• The Aztecs return home to host crosstown foe San Diego Wednesday evening at 6 p.m. inside Viejas Arena. The game will be streamed on the Mountain West Network with Chris Ello on the call.

• SDSU competed in Cal's Raising the B.A.R. Invitational last weekend. They went 0-2 with losses to Ole Miss (62-48) and Furman (71-62).

• The Aztecs were 12-for-24 from three against Furman, their second time this season making 12 or more threes in a game (Cal State Los Angeles, 11-9-21).

• Mercedes Staples scored 20 points and made a career-high six three-pointers against Furman.

• Staples is now shooting 55.6 percent from three this year, which leads the conference and is eighth best in the nation. Sophia Ramos is shooting 48.6 percent from deep, third in the Mountain West and 33rd in the nation.

• In her Aztec career, Staples is shooting 40.9 percent (45-110) from three, the best in school history (minimum 100 attempts).

 SDSU has three active players in the top seven all-time in career three-point percentage. Staples leads the way at 40.9 percent, Isabela Hernandez is third (38.6%, 49-127) and Sophia Ramos is seventh (35.8%, 113-316).

 As a team, the Aztecs are shooting 40.5 percent from three. That leads the Mountain West and is the 12th highest percentage in the nation.

• On the defensive side of the ball, SDSU is holding its opponents to 28.9 percent shooting from three.

• Sophia Ramos is one of five active players in the nation with at least 1,100 points, 400 rebounds, 300 assists and 100 steals in her career while playing in less than 100 games. She is the only one of those five who also has a career free throw percentage over 80.

• Three of SDSU's remaining four non-conference games will be at home: Dec. 1 vs. San Diego, Dec. 17 vs. UC San Diego 7 Dec. 21 vs. Ohio State who is currently ranked No. 18 in the nation.

• Point guard Asia Avinger (Cerritos, Calif.) was named the Mountain West Preseason Freshman of the Year for the second straight season. She missed all of last season with an injury.

• The Aztecs officially joined the Jordan Brand family this season, becoming just the ninth women's basketball program in the Jordan lineup.

### Asia Avinger Named Mountain West Preseason Freshman of the Year

 Redshirt freshman point guard Asia Avinger (Cerritos, Calif.) was named the Mountain West Preseason Freshman of the Year by select media and the league's coaches.

 Avinger won the award prior to last year as well but then suffered a season-ending injury.

 She is the first player to ever win the Mountain West Preseason Freshman of the Year twice.

 Avinger is the highest ranked recruit under head coach Stacie Terry-Hutson. She was one of the nation's best prep combo guards in 2020 earning a ranking of No. 56 in the nation according to espnW.

 Following her senior year, she was named the Orange County Register's Female Athlete of the Year and to the MaxPreps All-California First Team.
She was also named the Trinity League MVP and the Orange County Player of the Year.

 As a senior she averaged 13.8 points, 6.3 rebounds and 4.0 assists and helped lead Rosary High School to the 2020 CIF Southern California DI Regional championship before the tournament was suspended due to COVID-19. Rosary HS won the 2019 State Championship and Avinger took home tournament MVP honors after scoring 24 points in the championship game.

 Avinger's twin brother Noah is on the Aztec football team and became the first freshman cornerback to start a game since 2009. Her older brother Lucky is also on the team.

### Sophia Ramos Enters Senior Year with Sights Set on SDSU Record Books

 Barring injury, senior guard Sophia Ramos (San Antonio, Texas) could finish her career in the top five all-time in points and assists and become the only Aztec ever with 1,500 points, 400 assists and 500 rebounds in a career. She is also one of the best free-throw and three-point shooters in program history.

 Ramos is one of five active players in the nation with at least 1,100 points, 400 rebounds, 300 assists and 100 steals in her career while playing in less than 100 games. She is the only one of those five who also has a career free throw percentage over 80.

 With two more made free-throws, Ramos will move into 10th place for most free-throws made in a career, which means she will be top 10 all-time in four categories: 3-point field goal percentage, 3-point field goals made, assists and made free throws.

• Career records aren't kept for free throw percentage, but she has two of the top ten single-season marks for free throw percentage. She was 85 percent from the line in 2019-20 and 83.1 percent last year.

• Ramos became the 13th Aztec to reach 1,000 points in three seasons or less and the 10th to do it in 70 or fewer games.

#### **Opponent Notebook (San Diego)**

• The Toreros are 4-2 on the year.

- They are 1-1 on the road. This will be their first road game since Nov. 14, a 66-46 win at Idaho.
- They have wins over two Mountain West schools: Air Force (52-46) and Fresno State (68-64)
- They average 14.7 steals per game, fourth in the nation.
- USD is also sixth in the nation in turnovers forced per game, a whopping 25.7.
- They have balanced scoring with no players averaging double-digits. They have nine players average between 5.0 and 10 points per game.
- Jordyn Edwards averages 3.4 steals per game, 14th in the nation.
- Head coach Cindy Fisher is in her 17th year at USD. She has guided the Toreros to six 20-win seasons in the past 10 years.

#### **Series Notes**

- The Aztecs lead the all-time series 30-14
- SDSU won at USD last year 64-56 after jumping out to a 20-6 first quarter lead. Tea

Adams led the Aztecs with 19 points on 9-for-10 shooting and Sophia Ramos had 15 points, 10 rebounds and five steals.

- The Aztecs are 20-7 all-time against USD at home.
- SDSU won the first 17 meetings and 24 of the first 25 games against the Toreros.
- Since 2002, USD leads the series 13-6.
- In the last 10 meetings, the winning team has topped 70 points just twice,
- The first meeting between these two schools was Feb. 28, 1989, an 83-31 SDSU win.

### Aztecs Partner with Jordan Brand

The San Diego State women's basketball program is the newest member of the Jordan Brand family.

Beginning this season, the team will wear the latest Jordan Brand footwear and all oncourt apparel including uniforms, practice gear and travel attire will be Jumpman branded.

SDSU is the ninth women's basketball program in the Jordan lineup, joining Florida, Georgetown, Houston, Marquette, Michigan, North Carolina, Oklahoma and UCLA. The Aztecs are one of just two programs on the West Coast to be partnered with the brand.

Jordan is one of the most popular shoes in the basketball community and this will help us market the San Diego State program.

#### Aztecs Add Jason Glover and Kellie Lewis to Coaching Staff

Head coach Stacie Terry-Hutson added two new assistant coaches in the offseason in Jason Glover and Kellie Lewis.

Glover was most recently the Associate Head Coach at USC (2017-21) and brings over 30 years of coaching experience to SDSU including 15+ years at the DI level. Glover, who has spent time in the NBA, WNBA, NBA G-League and junior college, is known for being an X's and O's tactician and has an impressive track record in player development.

Glover, who attended SDSU for two years, has spent the past eight seasons as an associate head coach at the DI level. He was at USC for the last four years coaching under Mark Trakh, who he also coached with at New Mexico State for the 2016-17 season. That year the Aggies went 24-7 and 14-0 in the WAC and reached the NCAA Tournament. Lewis was most recently at Colorado State (2018-21) and comes to SDSU with 17 years of DI experience, including five as the head coach at Florida Atlantic.

Lewis also spent a combined nine years at Nebraska (2007-12) and Washington (2003-17) as an assistant while also coordinating each program's recruiting efforts. In her career, Lewis has coached in the Big Ten, Big 12, Pac-12 (then Pac-10), Conference USA and Sun Belt.

During Lewis' last two years at Colorado St., the Rams were second in the nation for fewest turnovers per game. Last season, CSU went 15-6 overall and 11-5 in the Mountain West and ranked in top ten nationally in four categories (turnovers/ game, assist-to-turnover ratio, three-point % and defensive rebounds/game).

Lewis coached a high-scoring offense throughout her tenure as head coach of Florida Atlantic, including the program's No. 2 all-time single-season scoring offense both by total points (2,331) and average (77.7) in 2013-14. Her teams made 195 three-pointers or more in four of her five seasons and broke the school record for threes in a season twice. The Owls sunk 264 triples in 2013-14, then 294 in 2015-16, a Conference USA record.

In addition to those single-season three-point field goal records, FAU also set the program record for highest team three-point field goal percentage (.350) in 2015-16. Among other records set under Lewis' guidance were C-USA's single-game three-point field goals record (20) and steals (33).

Terry-Hutson also announced the hiring of Mel Boscarino as the Director of Player Development She joins the women's basketball team after working for SDSU's event management department since 2019.
