

# San Diego State Aztecs

2019-20 Record: 9-0 (H: 4-0; A: 3-0; N: 2-0) 1-0 MW  
11-Time MW Champions, 12 Postseason Berths in Last 14 Years

- SDSU has won at least 19 games in 14 straight seasons, which is tied for 7th-longest active streak in the nation.
- SDSU has advanced to the postseason play in 12 of the last 14 seasons (2006 NCAA, 2007-09 NIT, 2010-15 NCAA, 2016 NIT, 2018 NCAA).

- SDSU is 14th nationally in winning percentage since the beginning of the 2010-11 season.
- Since its founding in 1999, no men's basketball program has won more Mountain West championships (regular-season and tournament) than San Diego State's 11.

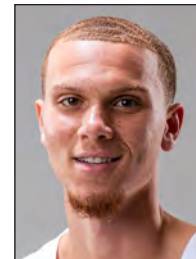
