year run of being the favorite in the eyes of the conference's head coaches.
- The Aztecs have won eight of the last 13 MW trophies (regular season and tournament), all of which have come under the
  direction of head coach Mike Friesen. In total, the 13th-year head coach has guided San Diego State to nine conference crowns.
- San Diego State brings back its top seven point-earners from last year, including 2018 Mountain West Newcomer of the Year
   Laura Fuentes (So., MF, Newark, Calif.). The midfielder tallied three goals and an assist as a true freshman. Fuentes finished
   with seven points on the year, one behind another freshman, team leader Chloe Frisch (Jr., MF/F, Solana Beach, Calif.) who
   totaled eight (two goals & four assists).
- Joining Frisch and Fuentes as the top returning point-getters are Taylor Moorehead (So., F, Valencia, Calif.), Phoebe Leitch (Jr., D/MF, Forest Row, England) and Darcy Weiser (Sr., F, Huntington Beach, Calif.) who each tallied three goals and six points in 2018. Sarah Broacha (Jr., D, Pleasanton, Calif.) totaled a goal and two assists for four points.

# **Opponent Notebook**

#### Air Force

The Falcons enter the game against San Diego State with an 8-4-1 overall record, which includes an 3-3-0 mark in Mountain West play, which leaves them in a tie with Colorado College in sixth place... AFA split a pair of games last week with a 2-1 win at UNLV and a loss (1-2) at Nevada... At home this season Air Force is 5-3-0, 1-2-0 in conference contests. Lexi Romero leads her squad with 10 goals, four assists and 24 points... The defense is anchored by keeper Danielle Katz, who this season, has every minute of the team's 13 games. She has as 1.10 GAA, a .758 save percentage and an 8-4-1 record... AFA is coached by Larry Friend who is in his 11th season leading the program and brought a 52-107-24 record at the Academy into the 2019 season.

#### Colorado College

The Tigers enter the week with a 8-4-0 (3-3-0 MW) record and host New Mexico on Friday before its match with the Aztecs on Sunday...Colorado College is 7-2-0 in games in Colorado Springs and 2-2-0 in Mountain West home games... Jacqui Hand leads the team with seven goals and 15 points and Kiley Suter tops the squad with nine assists... Abbie Opperman has played the majority of the minutes in goal this season. She has a 0.64 GAA and an 0.848 save percentage with a 6-2-0 record in 701:24... The Tigers are coached by Geoff Bennett, who is in his 16th season at Colorado College and brought a 157-104-39 record at the school into the 2019 season.
