Big Notes

- San Diego State wins its season-opening game for a ninth straight year.
- San Diego State wins its 20th straight game against Big West Conference competition.
- San Diego State won its 16th straight game against teams from the state of California.
- Matt Bradley's 23-points were the most in an Aztec debut since Jerome Habel scored 23 points vs. California on Nov. 18, 2006.
- San Diego State improves to 12-0 lifetime against UC Riverside.
- The 12-game win streak against the Highlanders is the second longest active streak for the Aztecs against any opponent (LaVerne, 13).

<u>Team Notes</u>

- San Diego State is 23-2 since the beginning of last season with 15 straight wins when leading at the half.
- The Aztecs are 123-7 the last 130 times it has led at the half in Viejas Arena.
- San Diego State is 54-7 since the beginning of the 2019-20 season.
- Since the start of the 2009-10 campaign, the Aztecs are 171-23 at home.
- Since Feb. 22, 2012, San Diego State is 106-8 at home when shooting at least 38.9 percent from the field.
- San Diego State held UC Riverside to 39.2 percent field goal shooting. The Aztecs are 41-1 the last 42 times they have been held to 40 percent or less.
- San Diego State has won 17 straight games when leading with five minutes to play.
- Tonight, marked just the third time in the last 29 contest that San Diego State did not make at least three 3-pointers (vs. Utah State in the MW Championship, 3-13-21 and vs. Pepperdine on 12-6-20)

Game Flow Notes

- Dunks: San Diego State 2 (Mensah 2), UC Riverside 0.
- Shot Clock Violations Caused: San Diego State 2.
- Tip: Moorman (UCR) controls tip via back tip.
- San Diego State scored on its first offensive possession of the game on a straightaway three-pointer by Trey Pulliam at 19:29 of the first half.

- Matt Bradley's first points as an Aztec came on a layup in transition at 16:49.
- San Diego State used a 16-2 first half run to take control. The Aztecs trailed 20-16 when the run started and ended the spurt with a 32-22 lead. Matt Bradley had 12 of the 16 points during the stretch.

<u>Playrer Notes</u>

Matt Bradley – game-high 23 points, 8-13 FGs, +16

Had a game-high 23 points... It is the most points in an Aztec debut since Jerome Habel scored 23 points vs. California on Nov. 18, 2006... Has scored in double figures in 14 straight games dating back to Jan. 23, 2021... During a 16-2 San Diego State run in the first half he scored 12 points... It was his 23rd career game with at least 20 points... It was his 14th consecutive double-digit scoring game dating back to his time at California.

Nathan Mensah – 8 points, 4-4 FGs, game-high 10 rebounds, 2 assists

His two blocked shots gave him 102 for his career and put him in an eighth-place tie on the program's career blocked shots list with 102... Recorded his 10th career double-digit rebound game (San Diego State is 10-0 in those games)... Recorded two dunks in the game... His 4-for-4 performance from the field is the second best of his career, trailing a 7-for-7 game against New Mexico (1-15-19)... This marked the 29th time in his career that he has blocked multiple shots in a game... He has blocked a shot in seven straight games dating back to last season.

Trey Pulliam - 15 points, 4 rebounds

This marked his ninth career double-digit scoring game (the Aztecs are 9-0 in those games)... Pulliam reached double figures for five of the last six games and six of the last 10 contests... His four rebounds were one of his career high of five.
