WHAT'S ON TAP FOR AZTEC BASEBALL

- > Winners of three straight, San Diego State hits the road this weekend for a three-game series at No. 11/15 Oklahoma, March 6-8, at L. Dale Mitchell Park in Norman, Oklahoma.
- > Friday's opener is scheduled to begin at 6:30 p.m. CT (4:30 p.m. PT), while the final two games are slated for afternoon starts. Saturday's clash is set to get underway at 2 p.m. CT (Noon PT), while Sunday's contest is pegged for a 1 p.m. CT (11 a.m. PT) first pitch. > In addition to live stats, all three games will be streamed live through Sooner Sports TV on a pay-per-view basis, with links available on GoAztecs.com.
- > After forging a split in its four-game home series against perennial national contender Oregon State, Feb. 27-March 1, SDSU kept the momentum rolling with a 7-2 triumph over No. 17/17 Long Beach State on Tuesday night at Tony Gwynn Stadium.
- > With the victory, the Aztecs raised their record to 9-4, marking the third time in head coach Mark Martinez's tenure that the Scarlet and Black has opened with at least nine wins in its first 13 games along with the 2015 (12-1) and 2018 squads (9-4).

STREAKING

- > Brian Leonhardt has reached base in all 12 games he has appeared as a field player/designated hitter this season and has hit safely in the last four outings, matching Jaden Fein for the longest current hitting streak on the team.
- > Similarly, Fein has reached base in seven consecutive games, while Wyatt Hendrie has accomplished the feat in five straight.
- > In addition, Matt Rudick and Jacob Cruce have knocked in at least one run in each of the last three games.
- > Rudick leads the team with two or more hits in six games this year and shares the top spot on the squad with multiple RBIs on two occasions, joining Leonhardt, Hendrie, Ryan Orr and Anthony Walters.

HEAD COACH MARK MARTINEZ

- > Mark Martinez begins his sixth season as head coach of the Aztecs and 15th overall as a member of the San Diego State staff after succeeding the late Tony Gwynn on August 20, 2014. He is just the fifth head coach in SDSU history since baseball was elevated to major sport status in 1936. > During his tenure as the Aztecs' head coach, Martinez has compiled a 184-132 record (.582), highlighted by three Mountain West tournament
- championships in 2015, 2017 and 2018. He has also posted an 84-64 ledger (.568) in conference regular-season games.
- > Since 2015, SDSU has garnered 27 all-Mountain West accolades under Martinez's tutelage, including back-to-back MW Pitchers of the Year Brett Seeburger (2017) and Garrett Hill (2018), as well as 2017 MW Player of the Year Danny Sheehan.
- > Additionally, Martinez has mentored three freshman All-Americans in Chase Calabuig (2015), Casey Schmitt (2018) and Jaden Fein (2019), with the latter also receiving Mountain West Co-Freshman of the Year distinction last year.
- > In 2017, Martinez recorded his 100th victory for the Scarlet and Black, becoming the fastest head coach in program history to reach the century mark in wins.
- > Not to be outdone, Martinez also became the fastest head coach in Mountain West history to win three conference championships when the Aztecs captured the title in 2018.
- > Martinez was hired as an assistant coach for the Aztecs in July of 2005 and served for nine years under head coach Tony Gwynn. During that time, he was promoted to the position of associate head coach.
- > Since his arrival on The Mesa as an assistant coach, Martinez has witnessed 42 SDSU players get drafted into the professional ranks, with nine of those selections making the major leagues (Stephen Strasburg, Addison Reed, Justin Masterson, Bruce Billings, Quintin Berry, Lance Zawadzki, Greg Allen, Ty France and Seby Zavala).
- > Prior to his arrival at San Diego State, Martinez was an assistant coach at New Mexico for 17 seasons from 1989-2005. During his time as a hitting and infield coach, he helped develop the Lobos into one of the most prominent offensive teams in the country, with UNM ranking among the top 11 nationally in hitting over his final four seasons.
- > Martinez served as an assistant at his alma mater, Mesa State College (now Colorado Mesa University) in Grand Junction, Colorado, from 1984-88. He played shortstop at the school from 1982-84, earning all-conference and all-district honors as a senior.
- > Martinez graduated from Mesa State with a bachelor's degree in physical education in 1984 and completed his master's in sports administration at New Mexico in 1990.

Record (9-4, 0-0 MW)

SERIES RECORD

- > Oklahoma leads the all-time series 8-1 after claiming a narrow 1-0 decision last year in San Diego at the Tony Gwynn Legacy.
- > In that contest, both pitching staffs gave up five hits each and recorded 12 strikeouts apiece.
- > SDSU threatened in the bottom of the eighth with one out and two runners aboard; however, the Sooners avoided trouble after former Aztec Angelo Armenta was doubled off second base on a flyout to right.
- > San Diego State's lone victory against Oklahoma occurred in the first meeting between the squads on Feb. 16, 2001, when the Scarlet and Black rallied with two runs in the bottom of the ninth to escape with a 9-8 thriller at the San Diego Classic.
- > This weekend's set will mark the Aztecs' first-ever trip to Norman and L. Dale Mitchell Park.
- > SDSU is 1-5 all-time in the Sooner State after dropping two games at Oklahoma State in 2006. The Aztecs also salvaged the finale of a three-game set at Oral Roberts in 1989. Additionally, San Diego State fell to ORU 3-1 in Tulsa at the NCAA regionals in 1981.
- > The Aztecs-Sooners clash will mark just the second series between the two squads after Oklahoma swept a four-game set at Tony Gwynn Stadium to open the 2010 campaign.

AZTEC WEEKEND ROTATION

- > San Diego State's projected pitching rotation for the Oklahoma series will feature two sophomores for the first two games, while the starter for Sunday's contest has yet to be determined at press time
- > Michael Paredes (0-1, 4.20 ERA, 15.0 IP) will receive his fourth consecutive Friday start after pitching 5 2/3 innings vs. Oregon State on Feb. 28, when he allowed three earned runs on eight hits and two walks in a 4-1 defeat.
- > The previous week, Paredes struck out a season-high seven batters and yielded just one run on three hits in the Aztecs' 4-1 victory over lowa at the Tony Gwynn Legacy on Feb. 21, but did not earn the decision
- > Meanwhile, Troy Melton (3-0, 1.06 ERA) is expected to get the call on Saturday after three superb performances in three starts vs. Coastal Carolina, Nebraska and Oregon State.
- > Against the Beavers on Feb. 29, Melton and two relievers combined on a 6-0 shutout, posting a career-high nine strikeouts while scattering four hits and one walk in six innings.
- > For his efforts, Melton collected Mountain West Pitcher of the Week honors on March 3.
- > Melton also impressed against Nebraska at the Tony Gwynn Legacy on Feb. 22, when he allowed two runs on four hits and two walks in six innings.

SCOUTING REPORT: OKLAHOMA

- > The Sooners (11-3) have won three straight games after a 13-2 shellacking of Arkansas-Pine Bluff at home on Wednesday.
- > Against the Golden Lions, five Oklahoma pitchers combined to set a Big 12 Conference record with 21 strikeouts, including nine by starter Jake Bennett.
- > The Sooner's sent 11 batters to the plate in the third inning, scoring five runs to give themselves an insurmountable 9-0 lead.
- > With the victory, Oklahoma improves to 7-3 at home this season.
- > The Sooners are currently ranked 11th by Baseball America and 15th by D1Baseball.com.
- > Oklahoma returns 19 letterwinners from last year's squad that finished with a 33-23 record.
- > Entering the weekend, outfielder Tanner Tredaway and catcher/designated hitter Justin Mitchell share the team lead with a .414 batting average, while infielder Peyton Graham is hitting .333 on the year.
- > Tredaway is perched atop the Big 12 individually with 24 hits and is tied for third in the conference with six doubles along with Graham.
- > Additionally, Tredaway is the national leader with four triples and tops the squad with 12 RBIs, followed by infielder Tyler Hardman (.286) and catcher/first baseman Brady Lindsly (.279) with 10 miere.
- > As a team, Oklahoma leads the Big 12 with a 4.46 strikeout-to-walk ratio and an average of 12.6 strikeouts per nine innings, which ranks third nationally.
- > The Sooners also top the league with a .988 fielding percentage, which is good for sixth in the country, while their average of 2.83 walks per nine innings, which ranks first in the conference and 22nd in the nation.
- > For the season, Oklahoma sports a 2.54 earned run average as a team, which ranks second in the Big 12 and 24th nationally, while its .284 batting average is fourth in the conference.
- > The Sooners are scheduled to pitch right-hander Cade Cavalli (1-1, 3.24 ERA, 28 K, 16.2 IP) on Friday, while left-hander Levi Prater (0-0, 4.32 ERA, 20 K, 16.2 IP) is slated to get the nod on Saturday, followed by righty Dane Acker (1-1, 2.57 ERA, 25 K, 21.0 IP) on Sunday.
- > Cavalli, who landed on the Golden Spikes Award Watch List, did not earn a decision in his last outing on Feb. 28 vs. then-No. 6 Arkansas when he struck 11 batters while allowing three runs and six hits in five innings as the Sooners rallied for a 6-3 win in the first game of the Shriners Hospitals for Children College Classic in Houston, Texas. For the season, he has 28 strikeouts, which leads the Bia 12.
- > Likewise, Prater completed his last appearance with a no-decision in Oklahoma's 8-7 setback to Missouri in the second game of the tournament on Feb. 29. He yielded four runs on four hits and

- > On the flip side, Dane Acker was named NCBWA National Pitcher of the Week after tossing a no-hitter over then-No. 14 LSU on March 1, allowing just four baserunners while recording 11 strikeouts. It was the Sooners' first no-hitter since Jim Huslig accomplished the feat against Old Dominion in 1989.
- > Oklahoma has advanced to the College World Series on 10 occasions, winning national championships in 1951 and 1994.
- > Head coach Skip Johnson is in his third season at the helm of the Sooner program after spending 10 years as an assistant and associate head coach at the University of Texas. In his second season in 2018, Johnson led Oklahoma to the finals of the Tallahassee Regional. His record at the school stands at 79-50.

AZTECS AMONG THE MW LEADERS

- > Entering the weekend, the San Diego State pitching staff leads the Mountain West with a collective 3.18 earned run average, while the offense tops the conference with 118 hits.
- > The Aztecs also rank second in the league in batting average (.274), slugging percentage (.385) and home runs (9).
- > Additionally, the Scarlet and Black occupies the third spot in several categories, including runs (64), on-base percentage (.350), stolen bases (10), strikeout-to-walk ratio (2.25), strikeouts per nine innings (9.6) and hits allowed per nine innings (8.61).
- > Individually, Casey Schmitt is tied with six other players for the national lead with a league-best five saves, while Matt Rudick tops the conference with three triples, which is tied for second in the country.
- > Rudick, who is tied with Ryan Orr for third in the MW with 17 hits apiece, finds himself among the league leaders in several statistical categories, including runs scored (4th, 11), total bases (4th, 28), RBIs (T-5th, 9) and slugging percentage (10th, .519).
- > Elsewhere, Mike Jarvis is tied with Brian Leonhardt for fourth in the conference with two home runs each. Jarvis, who has been hit by a pitch four times this year, also shares the fifth spot with 10 runs scored, while Leonhardt (9) is tied for eighth in that category.
- > In addition, Wyatt Hendrie is tied for third with eight walks, while Orr (.347) and Jacob Cruce (.345) rank seventh and eighth in batting average, respectively.
- > Not to be outdone, pitcher Troy Melton is tied for third in the national with a conference-high three victories and ranks second with a 1.06 earned run average and fourth with 21 strikeouts and a .172 opponent batting average.
- > Meanwhile, Jacob Flores ranks second with 23 strikeouts and is tied for the second position with two wins.

REWIND: AZTECS ROLL PAST NO. 17/17 LONG BEACH STATE

- > San Diego State won its third straight with a 7-2 triumph over No. 17/17 Long Beach State in a non-conference game on March 3 at Tony Gwynn Stadium.
- > With the result, the Aztecs defeated the Dirtbags for the third consecutive meeting and captured their 10th victory in the last 13 games vs. Big West opponents, improving to 30-10 in the last 39 outings against that conference.
- > Mike Jarvis (two RBI), Casey Schmitt (two runs), Anthony Walters and Brian Leonhardt finished with two hits apiece for the Scarlet and Black, which also utilized four pitchers on the night, giving up just two unearned runs to raise their record to 9-4 overall.
- > Freshman right-hander Ricky Tibbett (1-0) pitched three innings of relief to earn his first collegiate victory despite allowing the two aforementioned runs in the seventh after taking over for Leonhardt, who tossed four scoreless innings in his second straight start on the mound, vielding just two hits and two walks.
- > In addition, Tre Brown struck out the side in the eighth before Avery Jones came in to work the ninth.
- > SDSU plated two unearned runs in the first when Jarvis scored on Matt Rudick's sacrifice fly, while Schmitt raced home on Walters' RBI single. Previously, Jarvis was hit by a pitch, stole second and advanced to third on a throwing error by the catcher. Shortly thereafter, Schmitt reached on a throwing error and stole second as well following a strikeout.
- > The Aztecs executed a classic hit-and-run in the second after Jaden Fein drew a one-out walk and motored around to third on Leonhardt's single through the right side. Moments later, Jarvis knocked in Jaden Fein with a sacrifice fly to left, increasing the host school's advantage to 3-0.
- > Later in the fourth, Jarvis and Schmitt contributed RBI singles to give SDSU some additional breathing room, while Fein led off the sixth with his first home run of the season, a solo shot to left field, which upped the lead to 6-0.
- > LBSU finally broke through with two unearned runs on two hits in the seventh, all with two outs. Leonard Jones reached on a fielding error and advanced on Connor Kokx's ensuing single, ultimately taking home when the throw from the outfield went awry during his head-first slide into third. Kokx, who moved to second on the play, promptly scored on Aidan Malm's single to right.
- > However, the Aztecs closed out the scoring with a run in their half of the frame when Schmitt led off with a double and later touched home on Jacob Cruce's hot smash past the first baseman that also went for extra bases.
- > The Dirtbags squandered some early scoring opportunities, stranding seven runners in the first three innings and 10 for the game.
- > LBSU loaded the bases in the first on a single, a hit batter and a walk, but Leonhardt fought himself off the ropes with a swinging strikeout of Santino Rivera to end the inning.
- > Leonhardt also faced peril in the third after hitting two batters, while another got aboard on a fielding error. However, the SDSU lefty induced a flyout to get out of the jam.

MELTON TABBED MOUNTAIN WEST PITCHER OF THE WEEK

- > San Diego State right-hander Troy Melton (Anaheim, Calif./Canyon HS) was named Mountain West Pitcher of the Week after his superb performance vs. Oregon State on Feb. 29, as announced Tuesday by the league office.
- > With his award, Melton garnered the first conference weekly accolade of his career and the Aztecs' third of the season after Ryan Orr (Player of the Week) and Casey Schmitt (Pitcher of the Week) merited the distinction on Feb. 24.
- > Last Saturday, Melton (3-0) collected his third straight victory in as many starts after combining on SDSU's first shutout of the year in a 6-0 blanking of the Beavers. In six scoreless innings, the Aztec sophomore limited OSU to four hits while striking out a career-high nine batters against only one walk.
- > The Beavers advanced a runner to third base with two outs in each of the first two frames, but Melton avoided trouble with pivotal inning-ending strikeouts, setting the tone for the remainder of the contest.
- > For the season, Melton leads the Mountain West with three wins and ranks among the league leaders in ERA (2nd, 1.06), earned runs allowed (2nd, 3), strikeouts (4th, 21), opponent batting average (4th, .172) and innings pitched (5th, 17.0).

Week 4: at No. 11/15 Oklahoma

2020 Record (9-4, 0-0 MW)

NOTING THE OREGON STATE SERIES

- > After dropping the first two games of last weekend's home series against perennial contender OSU, 13-1 and 4-1, San Diego State roared back to win the final two engagements, 6-0 and 12-11.
- > The Aztecs were limited to four hits in the first game of the series and six in game two before pounding out 22 hits over the last two contests, including 13 in the finale to tie a season high.
- > With its 6-0 blanking last Saturday, San Diego State snapped a six-game losing streak to OSU dating back to 2012.
- > The shutout in the Aztecs' 11th game of the season marked the team's earliest whitewash in a season since 2015 when it defeated Valparaiso 3-0 in the third game of that campaign. SDSU did not shut out an opposing team until the 54th game of 2019 season in an 8-0 win over New Mexico on May 16.
- > With their 12-11 victory on Sunday, the Aztecs captured their second one-run game of the season, improving to 31-15 in their last 46 contests with a winning tally of one marker.

STRIKEOUTS GALORE

- > San Diego State recorded 27 games with 10 or more strikeouts during the 2019 campaign, marking the most double-digit strikeout performances for the Aztecs in the MW era (since 2000). SDSU surpassed the previous MW record of 23 set in a 10-6 win at Fresno State on May 11, 2009.
- > The SDSU pitching staff has already notched seven games with 10 strikeouts this year vs. Virginia Tech, Cal State Fullerton, Iowa, Nebraska, at UC Irvine and twice against Oregon State. Not surprisingly, the Scarlet and Black is 6-1 in those contests.
- > In addition, The Aztecs are 22-12 in their last 34 games when striking out 10 or more batters.

GOING, GOING, GONE

- > San Diego State has hit a home run in its last three outings, highlighted by Brian Leonhardt's game-tying grand slam that turned the tables in the final game of this past weekend's series vs. Oregon State.
- > The Aztecs have won three straight and 15 of their last 18 dating back to last year when hitting a home run.
- > During the 2019 campaign, SDSU was 17-5 when knocking one out of the park.

OTHER TRENDS

- > In addition, the scoring the game's first run proved to be important for the Aztecs, who are 6-2 this season when scoring first.
- > Last year, SDSU posted a 19-6 record when scoring first in comparison to a 13-17 mark when its opponent tallied the first run.
- > The Aztecs are 67-11 in their last 78 games when scoring five or more runs, including a 5-1 record in 2020.
- > San Diego State is 48-18 last 66 games following a loss.
- > With their 7-5 victory vs. Virginia Tech, the Aztecs snapped a 17-game losing streak when trailing after six innings.

SCHMITT CLIMBING THE CHARTS

- > After recording his fifth save of the season vs. Oregon State on Sunday, Casey Schmitt inched closer to the top spot on the Aztecs' all-time list in that statistic. He has 22 saves for his career, which ranks fourth in school history.
- > Earlier on Feb. 25, Schmitt recorded career save No. 21 in the Aztecs' 2-1 victory at UC Irvine, surpassing Michael Cederoth, who saved 20 games from 2011-14
- > With his total, Schmitt sits just four saves behind SDSU's career leader Royce Ring, who compiled 26 from 2000-02, while Addison Reed (2008-09) and CJ Saylor (2014-17) are tied for second with 24 apiece.

TOUGH AT HOME

- > Since the start of the 2012 season, San Diego State is 156-100 (.609) when playing at home.
- > In 2018, the Aztecs set a program record with 25 home victories at Tony Gwynn Stadium (since 1997), besting the previous standard of 24 set in 1997, 2002 and 2014.

TWO FOR A TUESDAY

> With San Diego State's 2-1 triumph at UC Irvine on Feb. 25, the Aztecs put the brakes on a 13-game losing streak when scoring two runs or fewer.

AZTECS SWEEP MOUNTAIN WEST WEEKLY AWARDS ON FEB. 24

- > San Diego State's Ryan Orr was named Mountain West Player of the Week, while Casey Schmitt earned league Pitcher of the Week honors after the duo propelled the Aztecs to a 3-1 record in four home games played from Feb. 17-23.
- > SDSU opened its homestand with an 8-4 triumph over Cal State Fullerton before taking two of three games at the Tony Gwynn Legacy tournament, featuring a 4-1 victory over lowa and a 4-2 conquest of Nebraska followed by an 11-5 setback to USC.
- > With his accolade, Schmitt merited MW weekly distinction for the third time in his career and second as a pitcher, while Orr collected his first conference certificate as a collegian.
- > In four games, Orr led the Aztecs in several categories, including batting average (.438), hits (7), RBIs (5) and doubles (2). The SDSU senior also topped the squad with a .700 success rate percentage of advancing runners for the week (7-10) and ranked second on team with a .563 slugging percentage.
- > Orr began the week with a 3-for-4 effort vs. Cal State Fullerton, scoring two runs to go with a pair of RBIs. The Aztec outfielder contributed a key two-run double in the decisive fifth inning vs. the Titans, as SDSU broke a 4-4 tie. He also smacked a double in SDSU's win over Iowa on Friday, advancing a runner to third who eventually scored.
- > In addition, Orr drove in a run and scored after reaching on a fielder's choice vs. Nebraska, as the Scarlet and Black plated all four markers in a pivotal sixth-inning rally. The La Costa Canyon High alumnus finished the week with a 3-for-5 performance vs. USC, adding two RBIs and a run scored. He also made three put-outs in left field.
- > Schmitt, meanwhile, posted saves in consecutive games vs. Power 5 schools Iowa and Nebraska at the Tony Gwynn Legacy. The Aztec junior also pitched the final inning vs. CSF, including a strikeout.
- > Collectively, Schmitt did not issue a walk in three scoreless appearances, limiting the opposition to a .167 batting average in 3 2/3 innings, including an 0-5 clip with runners on base. Additionally, the SDSU closer went 3-for-3 at the plate with a run scored vs. Nebraska before taking the mound in the ninth, where he struck out one.

SETTING THE SCENE FOR 2020

- > San Diego State returns 19 letterwinners from last year's squad that finished with a 32-25 overall record and a 16-13 mark in the Mountain West. The Aztecs welcome back five starting position players and two starting pitchers.
- > SDSU has captured five of the last seven MW tournament championships and is the only team in the league to have won 30 or more games six times in the last seven years.
- > The Aztecs were pegged for a first-place finish in the 2020 MW preseason coaches poll, attaining the status of conference favorites for the second year in a row.
- Leading the list of returners is junior Casey Schmitt, a consensus preseason All-American who additionally earned a spot on USA Baseball's Golden Spikes Award Watch List. Last year, the Aztec third baseman/relief pitcher was a second-team all-MW honoree after receiving freshman All-America recognition in 2018 from Collegiate Baseball magazine.
- > Also back in the mix are 2019 all-Mountain West selections Matt Rudick (first team) and Mike Jarvis (second-team), as well as Jaden Fein, who was named the league's Co-Freshman of the Year last season to go with freshman All-America distinction.
- > The Aztecs were ranked 31st in Collegiate Baseball's Fabulous 40 Preseason Poll and have received votes in the NCBWA Top 25 Preseason Poll.

SCHMITT NAMED TO GOLDEN SPIKES AWARD WATCH LIST

- > Junior Casey Schmitt added to his already lengthy list of preseason accolades on Feb. 13 when he earned a spot on the USA Baseball's Golden Spikes Award Watch List, beginning the process of identifying the nation's top amateur player for the 2020 season.
- > With his nomination, Schmitt becomes the fourth Aztec player since 2008 to land on the preseason Golden Spikes Award Watch List, joining Michael Cederoth (2014), Addison Reed (2010) and Stephen Strasburg, who took home the top prize in 2009. In addition, Tyler Adkison landed on the GSA mid-season watch list in 2017.
- > In addition, Schmitt enters the 2020 campaign with four preseason All-America honors, including three second-team plaudits from Collegiate Baseball, D1Baseball.com and Perfect Game and a third-team honor from Baseball America.
- > As SDSU's starting third baseman in 2019, Schmitt finished second on the team with a .315 batting average, adding eight doubles, five home runs and 36 RBI to merit second-team all-Mountain West distinction. He also appeared in 21 games with four starts as a pitcher, posting a 3-3 record and a 3.77 ERA in 43.0 innings to go with a team-high eight saves.
- > In 2018, Schmitt was a consensus freshman All-American, setting an Aztec single-season record with a 0.28 ERA (min. 30 IP) while allowing just one earned run in 32 innings pitched. He also posted a .264 batting average with one home run and 32 RBI, finishing the year as one of only two players nationally to maintain a 2.00 ERA or lower (min. 15 IP) and drive in more than 30 runs.

SCHMITT, RUDICK LAND ON PRESEASON ALL-MOUNTAIN WEST TEAM

- > Aztec juniors Casey Schmitt and Matt Rudick each earned on spot on the preseason all-Mountain West team announced on Feb. 11.
- > Rudick garnered first-team all-conference accolades in 2019 after leading SDSU in several categories, including batting average (.320), total bases (95), hits (77) and runs scored (48), serving as the team's leadoff hitter throughout the year.
- > Additionally, the Aztec outfielder topped the squad with 18 multi-hit games and reeled off a team-high 21-game hitting streak. The Scripps Ranch High alumnus was also the toughest player in the Mountain West to strike out last season, fanning just once per 12.1 at-bats which was good for 25th nationally.

VETERAN HONOREES

- > Not to be outdone, San Diego State also returns outfielders Mike Jarvis (.289, 5 HR, 8 2B, 30 RBI), who was a second-team all-MW selection as a junior last season, and Jaden Fein (.293, 4 HR, 11 2B, 20 RBI), who collected league Co-Freshman of the Year distinction to go with Freshman All-America honors from Collegiate Baseball magazine.
- > In addition, Brian Leonhardt (.272, 1 HR, 14 2B, 34 RBI) is back in the mix after leading the Aztecs with a team-high .389 batting average with runners in scoring position and topping the squad with 16 two-out RBIs. He also occupied the fourth spot with multiple RBIs in seven games and ranked fifth with 16 multi-hit performances.

NEWCOMERS AMONG STARTERS

- > A pair of junior college transfers and one true freshman have already cracked the starting lineup through the first 13 games of the year for SDSU.
- > Wyatt Hendrie has assumed the duties at catcher after earning all-state honors by the California Community College Baseball Coaches Association (CCCBA) at Antelope Valley College in 2019. In his lone season with the Marauders, he led the team in several categories, including batting average (.410), hits (59) runs (32), RBIs (26), doubles (10) and triples (10).
- > Hendrie was a 10th-round selection by the Chicago Cubs in the 2019 MLB First-Year Player Draft.
- > At shortstop, Anthony Walters has stepped in after arriving from Mt. San Antonio College, where he earned first-team all-state honors from the CCCBCA on the strength of a .374 batting average in 45 games with 10 home runs and 62 RBIs.
- > Caden Miller has received the starting nod at second base in eight games after graduating from Bishop Alemany High School in Mission Hills, California near Los Angeles. He was a two-time all-conference selection

- who finished with career-highs in batting average (.329), runs scored (29), stolen bases (21) and doubles (9) during his senior season.
- > Miller was listed as the Mountain West preseason freshman of the year in several publications, including D1Baseball.com.
- > Overall, the Aztecs' recruiting class for 2019 was ranked 20th nationally by Perfect Game.

AZTECS TABBED PRESEASON MOUNTAIN WEST FAVORITES

- > For the second straight season, San Diego State baseball team was picked first in the Mountain West preseason coaches poll, as announced Feb. 11 by the conference office.
- > Collectively, SDSU received 46 points and four first-place votes, edging second-place Fresno State (42 pts, 2 first-place votes), while Nevada (38 pts, 2 first-place votes) was predicted to finish third, followed by fourth-place UNLV (34 pts). Rounding out the remainder of the poll were New Mexico (5th, 23 pts), Air Force (T-6th, 17 pts), San José State (T-6th) and Boise State (8th, 7 pts).
- > The Aztecs were also predicted to finish first prior to the 2014 campaign.

- > Casey Schmitt gained valuable experience in the summer of 2019 when he played for th Cotuit Kettleers in the Cape Cod League.
- > Schmitt collected MVP honors for the championship finals after belting two homers and scoring three runs in Cotuit's 10-3 title-clinching victory over Harwich. He also pitched six scoreless innings in two relief appearances during the finals, striking out eight batters against two walks.

MOUNTAIN WEST CHAMPIONSHIP RETURNS TO TONY GWYNN STADIUM

- > For the fifth time since the league's inception, San Diego State will play host to the Mountain West Championship, May 21-24, at Tony Gwynn Stadium.
- > The Aztecs also welcomed the conference tournament in 2001, 2010, 2011, as well as 2018, when they claimed their fifth MW Championship crown in a span of six years.
- > SDSU has captured the most tournament titles in conference history, winning in 2000, 2013, 2014, 2015, 2017 and 2018.





TONY GWYNN STADIUM



Tony Gwynn Stadium became the new home of the San Diego State baseball program during the 1997 season. Upon its opening, the facility was hailed as one of the top college baseball stadiums in the country. A poll of college coaches by Baseball America ranked it among the top 20 collegiate facilities in the nation and the fourth-best park in the western U.S.

Groundbreaking for this project took place on Aug. 21, 1996. The \$4 million facility was made possible through the generosity of San Diego Padres owner John Moores, who donated the funds to make the program's dream of a state-of-the-art stadium at San Diego State University a reality.

The structure is named in honor of the former Aztec player, head

coach, and MLB Hall of Famer. The playing field remains Charlie Smith Field in honor of the long-time former San Diego State head coach. It retains its former dimensions of 340 feet down both the right and left field lines and 410 to dead center field. Distance to the alleys is 360 feet in left center and 370 in right center.

Additional area has been added between home plate and the backstop (now 45 feet), and the warning track in the outfield has been widened to 20 feet. The field itself is a natural turf (Tif Santa Ana grass), while the infield and warning track utilize crushed brick dust.

The most recent field improvement consists of artificial field turf that extends from the end of each dugout in foul territory outside the base lines. The turf was installed prior to the start of the 2010 season. In addition, a large Aztec logo now occupies the area directly behind home plate.

The outfield is enclosed by a 10-foot high green wall made of a material designed to be resilient upon contact. The outfield wall features advertising signage as well as the names and numbers of past

players who have been honored for their accomplishments as members of the SDSU program.

Stadium lighting consists of six poles using 2000watt fixtures, making the facility one of the most well-lit fields in college and professional baseball.

The stadium's electronic scoreboard, installed prior to the start of the 2003 season, is located behind the right centerfield fence and features a complete line score as well as video playback capability.

Seating capacity of the stadium is 3,000, and that number could reach as high as 4,000 in the future. Of the 2,200 permanent seats installed during the initial phase of construction, 800 were armchair-style around the stadium at the field level. With the addition of new seating in May 2005, that number has increased to over 1,800, as more than 1,000 chair back seats were installed in the plaza level from first to third base. The remaining seats are comprised of bleacher benches that extend down both base lines.

The latest stadium improvements came just prior to the start of the 2010 season when Field Turf was

installed in the foul territory areas in front of both dugouts and behind home plate. In addition, new sod was placed in the infield. These upgrades were made possible by a donation to the baseball program by former Aztec pitcher Stephen Strasburg.

Among the amenities contained within the stadium itself are the following:

- Two concession stands and two sets of restrooms located behind the seating area on the plaza level.
- A coaches dressing room and adjacent players' meeting room located at the east end of the first base stands to be used for team functions as well as a lounge for SDSU athletes.
- The Stephen and Mary Birch Baseball Museum located at the north end of the third base stand. The museum features numerous items relating to the history of baseball at San Diego State.
