11-Time MW Champions, 12 Postseason Berths in Last 14 Years

• SDSU has won at least 19 games in 14 straight seasons, which is tied for 7th-longest active streak in the nation.

• SDSU has advanced to the postseason play in 12 of the last 14 seasons (2006 NCAA, 2007-09 NIT, 2010-15 NCAA, 2016 NIT, 2018 NCAA).

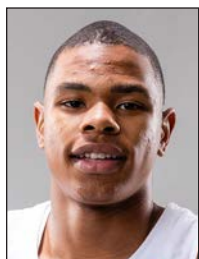
• SDSU is 14th nationally in winning percentage since the beginning of the 2010-11 season.
