### Postgame Notes: vs. Colorado State | Steve Fisher Court at Viejas Arena | Saturday, Jan. 2, 2021

## FINAL SCORE: Colorado State 70, No. --/23 San Diego State 67

#### Big Notes

- San Diego State fell to 36-4 since the start of the 2019-20 campaign.
- The Aztecs dropped to 17-2 over their last 19 Mountain West games (since the start of the 2019-20 league season).
- San Diego State had its 35-game winning streak snapped when leading with five minutes remaining in the game.
- SDSU had its five-game winning streak snapped against Colorado State.
- San Diego State fell to 17-4 at Viejas Arena against the Rams.
- CSU led for only 39 seconds for the game.
- Terrell Gomez scored a season-high 19 points, the most by an Aztec off the bench since Jeremy Hemsley scored 19 against UNLV on Jan. 27, 2018.

#### Game Notes

- San Diego State fell to 35-2 the last 37 times it has led at the half.
- The Aztecs dropped to 113-7 the last 120 times they have enjoyed a halftime advantage at home.
- SDSU fell to 57-9 in the Brian Dutcher era when committing fewer turnovers than its opponent.
- San Diego State dropped to 43-10 in the Brian Dutcher era when outscoring its opponent off the bench.
- The Aztecs had a season-high 14 three-point field goals.
- SDSU recorded a season-high 18 assists

#### Game Trends

- San Diego State outscored Colorado State, 16-9, off turnovers.
- The Aztecs outscored the Rams, 16-11, via fast break.
- SDSU's bench outscored CSU, 23-16.
- San Diego State had a 14-0 and 11-0 runs in the first half. The Aztecs have 10 runs this season of at least 10 consecutive points.
- San Diego State made seven consecutive field goal attempts in the first half

#### Player Notes

#### **Terrell Gomez – 19 points, 7-16 FG, 5-9 3PFG, 2 rebounds, 2 assists, 4 steals**

Scored a season-high 19 points, the most by an Aztec off the bench since Jeremy Hemsley scored 19 against UNLV on Jan. 27, 2018... It was his fourth double-figure scoring game of the season and 85th of his career (first 81 at CSUN)... Led the Aztecs in scoring for the first time this season... Passed 1,700

points for his career and now has 1,710... Had a season-high five 3-points field goals after recording four total over the last four games... Tied a career high with four steals (third occasion) and now has 91 for his career.

**Matt Mitchell – 14 points, 7 rebounds, 3 assists, 1 steal**

Moved into 18th place on SDSU's all-time scoring list, passing Lorenzo Wade... Now has 1,207 points, four shy of Marcus Slaughter's 1,211 points... Reached double figures in scoring for the eighth consecutive games (all games this season) and 65th time of his career... Passed Xavier Thames into 18th on the school's all-time leader in points-rebounds-assists and now has a combined 1,857, just five behind Kawhi Leonard's 1,862... Made the 92nd start of his career and 28th straight start... Recorded a season-high seven rebounds and tied a season high with three assists.

**Adam Seiko – 12 points, 4-6 3PFG, 2 rebounds, 4 assists**

Made his first career start today in his 69th career game... Scored a season-high 12 points, just one off a career high... Now has two career double-digit scoring games... Made a career-high four 3-point field goals, going 4-for-6 from the 3-point line after entering the game 4-for-14 on the season... Also recorded a career-high four assists... The junior entered the game averaging career highs in minutes (17.1), scoring (3.1 ppg) and rebounding (3.1 rpg).

**Jordan Schakel – 12 points, 4-9 3PFG, 5 rebounds, 1 assist, 2 steals**

Reached double figures for the 36th time (Aztecs are 32-4 in those games)... It was his sixth game with 10-plus points this season... Had at least four three-point field goals for the 11<sup>th</sup> time in his career (Aztecs are 9-2 in those games)... Led SDSU with a plus-11 in +/- rating.

**Trey Pulliam – 2 points, 5 rebounds, 6 assists, 1 steal**

Tied a career high with five rebounds (third time)... Matched a season high with six assists, one off a career high.
