AZTECS SET FOR TONY GWYNN LEGACY

- > The fifth annual Tony Gwynn Legacy, co-hosted by San Diego State and the University of San Diego begins play on Friday, Feb. 21.
- > Two games per day will be contested at SDSU's Tony Gwynn Stadium and USD's Fowler Park from Friday through Sunday.
- > In addition to the Aztecs and Toreros, the event features Arizona, Iowa, Nebraska, Seattle, Southern Illinois and USC. A complete tournament schedule can be found on GoAztecs.com.
- > SDSU will lock horns with Iowa on Friday beginning at 6 p.m. PT, before engaging Nebraska on Saturday with another 6 p.m. start. The Aztecs will wrap up their weekend with a clash against USC, which is slated to get underway at 2 p.m.
- > All three SDSU games this weekend will include a live video stream via the Mountain West Network on GoAztecs.com with Jordan Carruth calling the play-by-play.
- > The Aztecs have finished 2-1 at the Tony Gwynn Legacy in each of the last two years. Last season, SDSU bookended a narrow 1-0 loss to Oklahoma with a pair of victories against Utah (3-2) and Kansas State (10-7).

AN EARLY LOOK AT THE AZTECS

- > San Diego State is off to a 3-1 start for the third consecutive season after defeating Cal State Fullerton 8-4 in the team's home opener on Tuesday night.
- > Anthony Walters blasted a key two-run homer against the Titans, while Mike Jarvis hit a solo shot, helping the Aztecs secure their fourth straight home-opening victory.
- > Ryan Orr also contributed a clutch two-run double, finishing 3-for-4 at the plate with two runs scored, as the Scarlet and Black overcame six errors.
- > SDSU returned to "America's Finest City" after returning from a 2-1 road trip at the Brittain Resorts Baseball by the Beach event in Conway, South Carolina. The Aztecs won the first two games of their Palmetto State excursion by knocking off Virginia Tech 7-5 and host Coastal Carolina 3-1 before running out steam in an 11-4 loss to UNC Greensboro.
- > Matt Rudick hit .385 (5-13) for the weekend, finishing with one home run, one double, 5 RBIs and four runs scored. The Aztec outfielder also compiled a .462 on-base percentage and a .692 slugging percentage, both team highs, while hitting .750 (3-4) with runners in scoring position.

HEAD COACH MARK MARTINEZ

> Mark Martinez begins his sixth season as head coach of the Aztecs and 15th overall as a member of the San Diego State staff after succeeding the late Tony Gwynn on August 20, 2014. He is just the fifth head coach in SDSU history since baseball was elevated to major sport status in 1936.
 > During his tenure as the Aztecs' head coach, Martinez has compiled a 178-129 record (.580), highlighted by three Mountain West tournament championships in 2015, 2017 and 2018. He has also posted an 84-64 ledger (.568) in conference regular-season games.
 > Since 2015, SDSU has garnered 27 all-Mountain West accolades under Martinez's tutelage, including back-to-back MW Pitchers of the Year Brett Seeburger (2017) and Garrett Hill (2018), as well as 2017 MW Player of the Year Danny Sheehan.
 > Additionally, Martinez has mentored three freshman All-Americans in Chase Calabuig (2015), Casey Schmitt (2018) and Jaden Fein (2019), with the latter also receiving Mountain West Co-Freshman of the Year distinction last year.
 > In 2017, Martinez recorded his 100th victory for the Scarlet and Black, becoming the fastest head coach in program history to reach the century mark in wins.
 > Not to be outdone, Martinez also became the fastest head coach in Mountain West history to win three conference championships when the Aztecs captured the title in 2018.
 > Martinez was hired as an assistant coach for the Aztecs in July of 2005 and served for nine years under head coach Tony Gwynn. During that time, he was promoted to the position of associate head coach.
 > Since his arrival on The Mesa as an assistant coach, Martinez has witnessed 42 SDSU players get drafted into the professional ranks, with eight of those selections making the major leagues (Stephen Strasburg, Addison Reed, Justin Masterson, Bruce Billings, Quintin Berry, Lance Zawadzki, Greg Allen and Ty France).
 > Prior to his arrival at San Diego State, Martinez was an assistant coach at New Mexico for 17 seasons from 1989-2005. During his time as a hitting and infield coach, he helped develop the Lobos into one of the most prominent offensive teams in the country, with UNM ranking among the top 11 nationally in hitting over his final four seasons.
 > Martinez served as an assistant at his alma mater, Mesa State College (now Colorado Mesa University) in Grand Junction, Colorado, from 1984-88. He played shortstop at the school from 1982-84, earning all-conference and all-district honors as a senior.
 > Martinez graduated from Mesa State with a bachelor's degree in physical education in 1984 and completed his master's in sports administration at New Mexico in 1990.

IOWA AT A GLANCE

> The Hawkeyes posted a 31-24 overall record in 2019, finishing in a three-way tie for sixth place in the Big Ten with a 12-12 conference mark.

> Iowa won two out of three games at the Snowbird Classic last weekend in Florida, defeating Kent State (3-1) and Saint Joseph's (7-2) before falling to Pitt (10-8) in the finale.

> The Hawkeyes are receiving votes in the latest NCBWA poll after getting pick to finish fifth in the Big Ten Conference by both Perfect Game and Baseball America.

> Iowa had three players garner preseason all-Big Ten accolades, including right-handed pitcher Grant Leonard, who received second-team preseason NCBWA All-America honors after setting a school record with 14 saves last year. In addition, right-handed pitcher Grant Judkins (4-7, 2.72 ERA, 65 SO) ranked among the top 14 in the Big Ten last year in ERA, opposing batting average and innings worked, while catcher Austin Martin (.294, 10 2B, 30 RBIs) topped the squad with 18 multi-hit games.

> The Hawkeyes' scheduled starting pitcher for Friday is left-hander Jack Dreyer, who was limited to just two starts last year due to a shoulder injury, posting a 1-0 record and a 2.45 ERA. The Iowa redshirt sophomore was victorious in Iowa's 2020 debut on Feb. 14, striking out eight batters in 5.0 scoreless innings against Kent State, allowing just two hits and one walk to collect the victory.

> Outfielder Ben Norman hit .462 (6-of-13) with four runs scored and four RBIs last weekend at the Snowbird Classic, while Martin is batting .308 after three games.

> Head coach Rick Keller is in his seventh year at the helm of the Iowa program after leading the Hawkeyes to a pair of NCAA regional appearances (2015, 2017) and a Big Ten tournament title (2017). Prior to his arrival in Iowa City, Keller had stints at Indiana State (2010-13), Northern Iowa (2000-09) and Upper Iowa (1988-99). His career record stands at 896-698-4, including a 206-134 mark at Iowa.

NEBRASKA AT A GLANCE

> The Huskers dropped the final two games of a season-opening series at Baylor last weekend. Nebraska won the first encounter handily, 19-9, but fell short in game two by an 8-7 count in 10 innings before losing 7-2 in the finale.

> The Huskers return six position starters and 10 pitchers from last season's squad that compiled a 32-24 overall record and tied for third in the Big Ten with a 15-9 conference mark. Additionally, Nebraska lost to Ohio State in the final game of the 2019 Big Ten tournament.

> The Huskers were picked to finish fourth in the Big Ten this year behind 2019 College World Series runner-up Michigan, Ohio State and Minnesota, respectively.

> Saturday's projected starter is right-hander Colby Games, who gave up five runs on seven hits with one walk in two innings vs. Baylor on Feb. 15. Last season, the Omaha, Neb., native received first-team NCBWA All-America honors after serving as the Nebraska's closer, posting 13 saves which tied for 11th nationally and fourth in the Big Ten.

> Outfielder Aaron Palensky, infielder/pitcher Spencer Schwellenbach and pitcher Gareth Stroh received preseason all-Big Ten recognition. Last year, Palensky merited second-team all-Big Ten honors after leading the Husker offense in batting average (.320), hits (71), runs scored (43), home runs (7) and total bases (107). Schwellenbach batted .275 in 2019, adding five home runs, five doubles, 22 RBIs and 26 runs, while Stroh is a transfer from Purdue, where he went 10-6 with a 4.34 ERA and 86 strikeouts in 32 appearances over two seasons (2017-18).

> The Huskers are guided by first-year head coach Will Bolt, who spent five seasons as an assistant coach at Texas A&M from 2015-19 after working as Nebraska's associate head coach from 2012-14. A former infielder for the Huskers, Bolt served as team captain when Nebraska made back-to-back College World Series appearances in 2001 and 2002. He finished his collegiate career holding six school records, including games played (251), games started (242), at-bats (922), hits (281), doubles (56) and assists (639).

USC AT A GLANCE

> The Trojans return five starting position players and 10 pitchers from last year's team that finished seventh in the Pac-12 with a conference record of 13-15-1 and compiled a 25-29-1 mark overall.

> USC took two of three games from Western Michigan in its season-opening series at home last weekend, with an 8-5 setback sandwiched between two lopsided victories (16-2, 14-3).

> Outfielder Brady Shockey, shortstop Ben Ramirez and first baseman/designated hitter Clay Owens shared the team lead with five hits apiece during the series. Ramirez topped the squad with five RBIs over the weekend, including a pair of home runs in the finale on Feb. 16.

> Sunday's probable starter Alex Cornwell picked up the victory in that contest, allowing two runs on three hits and two walks while striking out six in 5.2 innings. The Trojan left-hander has been plagued by injuries over the last two seasons after getting selected by the Chicago Cubs in the 37th round of the 2017 MLB First-Year Player Draft.

> In 2019, Owens received all-Pac-12 recognition, hitting a team-best .348 in conference play. He also recorded a .927 OPS during league competition and racked up 11 extra-base hits, finishing the regular season with three homers, one triple and seven doubles.

> The Trojans will face seven teams this year that advanced to postseason play in 2019, including defending national champion Vanderbilt, along with TCU, Stanford, California, Oregon State, UCLA and Arizona State.

> USC is under the direction of first-year head coach Jason Gill, who spent the previous 11 seasons at Loyola Marymount, where he posted a 322-286-1 (.530) overall record. In 2019, he steered the Lions to a 34-25 mark and into the NCAA postseason, where they fell to top-ranked UCLA in the finals of the Los Angeles Regional.

SERIES RECORDS

> The Aztecs have faced Iowa on one previous occasion back in 1988 when the teams split a pair of games in San Diego. SDSU captured the opener by a 9-2 count before suffering a 6-2 defeat in the second contest.

> San Diego State sports a 7-4 all-time record vs. Nebraska. The two sides last met in final game of the Aztec Invitational in 2004 when the Huskers claimed a 6-2 decision at Petco Park in downtown San Diego during the stadium's inaugural event for baseball.

> The Aztecs sport an 18-8 record against eight Big Ten schools that currently sponsor baseball, including unblemished marks against Purdue (4-0), Michigan (2-0), Michigan State (1-0) and Indiana (1-0). SDSU is also 2-1 against Northwestern and 1-2 vs. Minnesota. Additionally, the Aztecs swept a three-game series from Wisconsin in 1989, the last year the Badgers fielded a varsity program in baseball.

> SDSU trails the all-time series against USC 26-62-3, including a 2-0 setback on the road in 2017, which marked the last encounter between the two squads. Earlier that year, the Scarlet and Black also came up empty in a 1-0 loss to the Trojans at home.

> In 2015, the Aztecs fell short to USC in the NCAA Lake Elsinore Regional, as the Trojans scored two runs in the top of the ninth to earn a wild 12-11 victory and eliminate SDSU from postseason play.

SETTING THE TABLE FOR 2020

> San Diego State returns 19 letterwinners from last year's squad that finished with a 32-25 overall record and a 16-13 mark in the Mountain West. The Aztecs welcome back five starting position players and two starting pitchers.

> SDSU has captured five of the last seven MW tournament championships and is the only team in the league to have won 30 or more games six times in the last seven years.

> The Aztecs were pegged for a first-place finish in the 2020 MW preseason coaches poll, attaining the status of conference favorites for the second year in a row.

> Leading the list of returners is junior Casey Schmitt, a consensus preseason All-American who additionally earned a spot on USA Baseball's Golden Spikes Award Watch List. Last year, the Aztec third baseman/relief pitcher was a second-team all-MW honoree after receiving freshman All-America recognition in 2018 from Collegiate Baseball magazine.

> Also back in the mix are 2019 all-Mountain West selections Matt Rudick (first team) and Mike Jarvis (second-team), as well as Jaden Fein, who was named the league's Co-Freshman of the Year last season to go with freshman All-America distinction.

> The Aztecs were ranked 31st in Collegiate Baseball's Fabulous 40 Preseason Poll and have received votes in the NCBWA Top 25 Preseason Poll.

WEEKEND ROTATION

> San Diego State's pitching rotation for the second weekend of the 2020 campaign will have sophomore Michael Paredes starting the tournament opener on Friday vs. Iowa.

> Paredes made his first start of the season vs. Virginia Tech, allowing four runs (three earned) on seven hits and one walk in 3.1 innings. In 2019, the San Diego High product started five games in 17 appearances during his freshman season, compiling a 3-3 record and a 5.29 ERA in 51.0 innings. He ranked third on the team with 56 strikeouts, walking just 19 batters.

> Fellow classmate Troy Melton will get the call on Saturday vs. Nebraska, with another sophomore Aaron Eden set to wrap up the tournament with a start in Sunday's contest vs. USC.

> In his first career start against Coastal Carolina on Feb. 15, Melton held the Chanticleers scoreless in five innings pitched, yielding just one hit while posting a career-high five strikeouts en route to his first collegiate victory.

> Eden, meanwhile, made 12 starts in 18 appearances during his rookie campaign in 2019, notching a 4-2 record with a 4.01 ERA and 41 strikeouts. He allowed one earned run or less in seven starts. Eden looks to rebound from a rough outing vs. UNC Greensboro when he absorbed the loss after ceding six runs (four earned) on six hits and two walks in 3 1/3 innings.

TOUGH AT HOME

> Since the start of the 2012 season, San Diego 151-97 (.609) when playing at home.

> In 2018, the Aztecs set a program record with 25 home victories at Tony Gwynn Stadium (since 1997), besting the previous standard of 24 set in 1997, 2002 and 2014.

AZTECS AMONG THE MW LEADERS

> Entering the weekend, San Diego State leads the Mountain West with a collective .298 batting average and a 3.34 earned run average.

> Individually, Ryan Orr occupies the third spot in the conference with a .471 batting average (8-17); Matt Rudick ranks fifth with a .412 clip (7-17), while Anthony Walters follows closely in eighth at .375 (6-16).
 > In addition, Orr leads the conference with eight hits, while Rudick sits atop the MW leaders with six runs scored. Likewise, Jacob Flores is enjoying a lofty perch with nine strikeouts in 6.2 innings so far this year.

SCHMITT NAMED TO GOLDEN SPIKES AWARD WATCH LIST

> Junior Casey Schmitt added to his already lengthy list of preseason accolades on Feb. 13 when he earned a spot on the USA Baseball's Golden Spikes Award Watch List, beginning the process of identifying the nation's top amateur player for the 2020 season.

> With his nomination, Schmitt becomes the fourth Aztec player since 2008 to land on the preseason Golden Spikes Award Watch List, joining Michael Cederoth (2014), Addison Reed (2010) and Stephen Strasburg, who took home the top prize in 2009. In addition, Tyler Adkison landed on the GSA mid-season watch list in 2017.

> In addition, Schmitt enters the 2020 campaign with four preseason All-America honors, including three second-team plaudits from Collegiate Baseball, D1Baseball.com and Perfect Game and a third-team honor from Baseball America.

> As SDSU's starting third baseman in 2019, Schmitt finished second on the team with a .315 batting average, adding eight doubles, five home runs and 36 RBI to merit second-team all-Mountain West distinction. He also appeared in 21 games with four starts as a pitcher, posting a 3-3 record and a 3.77 ERA in 43.0 innings to go with a team-high eight saves.

> In 2018, Schmitt was a consensus freshman All-American, setting an Aztec single-season record with a 0.28 ERA (min. 30 IP) while allowing just one earned run in 32 innings pitched. He also posted a .264 batting average with one home run and 32 RBI, finishing the year as one of only two players nationally to maintain a 2.00 ERA or lower (min. 15 IP) and drive in more than 30 runs.

SCHMITT, RUDICK LAND ON PRESEASON ALL-MOUNTAIN WEST TEAM

> Aztec juniors Casey Schmitt and Matt Rudick each earned on spot on the preseason all-Mountain West team announced on Feb. 11.

> Rudick garnered first-team all-conference accolades in 2019 after leading SDSU in several categories, including batting average (.320), total bases (95), hits (77) and runs scored (48), serving as the team's leadoff hitter throughout the year.

> Additionally, the Aztec outfielder topped the squad with 18 multi-hit games and reeled off a team-high 21-game hitting streak. The Scripps Ranch High alumnus was also the toughest player in the Mountain West to strike out last season, fanning just once per 12.1 at-bats which was good for 25th nationally.

VETERAN HONOREES

> Not to be outdone, San Diego State also returns outfielders Mike Jarvis (.289, 5 HR, 8 2B, 30 RBI), who was a second-team all-MW selection as a junior last season, and Jaden Fein (.293, 4 HR, 11 2B, 20 RBI), who collected league Co-Freshman of the Year distinction to go with Freshman All-America honors from Collegiate Baseball magazine.

> In addition, Brian Leonhardt (.272, 1 HR, 14 2B, 34 RBI) is back in the mix after leading the Aztecs with a team-high .389 batting average with runners in scoring position and topping the squad with 16 two-out RBIs. He also occupied the fourth spot with multiple RBIs in seven games and ranked fifth with 16 multi-hit performances.

NEWCOMERS AMONG STARTERS

> A pair of junior college transfers and one true freshman have already cracked the starting lineup through the first four games of the year for SDSU.
 > Wyatt Hendrie has assumed the duties at catcher after earning all-state honors by the California Community College Baseball Coaches Association (CCCBA) at Antelope Valley College in 2019. In his lone season with the Marauders, he led the team in several categories, including batting average (.410), hits (59) runs (32), RBIs (26), doubles (10) and triples (10).

> Hendrie was a 10th-round selection by the Chicago Cubs in the 2019 MLB First-Year Player Draft.

> At shortstop, Anthony Walters has stepped in after arriving from Mt. San Antonio College, where he earned first-team all-state honors from the CCCBA on the strength of a .374 batting average in 45 games with 10 home runs and 62 RBIs.

> Caden Miller has received the starting nod at second base through four games after graduating from Bishop Alemany High School in Mission Hills, California near Los Angeles. He was a two-time all-conference selection who finished with career-highs in batting average (.329), runs scored (29), stolen bases (21) and doubles (9) during his senior season.

> Miller was listed as the Mountain West preseason freshman of the year in several publications, including D1Baseball.com.

> Overall, the Aztecs' recruiting class for 2019 was ranked 20th nationally by Perfect Game.

AZTECS TABBED PRESEASON MOUNTAIN WEST FAVORITES

> For the second straight season, San Diego State baseball team was picked first in the Mountain West preseason coaches poll, as announced Feb. 11 by the conference office.

> Collectively, SDSU received 46 points and four first-place votes, edging second-place Fresno State (42 pts, 2 first-place votes), while Nevada (38 pts, 2 first-place votes) was predicted to finish third, followed by fourth-place UNLV (34 pts). Rounding out the remainder of the poll were New Mexico (5th, 23 pts), Air Force (T-6th, 17 pts), San José State (T-6th) and Boise State (8th, 7 pts).

> The Aztecs were also predicted to finish first prior to the 2014 campaign.

MORE SCHMITT

> Casey Schmitt gained valuable experience in the summer of 2019 when he played for the Cotuit Kettleers in the Cape Cod League.

> Schmitt collected MVP honors for the championship finals after belting two homers and scoring three runs in Cotuit's 10-3 title-clinching victory over Harwich. He also pitched six scoreless innings in two relief appearances during the finals, striking out eight batters against two walks.

STRIKEOUTS GALORE

> San Diego State recorded 27 games with 10 or more strikeouts during the 2019 campaign, marking the most double-digit strikeout performances for the Aztecs in the MW era (since 2000). SDSU surpassed the previous MW record of 23 set in a 10-6 win at Fresno State on May 11, 2009.

> The SDSU pitching staff has already notched two games with 10 strikeouts vs. Virginia Tech on Feb. 14 and Cal State Fullerton on Feb. 18.

> The Aztecs are 18-11 in their last 27 games when striking out 10 or more batters.

OTHER TRENDS

> San Diego State went 17-5 during the 2019 season and has won 12 of its last 14 when hitting a home run.

> In addition, the scoring the game's first run proved to be important for the Aztecs last year, with the team posting a 19-6 record when scoring first in comparison to a 13-17 mark when their opponent scores first. SDSU is 2-0 this season when scoring the first run.

> SDSU is 64-10 in its last 74 games when scoring five or more runs, including a 2-0 mark in 2020.

> The Aztecs are 29-15 in their last 44 one-run games.

> San Diego State is 46-17 last 63 games following a loss.

> With their 7-5 victory vs. Virginia Tech, the Aztecs snapped a 17-game losing streak when trailing after six innings.

MOUNTAIN WEST CHAMPIONSHIP RETURNS TO TONY GWYNN STADIUM

> For the fifth time since the league's inception, San Diego State will play host to the Mountain West Championship, May 21-24, at Tony Gwynn Stadium.

> The Aztecs also welcomed the conference tournament in 2001, 2010, 2011, as well as 2018, when they claimed their fifth MW Championship crown in a span of six years.

> SDSU has captured the most tournament titles in conference history, winning in 2000, 2013, 2014, 2015, 2017 and 2018.

CRAZY TONY GWYNN PLAYER STATS

> Tony Gwynn completed his illustrious career with a .338 lifetime batting average. Every other player who had a career batting average of at least .338 played before 1943.

> Gwynn hit .368 over a five-year stretch between 1993 and 1997.

> Gwynn faced Tom Glavine, Greg Maddux, Pedro Martinez, and John Smoltz a combined 323 times. He struck out three times over those at bats.

> Gwynn never struck out more than 40 times in a season and struck out less than 20 times in six straight seasons. Had a career-low 15 strikeouts in 1995.
