- The Aztecs will be back in Viejas Arena to host UNLY Saturday at 1:00 p.m.
- The game will be streamed on the Mountain West Network with Chris Ello (12th season) on the call.
- This will be the Aztecs' annual Play4Kay Pink Game. Additionally, SDSU will be honoring all of its past championship teams (regular season and conference tournament).
- SDSU lost at UNLV earlier this year 71-57. Mallory Adams led the Aztecs with 19 points and 10 rebounds. She had 17 points and eight rebounds in the second half.
- The Aztecs lost at Nevada 74-69 Wednesday evening. SDSU was outrebounded 42-32 and 16-4 on the offensive glass which lead to 17 second chance points for the Wolf Pack.
- Mallory Adams (18), Najé Murray (17) and Sophia Ramos (17) all scored at least 17 points.
- Mallory Adams has scored 10 or more points eight of her last nine games, averaging 14.4 points over that span.
- Mallory Adams is one of three true freshmen nationally to average 12.0 points and 8.5 rebounds per game.
- Sophia Ramos leads all freshmen in the Mountain West in points, assists, field goal percentage, free throw percentage and
- Ramos is the only true freshman in the nation to average 14 points, 4.5 assists and 4.5 rebounds per game.
- Sophomore Najé Murray has moved into the top ten in school history for career three-pointers and three-point attempts. Entering the weekend, she is 113-336 (.336), which would rank her at No. 7 for three-point makes and attempts. At her current rate of 2.5 made threes per game, Murray has a chance to break the SDSU all-time record for made three-pointers in a season.
- SDSU leads the conference with 14.0 made free throws per game. Mallory Adams is third in the MW in free throws made and first in attempts.
- SDSU's recent four game win streak was their longest since February 2016 when they won five in a row.

Last Time Out (69-74 at Nevada, 2-20-19)

The Aztec women's basketball team (10-14, 5-8) fell at Nevada (9-15, 5-8) 74-69 Wednesday evening. SDSU scored just five points in the second quarter allowing the Wolf Pack to go on a 17-2 run and the Aztecs were unable to recover.

Mallory Adams (18), Sophia Ramos (17) and Najé Murray (17) led the Aztecs in scoring. Téa Adams also chipped in 11 points.

The Aztecs fell behind 12-8 in the first quarter, but then reeled off an 18-6 run to push their lead to eight points. SDSU shot 75 percent in the first quarter (9-for-12), but the Wolf Pack hung around due to their offensive rebounding. 11 of Nevada's first 23 points came off second chance points.

After a blazing start, the Aztecs went ice cold in the second quarter. The scored just five points, a season low, and made just one of their final 15 shots in the first half. Meanwhile, Nevada made five of their final six shots and finished the half on a 17-2 run to take a 35-28 lead at the half. Only four Aztecs scored in the first half and Mallory Adams and Najé Murray accounted for 18 of their 28 points.

The Aztecs had their best defensive quarter in the third, holding the Wolf Pack to 33 percent shooting. Sophia Ramos was held scoreless in the first half but scored nine points in the third quarter and SDSU went 8-for-9 from the free throw line to close the gap to three points entering the fourth quarter.

SDSU shot 67 percent in the final frame and pulled within three points multiple times but the Wolf Pack had an answer every time and made nine free throws down the stretch.

Nevada was led by Jade Redmon's 21 points; she was 9-for-10 from the free throw line. Essence Booker had 11 points. Terae Briggs had a double-double with 10 points and 10 rebounds.

The Wolf Pack outrebounded the Aztecs 42-32, including 16-4 on the offensive glass.

Noting the Nevada Game

- The Aztecs were outscored in second chance points 17-2 and 13-0 in the first half.
 This is the most second chance points SDSU has allowed all season.
- Due to the extra opportunities Nevada created, the Wolf Pack attempted 70 field goals, the most the Aztecs have allowed this season.
- Nevada was just 2-for-10 from three. This is a season-low for the Aztecs for opponent three-pointers made and attempted.
- SDSU committed 25 fouls, a season-high.
- The Aztecs quartet of Mallory Adams, Sophia Ramos, Najé Murray, and Téa Adams combined to score 63 of the Aztecs' 69 points. SDSU had just two bench points.
- This was the second time this season Sophia Ramos has scored 17 points or more in the second half (CSUN, 12-9-19).
- Ramos set new career-highs for free throws made (7) and attempted (8). She is shooting 82.4 percent from the line this season.

Scouting the Rebels

- UNLV is 9-16 and 7-7 in conference.
- They are currently in fifth place in the Mountain West.
- They are just 2-9 on the road.
- UNLV leads the conference with a +3.8 rebounding margin.
- The Rebels are tenth in the MW in points per game (60.1) and three-point percentage
 (282)
- The Rebels are last in the MW in assists per game (9.6) and second to last in assist-toturnover ratio (0.6)
- Katie Powell, a preseason all-conference pick, leads the team in scoring (13.9) and rebounding (6.7).
- Head Coach Kathy Olivier (11th season) was a former All-American at UNLY. She became
 the Lady Rebels head coach after 15 years at UCLA.

All-Time Series vs. the Rebels

- UNLV leads the all-time series 30-38
- UNLV has won the last four meetings, but prior to that SDSU has won 16 of 22.
- The Aztecs are 18-9 against UNLV in San Diego.
- SDSU has won 10 of the last 12 matchups in San Diego.
- UNLV beat the Aztecs 71-57
- They first met February 2, 1979, a 78-58 UNLV win.

Climbing the Charts

- Sophomore Najé Murray has moved into the top ten in school history for career three-pointers and three-point attempts. Entering the weekend, she is 113-336 (.336), which would rank her at No. 7 for three-point makes and attempts.
- With three more made three-pointers, Murray will pass former teammate Geena Gomez into sixth place all-time.
- At her current rate of 2.5 made threes per game, Murray has a chance to break the SDSU all-time record for made three-pointers in a season. Jamey Cox (2003) and Courtney Clements share the record with 77 made.
- Murray leads the conference in made three-pointers and is second in attempts and made threes per game.

Fab Frosh

Mallory Adams

- Mallory Adams has scored 10 or more points eight of her last nine games, averaging 14.4
 points over that span.
- Adams is averaging 8.7 rebounds per game, the most by an SDSU freshman since Aztec since Ashlee Dunlap (2002-03). She is bringing in 9.5 boards per game in conference play, the second most in the league.
- She has 10 or more rebounds in 12 games this season and in eight of the Aztecs' 13 MW games.
- Mallory Adams is one of three true freshmen nationally to average 12.0 points and 8.5 rebounds per game.
- She leads the Mountain West in rebounding for freshmen.
- She is in the top six in the nation in free throws made and attempted per game among true freshmen
- Adams leads the conference in free throw attempts and is third in made free throws.
- Adams has led the Aztecs in rebounding in 17 of their 23 games.
- Mallory Adams was recently named a Star of the Month for January by the San Diego Sports Association. In seven January games, Adams had three double-doubles and 10-plus rebounds five times.
- Earlier this month, Adams became the first Aztec to have three consecutive double-doubles since Paris Johnson had four straight in the 2008-09 season.

 Adams averaged a double-double at the SDSU Thanksgiving Classic and was named to the All-Tournament Team.

Sophia Ramos

- Sophia Ramos leads the Aztecs in scoring with 14.0 points per game, this is best among freshmen in the MW.
- Ramos is the only true freshman in the nation averaging at least 14 points, 4.5 rebounds and 4.5 assists per game.
- She leads all freshmen in the Mountain West in points, assists, field goal percentage, free throw percentage and minutes.
- She is third in the conference with an .824 free throw percentage and tenth in three-point percentage (.359)
- Ramos has scored in double-digits in 20 of their 24 games.
- Ramos has led the Aztecs in assists in 18 of their 24 games.
- Sophia Ramos scored a career-high 28 points at CSUN (12-9-18) with seven threepointers including six in the fourth quarter.
- Her 28 points and 10 made field goals in that game were the most by an Aztec
- Her seven three-pointers tie her for the second most in school history and her she became the first Aztec to hit six three-pointers in a quarter
- Despite being 5'9", she is second on the team in rebounds (4.5 per game). She had a career-high 10 vs. Arizona (12-2-18).

Earning it at the Line

- The Aztecs lead the conference in made free throws and are third in attempts. They are 70.7 percent from the line, fourth best in the league.
- In conference play, Najé Murray is shooting 92.3 percent from the line (24-26), second best in the league. Sophia Ramos is fourth (86.2 percent).
- Mallory Adams leads the conference in free throw attempts and is third in made free throws and is in the top six in the nation in free throws made and attempted per game among true freshmen.

Master Thief

- Najé Murray is second in the conference with 2.2 steals per game.
- Murray has led the team or tied for the team lead in steals in 18 of their 24 games.

Block Party

- The Aztecs are fourth in the conference in blocked shots per game (3.7).

- Hernandez, a four-star recruit according to Prospects Nation, helped Lynden Christian High School (Bellingham, Wash.) to a perfect 29-0 record and state championship last season.
- A 6'2" wing, Hernandez averaged 13 points per game last season along with 5.3 rebounds. She knocked down 50 percent of her shots from the field and was 88 percent from the free-throw line.
- Hernandez was an all-state selection last year and earned all-league and all-county recognition as both a sophomore and as a junior. She was heavily recruited and received offers from Gonzaga, Colorado, Washington State and Colorado State among others.

Preseason Notes

- The Aztecs were picked to finish ninth in the Mountain West preseason poll.
- The Aztecs lost four starters and six players total from a year ago. The Aztecs return just 34.6 percent of their scoring from last season.
- Najé Murray (Stockton, Calif.), who was named to the Mountain West all-freshman team last year, is the Aztecs' leading returning scorer (9.3 ppg). She led all MW freshmen in three-pointers made per game and was fourth overall in scoring among freshmen.
- The support from the community was record-breaking a season ago. The Aztecs had 22,069 fans over their 16 home games for an average of 1,379. That broke the total and average attendance records set in 2007-08, when the Aztecs drew 14,730 fans for an average of 1,133 per game.
- The Aztecs have had a winning record at home in 10 of the past 12 seasons.
- The Aztecs shot 71.4 percent from the free throw line last year, their best mark since the 1988-89 season and the fourth best rate in program history.
- The Aztecs made 200 three-pointers last season, the second most in program history (204, 2016-17). They made 33.7 percent of their three-point attempts, their best percentage since the 2009-10 season and the fourth best rate in program history
- For the second straight season San Diego State's incoming freshman class is nationally ranked. The Aztecs' 2018 recruiting class is ranked 59th nationally (according to Prospects Nation), fourth in the Mountain West. G/F Mallory Adams (Frisco, Texas), G Jayden Perez (Las Cruces, N.M.) and G Sophia Ramos (San Antonio, Texas) comprise the freshmen class.
- Transfers Zayn Dornstauder (Ball State) and Taylor Kalmer (Oregon State) will also join the Aztecs this year, although Kalmer will sit out the 2018-19 season due to NCAA transfer rules. Dornstauder, a 6'3" center from Canada, redshirted at Ball State last year after playing two years at San Francisco as a reserve. Kalmer, a 5'8" guard, spent her past three years at Pac-12 powerhouse Oregon State where she averaged a career-high 6.0 points per game last season.
