OFF THE TOP (through games of Thursday, Nov. 18)

- San Diego State continues its challenging schedule to open the 2021-22 campaign on Saturday evening at Viejas Arena when the Aztecs play host to UT Arlington.
- This is the second in a stretch of five games in the final 13 days of November in which the Aztecs play.
- According to the Sagarin Ratings, San Diego State's schedule to date is the third toughest among the top 65 rated teams in the nation.
- The Aztecs and Mavericks are meeting for the first time, but it will be the sixth game in Viejas Arena for San Diego State against an opponent from the Sun Belt Conference. SDSU is just 2-3 at home against Sun Belt teams.
- This is the first time the Aztecs have played a Sun Belt team since Nov. 21, 2015, a 49-43 loss to Little Rock. The only other meeting in the Fisher/Dutcher era came in a 93-84 defeat at the hands of Troy on Nov. 30, 2003. Overall, SDSU is 5-4 against the conference with the last win coming on Nov. 26, 1997, in a 79-57 decision over Texas State.
- Following its 65-63 victory over Arizona State on Thursday, the Aztecs are 10-1 in their last 11 games immediately following a loss. In situations where a loss is followed immediately by a home game, San Diego State has won 17 consecutive games.
- Last time out, San Diego State limited Arizona State to 37.3 percent field goal shooting, limited the Sun Devils to six three-point field goals and closed out the game in the final minutes for a 65-63 victory. The Aztecs have won its last four games against Pac-12 teams and has defeated Arizona State in consecutive seasons for the first time since the 1977-78 and 1978-79 seasons.
- Senior forward **Nathan Mensah** is off to a fantastic start. Long known for being one of the best defenders in the country, Mensah is 13-of-16 (81.2 percent) from the field through the first three games. He is averaging 12.0 points, 9.0 rebounds and has four blocked shots this season. The senior is the only player in the nation shooting 81 percent or better with a minimum of 13 field goals, an average of 9.0 rebounds per game and at least one three pointer.
- Senior forward **Matt Bradley** is leading the Aztecs in scoring at 14.3 points. The transfer from California, had a game-high 23 points in the season-opening victory against UC Riverside. It was the most points in an SDSU debut since Nov. 18, 2006.
- Senior **Trey Pulliam** reached double figures in San Diego State's first two games this season. He has three back-to-back double digit scoring games in his 62-game Aztec career. In addition, he has five double-digit scoring outings in his last seven games dating back to last season (11.0 ppg) after reaching that figure five times in his first 56 games.
- Once again this season San Diego State is unranked in the preseason AP Top 25 Poll. That is no problem for the Aztecs. SDSU has been unranked each of the last two seasons but nonetheless have spent 22 weeks in the polls since the start of the 2019-20 campaign, climbing as high as No. 4 in 2019-20 and to No. 16 in 2020-21. Each of the last two seasons the Aztecs have ended the season nationally-ranked.
- Brian Dutcher** is in his fifth season as San Diego State's head coach and his 23rd season on the Aztec sidelines. In his four plus seasons as head coach, he has led the Aztecs to four conference titles, a 98-32 overall record and has already been named the national coach of the year and twice named Mountain West Conference Coach of the Year.
- Sophomore guard **Lamont Butler** responded when he was inserted into the starting line up for the Arizona State game. Butler produced a career-high 14 points and added three rebounds, three assists and two steals. It was his sixth double figure scoring game and San Diego

HOME SWEET HOME

-In its last 199 home games, SDSU has a 175-24 mark, including 82-10 against non-conference competition at Viejas Arena.

-Since the start of 2012-13, the Aztecs are 128-19 at home, including 57-9 in non-conference home contests during that stretch.

MENSAH IS ONE OF ONE

San Diego State senior forward **Nathan Mensah** is off to a strong start in the 2021-22 season. Entering play against UT Arlington he is one of one among Division I players.

- Mensah is shooting 81.2 percent from the floor (13-of-16 FGs) and has grabbed 27 rebounds and made at least one 3-pointer.
- There is only one player in college basketball who is shooting at least 81 percent with a minimum of 13 made buckets and is averaging 9.0 rebounds per game...San Diego State's Nathan Mensah.

HOME COURT ADVANTAGE

San Diego State has advanced to the NCAA tournament eight of the last 11 seasons in which a national championship has been crowned, and has an NIT national semifinalist appearance during that span as well. One reason for the success is that Viejas Arena is a very tough place for opponents. Since the start of the 2009-10 campaign, and entering this season, San Diego State has the ninth-highest winning percentage in the country, amassing a 171-23 home record, winning 88.1 percent of its home games during that span.

With the 2021-22 season underway, here are a few of the categories to keep an eye on.

- In its last 199 home games, San Diego State has compiled a 175-24 mark, including a 82-10 record against non-conference competition at Viejas Arena.
- Since the start of the 2012-13 campaign, the Aztecs are 128-19 at home, including a 57-9 record in non-conference home contests during that stretch (48-7 against non-top 25 non-conference foes).
- The Aztecs are 53-10 in their last 63 non-conference home games.

MORE HOME COOKING

- Following the Arizona State victory on Thursday, San Diego State is 29-3 at home in its last 32 games, with an average scoring margin of +15.1 points. Of the 32 home games, 22 were decided in the Aztecs' favor by at least nine points.
- The Aztecs 11-game non-conference home court win streak, snapped on Dec. 18, 2020 by Brigham Young, is the seventh-longest in school history and longest since a 13-game win streak from Dec. 16, 2000 to Nov. 23, 2002.
- San Diego State is 36-4 in its last 40 home games dating back to Jan. 1, 2019.
- The Aztecs are 31-3 in their 34 Mountain West Conference home games since Jan. 24, 2018.
- San Diego State has never had an undefeated home season as a Division I program. The last time the Aztecs made it through the home portion of the schedule unscathed was 1966-67. That season, San Diego State went 16-0 at home en route to a 24-5 record. In the Division I era, SDSU has ended the home portion of its schedule with a single loss on seven occasions (1977-78, 2009-10, 2010-11, 2012-13, 2013-14, 2014-15 and 2019-20).

SWEET HOME CALIFORNIA

Beginning with the Arizona State game, the Aztecs will play eight of their next 10 contests in the state of California. Here is how important that is:

- Since the start of the 2010-11 season, San Diego State is 183-34 in games played in the state of California.
- Since the start of the 2010-11 season, San Diego State is 152-23 in games played in Viejas Arena.

IT STARTS WITH DEFENSE

The Aztecs are known for defense. At the conclusion of last year's regular season...

- San Diego State ranked 8th in the nation in scoring defense (60.6 ppg) & held its opponent to 60 or fewer points 11 times.
- San Diego State was one of only eight teams in the nation that were limiting its opponents to 61.0 or fewer points per game.
- San Diego State's .387 field goal percentage defense was 7th in the nation & led the Mountain West.
- San Diego State was +3.9 in turnover margin which ranked No. 16 in the nation & led the Mountain West.
- San Diego State had 223 steals which ranked No. 14 in the nation & led the Mountain West.
- San Diego State ranked 12th in the nation in scoring margin at +13.5.

DUTCHER KEEPS THE BALL ROLLING ON

Brian Dutcher has been on The Mesa for 22 seasons, 18 of them as the top man on San Diego State Hall of Fame Head Coach Steve Fisher's bench. In that time he experienced 484 victories, 14 Mountain West titles and helped the Aztecs to 15 postseason tournaments, including 10 NCAA appearances and a pair of Sweet 16 berths (2011, 2014).

- Since his ascension to the top job prior to the 2017-18 season, he has captured four Mountain West crowns and guided his team to the championship game in the league tournament each year.
- In his inaugural campaign, in 2017-18, he was the only first-year Division I head coach to guide his team to the NCAA Tournament.
- He is the only head coach in program history to win at least 20 games in each of his first four seasons.
- His 96 wins in his first four seasons are a program record for victories in a coach's first four campaigns.
- **His 98 wins to date are the most of any head coach who started at his current institution at the start of the 2017-18 season.**

SAN DIEGO — Trey Pulliam made a go-ahead floater in the lane with 1:05 left and San Diego State held off Arizona State 65-63 Thursday night.

"It was a hard-fought game," Aztecs head coach Brian Dutcher said. "You know, I don't know if either team played up to what the coaches think their potential is, but both teams played hard and they competed at a high level. Sometimes that's enough and it was tonight. We competed and fought and toughed out a win. We'll learn from it. It's always better to learn from a win than a loss. So we have lessons to learn, we'll get better but it's an exciting way in front of a fantastic crowd. I forget what this crowd is like when you miss it for a whole year and then to

get into the building and have this kind of Aztec support, I don't think anyone in the country has it like this. It was fantastic. You think the back-to-back games, we had at BYU 20,000 and 12,000 plus here tonight. That's the kind of atmosphere any kid dreams to play in front of and you know, our team had it back-to-back games."

Lamont Butler scored 14 points for SDSU (2-1), which beat the Sun Devils (2-2) for the second straight year. Matt Bradley scored 12 and Keshad Johnson and Nathan Mensah had 10 each for the Aztecs.

Pulliam's floater gave the Aztecs a 64-63 lead.

"Honestly, I've been doing a floater my whole life," Pulliam said. "Growing up I was always kind of the younger guy and I always played up. I've always been athletic, but I grew slowly. So I had to figure out a way just to score and that was just an easy way for me to score. I hear that every guard that wants to play pro should have that shot."

ASU missed three 3-pointers in the final 16 seconds, including a desperation shot by Jamiya Neal with three seconds left, after Bradley made one of two free throws.

"You sit there, and you say, 'we have to get a body on a body.' We can't give them a clean look," Dutcher said. "Then all of a sudden you look up and it's a scramble, scrambling around and there's a guy open in the corner and to our credit, we ran it down. He had an open look, but we were flying to the corner. So we'll look back on tape and say we should have done this and we can't give any look at the end of the game. But to their credit they moved the ball and found the guy in the corner for a good look. With the game on the line and I just remember we flew to the corner and I'm glad we didn't fall. We passed the test without falling and escaped with a victory."

Marreon Jackson scored 16 and Kimani Lawrence had 14 points and 12 rebounds for ASU.

Arizona State took a 39-30 lead early in the second half before SDSU used a 12-0 run to take the lead. Butler and Adam Seiko had 3-pointers and Mensah a slam dunk after rebounding a missed free throw by Butler.

ASU worked the lead back to four before SDSU came back on 3-pointers by Butler and Seiko. ASU's last lead was 63-61 on Jackson's jumper with 1:43 left.

Both teams shot poorly. SDSU shot 39.2% while ASU shot 37.3%. ASU made only 6 of 28 3-pointers (21.4%) while SDSU made 6 of 21 (28.6%).

ASU led 30-28 at halftime.

AZTECS INK TWO 4-STAR PROSPECTS

SAN DIEGO – One of the most exciting days of the year is National Signing Day and fans of San Diego State men's basketball have a lot to be excited about. The Aztecs have inked a pair of 4-star recruits in Elijah Saunders and Miles Byrd. Head men's basketball coach Brian Dutcher made the announcement on Wednesday afternoon.

Saunders is a 6-8, 220 pound forward who will graduate from Sunnyslope High School in Phoenix, Ariz., this year. He is a 4-star recruit, nationally ranked No. 115 at his position and No. 23 at power forward and No. 8 in Arizona according to 247Sports, who has a big body and is equally comfortable down on the block as well as beyond the 3-point line. Saunders can run the floor, has a quick release, and scores with his back to the basket as well as off the bounce. He has shown the ability to attack closeouts, handle the ball, & finish thru contact.

As a junior, the No. 145 ranked recruit in the nation, according to Rivals, averaged 15.7 points, 6.5 rebounds, and 2.0 assists in 22 games according to Maxpreps. Sunnyslope finished the season on an 11-game winning streak and were 21-1 overall on its way to the 2021 Arizona Interscholastic Association (AIA) Conference 6A Boys Basketball State Championship and were ranked No. 4 in the state. Saunders was named to The Arizona Republic All-Arizona team.

In 2019-20, Saunders sophomore season, Sunnyslope was 23-6, including 9-3 in 5A League action. The team finished the year ranked No. 11 in the state. In his freshman year, Saunders played at Rancho Solano Prep in Scottsdale, Ariz., and averaged 5.8 points and 3.6 rebounds.

Saunders chose San Diego State over 24 other offers, including Miami, Notre Dame, South Carolina, St. John's and Virginia, as well as Mountain West programs UNLV, New Mexico, Nevada, Fresno State and San Jose State.

Byrd is a 6-7, 185-pound shooting guard who will graduate this year from Lincoln High School in Stockton, Calif. A four-star prospect, according to 247 Sports, Byrd is nationally rated as the No. 162 recruit, the No. 20 shooting guard and No. 15 in California. The lefty is the prototypical Aztec shooting guard.

He averaged a team-leading 19.0 points, 3.5 steals and 2.2 blocks in an eight-game COVID-19 shortened 2020-21 season. His 5.7 rebounds and 3.5 assists ranked second on the squad.

In a 28-game sophomore campaign his numbers were 12.3 points, 6.4 rebounds, 2.8 assists, 2.4 steals per game. Per 32 minutes played, he averaged 17.8 points, 9.3 rebounds, 4.0 assists, and 3.2 steals. Lincoln posted a 25-4 overall record, including 10-2 in Tri-City Athletic League play and competed in the CIF-Sac Joaquin Section 2020 Division I Boys Basketball Championship. Combined he shot better than 40 percent from the floor over the last two seasons.

His father, Calvin Byrd, is a former college basketball player and coach, most recently working at The University of the Pacific in Stockton.

Byrd chose the Aztecs over ten other programs, including Washington, California, Stanford, Villanova, Saint Mary's, and Minnesota, as well as Mountain West programs Colorado State, New Mexico, and San Jose State.

AZTECS PREDICTED TO FINISH SECOND IN PRESEASON MEDIA POLL

- San Diego State has won a Mountain West-record 14 titles in men's basketball (eight regular season & six tournament), six more than any other Mountain West program, and despite that winning both the regular season and tournament crowns last season, has been predicted to finish in second by a poll of the media that regularly cover the conference.
- SDSU has been predicted to finish either first or second in the Mountain West media's preseason poll in each of the last eight years. It is also the 13th time in the last 17 years that San Diego State has been picked first or second in the Mountain West's preseason poll. The Aztecs have garnered at least one first-place vote in the preseason poll in seven of the last eight years.
- Complete Mountain West media preseason predicted order of finish is located in the column on page 4.

BRADLEY INCLUDED ON WOODEN, NAISMITH & JERRY WEST AWARD WATCH LISTS

Senior Matt Bradley has been included on three of the most prestigious watch lists in college basketball.

On Monday it was revealed that he is one of 50 players to be included on the Naismith National Player of the Year watch list.

On Tuesday he was named one of the early favorites to earn the 2022 John R. Wooden Award Men's Player of the Year and is the first Aztec to garner the honors recognition since Malachi Flynn appeared on the national ballot in 2020.

In 2020-21, his third and final season competing for California, Bradley was 1-of-5 players in Division I to average 18.0 point per game, while shooting at least 45.5 percent from the floor, 36.4 percent from distance, a minimum of 82.1 percent from the line, and grab 4.6 rebounds per game. Except for his rebounding average, those other statistics would have all ranked the top-5 in the Mountain West last year. In addition, the San Bernardino, Calif., native, was one of 23 players in a Power-5 conference to shoot at least 45.5 percent overall and 36.4 percent from the bonus distance in 2020-21 and would have been the only player in the Mountain West to compile those stats last season.

A 2020-21 second-team All-Pac12 performer, he scored in double figures in 21 of the 22 games in which he appeared, finishing with 15+ points 15 times, and 20+ points 11 times, including a career-high 29 points vs. Colorado (2/13). His 11 20+ point games ranked No. 2 in the Pac-12 in 2020-21.

Over a three-year, 85 game career with the Bears, he scored 1,292 points and left California as the program's No. 21 career scorer. The 2021-22 Mountain West Preseason Newcomer of the Year is one of 12 players nationally to score at least 1,290 points in the last three seasons.

Bradley is the only player in the Mountain West conference to be included on the watch list.

Just under two weeks ago, Bradley was included on the Naismith Memorial Basketball Hall of Fame's initial watch list for the Jerry West Shooting Guard of the Year Award, the most prestigious individual honor a collegiate shooting guard can earn.

BRIAN DUTCHER

Head Coach

Fifth Season • 23rd Season Overall at SDSU • Minnesota, 1982

Brian Dutcher enters his fifth season as San Diego State head coach after four years in which he led the Aztecs to four Mountain West title games, its conference-record 11th, 12th, 13th and 14th Mountain West crowns and two NCAA tournament bids. He is the only coach in the 100-year history of San Diego State men's basketball to win at least 20 games in each of his first four seasons at the helm of the program.

In the COVID-affected season of 2020-21, the Aztecs were once again the cream of the Mountain West crop posting a 23-5 record, including a 14-3 mark in league play. San Diego State won the league's regular season and tournament crowns to earn an automatic bid to the NCAA tournament, where it was a 6-seed. For the second straight year, Dutcher was named Coach of the Year of both the Mountain West and NABC Division I District 17.

The Aztecs opened the season with a win over No. 22 UCLA and just over two weeks later won at No. 23 Arizona State. The team reached the Mountain West title game for the fourth straight season and earned a measure of revenge in the championship game, defeating Utah State, 68-57, the team that had knocked them off in the previous two league title games.

In 2019-20 his squad ripped off a program-record 26 straight wins to open the season and peaked, for eight weeks, at a No. 4 ranking in both the Associated Press and USA Today Coaches top-25 polls, before finishing the regular season at No. 6. The Aztecs went 30-2 on the year, including 17-1 in Mountain West play and Dutcher earned *USA Today* National Coach of the Year, Mountain West Coach of the Year (in both the coaches and media polls), National Association of Basketball Coaches (NABC) Division I District 17 Coach of the Year and United States Basketball Writers Association (USBWA) District IX Coach of the Year. In addition, he was one of five finalists for the 2020 Werner Ladder Naismith Men's College Coach of the Year Award.

In program history, his team's 30 wins in 2019-20 are the third most in a season and its two defeats are the fewest. SDSU's 17 wins in conference play are the most in program history, and its one loss is the fewest in the Aztecs' Division I era and equals the fewest since 1926-27, when it moved from junior college competition to the National Association of Intercollegiate Athletics (NAIA). San Diego State opened the 2019-20 league slate with a 15-game winning streak which set a new Mountain West record.

Led by junior guard and consensus All-American Malachi Flynn, the team won the Continental Tires Las Vegas Invitational with a blow out victory over Creighton and a 16-point comeback win against Iowa in the championship game. A month later, the Aztecs handed Utah a 28-point drubbing in the Basketball Hall of Fame Classic three days after the Utes defeated then No. 6 Kentucky.

In addition to Flynn, forwards Matt Mitchell and Yanni Wetzell and guard KJ Feagin, were recognized by the MW in its postseason awards as well as numerous national outlets.

With the expected return for the postseason of forward Nathan Mensah, who had been sidelined for the final 19 games of the year, San Diego State was poised for a deep run in the NCAA Tournament. The Aztecs were projected to be either a No. 1 or No. 2 seed and some felt were a Final Four team, but the coronavirus pandemic put an end to the postseason and fans were left to wonder what could have been.

In 2017-18, his inaugural season as Aztecs head coach, Dutcher was the only Division I head coach to guide his team to the NCAA Tournament after going 22-10 in the regular season, including winning the 2018 Mountain West Tournament championship.

Dutcher, who took the helm of the program following Steve Fisher's retirement announcement on April 11, 2017, was on The Mesa for all 18 of Fisher's seasons. He held the title of associate head coach/head coach in waiting for the six years prior to his ascension to the top job and is the 15th head coach in the program's history.

Over the course of his 21 years at San Diego State, Dutcher has helped the Aztecs reach the postseason 14 times, including nine trips to the NCAA tournament, win a conference-best 12 Mountain West titles and record 15 seasons of at least 20 victories.

Since 2008-09, Dutcher and SDSU twice advanced to the NCAA Sweet 16 (2011, 2014) and NIT semifinal round (2009, 2016), won at least 25 games eight times and captured nine MW championships (six regular season, three tournament).

Dutcher arrived at San Diego State shortly after Fisher was hired on March 26, 1999. In his first year in "America's Finest City," the Aztecs won only five games, but improved upon their win total from the season before. After that, San Diego State posted a 14-14 record in 2000-01, before winning the 2002 MW Championship, earning an NCAA tournament bid, and finishing with a 21-12 record. The 2002-03 campaign saw SDSU receive an NIT invitation, which culminated in the program's first Division I postseason victory.

After helping attract the program's first McDonald's All-American to the 2002-03 squad, Dutcher assisted in securing the signatures of future starters and all-league performers Brandon Heath and Marcus Slaughter. The duo started their first two seasons on The Mesa, leading to the 2005-06 campaign that produced the school's first MW regular-season and tournament title sweep.

The Aztecs advanced to the NCAA tournament and ultimately won a then-school-record 24 games. That appearance led to a string of 10 consecutive postseason berths.

From the 2006-07 campaign through 2008-09, San Diego State registered 20 or more wins and went to three straight NITs. In 2009, the Aztecs advanced to the NIT semifinals and broke the previous school record with 26 victories. That run to the 2009 NIT semifinals was a springboard to the most successful run in SDSU basketball history. Led by future NBA first-round draft pick and two-time NBA champion Kawhi Leonard, the 2009-10 Aztecs won the MW Championship, advanced to the NCAA tournament and fell four points shy of moving on to the second round before finishing with a 25-9 record.

The NCAA experience from the 2009-10 squad proved fruitful in 2010-11, when it returned all five starters, including Leonard, and freshman Jamaal Franklin, who would turn out to be a future MW Player of the Year and NBA draft selection. With Dutcher on staff, SDSU won its first 20 games of the year, shared the MW regular-season title,

and captured the MW tournament crown. The Aztecs moved on to the NCAA tournament as a No. 2 seed and won the program's first Division I NCAA tournament game. San Diego State, which was ranked as high as No. 4 and received first-place votes at one point in the season, advanced to the Sweet 16 and fell to the eventual national champion, finishing with a school-record 34 wins, a mark that still stands today. The Aztecs' also found themselves in the final top-25 polls, ranking sixth in the AP and 11th in the USA Today Coaches Poll. Five months after SDSU's record-setting 2010-11 campaign, the University elevated Dutcher to associate head coach/head coach in waiting.

In his first season with his new title, Dutcher and the Aztecs advanced to the 2012 NCAA tournament as an at-large team and recorded 26 wins. The next season, San Diego State was again an at-large selection to the NCAA tournament, moved on to the round of 32 for the second time in three years and finished with 23 victories.

Another NCAA Sweet 16 run was in the cards in Dutcher's third season as the head coach in waiting. The Aztecs opened the campaign by winning 21 of their first 22 games, including 20 in a row at one point, and were led by seniors Xavier Thames, who would become an NBA draft pick, and Josh Davis. SDSU won the program's second outright Mountain West regular-season title and later swept through two games in Spokane, Washington, to secure its second Sweet 16 appearance in four seasons. San Diego State compiled 31 wins and finished the season ranked 13th in the AP and 12th in the Coaches after rising to as high as fifth nationally in both polls.

The 2014-15 campaign saw the Aztecs spend their fifth straight season in the top 25. In the process of winning 27 games, San Diego State grabbed its second straight MW regular-season crown and earned an at-large invitation to the NCAA tournament where they defeated St. John's in the round of 64. One season later, the Aztecs found themselves in the NIT after winning the MW by three games with a 16-2 record. Nevertheless, San Diego State won three games and qualified for the NIT national semifinals, eventually logging 28 victories.

SDSU completed the 2016-17 slate with a 19-14 record despite experiencing a rash of injuries. The 2016 Hawaiian Airlines Diamond Head Classic champions entered 2017-18 as one of 12 teams to have won at least 19 games in 12 consecutive seasons, which was a sign of things to come in Dutcher's first year.

Dutcher's first roster as head coach featured a pair of seniors that had won multiple Mountain West titles and owned NCAA tournament experience in Trey Kell and Malik Pope.

Prior to coming to SDSU, Dutcher spent 10 seasons on Steve Fisher's bench at Michigan, where the program reached the postseason each year and participated in the NCAA Tournament eight times, including three trips to the Final Four and the championship game including a national championship in 1989.
