OFF THE TOP (through games of Monday, Nov. 22)

- San Diego State, the two-time outright defending Mountain West Conference regular season champions, takes aim at another exempt championship when the Aztecs open play against Georgetown on Thanksgiving evening in Anaheim, Calif.
- Against the Hoyas, fourth-year head coach **Brian Dutcher** looks to secure his 100th career victory as head coach, in his 132nd game. The national coach of the year is looking to become the fastest Aztec coach to 100 victories (by comparison, Steve Fisher owned a 100-105 record at the time of his 100th victory on The Mesa).
- Since the 2014 campaign, San Diego State has claimed three exempt event championships - the 2013 DirecTV Wooden Legacy, the 2016 Hawaii Airlines Diamond Head Classic and the 2019 Continental Tire Las Vegas Invitational.
- San Diego State and Georgetown are meeting for just the second time in school history. The 20th-ranked and NCAA finalist Hoyas defeated the Aztecs, 71-53, on Dec. 5, 1981 in Washington D.C. Michael Cage, a sophomore at the time, had nine points and 12 rebounds for SDSU.
- San Diego State has won five consecutive games against teams that have called the Big East home at the time of the game. Two of those five victories during the streak came against AP Top 25 teams. Also, of note, this is the eight straight time that a San Diego State-Big East Conference member matchup has occurred on a neutral floor.
- San Diego State's five-game win streak against the Big East is the second-longest active streak nationally (Michigan State, 6). See upper right box
- San Diego State has been one of the best neutral site teams nationally. Since the start of the 2019-20 campaign, among teams that have played at least 10 neutral site games, San Diego State's 9-2 record (81.8 percent) is tied for the fifth best mark in the country. See chart below
- Last time out, San Diego State put together another strong defensive effort, limiting UT Arlington to 38.5 percent field goal shooting en route to a workmanlike 68-62 victory on Saturday night at Viejas Arena. The Aztecs are 43-2 the last 45 times it has held the opposition to 40 percent or less from the field.
- San Diego State made 30 free throws, its highest total since the Aztecs made 31 against Wyoming on March 1, 2006. SDSU is now 35-1 the last 36 times it has attempted more free throws than its opponent.
- The Aztecs made 30-of-34 free throw attempts (88.2 percent). That is the highest free throw percentage for San Diego State in a game with at least 30 free throw attempts in at least the last 26 seasons.
- Senior guard **Matt Bradley** scored a team-high 15 points, making all seven of his free throw attempts, and added six rebounds and three assists. This marked the 41st time in his career that he has been perfect from the free throw line in a game. He has now reached

- SDSU has advanced to the postseason in 13 of the last 15 seasons in which a champions was crowned (2006 NCAA, 2007-09 NIT, 2010-15 NCAA, 2016 NIT, 2018 NCAA, 2021 NCAA).
- SDSU has won 54 of last 57 games when leading at the half.
- SDSU has won its last 55 of 57 when having a higher FG pct.
- SDSU is 9th nationally in winning percentage (.757) since the beginning of the 2010-11 season.
- Since its founding in 1999, no men's basketball program has won more Mountain West championships (regular-season and tournament) than San Diego State's 14.
- Since 2006, SDSU's 12 appearances in its conference championship game are the second most in Division I.
- SDSU's 17 MW wins in 2019-20 are the most in MW history.

- Senior guard **Trey Pulliam** scored 11 points, reaching double figures for the third time this season and 11th time in his career (San Diego State is 10-1 in those games).
- Sophomore guard **Lamont Butler** had a stat stuffer game, posting nine points, four rebounds, three assists and three steals.
- Senior forward **Nathan Mensah** had nine points, four rebounds and three blocked shots in the victory. Mensah has posted at least eight points in all four games this season and tied a career-high by extending his games with at least one blocked shot to 11. Mensah has 107 career blocked shots and moved into seventh place on the school's all-time list.
- **Brian Dutcher** is in his fifth season as San Diego State's head coach and his 23rd season on the Aztec sidelines. In his four plus seasons as head coach, he has led the Aztecs to four conference titles, a 99-32 overall record and has already been named the national coach of the year and twice named Mountain West Conference Coach of the Year.

CALIFORNIA DREAMIN' FOR SDSU...CALIFORNIA NIGHTMARE FOR IN-STATE OPPONENTS

- San Diego State opened the 2021-22 season defeating in-state foe in UC Riverside, 66-53 and could face Southern California on Friday.
- Since the start of the Coach Dutcher/Fisher era (1999-2000), the Aztecs are 117-33 (.780) against 24 of the other 25 current Division I schools in California (SDSU has not played Cal Baptist), and have a winning record against all but four of those 24 opponents.
- In the last 89 home games against those same 24 opponents, and also starting in 1999-2000, San Diego State is 78-11 (.876).
- In program history against the 24 schools, the Aztecs are 451-323 (.582) overall.

IT STARTS WITH DEFENSE

The Aztecs are known for defense. At the conclusion of last year's regular season...

- San Diego State ranked 8th in the nation in scoring defense (60.6 ppg) & held its opponent to 60 or fewer points 11 times.
- San Diego State was one of only eight teams in the nation that were limiting its opponents to 61.0 or fewer points per game.
- San Diego State's .387 field goal percentage defense was 7th in the nation & led the Mountain West.
- San Diego State was +3.9 in turnover margin which ranked No. 16 in the nation & led the Mountain West.
- San Diego State had 223 steals which ranked No. 14 in the nation & led the Mountain West.
- San Diego State ranked 12th in the nation in scoring margin at +13.5.

DUTCHER KEEPS THE BALL ROLLING ON

Brian Dutcher has been on The Mesa for 22 seasons, 18 of them as the top man on San Diego State Hall of Fame Head Coach Steve Fisher's bench. In that time he experienced 485 victories, 14 Mountain West titles and helped the Aztecs to 15 postseason tournaments, including 10 NCAA appearances and a pair of Sweet 16 berths (2011, 2014).

- Since his ascension to the top job prior to the 2017-18 season, he has captured four Mountain West crowns and guided his team to the championship game in the league tournament each year.
- In his inaugural campaign, in 2017-18, he was the only first-year Division I head coach to guide his team to the NCAA Tournament.
- He is the only head coach in program history to win at least 20 games in each of his first four seasons.
- His 96 wins in his first four seasons are a program record for victories in a coach's first four campaigns.
- His 99 wins to date are the most of any head coach who started at his current institution at the start of the 2017-18 season.

SAN DIEGO -- Senior Matt Bradley had 15 points and six rebounds and senior Trey Pulliam added 11 points as San Diego State defeated UT Arlington, 68-62, at Viejas Arena on Saturday night.

"We did everything we had to do to try to get them ready to play tonight," Aztec head coach Brian Dutcher said. "It's the first time in a long time where we've actually played live (at shootaround), because I didn't think they were engaged enough and mentally ready to play and that's on me. That's my job as the head coach. One of my job's is to get them ready to play and the other is to put them in a position to win and I have to do a better job of both. I always say it's better to learn in a win rather than a defeat, and that's what we did. We have a lot of lessons to learn."

The Aztecs (3-1) connected on 30-of-34 free throw attempts in the contest. The 30 makes were the most since March 1, 2006 and the 88.2 percent from the line on at least 30 attempts was its highest in the last 26 seasons.

The Mavs (1-4) kept the game close throughout, with San Diego State never building an advantage greater than 10 points. The game was tied at 46 with 8:38 to play, when the Aztecs went on a 9-0 run. Nathan Mensah and Bradley combined for three free throws and Lamont Butler followed with a three-pointer in transition and Bradley capped the run with a trey of his own.

"We've just got to pay respects to Texas Arlington," senior guard Matt Bradley said. "They came in here and really battled. It was a battle from the start to the end and, I think it took certain plays for us to wake up. They were crashing the glass hard, something we've been working on throughout the season. And I think we've just got to continue to keep our mental (state) right, and just get better every day."

For the fourth game this season, San Diego State held its opponent to under 70 points, and less than 40 percent shooting from the floor. The Aztecs are 65-5 in the Dutcher era (since the start of the 2017-18 season) when they limit the opponents to less than 40 percent shooting and are 31-8 when they hold an opponent to between 60-69 points.

THE NOTE

San Diego State is now 35-1 the last 36 times it has attempted more free throws than its opponent.

UP NEXT

San Diego State will open the Wooden Legacy with Georgetown in Anaheim on Thanksgiving night.

AZTECS INK TWO 4-STAR PROSPECTS

SAN DIEGO — One of the most exciting days of the year is National Signing Day and fans of San Diego State men's basketball have a lot to be excited about. The Aztecs have inked a pair of 4-star recruits in **Elijah Saunders** and **Miles Byrd**. Head men's basketball coach Brian Dutcher made the announcement on Wednesday afternoon.

Saunders is a 6-8, 220 pound forward who will graduate from Sunnyslope High School in Phoenix, Ariz., this year. He is a 4-star recruit, nationally ranked No. 115 at his position and No. 23 at power forward and No. 8 in Arizona according to 247Sports, who has a big body and is equally comfortable down on the block as well as beyond the 3-point line. Saunders can run the floor, has a quick release, and scores with his back to the basket as well as off the bounce. He has shown the ability to attack closeouts, handle the ball, & finish thru contact.

As a junior, the No. 145 ranked recruit in the nation, according to Rivals, averaged 15.7 points, 6.5 rebounds, and 2.0 assists in 22 games according to Maxpreps. Sunnyslope finished the season on an 11-game winning streak and were 21-1 overall on its way to the 2021 Arizona Interscholastic Association (AIA) Conference 6A Boys Basketball State Championship and were ranked No. 4 in the state. Saunders was named to The Arizona Republic All-Arizona team.

In 2019-20, Saunders sophomore season, Sunnyslope was 23-6, including 9-3 in 5A League action. The team finished the year ranked No. 11 in the state. In his freshman year, Saunders played at Rancho Solano Prep in Scottsdale, Ariz., and averaged 5.8 points and 3.6 rebounds.

Saunders chose San Diego State over 24 other offers, including Miami, Notre Dame, South Carolina, St. John's and Virginia, as well as Mountain West programs UNLV, New Mexico, Nevada, Fresno State and San Jose State.

Byrd is a 6-7, 185-pound shooting guard who will graduate this year from Lincoln High School in Stockton, Calif. A four-star prospect, according to 247 Sports, Byrd is nationally rated as the No. 162 recruit, the No. 20 shooting guard and No. 15 in California. The lefty is the prototypical Aztec shooting guard.

He averaged a team-leading 19.0 points, 3.5 steals and 2.2 blocks in an eight-game COVID-19 shortened 2020-21 season. His 5.7

rebounds and 3.5 assists ranked second on the squad.

In a 28-game sophomore campaign his numbers were 12.3 points, 6.4 rebounds, 2.8 assists, 2.4 steals per game. Per 32 minutes played, he averaged 17.8 points, 9.3 rebounds, 4.0 assists, and 3.2 steals. Lincoln posted a 25-4 overall record, including 10-2 in Tri-City Athletic League play and competed in the CIF-Sac Joaquin Section 2020 Division I Boys Basketball Championship. Combined he shot better than 40 percent from the floor over the last two seasons.

His father, Calvin Byrd, is a former college basketball player and coach, most recently working at The University of the Pacific in Stockton. Byrd chose the Aztecs over ten other programs, including Washington, California, Stanford, Villanova, Saint Mary's, and Minnesota, as well as Mountain West programs Colorado State, New Mexico, and San Jose State.

AZTECS PREDICTED TO FINISH SECOND IN PRESEASON MEDIA POLL

- San Diego State has won a Mountain West-record 14 titles in men's basketball (eight regular season & six tournament), six more than any other Mountain West program, and despite that winning both the regular season and tournament crowns last season, has been predicted to finish in second by a poll of the media that regularly cover the conference.
- SDSU has been predicted to finish either first or second in the Mountain West media's preseason poll in each of the last eight years. It is also the 13th time in the last 17 years that San Diego State has been picked first or second in the Mountain West's preseason poll. The Aztecs have garnered at least one first-place vote in the preseason poll in seven of the last eight years.

BRADLEY INCLUDED ON WOODEN, NAISMITH & JERRY WEST AWARD WATCH LISTS

Senior Matt Bradley has been included on three of the most prestigious watch lists in college basketball. On Monday it was revealed that he is one of 50 players to be included on the Naismith National Player of the Year watch list. On Tuesday he was named one of the early favorites to earn the 2022 John R. Wooden Award Men's Player of the Year and is the first Aztecs to garner the honors recognition since Malachi Flynn appeared on the national ballot in 2020.

In 2020-21, his third and final season competing for California, Bradley was 1-of-5 players in Division I to average 18.0 point per game, while shooting at least 45.5 percent from the floor, 36.4 percent from distance, a minimum of 82.1 percent from the line, and grab 4.6 rebounds per game. Except for his rebounding average, those other statistics would have all ranked the top-5 in the Mountain West last year. In addition, the San Bernardino, Calif., native, was one of 23 players in a Power-5 conference to shoot at least 45.5 percent overall and 36.4 percent from the bonus distance in 2020-21 and would have been the only player in the Mountain West to compile those stats last season.

A 2020-21 second-team All-Pac12 performer, he scored in double figures in 21 of the 22 games in which he appeared, finishing with 15+ points 15 times, and 20+ points 11 times, including a career-high 29 points vs. Colorado (2/13). His 11 20+ point games ranked No. 2 in the Pac-12 in 2020-21.

Over a three-year, 85 game career with the Bears, he scored 1,292 points and left California as the program's No. 21 career scorer. The 2021-22 Mountain West Preseason Newcomer of the Year is one of 12 players nationally to score at least 1,290 points in the last three seasons.

Bradley is the only player in the Mountain West conference to be included on the watch list. Just under two weeks ago, Bradley was included on the Naismith Memorial Basketball Hall of Fame's initial watch list for the Jerry West Shooting Guard of the Year Award, the most prestigious individual honor a collegiate shooting guard can earn.

HOME COURT ADVANTAGE

San Diego State has advanced to the NCAA tournament eight of the last 11 seasons in which a national championship has been crowned, and has an NIT national semifinalist appearance during that span as well. One reason for the success is that Viejas Arena is a very tough place for opponents. Since the start of the 2009-10 campaign, and entering this season, San Diego State has the ninth-highest winning percentage in the country, amassing a 171-23 home record, winning 88.1 percent of its home games during that span.

- With the 2021-22 season underway, here are a few of the categories to keep an eye on.
- In its last 200 home games, San Diego State has compiled a 176-24 mark, including a 83-10 record against non-conference competition at Viejas Arena.
 - Since the start of the 2012-13 campaign, the Aztecs are 129-19 at home, including a 58-9 record in non-conference home contests during that stretch (49-7 against non-top 25 non-conference foes).
 - The Aztecs are 54-10 in their last 64 non-conference home games.

MORE HOME COOKING

- Following the UT Arlington victory last Thursday, San Diego State is 30-3 at home in its last 33 games, with an average scoring margin of +15.1 points. Of the 33 home games, 22 were decided in the Aztecs' favor by at least nine points.
- The Aztecs 11-game non-conference home court win streak, snapped on Dec. 18, 2020 by Brigham Young, is the seventh-longest in school history and longest since a 13-game win streak from Dec. 16, 2000 to Nov. 23, 2002.
- San Diego State is 37-4 in its last 41 home games dating back to Jan. 1, 2019.
- The Aztecs are 31-3 in their 34 Mountain West Conference home games since Jan. 24, 2018.
- San Diego State has never had an undefeated home season as a Division I program. The last time the Aztecs made it through the home portion of the schedule unscathed was 1966-67. That season, San Diego State went 16-0 at home en route to a 24-5 record. In the Division I era, SDSU has ended the home portion of its schedule with a single loss on seven occasions (1977-78, 2009-10, 2010-11, 2012-13, 2013-14, 2014-15 and 2019-20).

- Of the 10 teams that currently make up the Pac 12 Conference, San Diego State has a .500 or better record against three of them. The team's 7-6 record (.538) against California being the best for the Aztecs against Pac-12 teams.
- Southern California is competing in the Paycom Wooden Legacy for the second time having won the event in 2007.
- The Trojans are the fourth-highest scoring team in the Pac-12 (85.3 ppg).
- The Trojans are sixth in the national in assist-to-turnover ratio (2.11:1).
- USC is one of 46 teams still undefeated in 2021-22.
- Chavez Goodwin ranks No. 11 in the nation in field goal percentage at .711 (27-38).

Brian Dutcher enters his fifth season as San Diego State head coach after four years in which he led the Aztecs to four Mountain West title games, its conference-record 11th, 12th, 13th and 14th Mountain West crowns and two NCAA tournament bids. He is the only coach in the 100-year history of San Diego State men's basketball to win at least 20 games in each of his first four seasons at the helm of the program.

In the COVID-affected season of 2020-21, the Aztecs were once again the cream of the Mountain West crop posting a 23-5 record, including a 14-3 mark in league play. San Diego State won the league's regular season and tournament crowns to earn an automatic bid to the NCAA tournament, where it was a 6-seed. For the second straight year, Dutcher was named Coach of the Year of both the Mountain West and NABC Division I District 17.

The Aztecs opened the season with a win over No. 22 UCLA and just over two weeks later won at No. 23 Arizona State. The team reached the Mountain West title game for the fourth straight season and earned a measure of revenge in the championship game, defeating Utah State, 68-57, the team that had knocked them off in the previous two league title games.

In 2019-20 his squad ripped off a program-record 26 straight wins to open the season and peaked, for eight weeks, at a No. 4 ranking in both the Associated Press and USA Today Coaches top-25 polls, before finishing the regular season at No. 6. The Aztecs went 30-2 on the year, including 17-1 in Mountain West play and Dutcher earned *USA Today* National Coach of the Year, Mountain West Coach of the Year (in both the coaches and media polls), National Association of Basketball Coaches (NABC) Division I District 17 Coach of the Year and United States Basketball Writers Association (USBWA) District IX Coach of the Year. In addition, he was one of five finalists for the 2020 Werner Ladder Naismith Men's College Coach of the Year Award.

In program history, his team's 30 wins in 2019-20 are the third most in a season and its two defeats are the fewest. SDSU's 17 wins in conference play are the most in program history, and its one loss is the fewest in the Aztecs' Division I era and equals the fewest since 1926-27, when it moved from junior college competition to the National Association of Intercollegiate Athletics (NAIA). San Diego State opened the 2019-20 league slate with a 15-game winning streak which set a new Mountain West record.

Led by junior guard and consensus All-American Malachi Flynn, the team won the Continental Tires Las Vegas Invitational with a blow out victory over Creighton and a 16-point comeback win against Iowa in the championship game. A month later, the Aztecs handed Utah a 28-point drubbing in the Basketball Hall of Fame Classic three days after the Utes defeated then No. 6 Kentucky.

In addition to Flynn, forwards Matt Mitchell and Yanni Wetzell and guard KJ Feagin, were recognized by the MW in its postseason awards as well as numerous national outlets.

With the expected return for the postseason of forward Nathan Mensah, who had been sidelined for the final 19 games of the year, San Diego State was poised for a deep run in the NCAA Tournament. The Aztecs were projected to be either a No. 1 or No. 2 seed and some felt were a Final Four team, but the coronavirus pandemic put an end to the postseason and fans were left to wonder what could have been.

In 2017-18, his inaugural season as Aztecs head coach, Dutcher was the only Division I head coach to guide his team to the NCAA Tournament after going 22-10 in the regular season, including winning the 2018 Mountain West Tournament championship.

Dutcher, who took the helm of the program following Steve Fisher's retirement announcement on April 11, 2017, was on The Mesa for all 18 of Fisher's seasons. He held the title of associate head coach/head coach in waiting for the six years prior to his ascension to the top job and is the 15th head coach in the program's history.

Over the course of his 21 years at San Diego State, Dutcher has helped the Aztecs reach the postseason 14 times, including nine trips to the NCAA tournament, win a conference-best 12 Mountain West titles and record 15 seasons of at least 20 victories.

Since 2008-09, Dutcher and SDSU twice advanced to the NCAA Sweet 16 (2011, 2014) and NIT semifinal round (2009, 2016), won at least 25 games eight times and captured nine MW championships (six regular season, three tournament).

Dutcher arrived at San Diego State shortly after Fisher was hired on March 26, 1999. In his first year in "America's Finest City," the Aztecs won only five games, but improved upon their win total from the season before. After that, San Diego State posted a 14-14 record in 2000-01, before winning the 2002 MW Championship, earning an NCAA tournament bid, and finishing with a 21-12 record. The 2002-03 campaign saw SDSU receive an NIT invitation, which culminated in the program's first Division I postseason victory.

After helping attract the program's first McDonald's All-American to the 2002-03 squad, Dutcher assisted in securing the signatures of future starters and all-league performers Brandon Heath and Marcus Slaughter. The duo started their first two seasons on The Mesa, leading to the 2005-06 campaign that produced the school's first MW regular-season and tournament title sweep.

The Aztecs advanced to the NCAA tournament and ultimately won a then-school-record 24 games. That appearance led to a string of 10 consecutive postseason berths.

From the 2006-07 campaign through 2008-09, San Diego State registered 20 or more wins and went to three straight NITs. In 2009, the Aztecs advanced to the NIT semifinals and broke the previous school record with 26 victories. That run to the 2009 NIT semifinals was a springboard to the most successful run in SDSU basketball history. Led by future NBA first-round draft pick and two-time NBA champion Kawhi Leonard, the 2009-10 Aztecs won the MW Championship, advanced to the NCAA tournament and fell four points shy of moving on to the second round before finishing with a 25-9 record.

The NCAA experience from the 2009-10 squad proved fruitful in 2010-11, when it returned all five starters, including Leonard, and freshman Jamaal Franklin, who would turn out to be a future MW Player of the Year and NBA draft selection. With Dutcher on staff, SDSU won its first 20 games of the year, shared the MW regular-season title,

and captured the MW tournament crown. The Aztecs moved on to the NCAA tournament as a No. 2 seed and won the program's first Division I NCAA tournament game. San Diego State, which was ranked as high as No. 4 and received first-place votes at one point in the season, advanced to the Sweet 16 and fell to the eventual national champion, finishing with a school-record 34 wins, a mark that still stands today. The Aztecs' also found themselves in the final top-25 polls, ranking sixth in the AP and 11th in the USA Today Coaches Poll. Five months after SDSU's record-setting 2010-11 campaign, the University elevated Dutcher to associate head coach/head coach in waiting.

In his first season with his new title, Dutcher and the Aztecs advanced to the 2012 NCAA tournament as an at-large team and recorded 26 wins. The next season, San Diego State was again an at-large selection to the NCAA tournament, moved on to the round of 32 for the second time in three years and finished with 23 victories.

Another NCAA Sweet 16 run was in the cards in Dutcher's third season as the head coach in waiting. The Aztecs opened the campaign by winning 21 of their first 22 games, including 20 in a row at one point, and were led by seniors Xavier Thames, who would become an NBA draft pick, and Josh Davis. SDSU won the program's second outright Mountain West regular-season title and later swept through two games in Spokane, Washington, to secure its second Sweet 16 appearance in four seasons. San Diego State compiled 31 wins and finished the season ranked 13th in the AP and 12th in the Coaches after rising to as high as fifth nationally in both polls.

The 2014-15 campaign saw the Aztecs spend their fifth straight season in the top 25. In the process of winning 27 games, San Diego State grabbed its second straight MW regular-season crown and earned an at-large invitation to the NCAA tournament where they defeated St. John's in the round of 64. One season later, the Aztecs found themselves in the NIT after winning the MW by three games with a 16-2 record. Nevertheless, San Diego State won three games and qualified for the NIT national semifinals, eventually logging 28 victories.

SDSU completed the 2016-17 slate with a 19-14 record despite experiencing a rash of injuries. The 2016 Hawaiian Airlines Diamond Head Classic champions entered 2017-18 as one of 12 teams to have won at least 19 games in 12 consecutive seasons, which was a sign of things to come in Dutcher's first year.

Dutcher's first roster as head coach featured a pair of seniors that had won multiple Mountain West titles and owned NCAA tournament experience in Trey Kell and Malik Pope.

Prior to coming to SDSU, Dutcher spent 10 seasons on Steve Fisher's bench at Michigan, where the program reached the postseason each year and participated in the NCAA Tournament eight times, including three trips to the Final Four and the championship game including a national championship in 1989.

SAN DIEGO -- Senior Matt Bradley had 15 points and six rebounds and senior Trey Pulliam added 11 points as San Diego State defeated UT Arlington, 68-62, at Viejas Arena on Saturday night.

"We did everything we had to do to try to get them ready to play tonight," Aztec head coach Brian Dutcher said. "It's the first time in a long time where we've actually played live (at shootaround), because I didn't think they were engaged enough and mentally ready to play and that's on me. That's my job as the head coach. One of my job's is to get them ready to play and the other is to put them in a position to win and I have to do a better job of both. I always say it's better to learn in a win rather than a defeat, and that's what we did. We have a lot of lessons to learn."

The Aztecs (3-1) connected on 30-of-34 free throw attempts in the contest. The 30 makes were the most since March 1, 2006 and the 88.2 percent from the line on at least 30 attempts was its highest in the last 26 seasons.

The Mavs (1-4) kept the game close throughout, with San Diego State never building an advantage greater than 10 points.

The game was tied at 46 with 8:38 to play, when the Aztecs went on a 9-0 run. Nathan Mensah and Bradley combined for three free throws and Lamont Butler followed with a three-pointer in transition and Bradley capped the run with a trey of his own.

"We've just got to pay respects to Texas Arlington," senior guard Matt Bradley said. "They came in here and really battled. It was a battle from the start to the end and, I think it took certain plays for us to wake up. They were crashing the glass hard, something we've been working on throughout the season. And I think we've just got to continue to keep our mental (state) right, and just get better every day."

For the fourth game this season, San Diego State held its opponent to under 70 points, and less than 40 percent shooting from the floor. The Aztecs are 65-5 in the Dutcher era (since the start of the 2017-18 season) when they limit the opponents to less than 40 percent shooting and are 31-8 when they hold an opponent to between 60-69 points.

THE NOTE

San Diego State is now 35-1 the last 36 times it has attempted more free throws than its opponent.
