NEWS AND NOTES (through games of Dec. 29)

- ▶ Having completed the school's fourth all-time unblemished regular-season non-conference schedule and just the second in the last 89 seasons, San Diego State returns to Mountain West Conference play with an afternoon home game against Fresno State on Wednesday.
- ▶ San Diego State and Fresno State are meeting for the 119th time, with the Aztecs owning a 62-56 series lead. The Aztec-Bulldog series is the most played in SDSU history.
- ▶ The Aztecs are looking for their first regular-season victory over the Bulldogs since Feb. 4, 2017. Since that game, Fresno State has won the four regular-season meetings with SDSU claiming a 64-52 victory in the quarterfinal round of the 2018 Mountain West Tournament. SDSU went on to win its record 11th MW conference championship.
- ▶ San Diego State improves two positions to No. 13 this week in the AP Top 25 Poll. It marks the fourth straight week the Aztecs have appeared in the poll, moving from 25 to 20 to 15 to 13. At No. 13, SDSU has matched its highest ranking since March 10, 2014.
- ▶ San Diego State is enjoying its 70th appearance in the AP Top 25 Poll this week (all have occurred since the start of the 2010-11 campaign). Since the start of the '10-11 season, SDSU's 70 weeks in the top 25 are the 23rd most nationally.
- ▶ San Diego State is currently one of two unbeaten teams nationally. Auburn (12-0) is the only other undefeated team and the Tigers are off until Saturday when they play at Mississippi State (8-3).
- ▶ San Diego State's current 13-game win streak is tied for the third-longest in school history. Overall, the Aztecs have enjoyed seven win-streaks of at least 11 games, with six of those coming with Brian Dutcher on the sidelines (five as an assistant coach).
- ▶ This is the Aztecs longest win streak since a school-record tying 20-game win streak during the 2013-14 campaign (that team posted a 31-5 record and advanced to the NCAA Sweet 16).
- ▶ San Diego State's metrics continue to pace at an elite level. The Aztecs are currently 1st in NET (the last time San Diego State was not at the top of this chart was Dec. 21), 1st in strength of record, 7th in RPI, 9th in Sagarin, 17th in BPI, and 20th in KenPom.
- ▶ Through Dec. 28 San Diego State's 3-0 record in NCAA NET Quadrant 1 games was the second best in the nation, trailing only Duke (4-0). No other team with at least three Quadrant 1 games was undefeated in the category.
- ▶ With the fast start, San Diego State finds itself ranked among the nation's elite in several statistical categories, including 2nd in scoring margin (+20.4), 6th in scoring defense (56.3), 7th in three-point field goal percentage differential (+11.3), 8th in assist-to-turnover ratio (1.50), 8th in field goal percentage defense (36.2), 14th in field goal percentage differential (+9.8), 16th in three-point field goal defense (27.0) and 26th in three-point field goal percentage (38.3).
- ▶ The Aztecs have won 12 straight non-conference games dating back to last season (does not include conference tournament games or postseason games). This is the third longest win streak in school history, trailing a 21-game stretch (2009-11) and a 15-game streak (2013-14).
- ▶ San Diego State improved to 13-0 on Saturday afternoon with a 73-57 victory over Cal Poly. The Aztecs forced a season-high 23 turnovers and limited the Mustangs to 34.6 percent shooting from the field. The 16-point margin marked the fifth smallest margin

Missed conference opponents: Air Force (home) - This is the second time in four seasons the teams have not met twice (2015-16); last time Air Force did not play at SDSU was the 1998-99 season; San Jose State (away) - For the second time in six seasons, the Aztecs will not travel to San Jose for a road game. The combined conference record last season of SDSU's two missed opponents is 9-27.

- Continental Tire Las Vegas Invitational (Orleans Arena - Las Vegas, Nev.); ^ - Basketball Hall of Fame Classic (STAPLES Center - Los Angeles, Calif.); * - Mountain West game. All times are local to the site

of victory this season for San Diego State.

- San Diego State has been impressive everywhere this season and that includes at home. The Aztecs are 7-0 at Viejas Arena this season and have outscored their opponents 530-378 (+152 points) in those games. In the seven home games, the Aztecs have trailed a total of 5:43 (343 seconds) of a possible 280 minutes.
- The Aztecs are dominating nearly every category at home, but a couple of the more impressive categories are on the defensive end - opponent field goal percentage (34.4 percent), opponent three-point field goal percentage (27.0 percent) and points allowed (54.0).
- San Diego State has four players averaging in double figures (10.6 points or more) and six players averaging 6.9 points or more. Six Aztec players have scored 13 or more points in a game this season.
- Junior guard **Malachi Flynn** enters the game having scored 992 points in his career and needs 8 to reach the 1,000-point plateau.
- Junior guard **Malachi Flynn** has been one of the best players in the nation through the opening two months of the season. A transfer from Washington State, Flynn leads the Aztecs in scoring (15.5), assists (5.5) and steals (1.8). **He is the only player in the nation to average 15 and five while owning an assist-to-turnover ratio of 3.50 or better.** He is currently sixth in the nation in assist-to-turnover ratio at 3.55 (71 assists, 20 turnovers).
- Despite coming off the bench, junior forward **Matt Mitchell** is third in the team in scoring (10.9) and is third on the team in rebounding (4.3), while shooting 37.5 percent from three-point range. He is averaging career bests in all three of those categories.
- Senior **Yanni Wetzell** has reached double figures in eight of his last 10 games after doing so nine times all of last season at Vanderbilt. The transfer is averaging 11.2 points and 6.1 rebounds (second on the team), while shooting 58.8 percent from the field. In his last 10 games he is averaging 12.7 points, 5.8 rebounds and has made 52-of-82 field goal attempts (63.4 percent).
- Junior **Jordan Schakel** has eight or more points in seven straight games (double figure in five of those contests). Not only is reaching double figures good for Schakel, it has proven good for the Aztecs. When Schakel scores 10 or more points in his career, SDSU is 16-2 with nine straight victories. The Aztecs are 12-0 at Viejas when he reaches double figures. The sharpshooter has made 29-of-62 attempts from bonus distance (46.8 percent) this season to rank 20th nationally among players with at least 29 makes.

INTO THE TOP-25s

- San Diego State is spending its fourth week in the AP Top-25 Poll this week, moving up to No. 13 this week.
- At No. 13, the Aztecs have matched their highest ranking in the AP Poll since a No. 8 ranking on March 10, 2014.
- The Aztecs debuted at No. 25 in the poll back on Dec. 9. SDSU has moved from 25 to 20

- This is the 70th week that the Aztecs have appeared in the AP Poll and all have come since the start of the 2010-11 campaign.
- San Diego State entered the top-25 in both the AP and Coaches polls on Dec. 9 at No. 25 and No. 24, respectively. It was the first time since Feb. 23, 2015, the team had been ranked by the AP.
- The Aztecs have been ranked as high No. 4 (Jan. 24, 2011).
- San Diego State's longest consecutive streak of weeks being ranked in the AP Top-25 is 22 (Dec. 2, 2013 to Dec. 15, 2014).
- Prior to this season, the last time the Aztecs were ranked in the Coaches Poll was March 9, 2015.

BEST EVER?

- Having completed a perfect regular-season non-conference campaign for just the fourth time in school history and second time in the last 89 seasons, comparisons can be made between this season and the 2010-11 and 2013-14 teams that advanced to the NCAA Sweet 16.
- In comparison, the 2019-20 squad appears to have the lead in accomplishments at this point in the season. It is worth noting that the 2013-14 squad posted a road win at Kansas on Jan. 5.
- Numbers next to the best wins reflects final RPI numbers for the 2010-11 and 2013-14 seasons and current NET numbers for the 2019-20 team.

NET NATIONAL RANKING

- The NCAA announced its first NET (NCAA Evaluation Tool) rankings on Monday (12/16) and San Diego State slotted comfortably at No. 3, behind only Ohio State (No. 1) and Kansas (No. 2).
- Since its initial rankings, the Aztecs have been No. 1 10 times, No. 2 three times and No. 3 twice.
- The NET replaced RPI this year as the primary sorting tool for evaluating teams during the season. NET relies on game results, strength of schedule, location, scoring margin, net offensive and defensive efficiency, and the quality of wins and losses to create its rankings.

...AND THEN THERE WERE FOUR...THREE...TWO

- When the season started on Nov. 5, all 353 schools that compete at the Division I level were undefeated.
- After games on Dec. 29, there were two Division I schools that remained unbeaten (San Diego State & Auburn).
- According to KenPom, which rates SDSU No. 18, the Aztecs have the best chance to remain unbeaten for the remainder of the year.
- Staying with the KenPom rankings, SDSU will be favored in every game for the rest of the regular season, except at Utah State on Jan. 4. In that contest, KenPom predicts the Aggies will win 67-66.
- SDSU's 13-0 start is the second-best start to a season, trailing only 20 straight to start the 2010-11 season.

HOME COURT ADVANTAGE

San Diego State has advanced to the NCAA tournament seven of the last 10 seasons and has a NIT national semifinalist appearance as well during that span. One reason for the success is that Viejas Arena is a very tough place for opponents. Since the start of the 2009-10 campaign, and entering this season, San Diego State has the ninth-highest winning percentage in the country, amassing a 143-20 home record, winning 87.7 percent of its home games during that span.

With the 2019-20 season underway, here are a few statistics to keep an eye on.

- In its last 173 home games, SDSU has compiled a 153-20 mark, including 75-9 against non-conference competition at Viejas Arena.
- Since the start of the 2012-13 campaign, the Aztecs are 105-16 at home, including a 50-8 record in non-conference home contests during that stretch (48-6 against non-top 25 non-conference foes).
- The Aztecs are 42-7 in their last 49 non-conference home games.

NEXT SIGNPOST IS 1,000 POINTS

- San Diego State has two players who are on the precipice of the 1,000 career-points **Matt Mitchell** and **Malachi Flynn**.
- Mitchell, a junior forward began 2019-20 with 695 points, and after totaling 141 in the first 13 games, is now 164 from the milestone.
- If Mitchell continues to score at his career pace (10.5 points per game), he will pass 1,000-career points in the team's regular-season finale at Nevada (Feb. 29).
- When Mitchell reaches 1,000-career points, he will be the 34th Aztec in program history to reach quadruple digits. He will be the third player in as many years to reach 1,000-points in an Aztecs uniform (Jeremy Hemsley passed 1,000 points in 2018 and finished his career on The Mesa in 2019 with 1,392 points & Malik Pope reached 1,000 points, finishing with 1,111, in his senior season of 2018).
- Flynn, a redshirt junior guard, arrived at SDSU after competing at Washington State for two seasons and compiling 791-career points. He began the season 209 points from 1,000 for his career and after scoring 201 in his first 13 games, is eight from the signpost.
- If Flynn continues to score at his career-pace (13.2 points per game), he will pass 1,000 points against Fresno State (Jan. 1).
- **KJ Feagin**, a grad transfer from Santa Clara, had 1,182-career points prior to arriving at San Diego State. Combined with his 95 points

in the team's first 13 games, he passed 1,200. He now stands at 1,277 for his career.

MULTI-TEAM EVENT SUCCESS

- ▶ Since the start of the 2010-11 season San Diego State has competed in 12 Multi-Team Events (MTE).
- ▶ San Diego State has played 32 games in those events and has compiled a 27-5 record.
- ▶ San Diego State has been crowned champion in seven of the 11 MTEs its competed in since 2010-11, including the 2019 Continental Tires Las Vegas Invitational late last month.

FLYNN NAMED MW PLAYER OF THE WEEK

Malachi Flynn, a junior transfer from Washington State, was named the Mountain West Player of the Week for the week ending on Dec. 1. In three games, Flynn hit 19-of-40 from the floor (.475) averaging 20.0 points to go along with 3.7 assists, 2.7 rebounds, 2.3 steals and had a 1.6:1 assist to turnover ratio. In two games in the Las Vegas Invitational, he totaled 49 points on 15-of-27 shooting, including six threes, and had seven rebounds, seven assists and five steals. The Tacoma, Wash., native, led SDSU in scoring all three games and was the overall leading scorer in two of three contests the team played last week.

- ▶ **Trailing by nine points starting the second half against Iowa in the LVI Championship game, Flynn went 8-of-13 from the field, 3-of-7 from distance and 9-of-9 from the line, scoring 28 points in the half, en route to being named the tournament's MVP.**

BRINGING HOME HARDWARE FROM CONTINENTAL TIRES LAS VEGAS INVITATIONAL

- ▶ With wins over Creighton (83-52) and Iowa (83-73), the Aztecs won the Las Vegas Invitational, its first exempt tournament title since the 2017 Hawaiian Airlines Diamond Head Classic.
- ▶ **Malachi Flynn**, who was held scoreless in the first half against Iowa but totaled 28 of the team's 51 second-half points en route to the win. In two San Diego State wins, Flynn totaled 49 points on 15-of-27 shooting, including six threes, was 13-for-13 from the line and had seven rebounds, seven assists, and five steals. For his efforts he was named the tournament MVP
- ▶ **Yanni Wetzell** averaged 14.5 points (11-of-15 FG, 1-of-2 3FG, 6-of-8 FT), 4.5 rebounds, 2.0 assists and had a steal and a block and was named to the All-Tournament Team.
- ▶ **Jordan Schakel** was also named to the All-Tournament Team after averaging 13.5 points (10-16 FG & 7-of-10 3FG), 4.5 rebounds, with an assist and two steals.

WETZELL NAMED MW PLAYER OF THE WEEK

Yanni Wetzell, a graduate transfer originally from Auckland, New Zealand, was named the Mountain West Player of the Week for the week ending on Nov. 24. In two games, Wetzell hit 15-of-18 from the floor (.833) averaging 16.5 points to go along with 8.5 rebounds and 1 assist and one steal win a pair of wins. Against USD, he reached career-highs with 20 points and 12 rebounds to become the first Aztec this year to finish a game with a double double.

- ▶ Wetzell is one of three players this year who has had a game where his shot at least .800 from the floor, grabbed at least 12 boards and was perfect from beyond the three-point line.

MORE AZTEC TIDBITS

- ▶ San Diego State finished November with a 51-13 record in its last 64 November games.
- ▶ San Diego State finished December 5-0 and is now 55-14 in its last 69 games played in that month.
- ▶ San Diego State's 13-game win streak is the longest of the Brian Dutcher era and equals the second longest in school history.
- ▶ In San Diego State history there have been seven win-streaks of at least 11 games. Brian Dutcher has been on the sidelines for six of them.
- ▶ San Diego State is 90-14 in its last 104 home games.
- ▶ San Diego State has won 18 straight games and are 50-8 in the Dutcher era when leading at intermission.

SERIES HISTORY vs. FRESNO STATE

- ▶ The game between San Diego State and Fresno State will mark the 119th in the series. The 118 previous meetings is the most against any opponent in school history, easily outdistancing itself from the 93 all-time meetings with UC Santa Barbara.
- ▶ The Aztecs hold a six-game edge over the Bulldogs in the all-time series, 62-56, and have won 12 of the last 20. San Diego State owns a commanding 39-20 lead in games played in San Diego, including wins in six of the last nine meetings. In games played in Fresno, however, SDSU is 21-33, and has won five of the last 10 meetings.
- ▶ Five of the last nine meetings in San Diego have been decided by eight points or less.
- ▶ The Aztecs started the series in 1940 by winning the first eight meetings and 15 of the first 16. As the series progressed, SDSU went on to win 29 of the first 33 contests, going up to 1956. Beginning with the second game of the season series in 1956, the Bulldogs won three straight and 15 of the next 18. During that 18-game span, Fresno State ran off six consecutive victories as well. After trading wins for a few seasons, in 1969, the Aztecs lost five in a row and then won the next eight. It wasn't until 1985 that another streak began as the Bulldogs won seven straight and 17 of 18 before SDSU pulled the upset in 2001, which was the first of the Aztecs' eight-game series winning streak, which was stopped in Fresno in 2015. Since that loss, the Bulldogs own a 7-4 edge and have won five of the last six encounters.
- ▶ **Matt Mitchell** averages 9.8 points and 4.6 rebounds in his five games against Fresno State. The junior has connected on 18-of-41 field goals (43.9 percent), including 15-of-27 from two-point range (55.5 percent).
- ▶ **Nathan Mensah** averages 8.0 points, including 6-of-10 from the floor (60.0 percent) and 4-of-4 from the free throw line in his two career meetings with Fresno State.
- ▶ All-time series meetings against Fresno State can be found in the columns on this page and the previous page and career stats of current San Diego State student-athletes against the Bulldogs are located below.

SAN DIEGO – New Williams stole the ball and scored the go-ahead basket on a slam dunk with 30 seconds left and Fresno State overcame an eight-point deficit in the final 2:50 to stun San Diego State 76-74 Wednesday night and clinch the No. 3 seed in the Mountain West Conference Tournament.

Deshon Taylor scored 25 points for Fresno State (21-8, 12-5 MWC), including a 3-pointer that keyed the comeback and then three free throws in the final 21 seconds.

Taylor's 3-pointer pulled Fresno State to 72-69 with 1:02 left and then SDSU couldn't handle the Bulldogs' full-court press, committing three costly turnovers.

Braxton Huggins, who finished with 14 points, stole the ball and went in for a layup to pull within one point. Devin Watson was caught in traffic and threw the ball away to Williams for his go-ahead slam dunk. A third turnover resulted in Taylor going to the free throw line and making both for a 75-72 lead.

SDSU's Jalen McDaniels was fouled while taking a 3-pointer and had a chance to tie it. He made the first two free throws but missed the third and the Bulldogs rebounded. Taylor made the first of two free throws and Watson missed a desperation 3 at the buzzer.

Watson and McDaniels each scored 16 points while Jeremy Hemsley had 15 and Nathan Mensah 12 for SDSU (19-11, 11-6).

San Diego State, which overcame a 15-point first-half deficit, seemed to have the game in hand when Matt Mitchell hit a 3-pointer for a 71-63 lead with 2:50 to go.

After trailing by 15 with seven minutes to go in the first half and 39-32 at halftime, SDSU went on a 13-5 run to open the second half and take its first lead of the game, 45-44, on McDaniels' slam dunk off a rebound. Hutson drew a technical foul during an ensuing timeout and Watson made both free throws for a 47-44 lead.

The Bulldogs beat SDSU 66-62 in Fresno on Jan. 22, when the Aztecs squandered a 20-point first-half lead.

SAN DIEGO -- San Diego State didn't look anything like the nation's 15th-ranked team for a long stretch of the first half against scrappy Cal Poly.

The Aztecs missed inside shots, had free throws clang off the rim and big man Yanni Wetzell and guard KJ Feagin air-balled 3-point shots.

And then the stunner: The Mustangs raced back from a 10-point deficit to take a 23-22 lead to hush the crowd at Viejas Arena.

That's when SDSU finally woke up. Wetzell started a 9-0 run that closed the first half and the Aztecs won 73-57 to continue their best start in nine seasons.

Malachi Flynn scored 14 points and Wetzell and Jordan Schakel added 12 points apiece for the Aztecs (13-0), who are one of three undefeated teams nationally.

SDSU remains on its hottest start since 2010-11, when it opened 20-0 behind Kawhi Leonard and reached the Sweet 16 for the first time before finishing 34-3. SDSU, Auburn and Liberty are the nation's only undefeated teams.

After leading just 31-23 at halftime, SDSU opened it up early in the first half. Flynn hit two long 3-pointers, including one that banked in, and Feagin also hit a shot from behind the arc. Wetzell, a New Zealander, made three close-in shots to help the Aztecs take a 50-31 lead.

Kyle Colvin scored 13 points and Junior Ballard had 12 for the Mustangs. Alimamy Koroma had 12 rebounds.

The Aztecs frittered away an early 18-8 lead and let the Mustangs go ahead 23-22 on Koroma's two free throws with 2:41 before halftime. The Mustangs also got 3-pointers by Colvin and Ballard in surprising the Aztecs.

SDSU turned it on in the final 1:40 to take a 31-23 halftime lead. After Matt Mitchell missed a 3-pointer, Koroma rebounded but Wetzell stole the ball and scored. Flynn and Schakel had layups before Mitchell followed Flynn's missed 3 with a slam dunk, was fouled and made the free throw.

SDSU shot just 40 percent in the first half, but forced a season-high 23 turnovers for the game.

- ▶ The Aztecs held their 10th opponent this season to 40 percent or less from the floor and has won 17 straight in that situation.
- ▶ San Diego State has won 15 of its last 17 meetings against Cal Poly and improved to 24-4 all-time at home against the Mustangs.
- ▶ San Diego State is 7-0 this season, 35-5 in home games in the Dutcher era and is 92-15 in its last 107 home games.
- ▶ San Diego State has won 33 straight when holding its opponent to under 60 points.
- ▶ In San Diego State history there have been four win-streaks of at least 12 games. Brian Dutcher has been on the sidelines for three of them.

Third Season • 21st Season Overall at SDSU • Minnesota, 1982

Brian Dutcher, a long-time San Diego State men's basketball assistant coach, begins his third season as head coach. Dutcher completed his first year at the helm in 2017-18, following Steve Fisher's retirement announcement on April 11, 2017. Dutcher, who was on Montezuma Mesa for all of Fisher's 18 seasons, held the title of associate head coach/head coach in waiting the previous six years and is the program's 15th head coach.

Last season, Dutcher guided San Diego State to a 21-13 record which included multiple victories over nationally ranked Nevada. He is the only head coach in program history to record 20+ wins in each of his first two seasons and for the second year in a row directed his squad to the championship game of the Mountain West Championship tournament.

In his first season, Dutcher led the Aztecs to the 2018 Mountain West tournament title and the NCAA tournament, the program's first appearance in three seasons. He was the only first-year head coach in the NCAA tournament and SDSU ultimately finished the year with a 22-11 record.

Over the course of his 20-year career at San Diego State, Dutcher has helped the Aztecs reach the post-season 14 times, including nine trips to the NCAA tournament, win a conference-best 11 Mountain West titles and record 14 seasons of at least 20 victories.

Since 2008-09, Dutcher and SDSU twice advanced to the NCAA Sweet 16 (2011, 2014) and NIT semifinal round (2009, 2016), won at least 25 games seven times and captured eight MW championships (five regular season, three tournament).

Dutcher arrived at SDSU shortly after Fisher was hired on March 26, 1999. In his first year in "America's Finest City," the Aztecs won only five games, but improved upon their win total from the season before. After that, San Diego State posted a 14-14 record in 2000-01, before winning the 2002 MW Championship, earning an NCAA tournament bid and finishing with a 21-12 record. The 2002-03 campaign saw SDSU receive an NIT invitation, which culminated in the program's first Division I postseason victory.

After helping attract the first McDonald's All-American to the 2002-03 squad, Dutcher assisted in securing the signatures of future starters and all-league performers Brandon Heath and Marcus Slaughter. The duo started their first two seasons on The Mesa, leading to the 2005-06 season that produced the school's first Mountain West regular-season and tournament title sweep.

The Aztecs advanced to the NCAA tournament and ultimately won a then-school-record 24 games. That appearance led to a string of 10 consecutive postseason berths.

From the 2006-07 campaign through 2008-09, San Diego State registered 20 or more wins and went to three straight NITs. In 2009, the Aztecs advanced to the NIT semifinals and broke the previous school record with 26 victories.

The run to the NIT semifinals was a springboard to the most successful run in SDSU basketball history. Led by future NBA first-round draft pick and NBA champion Kawhi Leonard, the 2009-10 Aztecs won the MW Championship, advanced to the NCAA tournament and fell four points shy of moving on to the second round before finishing with a 25-9 record.

The NCAA experience from the 2009-10 squad proved fruitful in 2010-11 when it returned all five starters, including Leonard, and a freshman named Jamaal Franklin, who would turn out to be a future MW Player of the Year and NBA draft selection. With Dutcher on staff, SDSU won its first 20 games of the year, shared the MW regular-season title and captured the MW tournament crown. The Aztecs moved on to the NCAA tournament as a No. 2 seed and won the program's first Division I NCAA tournament game. San Diego State, which was ranked as high as No. 4 and received first-place votes at one point in the season, advanced to the Sweet 16 and fell to the eventual national champion, finishing with a school-record 34 wins, a mark that still stands today. The Aztecs' also found themselves in the final top-25 polls, ranking sixth in the AP and 11th in the USA Today Coaches Poll.

Five months after SDSU's record-setting 2010-11 campaign, the University elevated Dutcher from associate head coach to associate head coach/head coach in waiting.

In his first season with his new title, Dutcher and the Aztecs advanced to the 2012 NCAA tournament as an at-large team and recorded 26 wins. The next year, SDSU was an at-large selection to the 2013 NCAA tourney, moved on to the round of 32 for the second time in three years and finished with 23 victories.

Another NCAA Sweet 16 run was in the cards in Dutcher's third season as the head coach in waiting. The Aztecs opened the season by winning 21 of their first 22 games, including 20 in a row at one point, and were led by seniors Xavier Thames, who would become an NBA draft pick, and Josh Davis. SDSU won the program's second outright Mountain West regular-season title and later swept through two games in Spokane, Washington, to secure its second Sweet 16 appearance in four seasons. San Diego State compiled 31 wins and finished the season ranked 13th in the AP and 12th in the Coaches after rising to as high as fifth nationally in both polls.

The 2014-15 campaign saw the Aztecs spend their fifth straight season in the top 25. In the process of winning 27 games, San Diego State grabbed its second straight MW regular-season crown and earned an at-large invitation to the NCAA tournament where they defeated St. John's in the round of 64. One season later, the Aztecs found themselves in the NIT after winning the MW by three games with a 16-2 record. Nevertheless, SDSU won three games and qualified for the NIT semifinals, eventually logging 28 victories.

In his final season as associate head coach/head coach in waiting (2016-17), San Diego State posted a 19-14 record despite experiencing a rash of injuries.

Before Dutcher arrived at San Diego State, he served as assistant coach and later associate head coach at Michigan under Fisher. He spent 10 seasons on the Wolverine staff, establishing himself as one of the nation's top assistant coaches. His first year in Ann Arbor was 1989 and resulted in a national title for Michigan as he assisted then-interim head coach Fisher on the bench.

The Bloomington, Minn., native led UM's recruiting efforts in 1990-91 when the Wolverines inked Juwan

Howard, Ray Jackson, Jimmy King, Jalen Rose and Chris Webber. The "Fab Five" is considered perhaps the best recruiting class in NCAA history. Dutcher helped lead that group to nearly 100 wins, two berths in the NCAA championship game and a regional final over a four-year period. He was also on the Michigan staff for an NIT championship (1997).

Dutcher's recruiting prowess, however, was demonstrated by more than just the "Fab Five" haul. Michigan had the nation's top-ranked recruiting class in 1993-94 and in 1994-95, with a group that included Maurice Taylor and Jerod Ward. The accomplishment marked the first time that a university had the nation's top class in consecutive years, according to recruiting analyst Bob Gibbons.

Dutcher was born Oct. 30, 1959, in Alpena, Mich. He attended Jefferson High School in Bloomington, Minn., and went on to earn a bachelor's degree in physical education from Minnesota in 1982. While an undergraduate, he worked for his father, then-Gopher head coach Jim Dutcher. He then spent one season in the prep ranks at Apple Valley (Minn.) High School before becoming a graduate assistant at Illinois, where he earned his master's degree in physical education and athletic administration.

While in Champaign, Dutcher helped Lou Henson lead the Illini to a Big Ten championship, two appearances in the Sweet 16 and one regional final.

Dutcher's first full-time coaching job came at South Dakota State, where he spent three seasons helping turn around the Division II program before departing in 1988 for Michigan.

His final season in Ann Arbor ended with the Wolverines claiming the first-ever Big Ten Tournament championship.
