Aztec Notes

- San Diego State enters the Mountain West tournament as the 3-seed and will play 6-seed Boise State at 2 p.m. MT, in the second quarterfinal match on Monday, Nov. 1.
- San Diego State's five Mountain West crowns are the most by any current member and rank second in conference history, trailing only Brigham Young's seven. In 20 previous MW tournaments, San Diego State has compiled a 20-12-5 (.608) overall record and is the only current program with a .600-plus winning percentage in the event. UNLV ranks second at .517 (12-11-6).
- The Aztecs 20-12-5 (.608) record in the Mountain West Tournament is the best among any current member and is the second highest in the league's history (BYU, 19-4-1 - .813).
- San Diego State has been the 3-seed in the MW Championship on four previous occasions: in 2000, 2004, 2010 and 2016. As the 3-seed, the Aztecs have a 6-3-2 record, have reached the semifinal round in each of those four years, and the championship match twice (2004 & 2016). In the 2004 championship match, following a 0-0 draw vs. Utah, SDSU lost 4-3 on PKs, and in 2016, San Diego State again lost 4-3 on PKs following a 3-3 draw vs. UNLV.
- As a 3-seed in the quarterfinal round, San Diego State is 4-0-0 and has not surrendered a goal in any of those contests. It has outscored its opponents 11-0 in the round, including a 2-0 decision over Boise State on Nov. 1, 2016, the last time it played on the opening day of the tournament.
- San Diego State has played a quarterfinal match on 10 occasions in the 20 previous times it has competed in the Mountain West Championship. In those games, it has a 6-3-1 mark and has advanced to the semifinal round six times.
- The Aztecs and Broncos have met in the MW tournament four previous times with San Diego State holding a 3-1-0 advantage. The teams have met once in the quarterfinal, a 2-0 Aztecs victory in 2016, once in the semifinal, a 1-0 win in 2017, and have split a pair of championship game matchups, a 1-0 SDSU triumph in 2013 and a 0-2 loss in 2019.

- The last meeting between San Diego State and Boise State, in the Mountain West tournament, was a 0-2 decision in Boise on Nov. 9, 2019. The Aztecs and Broncos put 16 and 15 shots on the board, but two and five in shots on goal, respectively.
- If San Diego State advances to the semifinal round, it would have a matchup with 2-seed Fresno State. The Aztecs have a 9-7-1 record in the MW semifinals and have advanced to the championship game in 10 of the 17 times it has completed in this round.
- As a 3-seed in the semifinal match of the MW tournament, San Diego State is 2-2-0 and, in its victories, has not surrendered a goal: defeating 7-seed Air Force 2-0 in 2004 and 2-seed San Jose State 2-0 in 2016. Its losses have come in a 1-2 decision against 2-seed Utah in 2000, and a 0-2 decision to 2-seed and No. 18 Brigham Young in 2016.
- San Diego State and Bulldogs have met in the MW tournament once previously, a 3-2 Aztecs win in the 2019 semifinal. In addition, the schools met in the semifinal round of the Western Athletic Conference (WAC) tournament in 1998. That game was a 2-0 triumph for the Aztecs on the way to securing that year's WAC championship.
- The last time San Diego State and Fresno State played in the MW tournament, the Aztecs earned a 3-2 decision. SDSU's goals came from Taylor Moorehead, Rachelle Elve and the game-winner from Kiera Utush, all of who are on the current San Diego State roster. Both teams scored their goals between the 27:08 and 40:11 marks, and seven yellow cards were shown in the match.
- With the regular season now complete, the Aztecs have won nine of the last 17 MW trophies (regular season and tournament), all of which have come under the direction of head coach **Mike Friesen**. In total, the 15th-year head coach has guided San Diego State to ten conference titles, and San Diego State has earned 11 Mountain West titles since the conference's inception in 1999. SDSU was the regular season champions in 1999, 2012, 2013, 2014, 2015 and 2019. The program was the tournament champion in 2009,

2012, 2013, 2014 and 2017, and its five tournament titles are the most among current members of the league and the second best in the league's history (BYU, 7).

- In his 15th campaign leading the Mountain West's most dominant women's soccer program, head coach **Mike Friesen** has guided his squad to ten Mountain West championships (five tournament and five regular season), and five NCAA Tournament appearances, each the most among any current league head coach. Having just completed his 15th season of conference play, Friesen has a 94-30-15 record. His 94 league victories are the most by any head coach in Mountain West history (the inaugural season of the MW was in 1999).
- Sophomore keeper **Alexa Madueno** (So. GK, Woodland, Calif.) has earned two Mountain West Defensive Player of the Week honors this season. She entered this week leading the MW in shutouts (6) and saves per game (5.14), and is No. 2 in saves (72). Nationally, despite missing the last five games, she ranks No. 62, 69 and 93 in those categories, respectively.
- Freshman striker **Denise Castro** (Fr., MF, San Ysidro, Calif.) leads the 2021 Aztecs with eight goals. Since the 2000 season, her eight tallies rank No. T-3 on the program's freshman goals list (a list of the top five is on the bottom of page 2). The San Diego State record for freshman scoring is shared by Leah Pruitt and Mia Root, who scored 10 goals in 2015 and 2017, respectively.
- After battling to get healthy for most of the season, **Anna Toohey** (Sr., F. Winston-Salem, N.C.) may be returning to the form that earned her MW Newcomer of the Year last season. In the last six matches, Toohey has scored three times, including a pair of game winners, in overtime at UNLV (10/8) and vs. Air Force (10/21) and assisted on another at Nevada (10/10). The Winston-Salem, N.C., native leads the Aztecs with 4 assists and ranks second with 3 goals.
- Boise State and San Diego State have met 17 times since the series began in the 2011 season, and the Aztecs hold a 10-6-0 advantage in the all-time series. In games played on the Broncos home field, San Diego State has posted a 4-3-0 mark, including a 2-2-0 mark in the last four games there. In the last matchup in Boise, on Aug. 9, 2021, the Aztecs came away with a 1-0 decision on a Chloe Frisch goal in the 51st minute. In the SDSU road wins at Boise State, the Aztecs have outscored the Broncos 5-0, but in its three losses has been beaten on the scoreboard 6-2. (All-time series scores on pg. 5)
- In the all-time series between the Aztecs and Fresno State, San Diego State holds a 14-5-2 advantage, including a 2-0-0 record in neutral site games. SDSU defeated Fresno State 2-0 in the Western Athletic Conference semifinal game in Provo, Utah on Nov. 5, 1998 and then again on Nov. 7, 2019 in Boise, Idaho, 3-2 in the semifinal of that season's MW tournament. (All-time series scores on pg. 5)
- After the games of Nov. 24, the Aztecs slot in at No. 138 in the NCAA RPI rankings. In those same rankings Boise State was No. 156 and Fresno State was No. 118.
- Head coach **Mike Friesen's** 164 victories (165-104-35) since the start of the 2007 season, the year he took control of the program, are the most by any current coach in the MW and rank second in league history (Jennifer Rockwood, BYU, 190 victories). Colorado College's Geoff Bennett's 150 victories in the last 14 seasons ranks second among current MW head coaches.
- When head coach **Mike Friesen** put together this season's non-conference schedule, he knew it would be challenging, SDSU was just 2-6-0, but here is the breakdown after the end of the non-conference slate. When the Aztecs started the league season, its eight non-conference opponents owned a 45-17-6 record (.706), three of the eight were ranked in the top-10 (UCLA No. 3, Pepperdine No. 6 & Stanford No. 7), three are from what are considered Power-5 conferences, and all but one of the eight opponent's records was .500 or better.

Player Notes

- Alexa Madueno** (So., GK, Woodland, Calif.) played every minute of the team's first 14 games (1,262:16 minutes) and every minute of her college career (2,267:13 minutes) up to that point, but has not played in the last five games. At No. 13 Stanford (8/29), she established a career-high with 14 saves, two shy of the program's all-time single game record, and faced more shots (44) against the Cardinal than any Aztec keeper in since the 2016 season (Penn State took 29 shots against the Aztecs on Sept. 9, 2016). She has six clean sheets; against Army West Point (8/19), at San Diego (9/10), at Colorado State (9/24), vs. Boise State & vs. Utah State for a total of nine shutouts in 25 career collegiate games. This season, she is 6-8-0 with a 1.71 GAA and a .750 save percentage and six clean sheets. Entering the MW tournament she leads the league in saves per game (5.14), shutouts (6), is second in total saves (72) and No. 5 in save percentage. Nationally, Madueno is No. 62 in shutouts, No. 93 in saves, and No. 69 in saves per game at the start of the week, despite not having played in five matches.
- Following her fourth and fifth clean sheet of the season, a pair of 2-0 wins against Boise State (10/1) & Utah State (10/3), Madueno was named the **Mountain West Defensive Player of the Week** for the week ending on Oct. 3. She faced 17 shots and turned away all five which reached her line. It was the second MW PotW honor for Madueno this season and the second of her career.
- In 14 matches this season Madueno has recorded 72 saves, blowing past her total of 35 saves in 11 contests last season. She is averaging 5.14 saves per game in 2021.

- Madueno went 8-3-0 last year, had a .714 save percentage (35-of-49) and surrendered 14 goals in 1,005 minutes (1.25 GAA). She was included on the Mountain West All-Newcomer team and was a second-team All-MW performer. Madueno is the first true freshman keeper to start every game in a season for SDSU since Aubree Southwick in 2007 and is the third keeper, and only true freshman, to play every minute in a season for the Aztecs since Stephanie Pearson in 2003. The only other keeper to start and play every minute in a season for San Diego State since 2003 was Brooke Lisowski in 2019.
- **Cameron Illingworth** (So., GK, Santa Ana, Calif.) made her Aztec debut at Fresno State (10/14) and has played every minute since. She recorded her first career collegiate shutout at San Jose State (10/17) after falling on a 108th minute goal at Fresno State. The transfer from Kansas State earned the first win of her collegiate career in a 1-0 decision against Air Force (10/21). In 507:20 she has a 1.06 GAA, a 0.806 save percentage and has stopped 25 of the 31 shots which have reached her line.
- **Denise Castro** (Fr., MF, San Ysidro, Calif.) in 17 appearances, 15 in a starting roll, has played 1,252 minutes and produced a team-high 47 shots, 25 of which have been on frame, which also leads the team, and has scored eight goals, including the 13th hat trick in program history, at San Diego (9/10). She entered the week No. 1-2 in the Mountain West in goals and is No. 1-7 in points (17). Castro missed the No. 3 UCLA (9/19) & Air Force (10/21) games due to a commitment to the U-20 Mexican National Team.
- Castro's hat trick provided all the scoring the Aztecs needed in a 3-0 decision at San Diego (9/10). The hat trick was the 13th in program history and the fourth by a freshman in the now 33-year history of the program. Her performance earned her **Mountain West Freshman of the Week** for the week of Sept. 6. Of the five hat tricks recorded by Mountain West players this season, hers is one of only two by a freshman (also Mia Otero of AFA on 10/1). In addition, Castro is the 11th freshman to have recorded a hat trick in Mountain West history and was first since the 2016 season.
- Castro missed the team's game against No. 3 UCLA (9/19) because she was competing for the U-20 Mexican National Team in two international friendlies against The Netherlands in Oldenzaal, Holland. She is the first active Aztec women's soccer player to compete for a national team since the start of the Friesen era (2007-present). Castro started the first game in Holland, a 7-0 decision for The Netherlands, and played as a reserve in the second match, a 2-1 decision for Mexico. Castro returned to the team in time for its games at Colorado State (9/24) and Wyoming (9/26).
- 2020 Mountain West Newcomer of the Year and first-team All-Mountain West performer **Anna Toohey** (Sr., F, Winston-Salem, N.C.), has appeared in 18 games, starting 17 times, and playing 1076 minutes. She led the team last year with six assists, and this season has picked up two more on two of Castro's three goals at San Diego (9/10), another against Nevada (10/10), and a fourth vs. New Mexico (10/28) to once again pace the squad. The USD game marked the first time she has produced multiple assists in a game in her collegiate career and the first time the Aztecs have had a player with multiple assists in a game since **Laura Fuentes** had a pair in the Aztecs 6-1 victory at San Jose State on March 12, 2021. Toohey has produced 18 shots with nine on frame and scored her first goal of the season against Utah State (10/1) and followed that up with the game winners at UNLV (10/8) and vs. Air Force (10/21). Entering the week, Toohey is 1-of-10 player in the MW with a multi-assist game this year.
- **Laura Fuentes** (Sr., MF, Newark, Calif.), a 2020 United Soccer Coaches second-team All-Pacific Region and first-team All-MW performer is third on the side with 22 shots, six shots on goals, one goal, two assists & four points in 1,660 minutes, second most on the side. Fuentes had the lone goal in a 1-0 decision against Army West Point (8/19). The tally came on a penalty kick, the fourth PK of her career and her fourth career game winner. She has never missed a contest and has earned a starting assignment in each of her 69 career games.
- **Alexys Ocampo** (Fr., F/MF, Upland, Calif.) has produced 13 shots, put three on frame, and opened her collegiate account with the game-winning goal at Colorado State (9/24), in a 1-0 victory. She has played a total of 571 minutes and is the second leading scorer among Aztec freshmen and leads her class with two assists. Is one of three freshmen to appear in all 19 contests (also: Sarah Funk & Trinity Coker).
- **Rachelle Elve** (Jr., F, Huntington Beach, Calif.) totaled 10 goals in 2019 & 2020, the highest total among returning Aztecs (Chloe Frisch, who graduated after the 2020 season, scored 11 goals in her last two campaigns). Elve entered this season as the Mountain West's top returning goal scorer from the last two seasons. At San Jose State (3/12/21), in the team's first foray away from home during the 2020 campaign, she tallied the program's 11th hat trick and the first since Aliyah Utush's trifecta vs. New Mexico on Nov. 4, 2017. Her first shot attempt this season, along with her first starting assignment, came at Stanford (8/29). She earned a starting nod vs. Washington State (9/2) and at Colorado State (9/24). Elve opened her season account at Wyoming (9/26) with a 32nd minute goal and then got the game winner in the sides 2-0 victory over Boise State (10/1). In 15 matches, she has produced four shots, putting them all on frame, with two goals in 426 minutes.
- **Daniela Filipovic** (Sr., MF, Laguna Hills, Calif.), who recorded the first point of her career on an assist last season, opted to utilize the extra year of eligibility offered by the NCAA due to the COVID-19 pandemic. Filipovic produced her first shot of the campaign in the Pepperdine game (8/22), and tallied her first point of the year assisting on the Elve goal at Wyoming (9/26) and picked up her second assists on the game winner vs. Air Force (10/21). In 1,161 minutes in 14 starts and 18 overall appearances she has produced eight shots. Filipovic's minutes and starts are both career-highs.

- **Emma Gaines-Ramos** (So., F, San Diego, Calif.) has produced 29 shots (12 in the last six games), putting 18 on frame, in 1,217 minutes. Gaines-Ramos, a first-team All-Mountain West honoree last season after producing three assists in league play, the second most by an Aztec true freshman in the last five years, scored the first goal of her career, the game winner against Utah State (10/3) and struck again against New Mexico (10/28). She has started in 29-of-30 games of her college career and her goals, shots, shots on goal and minutes are career highs.
- **Claire Watkins** (Jr., D, San Diego, Calif.) has started all 30 games since transferring from Oregon prior to the 2020 campaign. In 1,414 minutes this season, she has produced six shots, and with **Kiera Utush** (Jr., D, Rocklin, Calif.), has taken the reins as the program's center defenders. Watkins has played at least 90 minutes in 10 matches this year, including four in a row from Sept. 2 through Sept. 19, and saw a season-high 107 minutes at Fresno State (10/14). So far this season, Watkins has compiled single season career-high in minutes, games and starts.
- **Lauren Dicus** (Sr., D, Danville, Calif.) took one shot against Army West Point (8/19) - her 58th minute attempt resulted in a handball in the AWP box, which led to Laura Fuentes' game-winning PK. She picked up the first assists of her career in the team's 3-0 victory over USD (9/10). Dicus has played in and started in 18 games and played at least 90 minutes in 16 of those games. In 1,612 minutes has taken seven shots, including three against Colorado College, which equaled her single game career best, with four on frame
- **Hope Paredes** (Fr., MF, Irvine, Calif.) has earned 15 starts, including the last 11 games in a row. Her 13 shots are the sixth most on the team, and third among Aztec freshmen. In 1,144 minutes, second most among the freshmen on the squad, covering 18 appearances, she has put six shots on frame.
- **Sarah Funk** (Fr., F, El Cajon, Calif.) started in each of the first six matches, 10 in all, including the last three, and has appeared in all 19 this season. She has produced a single-game high three shots vs. Long Beach State (9/5). Funk has played 761 minutes, third most among Aztec freshmen (Denise Castro & Hope Paredes have played 1,252 & 1,144 minutes, respectively), and has produced 10 shots putting six on frame.
- **Malia Kaleiohi** (Sr., D, San Diego, Calif.) is back in 2021 having opted to utilize the extra year of eligibility offered by the NCAA due to the COVID-19 pandemic. Kaleiohi started the season's first six games, before sitting out the game at San Diego (9/10) and jumping back among the starters in the last 12. She has matched her career best with two assists this year (also in 2019), on Denise Castro's goal at Saint Mary's (8/26) & on an Anna Toohy goal vs. Utah State (10/3). She equaled her career best with four shots vs. Long Beach State (9/5) and for the season has attempted 13 shots overall with four on frame and has played single season career-high 1,509 minutes, fourth on the team in 18 matches. She has played at least 90 minutes in 10 games this season.
- In total, 11 freshmen/newcomers have seen field time for the Aztecs this season. In addition to Castro, Funk, Ocampo, and Paredes **Trinity Coker** (Fr., D, Poway, Calif.) has played 602 minutes in 19 games, including the first start of her college career, at San Diego (9/10). She recorded her first point of the campaign with an assist in the Nevada game (10/10) and has attempted 16 shots putting eight on frame. **Nichollette Palomo** (Fr., F, Cerritos, Calif.), in 10 appearances, and **Carlin Blake** (MF, Overland Park, Kan.), in 14 games, have played 113 & 356 minutes, respectively, and Blake has produced one shot. **Lily Davis** (So., D, San Diego, Calif.), a transfer from Indiana, has played in four matches and a total of 130 minutes. **Olivia Sekimoto** (So., MF/F, Chula Vista, Calif.), a transfer from American University, has played 241 minutes in nine appearances, including her first start as an Aztec, vs. No. 3 UCLA (9/19), and has taken two shots. **Jenna West** (Fr., D, Concord, Calif.) made her Aztec debut at San Diego (9/10) and has played a total of 42 minutes in five appearances and produced her first collegiate shot vs. Air Force (10/21). **Emily Lowe** (RFR., F/MF, San Clemente, Calif.) made her first appearance for San Diego State in 14 minutes against Utah State (10/3) and has appeared in a total of four matches playing a total of 47 minutes
- In four of the team's 19 games, the Aztecs have had three freshmen in its starting lineup. At Saint Mary's (8/26), vs. Washington State (9/2), & vs. Long Beach State (9/5) freshmen **Denise Castro**, **Sarah Funk** and **Hope Paredes** earned starting assignments and at San Diego (9/10) **Trinity Coker** (F, D, Poway, Calif.), Castro & Paredes all started. Prior to the Saint Mary's game, the last time the Aztecs started three freshmen was in the championship match of the 2019 Mountain West Tournament (Nov. 19, 2019) when, then freshmen **Kiera Utush** (D, Rocklin, Calif.), **Jessica Sanders** (D, Belmont, Calif.) & **Rachelle Elve** (F, Huntington Beach, Calif.) earned starting assignments. San Diego State has not had a starting lineup without at least two freshmen/newcomers this season.

General Notes

- **Laura Fuentes** (Sr., MF, Newark, Calif.) has become the Aztecs' iron lady, starting in all 69 games of her college career. **Claire Watkins** (Jr., D, San Diego, Calif.), currently owns the second-longest active consecutive start streak with 30. The 30 straight starting assignments for Watkins covers her entire Aztec career. **Emma Gaines-Ramos** (So., F, San Diego, Calif.) did not start against Boise State (10/1), which snapped a streak of 22 consecutive starts to begin her career and **Alexa Madueno** (So., GK, Woodland, Calif.), who did not play at Fresno State (10/14) or the four games since, which ended a 25 game starting streak to open her collegiate career.
- The Aztecs opened the regular season on August 19 with a 1-0 victory over Army West Point. The win improved the program's record in season openers, on its home pitch, to 15-6-1. Since 2007, when head coach **Mike Friesen** assumed leadership of the program, SDSU is 7-3-1 in games which opened a season on the Sports Deck. Those three losses are all to Power-5 programs, and two of those

programs went on to appear in that season's NCAA Tournament (UCLA in 2016 & Texas Tech in 2019). Now in its 33rd year of competition, the Aztecs are 18-14-1 overall in season openers, regardless of location.

- When San Diego State swept the weekend series against Boise State (10/1) and Utah State (10/3) it marked the only time this season the team had earned back-to-back victories. It was the first time in 12 games, dating back to the last game of the 2020 season, that San Diego State had won back-to-back contests and just the fifth time in the last 15 years the Aztecs went more than nine games without back-to-back decisions. It was the third longest consecutive games streak without back-to-back wins since head coach Mike Friesen assumed leadership of the program. The only longer streaks were 15 games from Nov. 15, 2009 to Oct. 16, 2010 and 28 games from Nov. 10, 2017 to Oct. 4, 2019.
- San Diego State was picked to finish in second place in the MW coaches' preseason poll. It marked the 11th time in 12 seasons the Aztecs have been picked to finish in either first or second place. The only time SDSU was lower than second place in the preseason poll in the last 12 years was in 2019, a year in which the Aztecs were predicted to finish fourth. That team went 10-9-1, shared the Mountain West regular-season title at 8-2-0, and reached the championship game of the league tournament.
- Having won five of the last nine regular-season titles, not including the 2020 season in which the league was divided into two divisions and the Aztecs earned the West Division title, SDSU finds itself not the favorite in the eyes of the conference's head coaches for just the second time in the last nine years.
- With its 3-0 decision at San Diego (9/10), San Diego State snapped a five-game slide, the longest winless streak for the program since head coach **Mike Friesen** took control of the program in 2007, covering 292 games. In the program's 33 years of existence (634 games played entering this weekend's matches), the longest winless streak is a six-games in the 2000 campaign.

Boise State

The Broncos are 10-6-3 overall, and finished at 4-4-3 in Mountain West action and qualified as the No. 6-seed in the MW championship tournament... Boise State is 7-1-1 at home this year and 3-1-1 in home league games... Entering the week, Keile Hansen (5G, 1A, 11 PTS) leads the side in goals, points, and is 2-of-2 in PKs... Stone Morgan (3G, 1A, 7 PTS) leads the team in shots (41) and shots on goal (13)... Keeper Sydney Smith (0.96 GAA, .750 SV%) had posted a 6-4-2 record, while playing 1130:24 of 1794:10 this season coming into this week's action... Jim Thomas is in his ninth season at the helm of the program.

Fresno State

The Bulldogs are 9-6-3 overall, and finished at 7-3-1 in Mountain West play and qualified as the No. 2-seed in the MW championship tournament... Fresno State is 0-0-0 in neutral site games this year, but is 4-5-1 in games away from home... Cassandra Ceja (8G, 4A, 20 PTS) leads the team in goals, assists, points, shots (35) and shots on goal (16)... Ceja has three game winners, which also leads the squad... The Bulldogs have used three keepers this season with Ella Wilson (1.17 GAA, .740 SV%) earning the majority (998:52) of the team's 1697:20 of action... Brian Zwasczka is in his 13th season at the helm of the program and brought a 90-108-32 record into the 2021 season.

SAN DIEGO — Senior Laura Fuentes scored on a penalty kick in the 58th minute against the Army West Point Black Knights to send the San Diego State women's soccer team a 1-0 victory in each team's season opener. The win improved the Aztecs record in season openers on SDSU's home field to 15-6-1.

Fuentes, a senior out of Newark, Calif., got the keeper to go left and slotted the ball low to the right to convert the PK. She is a perfect 4-of-4 in penalty kicks for her career. The attempt was set up by fellow senior Lauren Dicus, who with the ball in the Army West Point box, attempted a pass which one of the Black Knights touched with her hand. The ball was placed on the spot and Fuentes took care of the rest.

The first 45 minutes were fairly even, especially on the stat sheet. The Aztecs out shot Army West Point 5-4 and had a couple of dangerous chances which they were unable to convert.

In the 29th minute, Anna Toohey, who was just inside the left corner of the box, took a pass from Fuentes, who was at the top of the 18. Toohey showed the ball to a defender, then took it back and drove around her. She fired a shot across the face of the goal from 15 yards out which the Black Knight's keeper had no chance to stop.

Later in the period, Malia Kaleiohi got free down the right side and served the ball into the six toward a crashing Emma Gaines-Ramos. Gaines-Ramos was driving to the back post, but the ball was just out of her reach and the teams went to the intermission tied at 0-0.

"We knew Army was going to be very organized, have a plan, stick to that plan," head coach Mike Friesen said. "We were prepared for a lot of what they did in the first half, but we just didn't follow through on our game plan. One of the things they did was to step up and squeeze us and we didn't play over the top of them. That was one of the things we talked about at half time and in the first 15 seconds of the second half, we played behind them and that really opened the game up."

On the play that turned the game, center defender Kiera Utush took possession in Aztec territory and played a ball deep down the middle of the field. Sarah Funk, a freshman forward, ran onto it, laid it off for Toohey who gave it right back, but the Black Knight's keeper Sage Strohm charged off her line and dove on the ball to smother the play.

Then in the 53rd minute, Fuentes, on the left side of the box, took a cross from Funk, settled it and then fired a shot just over the crossbar. Finally, at the 57:38 mark, her PK attempt found the back of the net for what would eventually be the game winner.

San Diego State continued to press its advantage for the next 20-plus minutes and produced 12 of the team's total of 15 shots through the first 80 minutes.

However, in the final 10 minutes, the Black Knights turned up the pressure. They took six of their seven shots in the half in that time span and forced Aztecs' keeper Alexa Madueno to make the three saves she had in the second half. None was more important than a stop at the 82:18 mark. Army West Point's Keira Vesey found the ball 10 yards out on the left side of the box and fired a shot which would have tied the game, but Madueno dove to her left and punched it over the end line to preserve the 1-0 lead.

For the game, Madueno made four saves and earned the fourth clean sheet of her San Diego State career.

SAN DIEGO — The San Diego State women's soccer team surrendered an own goal less than five minutes into its contest against the Pepperdine Waves and was never able to claw its way back into the game, falling 3-0 on Sunday evening on the SDSU Sports Deck. It was the team's first home loss since a 0-1 decision to San Diego on Sept. 13, 2019.

"I thought we played a really good game," said head coach Mike Friesen. "We had an own goal, and they scored on a defensive mistake and a PK. It (the second score) was a silly goal to give away, but nothing too special that they did. (Pepperdine) is a very experienced team and that's why we played this game, so that we know what it takes to play at that level."

The first goal came at the 4:55 mark. Pepperdine's Leyla McFarland fired off a shot from a very tight angle on the left side of the goal. SDSU keeper Alexa Madueno got a hand on the ball, but couldn't control it and it deflected into the net, staking the Waves to a 1-0 advantage.

For most of the first 45 minutes, Pepperdine (2-0-0) had the advantage in the run of play, outshooting the Aztecs 8-of-4. Malia Kaleiohi, Daniela Filipovic, Alexys Ocampo and Laura Fuentes produced the team's shots while Fuentes' attempts at the 8:50 mark the only shot on goal San Diego State (1-1-0) would get in the game. The sides went to intermission with the Waves up 1-0.

In the second half, Pepperdine got a goal in the 53rd minute from McFarland. Tori Waldeck attempted a shot, which Madueno stopped, but was unable to control. McFarland found herself in the right place at the right time and popped the ball over a sprawled Madueno to make it 2-0.

In the 60th minute, a Pepperdine player was fouled in the box and Trinity Watson scored low to her left on a penalty kick to make it 3-0, which would be the final score.

"I thought in the last 20 minutes we were fantastic," Friesen said. "This was the first time that really everybody stepped up and played the way we want to play, so that is huge to build on. I'm excited about where we can go from here, but disappointed with the result. But we play these games because they put us in a good spot to get to the postseason. This is a team (Pepperdine) that returned pretty much everyone from last year, and picked up some great transfers, etc. It was good for our team to see the experience and composure they have, the willingness to do for the team whatever it takes to get a win. I thought we grew in the game and later we were very good. We had some quality chances in the first half; we just didn't put them away."

When the final whistle blew, the Aztecs had been outshot 19-to-6 and Pepperdine put eight shots on frame to SDSU's one. Madueno (1-1-0) made six saves, one off her career high.

In addition to the first-half shots of Kaleiohi, Fuentes, Filipovic and Ocampo, Hope Paredes produced both Aztecs second half shots.

San Diego State played nine newcomers, including seven true freshmen.

MORAGA, Calif. — Freshman Denise Castro scored the first goal of her college career and staked the San Diego State women's soccer team to a 1-0 lead in the 34th minute, but after having a player sent off in the 66th minute, the Aztecs surrendered a pair of goals to the Saint Mary's and lost its game 2-1.

The teams spent the first 15 minutes feeling each other out, but in the 17th minute, the Aztecs produced the first dangerous chance. Emma Gaines-Ramos, on a corner, sent the ball across the face of the goal where Claire Watkins, who was crashing at the far post, got a head on it, but the attempt was just wide.

Then at the 33:37 mark, San Diego State (1-2-0) struck. A ball was played through the box and was left to harmlessly roll into touch by everyone but Malia Kaleiohi. Kaleiohi raced to the corner to keep it in bounds. She then played a give-and-go with Alexys Ocampo and found Laura Fuentes about 10 yards outside the 18. Fuentes served it to Denise Castro just outside the six-yard box. Castro settled the pass with a touch and hammered a shot off her left foot which was past the Gaels keeper before she could even move. The tally opened the San Ysidro, Calif., native's collegiate account and both Kaleiohi and Fuentes were credited with assists.

For the half, Saint Mary's (3-0-0) outshot the Aztecs 7-to-2, but the score remained 1-0 through the intermission and into the second half.

The Gaels first dangerous chance came in the 50th minute when a shot from Vanessa Gaitan flashed across the goal face and just outside the far post. In the 55th minute a Saint Mary's striker got loose behind the defense, but the Aztec defense recovered, and her shot attempt went harmlessly wide right.

At the 65:05 mark, Hope Paredes, who earned the first start of her career in the game, made a hard side tackle on a Gael and was sent off with a red card. The Aztecs played the remaining 24-plus minutes a player down.

Saint Mary's found the equalizer in the 74th minute. Annamaria DiGeronimo played a long through ball to Alexis Gutierrez who got behind the Aztecs defense and shot low to the right corner of the goal.

In the 84th minute, the Gaels took the lead on an Isabella Santavicca tally. She got the ball inside box, behind the defense. San Diego State keeper Alexa Madueno charged Santavicca and when the two met at the top of the six-yard box, the ball slowly rolled off Santavicca's foot and trickled into the goal for what would be the game winner.

For the game Saint Mary's outshot the Aztecs 18-to-3, with Madueno making a career-high eight saves. In addition to Castro's goal and Watkins' header, Gaines-Ramos produced SDSU's third shot.

THE NOTE

The Aztecs started three freshmen in a regular-season game, Sarah Funk, Denise Castro & Hope Paredes, for the first time this year and the first time since the title match of the Mountain West Championship game on Nov. 9, 2019.

STANFORD, Calif. — San Diego State women's soccer keeper Alexa Madueno made a career-high 14 saves on Sunday at No. 13 Stanford, but the Cardinal offense was too potent, producing 44 shots and earning a 6-0 decision over the Aztecs at Laird Q. Cagan Stadium.

Madueno was two saves from equaling the program record for a match, which was set by Aubree Southwick at Oregon State on Sept. 19, 2010, who made 16 saves against the Beavers. The sophomore out of Woodland, Calif., eclipsed her previous single-game high of nine stops, which she totaled at Saint Mary's on Thursday afternoon.

Stanford's 44 shot attempts are the most an Aztecs opponent has produced since Penn State got off 29 in a 3-0 win at San Diego State on Sept. 9, 2016.

Facing a Stanford (3-0-0) team that produced 29 shots and beat CSUN 7-0 on Thursday, the Aztecs attempted to pack the box against the No. 13 Cardinal, but in the end the Stanford firepower proved to be the difference.

The Cardinal produced the first 12 shots in the game, and on its 13th attempt its broke though. Off a cross in the 22nd minute, there was a scramble in front of the goal. Belle Briede was able to collect it and slot the ball past Madueno for a 1-0 lead.

Between that score and a tally with 20 seconds left prior to the intermission, Madueno stopped nine Cardinal shots, already a career-high in saves. The second Stanford goal, at the 44:40 mark, was off the foot of Andrea Kitahata and the teams went to halftime with the Cardinal leading 2-0. In the first 45 minutes, which was almost exclusively played in the Aztecs (1-3-0) half of the field, Stanford produced 25 shots while holding San Diego State without an attempt.

Kitahata scored at the 48:40 mark to extend the Stanford lead to 3-0 early in the second half. The Cardinal then added goals in the 72nd, 81st and 85th minutes for the 6-0 decision.

The Aztecs' most dangerous opportunity came in the 49th minute. Denise Castro, from the left side of the 18-yard box, played give and go with Sarah Funk, seven yards outside the top of the box. Funk's return pass to Castro was right on the mark. Castro one-timed it, but Sanford keeper Katie Meyer was up to the challenge.

Castro, a midfielder, led the side with two shots, both on frame. Emma Gaines-Ramos & Rachelle Elve, both strikers, took one shot each and both put their attempts on goal. Midfielder Laura Fuentes & forward Sarah Funk each took one shot.

Alexa Madueno's 14 saves are a career-high and two off the program record.

SAN DIEGO — The San Diego State women's soccer team played the Washington State Cougars nearly straight up for the first 85 minutes, allowing only one goal, but a pair of late Cougars tallies put the game away in a 3-0 win over the Aztecs on the SDSU Sports Deck on Thursday night.

San Diego State (1-4-0) saw the Cougars attempt the game's first two shots, before Emma Gaines-Ramos pulled the trigger in the ninth minute. The shot went just wide left of the goal.

Seven minutes later, Washington State (2-0-1) got the game's initial goal, at the 16:42 mark, when Enzi Broussard collected a ball on the right side of the box and played it to the far post. Sydney Struder headed it in behind Aztecs' keeper Alexa Madueno for a 1-0 lead.

The score would remain 1-0 through the end of the first half with the Cougars out shooting SDSU 8-to-1 and Madueno making two saves.

The second half would see more of the same, Washington State would outshoot the Aztecs 11-to-2 and Madueno would make seven saves, but despite the disparity in stats, San Diego State kept playing hard and proving difficult for the Cougars to handle.

However, in the 86th minute Grayson Lynch would score the first of her two late goals to put the game out of reach. She was assisted on the first by Elyse Bennett and scored the second, unassisted, in the 88th minute.

For the game the Aztecs were outshot 19-to-3. Gaines-Ramos produced two shots and Trinity Coker attempted the other in the 78th minute, which was the only shot to reach the line of the Washington State keeper Marissa Zucchetto.

Madueno made nine saves, many simply spectacular, to keep the Aztecs in the game. In the last three games, she has made eight, 14 and nine saves and for the year has 41. Entering the game, the sophomore out of Woodland, Calif., ranked No. 11 in the nation in saves per game (8.00) and No. 4 in total saves (32), both of which should move her up the rankings after Thursday evening's performance.

After the Washington State game, Alexa Madueno leads the Mountain West in saves with 41. The No. 2 ranked keeper in the league has 18 saves.

SAN DIEGO — San Diego State generated season-highs in shots and shots on goal, but it wasn't enough to secure a victory as the women's soccer team fell to Long Beach State 2-1 on Sunday night at the SDSU Sports Deck.

The Aztecs (1-5-0) produced 19 shots and put seven on frame, including an 83rd minute goal from freshman Denise Castro to cut a two-goal deficit in half, but time ran out on San Diego State, which lost its fifth game in a row, its longest slide since the 2001 season.

The 19 shots, the most since the season opener in which San Diego State attempted 15, were more than the team had produced in its last four games combined (18). Malia Kaleiohi and Hope Paredes led the charge with four shots each. Sarah Funk took three shots, while Castro, Kiera Utush and Trinity Coker each produced two shots. Lauren Dicus and Taylor Moorehead attempted a shot a piece.

The Aztecs came out on fire. They dominated the run of play for the majority of the first half and outshot Long Beach State 8-to-2 in the first 45 minutes. But a hard tackle in the box by Utush in the 36th minute, generated a yellow card for San Diego State and penalty kick for the Beach (3-2-0). Lena Silano took the PK and slotted it low to Alexa Madueno's left to give Long Beach State a 1-0 lead.

In the second half, the Aztecs continued to produce more and better chances, outshooting Long Beach State 11-to-6, but were unable to convert them into goals for more than 35 minutes.

In the 60th minute, Long Beach State got what would turn out to be the game winner off a corner. Kaylee Ramirez played the ball to the far post where Silano headed back across the goal and in for a 2-0 advantage.

The Aztecs finally broke through at the 82:06 mark, ending a scoreless streak of 318:29 dating back to Castro's goal at Saint Mary's on August 26. The freshman from San Ysidro, Calif, picked up a loose ball at the top of the box and hammered a shot into the upper right corner for her second goal of the year.

Alexa Madueno, who entered the game leading the nation in saves (41), had a relatively quiet night totaling three stops, well below her 8.2 saves per game entering the contest.

SAN DIEGO — The San Diego State women's soccer team had scored three goals in its first six games, covering 540 minutes, but in just under 55 minutes on Friday night at San Diego, freshman Denise Castro equaled that goal total and sent the Aztecs to a 3-0 victory.

Castro scored in the 29th, 35th and 55th minute to become the third freshman to accomplish the feat in an SDSU uniform, and the first to do it since Kim Castellanos had a pair of hat tricks in her initial campaign on The Mesa in the 2000 season. The only other freshman to score three times in a game for San Diego State was Lori LaCourse who did it in the 1996 season.

The victory snapped a five-game skid, which had equaled the second longest losing streak in program history, as well as halting a six-game slide for the team in games played on the Toreros' home field. The last time the Aztecs had won at USD was in a 4-2 decision on October 7, 1998.

In addition to Castro's offensive output, sophomore keeper Alexa Madueno, who entered the week ranked No. 2 in the nation with 44 saves, recorded her second clean sheet of the year while stopping all five Toreros' shots which reached her line.

The team's played a statistically equal first half, both producing four shots. The difference was Castro.

In the 29th minute, senior striker Anna Toohey fed the ball to Castro at the top of the 18. Castro turned and fired a right footed shot low to the far post. At the time it was her team leading third goal and Toohey picked up her first assist of the season.

Then, at the 34:37 mark, Castro struck again. This time senior defender Lauren Dicus took a pass down the right side, played it into the box where, with one touch, the San Ysidro, Calif., native turned and fired a shot between the legs of Toreros' keeper Judith Sorribes to double the Aztecs lead. It was Dicus' first assist as an Aztec and the teams went to intermission with San Diego State holding a 2-0 advantage.

If two goals are good, three are better.

In the 55th minute, Castro got the hat trick. From midfield, junior defender Claire Watkins passed down the right side to Toohey who crossed it into Castro, who was crashing the goal. With one touch of her left foot, she slotted it in for her third goal of the game.

From there, the Aztecs defense took over and kept San Diego off the board for the next 35 minutes to secure the shutout victory.

The Aztecs offense was very efficient at San Diego, they produced seven shots (four from Castro, two from Emma Gaines-Ramos and one from Taylor Moorehead) and scored on three of them. The Toreros attempted 14 shots led by Aryssa Mahrt's four.

THE NOTE

Denise Castro is the third freshman in San Diego State history to record a hat trick, and is the first freshman to do all the team's scoring in the game in which she had her hat trick.

SAN DIEGO — The San Diego State women's soccer team battled the No. 3 team in the nation, the UCLA Bruins, on Sunday night on the Sports Deck and kept it a one goal game into the 72nd minute, before ultimately falling 2-0.

The Bruins got a 10th minute goal from Mia Fishel to take an early lead, but were held off the scoreboard for the next 60-plus minutes by the Aztecs defense.

Reigning Mountain West Defensive Player of the Week Alexa Madueno, who is averaging seven saves per game through the first seven contests, stopped six of the eight shots which reached her line against the Bruins. She now has 55 saves through eight games and is on pace to shatter the program's single season record which is held by Aubree Southwick who had 106 saves in 2007.

"Our growth has been tremendous," Aztec coach Mike Friesen said. "It is hard to see that sometimes when our record is 2-6, but where we are as a team compared to where we were on day one is phenomenal. One thing I promised all our players is that you will have adversity. I might have over delivered on that, but I told the team I intentionally put together a difficult schedule. I wasn't intending it to be this difficult because some of the teams we thought would be good, are really good, which has really made us better. One of the things I am most proud of this team is that they are together, they are excited, they are playing at a high level. We just have to do some little things to continue to get better and grow. But I'm really excited about the next steps, conference play, and I think we have put ourselves in a position to compete at a really high level."

The Bruins (8-0-0) produced three shots before Fishel found the back of the net and held the Aztecs without a shot in the first 45 minutes while totaling 11 attempts of their own.

In the 50th minute, Emma Gaines-Ramos produced the Aztecs first dangerous chance with a shot from the top of the 18 which Bruins keeper Lauren Brzykcy got her mitts on to make the save. FORT COLLINS, Colo. — Alexys Ocampo, a freshman striker, scored in the 43rd minute of San Diego State women's soccer's Mountain West opener and the Aztecs made the goal stand up in a 1-0 decision over Colorado State on Friday afternoon.

The Aztecs (3-6-0, 1-0-0 Mountain West) dominated the run of play and possession throughout the game, holding a 62-to-38 percent advantage in time of possession. Colorado State (1-3-2, 0-1-0 Mountain West), wary of SDSU's potent offense, chose to pack it in defensively in its own end and play a dump and chase style offense, hoping to catch San Diego State napping.

CSU only had two dangerous opportunities in the game, both coming in the first half and both off long passes where they got behind the Aztec back line and one-on-one with keeper Alexa Madueno. However, both opportunities were denied.

The first and most dangerous came just before a diving save by Madueno in the 25th minute. The second, in the 37th minute, ended with a harmless shot right at Madueno. In the match, Madueno, who entered the game ranked No. 1 in the MW and No. 1-11 in the nation in saves, totaled two against the Rams, earned her third clean sheet of the season and fifth of her career.

The Aztecs, playing at altitude for the first time this season, substituted freely. They used 20 players in the game and took a methodical approach to its offense. San Diego State played a possession game, which paid off at the 42:00 mark. On the receiving end of a cross in front of the far post, Laura Fuentes was dispossessed of the ball. But it came right to Ocampo, three yards away, who then powered it into the upper right corner for the first goal of her college career and a 1-0 Aztecs lead.

In the second half, San Diego State produced 11 of its 20 total shots in the game, and Anna Toohey had the only real dangerous chance for either team. In the 76th minute, the senior out of Winston-Salem, N.C., got behind the defense and ran onto a pass in the Rams half of the field. She looked to score but just as she was shooting, two Colorado State defenders and the CSU keeper converged on her, knocking her to the ground and the ball over the end line.

For the game, Toohey led the attack for San Diego State with four shots. Malia Kaleiohi and Denise Castro, just back with the team after competing for the U-20 Mexican National Team in Holland, took three shots each. Ocampo, Emma Gaines-Ramos, and Jessica Sanders each produced a pair of shots with Laura Fuentes, Kiera Utush, Daniela Filipovic and Rachelle Elve taking a shot each.

CSU's Kristen Noonan paced her team with four shots.

LARAMIE, Wyo. — Coming off a victory at Colorado State to open Mountain West play on Friday, the San Diego State women's soccer team couldn't maintain that momentum at Wyoming and lost 3-1 to the Cowgirls at the Louis S. Madrid Sports Complex.

The Aztecs produced a season-high 20 shots two days ago in Fort Collins, Colo., but managed just eight in Laramie on Sunday to wrap up what is one of the toughest road trips in the Mountain West, back-to-back games at elevation.

San Diego State (3-7-0, 1-1-0 Mountain West) had two dangerous chances in the game with the first coming in the opening minute. From the left side of the pitch, Hope Paredes fired a bullet that Cowgirls keeper Hannah Lee just got a hand on to save Wyoming from going down 1-0.

The second dangerous chance came in the 32nd minute with the Aztecs already down 1-0. Daniela Filipovic placed a high lob from the top right corner of the box to the far post. The ball sailed over one Aztec and a Wyoming defender and right onto the foot of Rachelle Elve who fired it into the back of the net for the equalizer. Elve, who had 10 career goals before today, came into this season as the Mountain West's highest scoring player in the last two years who returned in 2021. Sunday's strike was her first goal of the season and Filipovic picked up her first assists of the campaign as well.

Less than six minutes later, at the 36:00 mark, Wyoming (5-4-1, 1-1-0 Mountain West) retook the lead for good. Savannah Warner beat Aztec keeper Alexa Madueno for a 2-1 lead, which was the score as the teams went to the intermission.

The Cowgirls got an insurance goal at the 48:47 mark and then played out the game for the 3-1 victory. Denise Castro led the Aztecs with three shots. Elve, Malia Kaleiohi, Hope Paredes, Claire Watkins, and Alexys Ocampo produced one shot each. Madueno made four saves in the loss.

Wyoming, which produced 17 shots, was led by three players, Jamie Tatum, Alyssa Bedard and Maddie Chance, with three shots. Lee made three saves to earn the win.

SAN DIEGO — The San Diego State women's soccer team scored twice in the first half and then the defense took care of the rest of the game as the Aztecs shutout the Boise State Broncos 2-0 in a Mountain West Conference match on Friday night on the Sports Deck.

"We really played as a team," Aztec head coach Mike Friesen said. "I thought one of the biggest things tonight was a sense of unity and togetherness. We talked a lot about being able to get forward. I thought we did that well early, and we were on the front foot for a lot of the game. Boise State is a very good team, so they certainly had their moments as well, but I thought we did a good job and just making sure that everybody did their job but had each other's backs."

The Broncos (7-3-1, 1-1-1 MW) got off a pair of shots in the first 10 minutes, but then San Diego State 4-7-0, 2-1-0 MW) took over. In the remaining 35 minutes of the first half the Aztecs outshot Boise State 9-to-1 and struck twice.

In the 19th minute, Laura Fuentes picked up a ball about 30 yards out from Daniela Filipovic, turned and drove down the middle of the field. At the spot Rachelle Elve and Denise Castro were bookended around the last Boise State defender. Fuentes laid the ball off to her right to Castro, who took a touch and as the defender turned to her, passed to Elve with the heel of her boot. Elve took it and one timed it to beat the Broncos keeper through her legs for a 1-0 lead. It was Elve's second goal in as many games, and Fuentes and Castro picked up assists on the strike. Just ten minutes later the Aztecs doubled the advantage.

At the 29:23 mark, Emma Gaines-Ramos got a pass on the left sideline from Anna Toohey who was at midfield. Gaines-Ramos drove across the field and from 40 yards out threaded the needle, with a pinpoint pass to Castro, who was 15 yards out on the right side of the box. Castro weaved around one defender and fired a left footed shot low past the charging Boise State keeper to make it 2-0. It was her team-leading sixth goal of the season. Gaines-Ramos got an assist, her first point of the campaign.

The second half started similarly to the first. Boise State produced five of its eight second half shots in the first 20 minutes, but from there San Diego State settled things down and played a possession game. They limited the Broncos to just three shot attempts in the final 25 minutes and only one dangerous opportunity.

Off a Boise State corner in the 82nd minute, the Broncos got a header from point blank range and it looked to be going into the top corner, just inside the far post. But San Diego State keeper Alexa Madueno, in what has seemingly become commonplace, made a spectacular, one-handed stop to deny the goal and preserve the shutout.

In the game, Madueno faced 11 shots and turned away all three that reached her line to earn her fourth clean sheet of the year and second in the team's three league games.

Castro led the Aztecs offense with a season-high seven shots. Alexys Ocampo and Gaines-Ramos each took two shots, while Fuentes, Toohey and Elve produced one shot each.

SAN DIEGO — The San Diego State women's soccer team defended its home field this weekend with a pair of victories, the second coming on Sunday on goals from strikers Emma Gaines-Ramos and Anna Toohey in a 2-0 decision over the Utah State Aggies.

"This is a big weekend for us," Aztec head coach Mike Friesen said. "(Boise State and Utah State) are two teams that you know are going to be in the top of the table with Boise on Friday, which was an emotional win. To come back today, have a hot day and struggle a little bit physically in the first half, I thought we did a really good job in the second half of creating opportunities and finishing a couple of them, so I'm really pleased with where we're at."

For the third time in four Mountain West contests, and second time this weekend, sophomore keeper Alexa Madueno was a wall in goal. Against the Aggies (9-3-1, 2-2-0 MW), she recorded her fifth clean sheet of the season and third in league play. In four Mountain West contests, Madueno has a 0.75 GAA and has stopped 11 of the 14 shots which have reached her line (.786 save percentage). Utah State was not able to put a shot on frame until the 68th minute and managed only two shots on goal among the six attempts they produced.

The teams played a fairly even first 45 minutes with the Aztecs outshooting Utah State 7-to-4, including putting four shots on goal. The most dangerous opportunity for San Diego State in the first half came in the 37th minute. Sarah Funk fed Denise Castro who was five yards out and right in front of the goal, but Castro's shot sailed right into the hands of Aggies keeper Diera Walton and the sides went to the intermission tied 0-0.

In the second half, San Diego State (5-7-0, 3-1-0 MW) came out with more purpose, and it took just 13 minutes to put the first goal on the board.

Gaines-Ramos drove down the left side of the field and into the box. Walton came charging off her line and met Gaines-Ramos and the ball at the corner of the six. Walton tried to stop the attack by smothering the ball but couldn't. Gaines-Ramos picked up possession again and from an impossible angle, tucked the ball into the open goal. It gave the Aztecs a 1-0 lead and was the first goal of the sophomore's collegiate career.

The score remained 1-0 for the next 15 minutes, until Toohey made it 2-0.

She struck at the 72:06 mark, picking up her first goal of the campaign. On the left side of the pitch, Malia Kaleiohi threw the ball in to Laura Fuentes, who gave it right back to Kaleiohi. The senior then drove toward the center of the field and played a perfect ball into the box. It looked like Olivia Sekimoto would get a boot it and Aggies keeper Walton thought so too.

However, the ball bounced over Sekimoto's foot and Walton, looking for a deflection, couldn't smother it. The ball trickled past her and right onto the foot of Toohey, who tucked it inside the near post for an insurance goal.

From there, San Diego State cruised to the victory.

LAS VEGAS — In what was an evenly played match on Friday night, senior forward Anna Toohey was the difference as her 91st minute goal gave the San Diego State women's soccer team a 1-0 overtime victory over the UNLV Rebels.

In the early moments of overtime, the teams exchanged possession in the midfield. Trinity Coker had a throw in at midfield, and found Sarah Funk, who gave it back to her. Coker then played a long ball down the left touchline to Emma Gaines-Ramos. Gaines-Ramos collected the ball and drove toward the goal.

At about 10 yards outside the six, Gaines-Ramos played the ball toward the far post. Toohey was crashing the goal and she met Rebels' keeper Riley Liebsack right on the doorstep. Toohey forced the ball past Liebsack and in for her second goal in as many games and her first game winner of the season.

Keeper Alexa Madueno had five saves and picked up her fourth clean sheet in five Mountain West games. Additionally, it was her sixth clean sheet of the campaign. Every one of the team's victories this year have come on a Madueno shutout. The sophomore is one shutout shy of entering the top-10 of the program's single-season and career shutouts list.

For the game San Diego State (6-7-0, 4-1-0 MW) was outshot 15-to-14, but critically had the only shot in overtime, and the only shot that ended up counting. Denise Castro led the offensive attack with three shots, putting two on frame. Malia Kaleiohi, Laura Fuentes and Toohey each produced two shots, with Kaleiohi and Toohey putting single shots on goal. Hope Paredes, Daniela Filipovic, Trinity Coker, Sarah Funk and Gaines-Ramos each got one shot off and Gaines-Ramos was credited with the assist on Toohey's goal.

In the 90 minutes of regulation, the game was played fairly evenly, but the second half saw more dangerous chances from both sides.

The Aztecs had four great looks in the second half. In the 58th minute, Toohey unloaded a shot which had the keeper beaten, but was just over the crossbar. In the 65th minute, Coker uncorked a shot from the left side of the box. It was going to be a goal, but for a diving save from Liebsack to preserve the 0-0 tie.

Then in the 88th minute, Castro had a free kick which she placed into the box, but just beyond the reach of Toohey. The play resulted in a corner for the Aztecs, on which Kaleiohi attempted a shot that was saved by Liebsack.

In the final 15 minutes UNLV (8-6-0, 1-4-0 MW) produced five shots as it grabbed the momentum. Two were saved by Madeuno and both center defender Kiera Utush and midfielder Filipovic made spectacular plays on the back line to thwart what appeared to be a UNLV attacker going in one-on-one against Madeuno.

RENO, Nev. — San Diego State's women's soccer team got a pair of first half goals, but couldn't make them stand up and lost the Nevada Wolf Pack 2-3 on Sunday afternoon in Mackay Stadium.

The loss leaves the Aztecs with a 6-8-0 overall record, 4-2-0 in Mountain West play while Nevada improves to 3-8-2, 2-2-0 in league action. The loss is that much more of a gut punch since both Fresno State and New Mexico, the two teams ahead of San Diego State in the standings, lost their Sunday matches.

It was a game of halves with the Aztecs controlling the run of play throughout the first half. It paid dividends in the 20th minute on Denise Castro's first of two goals in the game. Anna Toohey picked up a loose ball about 30 yards out and fed Castro, who from 15 yards away, beat Kendal Stovall, the Nevada keeper, to make it 1-0. It was Castro's seventh goal of the campaign and Toohey's team-leading third assist of the year.

Eight and a half minutes later, Castro doubled the Aztec lead.

From the right corner, Emma Gaines-Ramos played the ball into the box and onto the foot of Trinity Coker, who arrived at the far post at the exact time as the ball. Coker pounded a shot inside the near post. Stovall stopped the attempt, but could not corral it. The ball trickled away from her, right in front of the goal. Castro pounced on it and slotted it in for her second tally of the half. It was Castro's eighth of the campaign and Coker was credited with an assist, the first of her collegiate career.

Castro now has eight goals on the year. Since the 2000 season, her eight strikes are tied for the third most on the program's freshman goal-scoring list. She is level with Jen Mello, who scored eight times in 2015, her freshman season, and sits two goals from equaling the record, which is currently held by Mia Root (2017) and Leah Pruitt (2015) who scored 10 goals in their freshman campaigns on The Mesa.

The second half belonged to Nevada.

The Wolf Pack got on the board after a 51st minute San Diego State giveaway in the midfield. Luz Arreaga scored to cut the lead in half. Then in the 78th minute, defender Lauren Dicus was assessed a penalty in the box. The foul put Nevada on the spot for a penalty kick and the possible equalizer. Penny Murphy converted the PK, low to her right, and with it, Nevada seemed to grab the momentum.

The dagger came on the Wolf Pack's 89th minute goal. Nevada's Emily Rich drove the ball into the box and attempted a shot, which was not going to go in, but Olivia Fothergill redirected the shot in for the go-ahead goal with 90 seconds to play.

The Aztecs outshot Nevada 12-to-11 with Castro leading the team with five shots, three on frame and two goals. Gaines-Ramos and Laura Fuentes produced two shots each while Dicus, Daniela Filipovic, and Claire Watkins took one shot each.

In goal, Alexa Madueno had one save, but surrendered three goals.

 San Diego State's loss after holding the lead was just its second this season and it snapped a four-game streak of getting a lead and holding it to earn a victory.

FRESNO, Calif. — On a 108th minute goal, the San Diego State women's soccer team lost a heartbreaker on Thursday night, 0-1 to the Fresno Bulldogs in a Mountain West Conference game.

Off a cross in the 108th minute, the Bulldogs got a shot right at the far post which Aztec keeper Cameron Illingworth saved, but was unable to smother. The ball ended up on the foot of Fresno State's Kaelyn Miller, who put it into the top of the net at the 107:20 mark to win it for the Bulldogs.

For the game, San Diego State (6-9-0, 4-3-0 Mountain West) and the Bulldogs attempted 15 shots a side, with the Aztecs holding a 7-to-6 advantage over Fresno State (7-4-3, 5-1-1 Mountain West) in shots on goal. Despite those close statistics, Fresno State controlled the run of play through possessing the ball 60 percent of the game.

In her first action in goal as an Aztec, Illingworth was up to the test. The sophomore from Santa Ana, Calif., who transferred from Kansas State this year, stopped five shots and had a clean sheet through 107 minutes.

The Aztecs had three players with three shots each led by freshmen Trinity Coker and Denise Castro as well as senior Anna Toohey. For Coker, the three shots are a season high. Emma Gaines-Ramos, Laura Fuentes, Hope Paredes, Daniela Filipovic, Taylor Moorehead and Sarah Funk produced a shot each. Castro led the side with three shots on goal.

In the first half, the Aztecs had the one really dangerous chance, and it came in the 22nd minute.

At the 21:48 mark, Lauren Dicus chipped a ball over the top and just behind the defense to a streaking Castro. Castro settled it, let two defenders run past her, and from the top of the box uncorked a left footed shot which the Fresno State keeper was able to smother.

After the first 45 minutes, the Aztecs had outshot Fresno State 6-to-4, putting four of those attempts on frame while Fresno State put two of its four shots on goal.

In the second half both offenses opened up and created good chances.

In the 59th minute, Fresno State's Jordan Brown hammered a shot from the top of the box, low to the near post, but Illingworth made a diving save to preserve the 0-0 tie.

At the 65:20 mark, Fresno State had a shot go off the crossbar and then, from a hard angle to the right of the goal, got a point-blank shot which Illingworth saved by deflecting over the end line.

In the 68th minute, Anna Toohey split the defense and got a shot off just inside the 18, which keeper Ella Wilson, who replaced Fresno State's starter Valentina Vivas at halftime, was able to coral before it went in.

At the end of regulation, SDSU still led in shots 14-to-11 and in shots on goal 6-to-4. The 8-to-1 disparity in fouls called against the Aztecs in the first 45 minutes had somewhat equalized, though the Aztecs still had three more than Fresno 12-to-9 at the end of regulation.

In the first overtime, each side took one shot, the Aztecs was on frame, but neither side could score.

In the second extra period, the Bulldogs got three shots off in the final minute and a half, with the last being the game winner.

SAN JOSE, Calif. — Sophomore keeper Cameron Illingworth made six saves, equaling her career-high, and recorded the first shutout of her collegiate career as the San Diego State Aztecs and San Jose State Spartans could not decide a winner in 110 minutes and finished in a 0-0 tie on Sunday afternoon.

Illingworth, who transferred from Kansas State after the 2020 season, made five saves in the two periods of regulation and one in the second overtime, equaling her career-high, which she set at Kansas State in a game against Texas on Oct. 9, 2020.

In two games this season, both double overtime affairs this weekend, the Santa Ana, Calif., native, had 11 saves in 217:20 for a goals against average of 0.41 and of the 30 shots she faced only one got past her.

San Diego State (6-9-1, 4-3-1 Mountain West) produced a season-high 21 shots with nearly half coming off the feet of Denise Castro (six) and Kiera Utush (four). The 21 shots are the most by the Aztecs since a 25-shot barrage in the 2020 season opener against Nevada on March 5, 2021.

The Aztecs had multiple chances to put a goal on the board, with the first coming in the ninth minute. Hope Paredes, taking a corner, played the ball to the back post. It was just out of the reach of Malia Kaleiohi who was alone at the far post and would have just needed one touch to put it in.

Then in the 13th minute, Denise Castro was dragged down in the box which gave the Aztecs a penalty kick. Laura Fuentes took the PK, but her attempt, which had Spartans keeper Autumn Monty beaten, went off the post to keep it 0-0.

Emma Gaines-Ramos, in the 33rd minute, played a beautiful pass to Alexys Ocampo who was making a long run toward the post on the opposite side of the field. Gaines-Ramos placed the ball just in front of Ocampo who one-timed a shot that went just over the crossbar.

After 45 minutes SDSU led 8-to-6 in shots, but San Jose State (7-8-1, 4-3-1 Mountain West) put three shots on goal to the Aztecs one.

Early in the second half, in the 54th minute, Trinity Coker took a shot from inside the box which Monty had to dive to her left to save. Off the ensuing corner, Castro took a shot at the far post, which Monty had to dive to the opposite direction to make another save.

Then in the 82nd minute, Castro had a shot from just outside the 18, which ricocheted off the far post to leave the score still at 0-0.

In the first extra period, San Diego State out shot the Spartans 3-to-1 and put two shots on frame, but were unable to score.

In the second overtime, the Aztecs, who controlled possession for nearly 60 percent of the game, again outshot San Jose State 4-to-1 and put three on goal. The final shot of the contest, a Trinity Coker attempt, was saved by Monty with just four seconds left and the game ended in a 0-0 tie.

In addition to Castro and Utush's combined ten shots, Coker and Laura Fuentes produced three shots each. Ocampo had two shots and Kaleiohi, Jessica Sanders and Sarah Funk took one shot apiece.

SAN DIEGO — Coming off a pair of tough double overtime decisions last weekend, a 0-1 loss at Fresno State and a 0-0 tie at San Jose State, the San Diego State women's soccer team was in need of a win and got it in the form of a 1-0 victory over the Air Force Falcons on Thursday night on the SDSU Sports Deck.

The victory vaults the Aztecs into a tie for second place in the conference standing with Fresno State, which will play at Nevada on Friday. Both teams trail New Mexico which defeated Colorado College 2-0 on Thursday night. The top six teams qualify for the conference tournament, which starts on Nov. 1, in Boise, Idaho.

The game was physical from the kickoff until the final whistle. There were five yellow cards issues, three of which were given to San Diego State (7-9-1, 5-3-1 Mountain West) players and of the 12 total fouls called, San Diego State was whistled for ten.

"Air Force is really gritty, and you never get a team that comes from there that is going to back down or back off," Aztec head coach Mike Friesen said. "The way they have been playing and the success they have had this year, we knew they were going to come right at us and be physical. Teams know that they have to do something to slow us down and they did that tonight by being physical with us, bumping us. The way the game was being called, allowing all the physicality helped them a bit. They did a good job adjusting to those things and made it difficult for us."

The lone goal of the game came at the 60:06 mark, and for the third time in the last six games the strike came off the right foot of senior Anna Toohy. Midfielder Daniela Filipovic had the ball just outside the right side of 18. Toohy made a run from the opposite side of the field and Filipovic played the ball right onto her foot at the top of the 18. Toohy didn't have to break stride and one-timed it inside the far post for her third goal of the year. Filipovic's assist was her second of the campaign and SDSU led 1-0.

"Anna scored a lot of goals for us late last year and we needed her tonight, especially with Denise (Castro) not with the team in this one," Friesen said. "I think we need to get (offense) from multiple players, so we are more difficult to shut down."

That offense produced 19 shots against Air Force (6-8-2, 3-5-1 Mountain West), led by Gaines-Ramos' four shots. Alexys Ocampo and Toohy produced three shots apiece while Malia Kaleiohi, Laura Fuentes, Lauren Dicus, Kiera Utush, Claire Watkins, Funk, Coker, Filipovic and Jenna West attempted a shot each.

In goal, Cameron Illingworth stopped all six shots that reached her line, recorded her second straight clean sheet and earned her first collegiate. She has started the last three games for the Aztecs and has a 1-1-1 record.

"We some of the best goalkeepers in the conference," Friesen said. "Alexa (Madueno) is injured right now, but we have Cameron, and she is a big-time keeper, too. I thought that she handled last weekend phenomenally, especially with short notice to get prepared to play. She has played three straight games, has given up one goal and both games last weekend went into overtime. She is a big-time keeper, who happened to have a big-time keeper playing in front of her. But when your moment arrives, you have to be ready, and she has been huge for us. I am really confident with her in there."

SAN DIEGO — With a chance to lock up a spot in the upcoming Mountain West tournament with a win, the San Diego State women's soccer team was shutout at home, 3-0, to the Colorado College Tigers on Sunday afternoon.

It was the first time since a 0-1 loss to Boise State on Oct. 7, 2018, that San Diego State (7-10-1, 5-4-1 Mountain West) has been held off the scoreboard in a league game on its home field, and it was the first time Colorado College (4-10-3, 3-4-3 Mountain West) won a game on the Sports Deck in six tries.

The Aztecs controlled the run of play in the first 20 minutes, with the vast majority of that time spent in the Tigers end of the field. San Diego State produced five shots in that time frame but would struggle in the final third of the field the rest of the day.

In the 25th minute, Colorado College got on the board. Off a corner kick, the ball was played to Jenna Wilt on the left side of the box. She attempted a shot which Aztecs keeper Cameron Illingworth deflected but did not control. As the ball trickled away from Illingworth, it came right to Tiger Camille Weaver who headed it in at the far post for a 1-0 lead.

Then at the 37:21-mark, Colorado College had a free kick from about 30 yards out. Abby Hubbard took the kick and sent it toward the goal, Illingworth was in position to make the save, but at the last second Kaelin Enga changed the direction of the ball just enough to get it past Illingworth and in for a 2-0 advantage.

The air came out of the crowd early in the second half.

In the 51st minute, Kiley Suter took one touch from about 25 yards out and fired a shot to the top corner of the far post. It was just outside of the reach of Illingworth and made the score 3-0. Adelaide Gaffney was credited with an assist on the play.

San Diego State's best chance to score came in the 66th minute, when Denise Castro took a short throughball from Olivia Sekimoto's and from 12 yards out pushed her shot attempt just right.

For the game the Aztecs attempted eight shots to Colorado College's ten.

Lauren Dicus led the attack with three shots, Emma Gaines-ramos, Alexys Ocampo, Hope Paredes, Daniela Filipovic and Castro produced one shot each. In goal, Illingworth had three saves and allowed three goals.

The Tigers' Wilt led her side with five shots and keeper Taryn Benham made four saves.

THE NOTE

Prior to today, San Diego State had not been shut out at home in a Mountain West contest since Oct. 7, 2018, a span of 1,113 days and 16 straight league contests.

SAN DIEGO — In her final game on the SDSU Sports Deck, senior striker Taylor Moorehead scored with just over three minutes to play in regulation against the New Mexico Lobos. Her goal tied the score at 2-2 and sent the game, which ultimately ended in a draw, into overtime. San Diego State had qualified for the Mountain West tournament earlier in the day, but secured the No. 3 seed with its draw against New Mexico.

Down 0-2 after 45 minutes, on a goal from outside the box and a controversial penalty which resulted in a converted penalty kick, the Aztecs battled back and picked up some goal scoring momentum in the 53rd minute.

Anna Toohey picked up the ball deep in the Aztecs end of the field. She saw Emma Gaines-Ramos sprinting down the far sideline and played a perfect long pass across the field. Gaines-Ramos ran right onto it, took one touch and just flipped the ball over the leg of the Lobo keeper and halved the New Mexico lead, 2-1. It was the second goal of the year for Gaines-Ramos and added to Toohey's team leading assist total, which now stands at four.

The score remained 2-1 into the 87th minute.

Off a corner, Aztec Jessica Sanders got a shot off which was blocked by the defense. In the scramble for the loose ball, Moorehead pounced and hammered a shot from inside the six. It ricocheted off the inside of the New Mexico keeper's leg and in for the tying goal. It was Moorehead's first goal of the campaign and her first since a 3-2 decision against Fresno State on Nov. 7, 2019.

The Aztecs were the more dangerous team throughout the game and that trend continued into the overtime periods.

In the 94th minute, Malia Kaleiohi, also playing the final regular season game of her college career, played the ball across the goal and just out of the reach of several players, but in the scramble for the loose ball Gaines-Ramos found it and shot it into the top corner, but the New Mexico keeper made the save.

Then with 15 seconds left in the same overtime period, Moorehead got the ball, drove to the goal and fired a shot low to her left. The attempt was saved, but not smothered. It came away from the line and Alexys Ocampo had a shot but pushed it high over the crossbar.

Neither team scored in the second overtime, mostly due to Aztec keeper Cameron Illingworth, who had five saves on the night, but none more important than one in the 103rd minute. Lobo Zaria Katesigwa split the Aztec defense and was in one-on-one against Illingworth, who came charging off her line and from 15 yards out deflected a point-blank shot over the end line to keep the game tied.

For the game, San Diego State outshot New Mexico 21-to-17, including 10-to-7 in shots on goal.

Gaines-Ramos led the Aztec attack with four shots and a goal. Denise Castro and Trinity Coker produced three shots while Laura Fuentes, Moorehead and Toohey took a pair of shots each. Kiera Utush, Sarah Funk, Ocampo, Sanders and Olivia Sekimoto attempted a shot apiece.
