

San Diego State Postgame Notes at No. 17/18 Nevada

Game Notes

- San Diego State's three-game winning streak against Nevada was snapped.
- Since Feb. 12, 2017, San Diego State is 4-2 against Nevada while the rest of the nation is a collective 9-64.
- San Diego State trailed by 13 points with 8:48 to play in the game before Nevada went on a 17-0 run.
- San Diego State shot a season-low 34.6 percent from the floor and a season-low 41.2 percent from the free throw line.
- SDSU had a season-low one offensive rebound.
- Nevada became the first San Diego State opponent in the last nine games to shoot 50 percent or better from the field (53.1 percent).

General Notes

- Despite the loss, SDSU ends Mountain West Conference play with an 11-7 record and earned the fourth seed entering the conference tourney. It marks the fifth time in the last six seasons the Aztecs have won at least 11 conference games.
- In the Brian Dutcher era (start of the 20177-18 season), San Diego State is 4-4 against nationally-ranked teams.

Player Notes

Jeremy Hemsley – team-high 16 points, 3 assists, 2 stelas, 3-6 3FGs

Has three consecutive games with 15+ points for the first time this season and first time since February, 2016... His 16 points were the most in a game since scoring 19 at California (12-8-18)... Made multiple three-point field goals in three straight games (7-of-14 during that span)... Posted fourth straight game with three or more assists (15 total during that stretch)... Recorded his 75th double-digit scoring games... Led SDSU in scoring for the third time this season and the 30th time in his career... 1,372 career points.

Matt Mitchell – 14 points, team-high 9 rebounds, 2 assists, 3-5 3FGs

Reached double figures for the third time in the last five games, the 16th time this season and the 36th time in his career... Made a threepoint field goal for the seventh consecutive game... Led the Aztecs in rebounding for the third time this season and the sixth time in his career... Tied a career-high with nine rebounds (two other occasions). Devin Watson – 14 points, 2 rebounds, 4-7 3FGs

Recorded his third straight double-digit scoring game, the 27th of the season and the 92nd of his career... Made four three-point field goals for the second time in three games (nine total during that span).
