#### WHAT'S ON TAP FOR AZTEC BASEBALL

- > San Diego State opens its 82nd season of baseball competition this weekend when it plays host to the University of San Diego for a three-game series, Feb. 19-21.
- > The Aztecs and Toreros will clash at Tony Gwynn Stadium on Friday and Saturday, starting at 1 p.m. PT, before the scene shifts to USD's Fowler Park for Sunday's finale, which is scheduled to get underway at 2 p.m. PT.
- > A link to live stats will be available throughout the weekend, while Friday's opener will be streamed live via the Mountain West Network on GoAztecs.com.
- > For the third straight season, San Diego State was picked first in the Mountain West Preseason Coaches Poll.
- > In addition, the Aztecs had three players selected to the preseason all-MW team in right fielder Jaden Fein, starting pitcher Troy Melton and center fielder Matt Rudick.
- > With the Mountain West back to seven teams, the league returns to a double round-robin format for the 2021 campaign. The teams will play a 36-game conference schedule, with weekends consisting mostly of doubleheaders on Saturday and a Sunday series finale.
- > The MW tournament has been eliminated and the regular-season champion will receive the league's automatic NCAA Tournament bid.
- > In accordance with state, local and university guidelines, fans will not be permitted to attend Aztec home baseball games at Tony Gwynn Stadium during the 2021 season.
- > However, the Mountain West Network will stream 14 SDSU home baseball games this year, as well as selected road contests against conference opponents.
- > In addition, the Aztecs' other home games will feature a live stream on the team's YouTube channel, with a link available on GoAztecs.com.

#### **HEAD COACH MARK MARTINEZ**

> Mark Martinez begins his seventh season as head coach of the Aztecs and 16th overall as a member of the San Diego State staff after succeeding the late Tony Gwynn on August 20, 2014. He is just the fifth head coach in SDSU history since baseball was elevated to major sport status in 1936. > During his tenure as the Aztecs' head coach, Martinez has compiled a 185-134 record (.580), highlighted by three Mountain West tournament championships in 2015, 2017 and 2018. He has also posted an 84-64 ledger (.568) in conference regular-season games.

> Since 2015, SDSU has garnered 30 all-Mountain West accolades under Martinez's tutelage, including back-to-back MW Pitchers of the Year Brett Seeburger (2017) and Garrett Hill (2018), as well as 2017 MW Player of the Year Danny Sheehan.

> Additionally, Martinez has mentored three freshman All-Americans in Chase Calabuig (2015), Casey Schmitt (2018) and Jaden Fein (2019),

with the latter also receiving Mountain West Co-Freshman of the Year distinction last year.

> In 2017, Martinez recorded his 100th victory for the Scarlet and Black, becoming the fastest head coach in program history to reach the century mark in wins.

> Not to be outdone, Martinez also became the fastest head coach in Mountain West history to win three conference championships when the Aztecs captured the title in 2018.

> Martinez was hired as an assistant coach for the Aztecs in July of 2005 and served for nine years under head coach Tony Gwynn. During that time, he was promoted to the position of associate head coach.

> Since his arrival on The Mesa as an assistant coach, Martinez has witnessed 44 SDSU players get drafted into the professional ranks, with nine of those selections making the major leagues (Stephen Strasburg, Addison Reed, Justin Masterson, Bruce Billings, Quintin Berry, Lance Zawadzki,

Greg Allen, Ty France and Seby Zavala).

> Prior to his arrival at San Diego State, Martinez was an assistant coach at New Mexico for 17 seasons from 1989-2005. During his time as a hitting and infield coach, he helped develop the Lobos into one of the most prominent offensive teams in the country, with UNM ranking among the top 11 nationally in hitting over his final four seasons.

> Martinez served as an assistant at his alma mater, Mesa State College (now Colorado Mesa University) in Grand Junction, Colorado, from 1984-88. He played shortstop at the school from 1982-84, earning all-conference and all-district honors as a senior.

> Martinez graduated from Mesa State with a bachelor's degree in physical education in 1984 and completed his master's in sports administration at New Mexico in 1990.

Week 1: vs. San Diego 2020 Record (10-6, 0-0 MW)

#### FOR OPENERS

- > San Diego State has a record of 53-28-1 in season openers dating back to 1936 (SDSU did not field a team from 1943-45). Since attaining Division I status in 1969, the Aztecs are 32-17 in their
- > SDSU has won its last four openers Virginia Tech (2020), San Francisco (2019), UC Santa Barbara (2018) and Pacific (2017) - giving the Scarlet and Black a 6-4 mark in its last 10 lid-lifters.
- > When opening the season at home, SDSU sports a record of 18-11 in the Division 1 era and a 13-9 ledger when beginning the year on the road.
- > Last season, the Aztecs rallied for a 7-5 victory over Virginia Tech at the Brittain Resorts Baseball by the Beach tournament in Conway, South Carolina, marking SDSU's first neutral-site opener in 52 years at the Division I level.

#### **SERIES RECORD VS. USD**

- > San Diego State leads the all-time series, 76-58-3, dating back to 1962.
- > The Aztecs and Toreros were scheduled to meet twice during the 2020 campaign; however, the remainder of the season was canceled following the onset of the COVID-19 pandemic.
- > SDSU split its last two meetings against USD in 2019, with each team claiming a 4-2 victory on the other's home field in single mid-week encounters.
- > In the Aztecs' triumph at Fowler Park that season, Brian Leonhardt hit a solo home run in the top of the second and also struck out three batters in a pitching relief appearance of 3.1 innings.
- > San Diego State will battle the Toreros in a season-opening series for the first time since 2013, when the visiting Aztecs swept all three games at USD (8-1, 4-2, 5-3).
- > The Scarlet and Black also captured three of four games vs. the Toreros to open the 2008 campaign, winning twice at Tony Gwynn Stadium.
- > SDSU head coach Mark Martinez is 7-4 against USD after taking over the reins of the Aztec
- > Since Fowler Park and Cunningham Field opened in 2013, San Diego State is 8-1 when playing at USD and has outscored the Toreros 51-22 during that stretch.

#### **AZTEC WEEKEND ROTATION**

- > San Diego State's projected pitching rotation against USD will feature two returning starters bookending the series ground an intriguing matchup on Saturday.
- > Troy Melton (3-1, 3.22 ERA, 22.0 IP) will get the call on opening day. The SDSU right-hander shared the conference lead with three victories in a shortened 2020 campaign, which was tied for 23rd nationally, while his 26 strikeouts and .192 opposing batting average ranked second and third in the MW, respectively.
- > On Saturday, Kohl Simas will face his old teammates in his first start as an Aztec after transferring from USD. In his lone season with the Toreros last year, the Fresno native made four relief appearances, posting the second-lowest ERA on the team (2.45) while striking out 15 batters in 11.0 innings.
- > Meanwhile, Michael Paredes (1-1, 4.05 ERA, 20.0 IP) is projected to get the starting nod in Sunday's finale. Last season, the San Diego High alumnus ranked among the Mountain West leaders in walks (T8th - 6) and earned runs allowed (T9th - 9)
- > Neither Melton nor Paredes have faced USD in their respective collegiate careers.

#### **SETTING THE SCENE FOR 2021**

- > San Diego State returns 20 letterwinners from last year's squad that finished with a 10-6 overall record during the 2020 season that was cut short due to the COVID-19 pandemic. The Aztecs welcome back six starting position players and three starting pitchers.
- > Between 2013 and 2019. SDSU captured five Mountain West tournament championships and made five NCAA Regional appearances. The Aztecs are also the only team in the league to have won 30 or more games six times in that stretch
- > The Aztecs were pegged for a first-place finish in the 2021 MW preseason coaches poll, attaining the status of conference favorites for the third year in a row.
- > Leading the list of returners is starting pitcher Troy Melton, who earned a spot on USA Baseball's Golden Spikes Award Preseason Watch List. The Anaheim, California, product was ranked 79th on D1Baseball.com's Top 100 List of collegiate draft prospects for 2021 and was tabbed the preseason Mountain West Pitcher of the Year by the same website, as well as Baseball America.
- > An all-conference honoree from last year, Melton was also named to the preseason all-Mountain West team, along with center fielder Matt Rudick and right fielder Jaden Fein.
- > In addition to all-league consideration, Fein was named the MW Preseason Player of the Year by Baseball America.
- $>\,$  SDSU also welcomes 20 newcomers, including 13 true freshmen, four transfers from the Division I ranks and three junior college players, all of whom comprise a talented recruiting class that was ranked 22nd nationally by Perfect Game.
- > One of the new rookie is Cole Carriag, a catcher/utility player who twice participated at the prestigious Area Code Games for the Athletics squad.
- > As a junior at Turlock High in 2019, Carrigg garnered first-team all-Central California Athletic Legaue accolades as a utility player after leading the Bulldogs to the conference title and a berth in

> Another touted newcomer is catcher Poncho Ruiz, who was named the No. 1 ranked Mountain West incoming freshman by Perfect Game. A graduate of Mater Dei Catholic High in nearby Chula Vista, Ruiz also earned a No. 18 national ranking among catchers for the 2020 high school graduating class by Perfect Game and received a scout grade of 9.5 by the website.

#### **USD AT A GLANCE**

- > The Toreros finished the shortened 2020 campaign with a 12-4 record, including an 8-0 mark at home.
- > USD notched victories over multiple Power 5 schools last year, including Oregon, Minnesota, Nebraska, Iowa and Indiana.
- > The Toreros' Jake Miller tossed a no-hitter in the opener of a three-game series vs. Monmouth.
- > San Diego was picked third in the 2021 West Coast Conference preseason poll behind Pepperdine and Gonzaga.
- > In addition, Shane McGuire, Caleb Ricketts, and Carter Rustad were named to the 2021 preseason all-WCC team.
- > McGuire, who split time between first base and catcher last year, hit a team-leading .469 (15-32), finishing fifth on the squad in hits while collecting four doubles and one home run. His batting average ranked second in the WCC and No. 7 nationally.
- > Another utility player who alternated between first base and catcher in 2020, Ricketts ranked third on the Toreros with a .351 batting average and occupied the second spot on the team with 20 hits to go with four doubles and one triple. He also finished sixth in the WCC with a team-high 16 RBIs and compiled a .456 slugging percentage.
- > Rustad was named a Collegiate Baseball Freshman All-American last year after leading the team with a 0.84 ERA, which ranked second in the WCC and 39th nationally. The 6-foot-5 right-hander also topped the WCC and ranked second in the country in both victories (4) and hits allowed per nine innings (2.11).
- > Rich Hill is entering his 34th season as a head coach at the collegiate level in 2021 and 23rd in charge of the Torero program. Hill has amassed a career record of 1,046-726-4 (.589) and is 714-502-4 (.585) during his tenure at USD. He is the youngest active coach with 1,000 wins and the winningest coach in the WCC, both current and all-time.

#### **AZTECS TABBED PRESEASON MOUNTAIN WEST FAVORITES**

- > For the third straight season, San Diego State baseball team was picked first in the Mountain West preseason coaches poll, as announced Feb. 11 by the conference office.
- > Collectively, SDSU garnered 36 points and five first-place votes, topping second-place Fresno State (29 pts, 1 first-place vote), while New Mexico and UNLV tied for third with 23 points apiece. Rounding out the remainder of the poll were Nevada (5th, 16 pts), Air Force (6th, 11 pts) and San José State (7th, 9 pts).
- > The Aztecs were also predicted to finish first prior to the 2014 campaign.

#### MELTON NAMED TO GOLDEN SPIKES AWARD WATCH LIST

- > Starting pitcher Troy Melton added to his growing list of preseason accolades on Feb. 18 when he earned a spot on the USA Baseball's Golden Spikes Award Watch List, beginning the process of identifying the nation's top amateur player for the 2021 season.
- > With his nomination, Melton becomes the fourth Aztec player since 2008 to land on the preseason Golden Spikes Award Watch List, joining Casey Schmitt (2020), Michael Cederoth (2014), Addison Reed (2010) and Stephen Strasburg, who earned the top honor in 2009. In addition, Tyler Adkison landed on the GSA mid-season watch list in 2017.
- > A native of Anaheim, California, Melton garnered all-Mountain West accolades in the abbreviated 2020 campaign after posting a 3-1 record with a 3.22 ERA and 26 strikeouts. The SDSU right-hander shared the conference lead with three victories, which was tied for 23rd nationally, while his strikeouts and opposing batting average (.192) ranked second and third in the MW, respectively. He also found himself among the MW leaders in fewest hits allowed (4th 15), runs allowed (T4th 9), ERA (7th) and innings pitched (7th 22.1) while limiting opponents to a .185 batting average with runners in scoring position.
- > Last season, Melton earned Mountain West Pitcher of the Week honors after combining on the Aztecs' 6-0 home shutout of 2018 national champion Oregon State on Feb. 29, 2020. In that contest, he held the Beavers to four hits in that game while striking out a career-high nine batters against only one walk in six scoreless innings.
- > Prior to the upcoming campaign, Melton was rated 79th on D1Baseball.com's Top 100 List of collegiate draft prospects for 2021 and was heralded as the preseason Mountain West Pitcher of the Year by the same website, as well as Baseball America.

#### FEIN, MELTON, RUDICK LAND ON PRESEASON ALL-MOUNTAIN WEST TEAM

- > The Aztec trio of Jaden Fein, Troy Melton and Matt Rudick each earned on spot on the preseason all-Mountain West team announced on Feb. 11.
- > Fein, who earned Mountain West Co-Freshman of the Year honors in 2019 to go with Freshman All-America accolades from Collegiate Baseball magazine, recorded a team-high .348 batting average during the abbreviated 2020 season, finishing with one home run, one double, seven RBIs and seven runs scored in 16 games.
- > The Aztec right fielder also found himself among the team leaders in on-base percentage (2nd .404), slugging percentage (3rd .435), RBIs with two outs (3rd 5), walks (T-4th 5) and RBIs (5th) and topped the squad in batting average with runners in scoring position (.571) and with two outs (.474). He hit safely in the final seven games in 2020, raising his average from .273 to .348 during that span.
- > In addition to all-conference consideration, Fein was named the MW Preseason Player of the Year by Baseball America.
- > Not to be outdone, Rudick merited all-conference distinction for the second straight year in 2020 after posting the Aztecs' third-highest batting average (.313) while leading the team in slugging percentage (.478), hits (21) and runs scored (13), with the latter tying for ninth

in the league.

- > The SDSU center fielder also topped the squad with 32 total bases and tied for second in the MW with a team-high three triples, which was tied for 10th in the country.
- > In addition, Rudick was the Aztecs' leader with multiple hits in seven games and tied for second on the squad with a six-game hitting streak to open the season. He was also none of the toughest players in the conference to strike out, fanning once every 11.2 at-bats, which ranked third in the MW.
- > In the summer of 2020, Rudick was named San Diego College Baseball League Player of the Year after batting .419 in 16 regular-season games while posting four doubles, three triples, three home runs, 18 RBI and 22 runs scored for the Warriors squad. He also went 5-for-10 at the plate in two playoff games.

#### **SUPER SENIORS**

- > Head coach Mark Martinez has dubbed the trio of Ryan Orr, Mike Jarvis and Jacob Cruce "Super Seniors" after the three players returned to The Mesa this season after their 2020 campaign was cut short due to the COVID-19 pandemic. All three have provided outstanding upperclassman leadership, helping the Aztec program navigate through new health and safety protocols.
- > In his first year as an outfielder in 2020, Orr was enjoying a breakout season, starting all 16 games for the Aztecs, including 14 in left field. The La Costa Canyon High alumnus posted the fifth-highest batting average on the team at .295 while tying for third with 18 hits in 61 at-bats.
- > Orr also finished fourth on the sauad with 22 total bases and shared the team lead with four doubles, adding eight runs scored, seven RBIs and one stolen base. He additionally tied for fourth on the squad with multiple hits in five games and ranked fifth with a five-game hitting streak from Feb. 14-Feb. 21. 2020.
- > Jarvis started all 16 agmes as the Aztecs' leadoff hitter last season, including 10 in center field and six at second base, batting .273 with two home runs and seven RBIs.
- > The Clairemont High product led the Scarlet and Black with five stolen bases, which was tied for ninth in the Mountain West, and shared the team top spot in homers and doubles (4). He also found himself among SDSU's leaders in runs scored (2nd - 12), hits (3rd - 18), on-base percentage (5th - .342) and slugging percentage (5th - .424).
- > In the summer of 2020, Jarvis played for the Hooks team that captured the San Diego League championship. He received first-team all-league recognition and was named to Team Sea for the circuit's All-Star game in July.
- > Cruce, meanwhile, appeared in 13 games in 2020, making seven starts at designated hitter and three at first base. The northern California native ranked fourth on the Aztecs in batting average (.300) and slugging percentage (.425), collecting 12 hits in 40 at-bats to go with two doubles and seven RBIs with four runs scored. He strung together two three-game hitting streaks (Feb. 16-21 and Feb. 29-March 3), driving in at least one run in each of those contests.

#### STRIKEOUTS GALORE

- > San Diego State recorded 27 games with 10 or more strikeouts during the 2019 campaign, marking the most double-digit strikeout performances for the Aztecs in the MW era (since 2000). SDSU surpassed the previous MW record of 23 set in a 10-6 win at Fresno State on May 11, 2009.
- > During the shortened 2020 season, the Aztec pitching staff notched seven games with 10 strikeouts: vs. Virginia Tech, Cal State Fullerton, Iowa, Nebraska, at UC Irvine and twice against Oregon State. Not surprisingly, the Scarlet and Black went 6-1 in those contests.
- > Dating back to 2019, the Aztecs are 22-12 in their last 34 games when striking out 10 or more batters.

#### GOING, GOING, GONE

- > San Diego State owns a current winning streak of three games when hitting a home run and has captured 15 of its last 18 dating back to 2019 when aoina vard.
- > During the 2019 season, the Aztecs were 17-5 when launching one out of the park.

#### OTHER TRENDS

- > In addition, the scoring the game's first run has proved to be important for the Aztecs, who posted a 6-2 ledger during the shortened 2020 season when scoring first.
- > In 2019, SDSU compiled a 19-6 record when scoring first in comparison to a 13-17 mark when its opponent tallied the first run.
- > The Aztecs are 68-12 in their last 80 games when scoring five or more runs, including a 6-2 record in 2020.
- > San Diego State is 48-19 last 67 games following a loss.

- > Since the start of the 2012 season, San Diego State is 156-100 (.609) when playing at home.
- > In 2018, the Aztecs set a program record with 25 home victories at Tony Gwynn Stadium (since 1997), besting the previous standard of 24 set in 1997, 2002 and 2014.

#### **CRAZY TONY GWYNN PLAYER STATS**

- > Tony Gwynn completed his illustrious career with a .338 lifetime batting average. Every other player who had a career batting average of at least .338 played before 1943.
- > Gwynn hit .368 over a five-year stretch between 1993 and 1997.
- > Gwynn faced Tom Glavine, Greg Maddux, Pedro Martinez, and John Smoltz a combined 323 times. He struck out three times over those at bats.
- > Gwynn never struck out more than 40 times in a season and struck out less than 20 times in six straight season. Had a career-low 15 strikeouts in 1995.

# TONY GWYNN STADIUM



Tony Gwynn Stadium became the new home of the San Diego State baseball program during the 1997 season. Upon its opening, the facility was hailed as one of the top college baseball stadiums in the country. A poll of college coaches by Baseball America ranked it among the top 20 collegiate facilities in the nation and the fourth-best park in the western U.S.

Groundbreaking for this project took place on Aug. 21, 1996. The \$4 million facility was made possible through the generosity of San Diego Padres owner John Moores, who donated the funds to make the program's dream of a state-of-the-art stadium at San Diego State University a reality.

The structure is named in honor of the former Aztec player, head

coach, and MLB Hall of Famer. The playing field remains Charlie Smith Field in honor of the long-time former San Diego State head coach. It retains its former dimensions of 340 feet down both the right and left field lines and 410 to dead center field. Distance to the alleys is 360 feet in left center and 370 in right center.

Additional area has been added between home plate and the backstop (now 45 feet), and the warning track in the outfield has been widened to 20 feet. The field itself is a natural turf (Tif Santa Ana grass), while the infield and warning track utilize crushed brick dust.

The most recent field improvement consists of artificial field turf that extends from the end of each dugout in foul territory outside the base lines. The turf was installed prior to the start of the 2010 season. In addition, a large Aztec logo now occupies the area directly behind home plate.

The outfield is enclosed by a 10-foot high green wall made of a material designed to be resilient upon contact. The outfield wall features advertising signage as well as the names and numbers of past

players who have been honored for their accomplishments as members of the SDSU program.

Stadium lighting consists of six poles using 2000watt fixtures, making the facility one of the most well-lit fields in college and professional baseball.

The stadium's electronic scoreboard, installed prior to the start of the 2003 season, is located behind the right centerfield fence and features a complete line score as well as video playback capability.

Seating capacity of the stadium is 3,000, and that number could reach as high as 4,000 in the future. Of the 2,200 permanent seats installed during the initial phase of construction, 800 were armchair-style around the stadium at the field level. With the addition of new seating in May 2005, that number has increased to over 1,800, as more than 1,000 chair back seats were installed in the plaza level from first to third base. The remaining seats are comprised of bleacher benches that extend down both base lines.

The latest stadium improvements came just prior to the start of the 2010 season when Field Turf was

installed in the foul territory areas in front of both dugouts and behind home plate. In addition, new sod was placed in the infield. These upgrades were made possible by a donation to the baseball program by former Aztec pitcher Stephen Strasburg.

Among the amenities contained within the stadium itself are the following:

- Two concession stands and two sets of restrooms located behind the seating area on the plaza level.
- A coaches dressing room and adjacent players' meeting room located at the east end of the first base stands to be used for team functions as well as a lounge for SDSU athletes.
- The Stephen and Mary Birch Baseball Museum located at the north end of the third base stand. The museum features numerous items relating to the history of baseball at San Diego State.
