## San Diego State Head Coach Brian Dutcher

On what he takes away from the tournament about the team:
"We have a grit about us. When we got down, we were able to fight back. Obviously, it's sasier to play with a lead, but we were down by as many as 16 and found a way to hang in there and came out with a hard-fought win."

On what he talked about at halftime:
"We talked about having 12 turnovers; that is not in our nature, especially against a zone. I thought we were careless against the press. We used two timeouts in the first half to try to get things corrected. We got to the lockerrom and just told them to show us what we see in practice. We are a good team and we are capable of playing much better. We did that in the second half."
