OSU leads all-time series, 13-8-1

WHAT'S ON TAP FOR AZTEC BASEBALL

- > Fresh off a 2-1 victory at UC Irvine on Tuesday, San Diego State returns home to host Oregon State in a four-game series, Feb. 27-March 1, at Tony Gwynn Stadium.
- > The first three games are scheduled to begin at 6 p.m. PT, while Sunday's finale is slated for a 1 p.m. PT start.
- > Live stats will be available throughout the weekend, while Friday's game will be broadcast on XTRA Sports 1360 AM with Jon Schaeffer handling the play-by-play responsibilities.
- > In addition, Sunday's contest will feature a live stream on GoAztecs.com via the Mountain West Network with Jordan Carruth calling the action.
- > The first 300 fans attending the Aztecs-Beavers showdown this Sunday will also receive a free Stephen Strasburg T-shirt.
- > After its nail-biter at UC Irvine, San Diego State improves to 6-2 on the year, matching the second-best record through eight games in head coach Mark Martinez's tenure. The Aztecs opened with a 7-1 ledger in Martinez's first season at the helm in 2015 and also posted a 6-2 start in 2018.
- > For the third consecutive season, the Aztecs finished with a 2-1 record at the Tony Gwynn Legacy last weekend, defeating Iowa (4-1) and Nebraska (4-2) on consecutive nights before falling to USC (11-5) on Sunday.

TOUGH AT HOME

- > Since the start of the 2012 season, San Diego State is 153-98 (.614) when playing at home.
- > In 2018, the Aztecs set a program record with 25 home victories at Tony Gwynn Stadium (since 1997), besting the previous standard of 24 set in 1997, 2002 and 2014.

HEAD COACH MARK MARTINEZ

> Mark Martinez begins his sixth season as head coach of the Aztecs and 15th overall as a member of the San Diego State staff after succeeding the late Tony Gwynn on August 20, 2014. He is just the fifth head coach in SDSU history since baseball was elevated to major sport status in 1936.
 > During his tenure as the Aztecs' head coach, Martinez has compiled a 181-130 record (.582), highlighted by three Mountain West tournament championships in 2015, 2017 and 2018. He has also posted an 84-64 ledger (.568) in conference regular-season games.
 > Since 2015, SDSU has garnered 27 all-Mountain West accolades under Martinez's tutelage, including back-to-back MW Pitchers of the Year Brett Seeburger (2017) and Garrett Hill (2018), as well as 2017 MW Player of the Year Danny Sheehan.
 > Additionally, Martinez has mentored three freshman All-Americans in Chase Calabuig (2015), Casey Schmitt (2018) and Jaden Fein (2019), with the latter also receiving Mountain West Co-Freshman of the Year distinction last year.
 > In 2017, Martinez recorded his 100th victory for the Scarlet and Black, becoming the fastest head coach in program history to reach the century mark in wins.
 > Not to be outdone, Martinez also became the fastest head coach in Mountain West history to win three conference championships when the Aztecs captured the title in 2018.
 > Martinez was hired as an assistant coach for the Aztecs in July of 2005 and served for nine years under head coach Tony Gwynn. During that time, he was promoted to the position of associate head coach.
 > Since his arrival on The Mesa as an assistant coach, Martinez has witnessed 42 SDSU players get drafted into the professional ranks, with eight of those selections making the major leagues (Stephen Strasburg, Addison Reed, Justin Masterson, Bruce Billings, Quintin Berry, Lance Zawadzki, Greg Allen and Ty France).
 > Prior to his arrival at San Diego State, Martinez was an assistant coach at New Mexico for 17 seasons from 1989-2005. During his time as a hitting and infield coach, he helped develop the Lobos into one of the most prominent offensive teams in the country, with UNM ranking among the top 11 nationally in hitting over his final four seasons.
 > Martinez served as an assistant at his alma mater, Mesa State College (now Colorado Mesa University) in Grand Junction, Colorado, from 1984-88. He played shortstop at the school from 1982-84, earning all-conference and all-district honors as a senior.
 > Martinez graduated from Mesa State with a bachelor's degree in physical education in 1984 and completed his master's in sports administration at New Mexico in 1990.

SERIES RECORDS

> Oregon State leads the all-time series vs. San Diego State 13-8-1 after the teams split two games in Corvallis last season.
 > The Aztecs earned a 4-3 decision in the opener before dropping an 8-1 decision in game two at Goss Stadium.
 > The Beavers entered that two-game set as the sixth-ranked team in the country after winning the NCAA title in 2018.
 > In its aforementioned victory, SDSU scored two runs with two outs in the top of the fifth, taking the lead for good following an RBI single by Casey Schmitt, who later scored on a fly ball by former Aztec Joe Fitzhugh, which was dropped in the right-centerfield gap.
 > Another former SDSU player Adrian Mardueno picked up the win after pitching seven innings of relief, allowing no runs on two hits and one walk with six strikeouts.
 > The Aztecs will be seeking to end a four-game losing streak to OSU in San Diego. SDSU's last victory over the Beavers in Tony Gwynn Stadium occurred on Feb. 24, 2012, when the Scarlet and Black romped to an 18-2 victory.

WEEKEND ROTATION

> San Diego State's pitching rotation for the Oregon State series will feature four sophomores, including Brian Leonhardt, who is slated to star the opener on Thursday.
 > Leonhardt has made two relief appearances in 2020, pitching one inning each vs. Cal State Fullerton and USC. The Aztec left-hander has given up two runs (one earned) on two hits this year with one strikeout.
 > Last season, Leonhardt pitched in nine games with two starts, including SDSU's victory at Oregon State, where he tossed two innings but did not earn a decision. He finished the year with a 6.62 ERA and 17 strikeouts in 17 2/3 innings overall.
 > Michael Paredes (0-0, 3.86 ERA) will receive his third consecutive Friday night start after striking out seven batters vs. Iowa on Feb. 21. He pitched six innings in that contest, giving up one run on three hits and one walk but did not get the decision.
 > Troy Melton is expected to get the call on Saturday, with Aaron Eden set to wrap up the weekend with a start in Sunday's contest.
 > Melton (2-0, 1.64 ERA) has impressed in his first two starts in 2020, including a career-high seven strikeouts vs. Nebraska on Feb. 22, when he allowed two runs on four hits and two walks in six innings.
 > Eden (0-1, 4.50 ERA), meanwhile, yielded five unearned runs in his last start against USC on Feb. 23, where he lasted 4 2/3 innings.

SCOUTING REPORT: OREGON STATE

> The Beavers are off to a 3-4 start this season after losing two of three games at No. 9 Mississippi State last weekend. OSU dropped a 6-2 decision in the opener and fell short by a 7-4 count in game two before posting a 7-2 victory in the finale.
 > The Beavers began the 2020 campaign with a 2-2 mark at the Sanderson Ford College Baseball Classic in Surprise, Arizona, splitting two games with Gonzaga (L, 10-4; W, 5-1), sandwiched between a victory over New Mexico (11-4) and a loss to Brigham Young (4-3).
 > Oregon State compiled a 36-20-1 record in 2019 and hosted an NCAA regional for the third year in a row but was unable to advance after falling to Cincinnati (7-6) and Creighton (4-1).
 > The Beavers return six starters and seven pitchers from last year's squad, including left-handed hurler Jake Mulholland, who garnered All-America accolades in each of the past three seasons. Last season, the Snohomish, Wash., native went 3-3 with a 1.93 ERA and 41 strikeouts in 46 2/3 innings while collecting eight saves.
 > In addition to Mulholland, who received all-Pac-12 recognition as well last year, OSU welcomes back another first-team all-conference selection in outfielder Alex McGarry (.293, 8 HR, 5 2B, 29 RBI) while right-handed pitcher Mitchell Verburg (1-0, 1.40 ERA, 24 K, 14.0 IP, 2 SV) earned honorable mention.
 > Entering the weekend, the Beavers have six players hitting over .300, including Andy Armstrong (.385), Jake Dukart (.375), Kyle McMahan (.355), Alex McGarry (.333), Ryan Ober (.321) and Troy Claunch (.308).
 > McMahan leads the Pac-12 with five doubles, which is tied for seventh nationally, while Claunch is second in the conference with 11 RBIs.
 > Collectively, OSU leads the nation with a .996 fielding percentage, committing just one error on the year.
 > The Beavers are scheduled to pitch right-hander Jake Pfennigs (1-1, 6.75 ERA, 7 K, 6.2 IP) in Thursday's opener vs. the Aztecs. In his last outing at Mississippi State on Feb. 22, Pfennigs absorbed the loss after giving up four runs on two hits and five walks in 1 2/3 innings.
 > OSU is also expected to start left-hander Christian Chamberlain (1-0, 0.00 ERA, 17 K, 11.1 IP) on Friday, while right-hander Nathan Burns (0-0, 3.64 ERA, 14 K, 11.2 IP) is slated to get the nod on Saturday. The Beavers' starter for Sunday was unavailable at press time.
 > Chamberlain did not get the decision in his last appearance at Mississippi State on Feb. 21, allowing no runs on two hits and two walks while striking out 12 batters in 5 1/3 innings.
 > Likewise, Burns pitched 5 1/3 innings at MSU on Sunday, yielding two runs on three hits and one walk to go with six strikeouts.

> OSU has captured three NCAA championships in 2006, 2007 and 2018 and has advanced to the College World Series on seven occasions to go with 19 regional appearances.

> The Beavers are guided by first-year head coach Mitch Canham, who spent the previous three-and-a-half seasons as a manager in the Seattle Mariners organization. Canham played collegiately at OSU from 2004-07, contributing to a pair of national championships in his final two seasons. He was drafted in the first round of the 2007 MLB Draft by the San Diego Padres and spent time in five different organizations, including San Diego (2007-10), Oakland (2011), St. Louis (2012), Kansas City (2013) and Washington (2014).

AZTECS AMONG THE MW LEADERS

> Entering the weekend, San Diego State leads the Mountain West with a collective .281 batting average, 76 hits and a 2.28 earned run average, which ranks 32nd in the nation.

> The Aztecs also occupy the second spot in the conference in several categories, including total bases (100), home runs (5), slugging percentage (.370), on-base percentage (.355), strikeout-to-walk ratio (2.39) and strikeouts per nine innings (9.4), opponent batting average (.228) and earned runs allowed (18).

> Individually, Ryan Orr leads the conference with 13 hits and ranks second with a .406 batting average, while Matt Rudick and Mike Jarvis share the top spot with eight runs scored, with Jarvis tied for the lead with three stolen bases as well. In addition, Rudick finds himself in a tie for sixth in the league with a .353 batting average.

> Not to be outdone Jacob Flores maintains a lofty perch atop the Mountain West with 18 strikeouts and ranks fourth with a 0.79 earned run average, while Troy Melton (1.64) follows in fifth.

REWIND: AZTECS TRIUMPHANT AT UC IRVINE

> The Aztecs made the short trip up the freeway on Tuesday, posting a 2-1 victory over UC Irvine in a non-conference game at Anteater Ballpark.

> With the result, SDSU won its ninth in the last 12 games vs. Big West opponents and improved to 29-10 in the last 39 outings against that conference.

> Despite three wild pitches and two hit batters, four Aztec pitchers held the Anteaters in check, combining for 11 strikeouts while scattering six hits on the evening.

> Avery Jones (1-0), a transfer from Central Arizona College, picked up the victory in his first SDSU start, allowing two hits and two walks in 3 1/3 innings before yielding to Jacob Flores, who recorded five strikeouts in his two-inning stint. Tre Brown quickly fanned three batters after entering in the seventh and added another punchout in the eighth before giving way to Casey Schmitt.

> Jaden Fein went 3-for-4 to lead the Aztec offense, while Matt Rudick and Anthony Walters finished with two hits apiece.

> SDSU scored in the first inning for the fourth time this year, grabbing a 1-0 lead when Rudick raced home on Brian Leonhardt's grounder to third. Previously, Rudick singled and moved to third on Schmitt's double.

> The Aztecs extended their advantage to 2-0 in the fourth on Fein's RBI single with two outs. Earlier, Leonhardt drew a leadoff walk, while Ryan Orr reached on an infield single. After a strikeout and a popout, Fein came through in the clutch, lacing an 0-1 pitch to right that brought home Leonhardt.

> UCI threatened its half of the fourth, loading the bases on an infield hit and two walks. However, the Scarlet and Black got out of the jam when Flores, who gave up the second base on balls after committing a balk, got a swinging strikeout by Taishi Nakawake on a 3-2 pitch.

> Despite putting a runner aboard in each of the next four innings, the Anteaters came up empty before finally breaking through with a run in the ninth off Schmitt, who came in to close.

> With two outs, Mike Peabody reached on a fielder's choice, plating Jacob Castro, who led off with a double and ultimately advanced to third after John Jensen struck out and Jake Palmer singled through the left side.

> However, Schmitt persevered, inducing a game-ending groundout to Adrian Damla to collect his fourth save of the year.

SCHMITT CLIMBING THE CHARTS

> After recording his fourth save of the season at UC Irvine on Tuesday, Casey Schmitt took over sole possession of fourth place on the Aztecs' all-time list with 21 saves for his career, surpassing Michael Cederoth, who recorded 20 from 2011-14.

> As a result, Schmitt is just five saves behind the Aztecs' career leader Royce Ring, who compiled 26 from 2000-02, while Addison Reed (2008-09) and CJ Saylor (2014-17) are tied for second with 24 apiece.

AZTECS SWEEP MOUNTAIN WEST WEEKLY AWARDS

> San Diego State's Ryan Orr was named Mountain West Player of the Week, while Casey Schmitt earned league Pitcher of the Week honors after the duo propelled the Aztecs to a 3-1 record in four home games played from Feb. 17-23.

> SDSU opened its homestand with an 8-4 triumph over Cal State Fullerton before taking two of three games at the Tony Gwynn Legacy tournament, featuring a 4-1 victory over Iowa and a 4-2 conquest of Nebraska followed by an 11-5 setback to USC.

> With his accolade, Schmitt merited MW weekly distinction for the third time in his career and second as a pitcher, while Orr collected his first conference certificate as a collegian.

> In four games, Orr led the Aztecs in several categories, including batting average (.438), hits (7), RBIs (5) and doubles (2). The SDSU senior also topped the squad with a .700 success rate percentage of advancing runners for the week (7-10) and ranked second on team with a .563 slugging percentage.

> Orr began the week with a 3-for-4 effort vs. Cal State Fullerton, scoring two runs to go with a pair of RBIs. The Aztec outfielder contributed a key two-run double in the decisive fifth inning vs. the Titans, as SDSU broke a 4-4 tie. He also smacked a double in SDSU's win over Iowa on Friday, advancing a runner to third who eventually scored.

> In addition, Orr drove in a run and scored after reaching on a fielder's choice vs. Nebraska, as the Scarlet and Black plated all four markers in a pivotal sixth-inning rally. The La Costa Canyon High alumnus finished the week with a 3-for-5 performance vs. USC, adding two RBIs and a run scored. He also made three put-outs in left field.

> Schmitt, meanwhile, posted saves in consecutive games vs. Power 5 schools Iowa and Nebraska at the Tony Gwynn Legacy. The Aztec junior also pitched the final inning vs. CSF, including a strikeout.

> Collectively, Schmitt did not issue a walk in three scoreless appearances, limiting the opposition to a .167 batting average in 3 2/3 innings, including an 0-5 clip with runners on base. Additionally, the SDSU closer went 3-for-3 at the plate with a run scored vs. Nebraska before taking the mound in the ninth, where he struck out one.

TWO FOR TUESDAY

- > With San Diego State's 2-1 triumph at UC Irvine, Aztecs snapped a 13-game losing streak when scoring two runs or fewer.
- > In addition, SDSU played its first one-run game of the year, improving to 30-15 in its last 45 games with a winning tally of one marker.

STRIKEOUTS GALORE

- > San Diego State recorded 27 games with 10 or more strikeouts during the 2019 campaign, marking the most double-digit strikeout performances for the Aztecs in the MW era (since 2000). SDSU surpassed the previous MW record of 23 set in a 10-6 win at Fresno State on May 11, 2009.
- > The SDSU pitching staff has already notched five games with 10 strikeouts this year vs. Virginia Tech, Cal State Fullerton, Iowa, Nebraska and at UC Irvine. Not surprisingly, the Scarlet and Black is 5-0 in those contests.
- > In addition, The Aztecs are 21-11 in their last 32 games when striking out 10 or more batters.

SETTING THE SCENE FOR 2020

- > San Diego State returns 19 letterwinners from last year's squad that finished with a 32-25 overall record and a 16-13 mark in the Mountain West. The Aztecs welcome back five starting position players and two starting pitchers.
- > SDSU has captured five of the last seven MW tournament championships and is the only team in the league to have won 30 or more games six times in the last seven years.
- > The Aztecs were pegged for a first-place finish in the 2020 MW preseason coaches poll, attaining the status of conference favorites for the second year in a row.
- > Leading the list of returners is junior Casey Schmitt, a consensus preseason All-American who additionally earned a spot on USA Baseball's Golden Spikes Award Watch List. Last year, the Aztec third baseman/relief pitcher was a second-team all-MW honoree after receiving freshman All-America recognition in 2018 from Collegiate Baseball magazine.
- > Also back in the mix are 2019 all-Mountain West selections Matt Rudick (first team) and Mike Jarvis (second-team), as well as Jaden Fein, who was named the league's Co-Freshman of the Year last season to go with freshman All-America distinction.
- > The Aztecs were ranked 31st in Collegiate Baseball's Fabulous 40 Preseason Poll and have received votes in the NCBWA Top 25 Preseason Poll.

SCHMITT NAMED TO GOLDEN SPIKES AWARD WATCH LIST

- > Junior Casey Schmitt added to his already lengthy list of preseason accolades on Feb. 13 when he earned a spot on the USA Baseball's Golden Spikes Award Watch List, beginning the process of identifying the nation's top amateur player for the 2020 season.
- > With his nomination, Schmitt becomes the fourth Aztec player since 2008 to land on the preseason Golden Spikes Award Watch List, joining Michael Cederoth (2014), Addison Reed (2010) and Stephen Strasburg, who took home the top prize in 2009. In addition, Tyler Adkison landed on the GSA mid-season watch list in 2017.
- > In addition, Schmitt enters the 2020 campaign with four preseason All-America honors, including three second-team plaudits from Collegiate Baseball, D1Baseball.com and Perfect Game and a third-team honor from Baseball America.
- > As SDSU's starting third baseman in 2019, Schmitt finished second on the team with a .315 batting average, adding eight doubles, five home runs and 36 RBI to merit second-team all-Mountain West distinction. He also appeared in 21 games with four starts as a pitcher, posting a 3-3 record and a 3.77 ERA in 43.0 innings to go with a team-high eight saves.
- > In 2018, Schmitt was a consensus freshman All-American, setting an Aztec single-season record with a 0.28 ERA (min. 30 IP) while allowing just one earned run in 32 innings pitched. He also posted a .264 batting average with one home run and 32 RBI, finishing the year as one of only two players nationally to maintain a 2.00 ERA or lower (min. 15 IP) and drive in more than 30 runs.

SCHMITT, RUDICK LAND ON PRESEASON ALL-MOUNTAIN WEST TEAM

- > Aztec juniors Casey Schmitt and Matt Rudick each earned on spot on the preseason all-Mountain West team announced on Feb. 11.
- > Rudick garnered first-team all-conference accolades in 2019 after leading SDSU in several categories, including batting average (.320), total bases (95), hits (77) and runs scored (48), serving as the team's leadoff hitter throughout the year.
- > Additionally, the Aztec outfielder topped the squad with 18 multi-hit games and reeled off a team-high 21-game hitting streak. The Scripps Ranch High alum was also the toughest player in the Mountain West to strike out last season, fanning just once per 12.1 at-bats which was good for 25th nationally.

VETERAN HONOREES

- > Not to be outdone, San Diego State also returns outfielders Mike Jarvis (.289, 5 HR, 8 2B, 30 RBI), who was a second-team all-MW selection as a junior last season, and Jaden Fein (.293, 4 HR, 11 2B, 20 RBI), who collected league Co-Freshman of the Year distinction to go with Freshman All-America honors from Collegiate Baseball magazine.
- > In addition, Brian Leonhardt (.272, 1 HR, 14 2B, 34 RBI) is back in the mix after leading the Aztecs with a team-high .389 batting average with runners in scoring position and topping the squad with 16 two-out RBIs. He also occupied the fourth spot with multiple RBIs in seven games and ranked fifth with 16 multi-hit performances.

NEWCOMERS AMONG STARTERS

- > A pair of junior college transfers and one true freshman have already cracked the starting lineup through the first four games of the year for SDSU.
- > Wyatt Hendrie has assumed the duties at catcher after earning all-state honors by the California Community College Baseball Coaches Association (CCCBA) at Antelope Valley College in 2019. In his lone season with the Marauders, he led the team in several categories, including batting average (.410), hits (59) runs (32), RBIs (26), doubles (10) and triples (10).
- > Hendrie was a 10th-round selection by the Chicago Cubs in the 2019 MLB First-Year Player Draft.
- > At shortstop, Anthony Walters has stepped in after arriving from Mt. San Antonio College, where he earned first-team all-state honors from the CCCBA on the strength of a .374 batting average in 45 games with 10 home runs and 62 RBIs.
- > Caden Miller has received the starting nod at second base through four games after graduating from Bishop Alemany High School in Mission Hills, California near Los Angeles. He was a two-time all-conference selection who finished with career-highs in batting average (.329), runs scored (29), stolen bases (21) and doubles (9) during his senior season.
- > Miller was listed as the Mountain West preseason freshman of the year in several publications, including D1Baseball.com.
- > Overall, the Aztecs' recruiting class for 2019 was ranked 20th nationally by Perfect Game.

AZTECS TABBED PRESEASON MOUNTAIN WEST FAVORITES

- > For the second straight season, San Diego State baseball team was picked first in the Mountain West preseason coaches poll, as announced Feb. 11 by the conference office.
- > Collectively, SDSU received 46 points and four first-place votes, edging second-place Fresno State (42 pts, 2 first-place votes), while Nevada (38 pts, 2 first-place votes) was predicted to finish third, followed by fourth-place UNLV (34 pts). Rounding out the remainder of the poll were New Mexico (5th, 23 pts), Air Force (T-6th, 17 pts), San José State (T-6th) and Boise State (8th, 7 pts).
- > The Aztecs were also predicted to finish first prior to the 2014 campaign.

- > Casey Schmitt gained valuable experience in the summer of 2019 when he played for th Cotuit Kettleers in the Cape Cod League.
- > Schmitt collected MVP honors for the championship finals after belting two homers and scoring three runs in Cotuit's 10-3 title-clinching victory over Harwich. He also pitched six scoreless innings in two relief appearances during the finals, striking out eight batters against two walks.

OTHER TRENDS

- > San Diego State went 17-5 during the 2019 season and has won 12 of its last 15 when hitting a home run.
- > In addition, the scoring the game's first run proved to be important for the Aztecs last year, with the team posting a 19-6 record when scoring first in comparison to a 13-17 mark when their opponent scores first. SDSU is 4-1 this season when scoring the first run.
- > SDSU is 64-11 in its last 75 games when scoring five or more runs, including a 2-1 mark in 2020.
- > San Diego State is 47-17 last 63 games following a loss.
- > With their 7-5 victory vs. Virginia Tech, the Aztecs snapped a 17-game losing streak when trailing after six innings.

MOUNTAIN WEST CHAMPIONSHIP RETURNS TO TONY GWYNN STADIUM

- > For the fifth time since the league's inception, San Diego State will play host to the Mountain West Championship, May 21-24, at Tony Gwynn Stadium.
- > The Aztecs also welcomed the conference tournament in 2001, 2010, 2011, as well as 2018, when they claimed their fifth MW Championship crown in a span of six years.
- > SDSU has captured the most tournament titles in conference history, winning in 2000, 2013, 2014, 2015, 2017 and 2018.

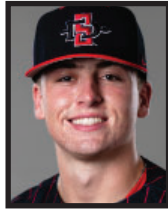

TONY GWYNN STADIUM



Tony Gwynn Stadium became the new home of the San Diego State baseball program during the 1997 season. Upon its opening, the facility was hailed as one of the top college baseball stadiums in the country. A poll of college coaches by Baseball America ranked it among the top 20 collegiate facilities in the nation and the fourth-best park in the western U.S.

Groundbreaking for this project took place on Aug. 21, 1996. The \$4 million facility was made possible through the generosity of San Diego Padres owner John Moores, who donated the funds to make the program's dream of a state-of-the-art stadium at San Diego State University a reality.

The structure is named in honor of the former Aztec player, head

coach, and MLB Hall of Famer. The playing field remains Charlie Smith Field in honor of the long-time former San Diego State head coach. It retains its former dimensions of 340 feet down both the right and left field lines and 410 to dead center field. Distance to the alleys is 360 feet in left center and 370 in right center.

Additional area has been added between home plate and the backstop (now 45 feet), and the warning track in the outfield has been widened to 20 feet. The field itself is a natural turf (Tif Santa Ana grass), while the infield and warning track utilize crushed brick dust.

The most recent field improvement consists of artificial field turf that extends from the end of each dugout in foul territory outside the base lines. The turf was installed prior to the start of the 2010 season. In addition, a large Aztec logo now occupies the area directly behind home plate.

The outfield is enclosed by a 10-foot high green wall made of a material designed to be resilient upon contact. The outfield wall features advertising signage as well as the names and numbers of past

players who have been honored for their accomplishments as members of the SDSU program.

Stadium lighting consists of six poles using 2000-watt fixtures, making the facility one of the most well-lit fields in college and professional baseball.

The stadium's electronic scoreboard, installed prior to the start of the 2003 season, is located behind the right centerfield fence and features a complete line score as well as video playback capability.

Seating capacity of the stadium is 3,000, and that number could reach as high as 4,000 in the future. Of the 2,200 permanent seats installed during the initial phase of construction, 800 were armchair-style around the stadium at the field level. With the addition of new seating in May 2005, that number has increased to over 1,800, as more than 1,000 chair back seats were installed in the plaza level from first to third base. The remaining seats are comprised of bleacher benches that extend down both base lines.

The latest stadium improvements came just prior to the start of the 2010 season when Field Turf was

installed in the foul territory areas in front of both dugouts and behind home plate. In addition, new sod was placed in the infield. These upgrades were made possible by a donation to the baseball program by former Aztec pitcher Stephen Strasburg.

Among the amenities contained within the stadium itself are the following:

- Two concession stands and two sets of restrooms located behind the seating area on the plaza level.
- A coaches dressing room and adjacent players' meeting room located at the east end of the first base stands to be used for team functions as well as a lounge for SDSU athletes.
- The Stephen and Mary Birch Baseball Museum located at the north end of the third base stand. The museum features numerous items relating to the history of baseball at San Diego State.
