San Diego State Postgame Notes vs. Creighton Orleans Arena | Las Vegas, Nevada November 28, 2019

Team Notes

- San Diego State improves to 7-0 for the first time in eight seasons (2010-11).
- San Diego State has won five consecutive games against Big East Conference teams. The Aztecs are tied with Michigan State for the longest active non-conference win streak against Big East Conference teams.
- This was Creighton's widest margin of defeat since a 34-point loss at Western Kentucky on Dec. 19, 2001. This was the Bluejays 609th game since the loss to the WKU.
- San Diego State held Creighton to its lowest point output (52) since the Bluejays scored 51 at Georgetown on Jan. 25, 2017.
- San Diego State improves to 32-12 in games played in Las Vegas since the start if the 2009-10 campaign. That includes a 12-4 record in road games playing at UNLV and a 21-8 mar in neutral site games in the city.
- There are 27 remaining undefeated teams in the country at the end of the day.
- San Diego State closes the all-time series deficit with Creighton to 4-3. The Aztecs have won each of the last two meetings, both in neutral site exempt events
- <u>Brian Dutcher wins his 50th career game and improves to 50-24</u>. When Dutcher first arrived on campus, he and then head coach Steve Fisher needed 103 games to reach 50 victories (50-53).
- San Diego State has won 14 straight games when leading at intermission.
- SDSU shot 55.8 percent from the field and is 19-1 in the Dutcher era when shooting 50 percent or better from the field.
- The Aztecs held the opponent to 38.5 percent from the field and has won 13 straight contests when doing so.
- SDSU enjoyed a 37-21 rebound advantage and has won seven straight when owning an edge on the glass.
- The Aztecs connected on 14-of-18 free throws tonight and are now 30-of-35 (85.7 percent) in its last two games.
- San Diego State wins its eighth straight November game and is 17-4 in the month under Brian Dutcher.
- San Diego State is 6-1 in the Dutcher era in Thursday games and played for just the 29th time on a Thursday since the start of the 2010-11 season.
- San Diego State is 41-22 in its last 63 neutral site games.
- San Diego State improves to 2-0 while in the red on black uniforms that made their debut at San Diego on Nov. 20.

Player Notes

Malachi Flynn - season-high 21 points, 3 assists, 2 rebounds

Scored a season-high 21 points, marking his first 20-point game as an Aztec and the 13th of his career... Ran his double-digit scoring streak to seven games and has scored 10 or more points 45 times in his career... He now has a team-high 38 assists through seven games.

Matt Mitchell – 16 points, 5-7 FGs, 3-3 3FGs, 4 rebounds, 2 assists

Mitchell reached double figures for the second time this season and the 39th time in his career... Made a season-high three three-point field goals on three attempts and has made 8-of-17 attempts (47.1 percent) from beyond the arc this season... He has 35 points in his last three games (11.7 ppg).

Yanni Wetzell — 15 points, 5-8 FGs, 6 rebounds, 4 assists

Continued his stellar play by reaching double figures for a fourth straight game (prior to this stretch he had only scored in double figures in back-to-back games once in his career)... In his last four games he has 58 points on 23-of-31 (74.2 percent) shooting from the field and 28 rebounds.

Jordan Schakel - 13 points, 5-10 FGs, 3-5 3FGs

Schakel had a big second half to reach double figures for the fourth time this season and the 14th time in his career (12-2)... He has connected on 18-of-35 (51.4 percent) three-point attempts this season.
