- The Aztecs play at Utah State Saturday at 2:00 p.m. MT
- The game will be streamed on the Mountain West Network and there will be an audio-only broadcast with Chris Ello (12th season) on the call as well.
- Utah State (10-11, 5-5) has lost four games in a row and is tied for fifth in the MW with UNLV.
- The Aztecs have won two games in a row and are coming off a huge 61-59 win over New Mexico, who was in first place entering the game.
- The Aztecs held the high-powered Lobo offense to 59 points and 32 percent shooting.
- New Mexico was just 3-for-26 from three on Wednesday and just 1-for-21 after the first quarter.
- Zayn Dornstauder had 11 points and a career-high 11 rebounds, notching her first collegiate double-double. averaging 8.7
 points per game in conference play while shooting 53.8 percent from the floor.
- Mallory Adams' streak of three straight double-doubles was snapped on Wednesday. Adams is averaging 12.1 points and 10.0
 rebounds in conference play.
- Adams is averaging 8.7 rebounds per game, the most for an Aztec freshman since Ashlee Dunlap in the 2002-03 season. She is bringing in 10.0 boards per game in conference play, the second most in the league.
- Murray is one of eighth players in the nation to average 14 points, 2.3 steals and 2.3 three-pointers per game.
- Sophia Ramos leads all Mountain West freshmen in points, assists, free throw percentage, assist-to-turnover ratio and minutes
 played. In conference play, she is shooting 88.0 percent from the free throw line, the most accurate among all qualified players.
- Ramos is the only true freshman in the nation to average 14 points, 4.5 assists and 4.5 rebounds per game.

Last Time Out (61-59 vs. New Mexico, 2-6-19)

The Aztec women's basketball team (8-12, 3-6) defeated first place New Mexico (18-3, 8-2) 61-59 in front of 4,272 fans Wednesday afternoon. SDSU had their best defensive performance of the year and held the high-powered Lobo offense to 32 percent shooting from the field and 11 percent from three.

The Aztecs led by ten early in the fourth quarter and by seven with four minutes to go but only scored two more points and saw their lead dwindle to two. New Mexico had the ball with a chance to tie or win on the last possession but Jayla Everett's baseline jumper rimmed out at the buzzer.

"It was the defense that won the game for us," head coach Stacie Terry said after the game. "We've been talking a lot about our defense and our goal is not to give up 60 points and we did that today. We've talked a lot about how every great moment is formed from a great opportunity. I thought today would be our great opportunity so I'm glad it worked out for us."

Sophia Ramos continued her fantastic freshman campaign to lead the Aztecs with 21 points on an efficient 9-for-14 shooting. Zayn Dornstauder notched her first career double-double with 11 points and a career-high 11 rebounds. Mallory Adams just missed out on her fourth consecutive double-double and finished with 10 points and eight rebounds.

New Mexico made five of their first six shots and ended up shooting 50 percent in the first quarter to take a 18-13 lead, but they wouldn't shoot better than 30 percent in any other quarter as the SDSU defense tightened up.

The Lobos missed eight of their first nine shots in the second quarter and the Aztecs took their first lead since being up 2-0 with 1:34 left in the guarter.

New Mexico scored the first three points of the second half but then SDSU went on an 11-0 run to take a 41-33 lead midway through the third quarter. The Lobos responded with a 9-1 run only to see the Aztecs score the next eight points.

The Aztecs went up 10 after Ramos nailed a three-pointer with 7:50 left and then the Lobos started to chip away. They cut the deficit to two with 1:54 left but Mallory Adams pushed the lead back to four with a layup with 1:29 left. After a pair of free throws from Jaisa Nunn, who had a game-high 27 points, the Lobos were down 61-59 with 31 seconds left but still had two fouls to give.

New Mexico fouled the Aztecs twice and then when going for another foul to put SDSU on the line, the Aztecs turned the ball over giving the Lobos a chance to tie or win with 11 seconds left. Following a timeout, the Lobos got a good luck from Jayla Everett on a 15-foot baseline jumper at the buzzer, but it rimmed out.

This was just the second time the Lobos have been held under 60 points. They were just 3-for-26 from three, a season-best defensively for the Aztecs. Meanwhile SDSU was 47 percent from deep (8-17).

Noting the New Mexico Game

- The Aztecs had 4,272 fans in attendance, a season-high.
- The crowd attempted to set the world record for most people simultaneously doing the "floss dance" during the first timeout of the third quarter. It is now pending review from the Guinness Book of World Records.
- After the first quarter the Lobos shot 26 percent from the floor and five percent

from three (1-for-21).

- New Mexico made was just 3-for-26 on three-pointers (11.5 percent). The amount of threes made and the percentage made were both season-bests for the Aztecs.
- This was just the second time New Mexico has been held under 60 points and just the third time the Aztecs have held an opponent under 60 and their first since November.
- New Mexico attempted 69 field goals, the most an opponent has shot against SDSU. The previous high was 69, also set by the Lobos.
- The Lobos entered the game as the conference's best rebounding team, but SDSU beat them on the glass 36-34, holding New Mexico 10 rebounds under their season average. SDSU had a season-best 47 rebounds in their game at New Mexico.
- SDSU is now 7-1 when holding opponents under 40 percent from the floor.
- Sophia Ramos had her third 20 point game of the season. The freshman point guard has scored in double-digits in 17 of the Aztecs' 20 games.
- Zayn Dornstauder had a career day. She recorded her first career double-double and hauled in a career-best 11 rebounds. She also set career-highs for free throws made (7) and attempted (10).
- Téa Adams had a career-high five steals.
- The Aztecs had 18 points in the paint, their second fewest on the year and fewest in MW play.

Scouting the Aggies

- Utah State is 10-11 overall and 5-5 in conference.
- They started 5-1 in league, but have now lost four in a row.
- The Aggies are 5-5 at home.
- They are second in the MW in blocks (4.5) and rebounds (38.7) per game and third in assists per game (15.8).
- They are second to last in free throws made and eighth in FT percentage (68.8).
- Shannon Dufficy leads the team in scoring (16.6 ppg) and is tops in the conference in rebounds per game (10.2) and double-doubles (13).
- Deja Mason is second in the conference with 1.5 blocks per game. She is the Aggies' all-time leader in blocks.
- Eliza West leads the team with 5.2 assists per game, third best in the nation and 33rd in the country.
- Head Coach Jerry Finkbeiner (7th year) is closing in on 600 career wins. He made previous stops at Oral Roberts (1996-2013) and Southern Nazarene (1991-96).

All-Time Series vs. Aggies

- The Aztecs lead the all-time series 6-5.
- They Aggies have won five of the last six meetings.
- They played only once last year, and the Aggies won 62-58 in Logan (12-30-17).
- SDSU is 2-4 all-time vs. the Aggies on the road. Their last win in Logan was Jan. 31, 2015, a 70-59 win.
- SDSU once scored 132 points against the Aggies en route to a 132-64 win on December 16, 1983.
- They first met December 5, 1980, a 79-51 SDSU win.

Fab Frosh

Mallory Adams

- Mallory Adams' streak of three straight double-doubles was snapped on Wednesday. Adams is averaging 12.1 points and 10.0 rebounds in conference play.
- Adams became the first Aztec to have three consecutive double-doubles since Paris Johnson had four straight in the 2008-09 season.
- Adams is averaging 8.7 rebounds per game, the most for an Aztec freshman since Ashlee Dunlap in the 2002-03 season.
- Mallory Adams is one of four true freshmen nationally to average 11.5 points and 8.5 rebounds per game.
- She leads the Mountain West in rebounding for freshmen.
- She is top ten in the nation in free throws made and attempted per game among true freshmen.
- Adams had 10 or more rebounds in three straight games earlier this year. The last Aztec to do that was SDSU legend and current pro Chelsea Hopkins, who did it in the 2011-12 season.
- Adams averaged a double-double at the SDSU Thanksgiving Classic and was named to the All-Tournament Team.

Sophia Ramos

- Sophia Ramos leads the Aztecs in scoring with 14.7 points per game, this is seventh in the conference and best among freshmen.
- Ramos is the only true freshman in the nation averaging at least 14 points, 4.5 rebounds and 4.5 assists per game.
- She leads all freshmen in the Mountain West in points, assists, assist-to-turnover ratio, free throw percentage and minutes.
- She is second in the conference with an .821 free throw percentage
- Sophia Ramos scored a career-high 28 points at CSUN (12-9-18) with seven three-pointers including six in the fourth quarter.
- Her 28 points and 10 made field goals in that game were the most by an Aztec this season.
- Her seven three-pointers tie her for the second most in school history and her she became the first Aztec to hit six three-pointers in a quarter

Earning it at the Line

- The Aztecs lead are second in the conference in made free throws and third in attempts. They are 70.4 percent from the line.
- Mallory Adams is second in the conference in made free throws and in attempts.
 and is top ten in the nation in free throws made and attempted per game among true freshmen.

Master Thief

- Najé Murray is second in the conference with 2.3 steals per game.
- Murray has led the team or tied for the team lead in steals in 15 of their 20 games.

Block Party

- The Aztecs are third in the conference in blocked shots per game.
- They have already eclipsed their total for blocks from last year (82-64).
- Zayn Dornstauder is third in the conference with 1.5 blocks per game.

Youth Movement

- The Aztecs started two freshmen, two sophomores and one junior in the season opener against Hawai'i. That group had a combined 33 career starts entering the game.
- The freshmen duo of Sophia Ramos and Mallory Adams earned the starting nod in the season opener, marking the first time two freshmen started the season opener for the Aztecs since 2003 (Michelle Elliott and Courtney Fritz).

Aztecs Ink Isabela

- Head Coach Stacie Terry and her staff announced the signing of Isabela Hernandez to a letter of intent in November.
- Last month, she hit seven three-pointers in a game and scored 25 points.
- Hernandez, a four-star recruit according to Prospects Nation, helped Lynden Christian High School (Bellingham, Wash.) to a perfect 29-0 record and state championship last season.
- A 6'2" wing, Hernandez averaged 13 points per game last season along with 5.3 rebounds. She knocked down 50 percent of her shots from the field and was 88 percent from the free-throw line.
- Hernandez was an all-state selection last year and earned all-league and all-county recognition as both a sophomore and as a junior. She was heavily recruited and received offers from Gonzaga, Colorado, Washington State and Colorado State among others.

Preseason Notes

- The Aztecs were picked to finish ninth in the Mountain West preseason poll.
- The Aztecs lost four starters and six players total from a year ago. The Aztecs return just 34.6 percent of their scoring from last season.
- Najé Murray (Stockton, Calif.), who was named to the Mountain West all-freshman team last year, is the Aztecs' leading returning scorer (9.3 ppg). She led all MW freshmen in three-pointers made per game and was fourth overall in scoring among freshmen.
- The support from the community was record-breaking a season ago. The Aztecs had 22,069 fans over their 16 home games for an average of 1,379. That broke the total and average attendance records set in 2007-08, when the Aztecs drew 14,730 fans for an average of 1,133 per game.
- The Aztecs have had a winning record at home in 10 of the past 12 seasons.

- The Aztecs shot 71.4 percent from the free throw line last year, their best mark since the 1988-89 season and the fourth best rate in program history.
- The Aztecs made 200 three-pointers last season, the second most in program history (204, 2016-17). They made 33.7 percent of their three-point attempts, their best percentage since the 2009-10 season and the fourth best rate in program history
- For the second straight season San Diego State's incoming freshman class is nationally ranked. The Aztecs' 2018 recruiting class is ranked 59th nationally (according to Prospects Nation), fourth in the Mountain West. G/F Mallory Adams (Frisco, Texas), G Jayden Perez (Las Cruces, N.M.) and G Sophia Ramos (San Antonio, Texas) comprise the freshmen class.
- Transfers Zayn Dornstauder (Ball State) and Taylor Kalmer (Oregon State) will also join the Aztecs this year, although Kalmer will sit out the 2018-19 season due to NCAA transfer rules. Dornstauder, a 6'3" center from Canada, redshirted at Ball State last year after playing two years at San Francisco as a reserve. Kalmer, a 5'8" guard, spent her past three years at Pac-12 powerhouse Oregon State where she averaged a career-high 6.0 points per game last season.
