Big Picture

- A record five-time winner of this event, San Diego State advances to its 12th Mountain West Conference championship game, including its third straight and its 10th in the last 13 seasons.
- San Diego State becomes the first team in the nation to reach 30 wins this season.
- San Diego State improves to 30-1, the best 31-game record in school history, and remains the only team in the nation with only one loss.
- San Diego State wins its 16th straight road/neutral game. This is a school record and the longest active win streak.
- San Diego State is 16-0 in road/neutral games this season. The Aztecs are the only team in the nation to win every road/neutral contest in 2019-20 and leads the nation with 16 road/neutral victories.
- San Diego State is 5-0 in neutral court games this season, including wins over Creighton and Iowa.
- This is the third 30-win season in school history. The 2010-11 (34) and 2013-14 (31), both advanced to the NCAA Sweet 16.
- San Diego State is now 29 games above .500. Only once have the Aztecs completed a season more games above the .500 mark (2010-11, +31).
- San Diego State wins its 34th game at Thomas & Mack Center since the start of the 2008-09 campaign. That is the most victories in a venue in which a team has not played a home game in the nation.

Series Notes

- San Diego State leads the all-time series, 15-7.
- The Aztecs have won the last four encounters, including all three this season, with the Broncos.
- San Diego State is 4-0 against Boise State on neutral courts, with all four of those games occurring as part of the Mountain West tournament (2012, 2013, 2017 and 2020).

Tournament Notes

- San Diego State improves 34-15 in Mountain West tournament history (69.4 percent). Regardless of other outcomes today, the Aztecs own the highest winning percentage and have the most victories of any team current or past in league history.
- The Aztecs are now 12-4 in semifinal round Mountain West Conference history and own a 5-6 record in championship games.
- The Aztecs are 24-7 in the Mountain West tourney since 2010.
- The Aztecs have won the tournament championship five times 2002, 2006, 2010, 2011 and 2018.

• San Diego State's 15 three-pointers are the program's most in a Mountain West Tournament game. (previous high: 11 vs. Air Force – 3-5-20). They also attempted tournament record 36 three-pointers (previous high: 28 vs. Utah State – 3-16-19).

Game Notes

- Boise State scored the first basket of the game. San Diego State is 10-0 this season when its opponent scores the first points.
- San Diego State made four of its first six shots, all three pointers, but then went 1-for-8.
- Eleven of San Diego State's first 13 shots were three pointers.
- San Diego State's 10 three-pointers in the first half were the most in a half for the team this season.
- San Diego State overcame a double-digit deficit (16 points) to win the game. It is the fourth time this season the team has accomplished the feat (previously; 16 points vs. Iowa, 13 points at Nevada & 10-point to Utah State).
- San Diego State outshot Boise State (49%-to-39%) and improves to 26-0 this season and 63-4 in the Dutcher era when shooting better than its opponent.
- San Diego State's 15 three-pointers ties for the most in a game this season (New Mexico, 1-29-20).

Game Trends

- San Diego State trailed by 16 points in the first half, which equals the largest deficit the team has faced this season (vs. Iowa)
- At one point in the first half Boise State was successful on 11-of-13 field goals.
- San Diego State closed the first half on a 21-5 run to erase a (35-19) 16-point deficit.
- San Diego State and Boise State were tied at the half (40-40). It was the first time this season the Aztecs have been tied at the intermission.

Player Notes

Malachi Flynn (Stat line)

Scored in double figures for the 30th time this year and 68th time in his career... He reached 20 points in a game for the 10th time this season.

KJ Feagin (Stat line)

Reached double figure scoring for the 11th time this season and 68th time in his career... He reached 20 points in a game for the 3rd time this season.

Matt Mitchell (Stat line)

Scored in double figures for the 20^{th} time this season and 57^{th} of his career.
