Big Notes

- **Matt Bradley** scores 20-plus points in consecutive games for the first time in his SDSU career.
- In the last 4:31 of the contest, **Matt Bradley** had eight points (3-3 FGs, 2-2 FTs), one assist and one steal.
- **Trey Pulliam** had 15 points, career-high seven rebounds, a career-high tying four steals in 36:38 of action.
- **Adam Seiko** scored a season-high 11 points with his fourth career double-digit scoring game.
- This is just the second time this season Cal State Fullerton has suffered a double-digit loss.

Trends

- The Aztecs are 11-1 in its last 12 games immediately following a loss.
- When a loss is immediately followed by a home game, San Diego State has won 18 straight games.
- San Diego State is 54-3 in the Dutcher era when holding the opponent to less than 60 points.
- This is the seventh time in nine games this season that SDSU has held its opponent to 40 percent or less shooting from the field.
- SDSU is 46-2 the last 48 times it has held its opponent to 40 percent or less shooting.
- San Diego State has won 23 straight games when outrebounding its opponent.

Streaks Extended

- San Diego State has won 30 straight games vs. Big West competition
- San Diego State has won its last 24 home games against Big West teams.
- San Diego State extends its home winning streak to 14 games.
- San Diego State has won its last 12 games on Wednesday.
- San Diego State extends its winning streak against Cal State Fullerton to 3 games.

Big Picture

- SDSU improves to 155-23 (.871) in games played in Viejas Arena since the start of the 2010-11 season.
- The Aztecs improve to 187-35 (.842) in game played in California since the start of the 2010-11 season.
- San Diego State improves to 64-17 (.790) in its last 81 games played on Tuesday.
- San Diego State improves to 58-8 (.9906) in Viejas Arena since in the start of the Dutcher era (2017-18 season).

Matt Bradley – game-high 22 points, 3 assists, season-high 34:55

Scored consecutive 20-point games for the first time in his San Diego State career... Has 22 or more points in consecutive games for the first time since Jan. 30 and Feb. 1, 2020)... This was the 26th game with at least 20 points in his career (3rd at SDSU)... Reached double figure scoring for the seventh time this season and 78th time in his collegiate career... Scored seven of the team's first nine points... In the last 4:31 of the game, he had eight points (3-3 FGs, 2-2 FTs), one assist and one steal... Had multiple three-pointers for the second straight game (first time this season) and the third time this season... Played a season-high 34:55.

Trey Pulliam – 15 points, 7 rebounds, tied career-high 4 steals, 3 assists

Scored 15 points (one off his season high of 16)... Scored in double figures for the sixth time this season and 14th time in his career (SDSU 12-2 in those games)... Tied a career-high with four steals (also: vs. St. Katherine, 12-2-20)... Set a career-high with seven rebounds.

Adam Seiko – 11 points, 4-6 FGs, 3-4 3FGs, 3 rebounds, 2 steals, 0 turnovers

Scored in double figures for the first time this season and fourth time of his career... It is the sixth time in his career he has at least three 3-pointers in a game and SDSU is 5-1 in those games... This is the 57th time in his career he has played in a game without committing a turnover (has played at least 10 minutes in 47 of those games)... Entered the game with 21 points and five treys for the season (had 11 points and three treys tonight)... Has two turnovers in 175 minutes played this season... First player this season with at least the following 11 points, three rebounds, two steals and no turnovers in a game... Last season, an Aztec player produced that line five times (Jordan Schakel 3, Lamont Butler and Matt Mitchell).

Nathan Mensah – 6 points, 9 rebounds, 3 blocked shots, 2 steals, 2 assists, season-high 31:41

Took solo possession of No. 4 on the program's career blocked shots list with three rejections and now has 121 for his career... He is six blocks from equaling Malcolm Thomas for No. 3 (127 blocks)... This is his career-high sixth straight game with multiple blocked shots (17 blocks)... He has a blocked shot in a career-high 16 consecutive games... His five offensive rebounds tonight are his most since pulling down seven boards off the offensive glass against San Jose State (2-8-21)... It is tied for his fourth most offensive rebounds in his career... His 31:41 tonight is a season-high.
