2019 MOUNTAIN PACIFIC SPORTS FEDERATION ALL-MPSF WOMEN'S LACROSSE SELECTIONS

2019 MPSF Player of the Year TAYLOR CUENIN • # 6 • SENIOR • ATTACKER • UC DAVIS



UC Davis senior attacker **Taylor Cuenin** (Danville, CA/San Ramon Valley HS) goes back-to-back as MPSF Player of the Year, leading the MPSF in goals (47) and caused turnovers per game (1.21), ranking second in points per game (3.57) and caused turnovers (17), and eighth in ground balls per game (1.86). Through the regular season, Cuenin is also tied for 18th nationally in goals per game (3.36) and tied for 33rd in total goals. Cuenin totaled 10 hat tricks in her 14 regular season games, including a 2019 MPSF single-game high of seven goals vs. Radford (Mar. 16). Her six-goal game against San Diego State on Senior Day made her the 10th player in MPSF history to reach a career total of 150. She was named MPSF Offensive Player of the Week on Mar. 18 and Apr. 15, finishing her career with seven weekly awards. Cuenin is the only MPSF Player of the Year recipient from UC Davis, and becomes the first Aggie in MPSF Lacrosse history to be a four-time all-conference selection.

2019 MPSF Rookie of the Year SYDNEY SKALSTAD • # 54 • FRESHMAN • ATTACKER • FRESNO STATE



Fresno State freshman midfield **Sydney Skalstad** (Baltimore, MD/Mount de Sales Academy) leads the Bulldogs in goals (31), shots (84), draw controls (42) and hat tricks (6) this season. She is tied for fourth and is the highest-ranked freshman in the MPSF in goals scored. Skalstad inked her name in the Fresno State record book by ranking sixth in a single season in both goals and draw controls after just one year with the program. Through the regular season, she is the ninth highest-ranked freshman in the country in scoring average (2.38 GPG). Her 38 total points ranks sixth in the conference, while her 42 draws are within the MPSF's top-five. She tied the MPSF-high with five weekly awards this year. Skalstad, the only freshman all-conference honoree this year, represents Fresno State's second-straight MPSF Rookie of the Year and the program's second all-time major award winner (Mackenzie Wallevand-2018).

2019 MPSF Coach of the Year SUZANNE ISIDOR • SECOND YEAR • UC DAVIS



UC Davis Head Coach **Suzanne Isidor** makes it two-for-two as MPSF Coach of the Year in her first two seasons at the helm of the Aggies. UC Davis is making its second-straight appearance in the MPSF Championship game as the No. 1 seed, having again won both conference games. In a very similar pattern to last year, the Aggies got off to a 2-4 start in February and showed remarkable progress by winning seven of their last 10. Taylor Cuenin repeated as MPSF Player of the Year, the only Aggie ever to receive the honor. Cuenin leads the conference in goals, Amanda Outcalt in assists and points, and Kate Graham is at the top in draw controls. As a team, UCD has been outstanding on the draw, setting a school record of 254 and a No. 11 NCAA ranking of 15.88 per game. The fifth head coach in UC Davis Lacrosse history, Isidor is the program's lone MPSF Coach of the Year.
