Postgame Notes: vs. San José State | San Diego, Calif. | Wednesday, Feb. 10, 2021

Big Notes

- San Diego State has won six consecutive games, all of which have come by at least 22 points. Tonight's game was the smallest margin during the win streak.
- The Aztecs have not trailed for one second, in the second half, of any of the last six games.
- San Diego State has outscored its opponent in the last six games by a score of 536-357 (+179 points).
- San Diego State extends the following win streaks:
 - 6-game overall win streak (longest active win streak in the Mountain West Conference, SDSU's season-long win streak)
 - 7-game homecourt win streak (the Aztecs are 25-3 in their last 28 home games)
 - 10-game homecourt win streak against San José State (last Spartans win at SDSU came on Feb. 27, 1997, one month later head coach Steve Fisher and his assistant Brian Dutcher led Michigan to the postseason NIT title)
 - 7-game overall win streak against San José State (Brian Dutcher is 7-0 against the Spartans)
 - 13-game winning streak against teams from the state of California (SDSU is tied with USC for the longest active win streak by a California team against teams from the state of California)
- The six-game win streak is the third-longest win streak of his tenure. The Aztecs won nine straight games (last six of the regular season and three games in the conference tournament) during his first season in 2017-18 and won the first 26 games of the 2019-20 campaign.

Team Notes

- San Diego State held San Jose State to just 55 points. The Aztecs are 49-2 the last 51 times they have held the opposition to 60 points or less.
- The Aztecs enjoyed a 51-39 rebound advantage tonight and the Aztecs are now 14-0 this season when owning a rebound advantage.
- This is the sixth straight game SDSU has held a +12 rebound margin or better. During the six-game stretch, the Aztecs are +108 on the glass (+18.0 rpg).
- The Aztecs had only six turnovers tonight and has only 19 turnovers in the last three games (6.3 topg).
- San Diego State shot 39.7 percent from the field and is 103-8 at home since Feb. 22, 2012 when shooting at least 38.9 percent from the floor.
- Second chance points: San Diego State 17, San Jose State 0.
- The Aztecs had a 34-8 advantage in points in the paint.
- San Diego State enjoyed a halftime advantage for the seventh consecutive game.
- San Diego State had a 10-0 scoring run in the second half. It marked the 21st time this season that SDSU has put together a run of at least 10-0.

Player Notes

Jordan Schakel – game-high 24 points, 6-13 3FGs, 4 rebounds, 2 assists, team-high +18

This is the 5th 20-point scoring game of his career (SDSU is 5-0 in those games) and the first time he has ever done it in back-to-back games... Scored 15 or more points in a game for the 18th time in his career (San Diego State is 17-1 in those games)... Mad six three-point field goals (his third career game with at least six treys)... Had at least one three-point field goal in 19 consecutive games... Reached double figures in a career-high seven straight contests... **Made his 200th career three-point field goal tonight (he is the fifth player in school history to do it – also: Brandon Heath (281), Tony Ross (270), Chase Tapley (223), D.J. Gay (219))**... Needs 88 points to reach 1,000 for his career.

Terrell Gomez – 13 points, 5 rebounds, 3 assists, +12

Reached double figures for the ninth time this season and the 90th time in his career... His career numbers: 1,793 points, 251 rebounds, 329 assists, 332 three-point field goals... Tied his season-high with five rebounds... Last five games: 15 assists, 1 turnover... Last five games: 12-of-24 from three-point range (50.0 percent).

Lamont Butler – 11 points, 5 rebounds, 2 assists, 2 steals

Did not reach double figure sin his first 12 career games but the freshman has 11 or more points in four of his last seven contests... Tied a career-high with five rebounds... Posted multiple steals for the third time this season.
