WHAT'S ON TAP FOR AZTEC BASEBALL

San Diego State returns to the diamond this weekend when it squares off against UC San Diego in a four-game series, Feb. 26-28.
 The Aztecs and Tritons will battle at Tony Gwynn Stadium on Friday and Saturday, starting at 1 p.m. PT, before the scene shifts to UCSD's Triton Ballpark for a Sunday doubleheader, which is scheduled to commence at 1 p.m. PT.

> The SDSU-UCSD series will be recognized as the sixth installment of the Tony Gwynn Legacy, which was launched in 2016. The Aztecs are 7-8 all-time in the Tony Gwynn Legacy, defeating Iowa (4-1) and Nebraska (4-2) at last year's tournament before falling to USC (11-5). The event has been scaled back this season amidst the COVID-19 pandemic.

> In accordance with state, local and university guidelines, fans will not be permitted to attend Aztec home baseball games at Tony Gwynn Stadium during the 2021 season.

Live stats will be available throughout the weekend, while Friday's opener will be streamed live via the Mountain West Network. In addition, Saturday's clash will feature a unique split-screen four-camera video stream, while Sunday's twin bill will be streamed on the ESPN3. Links to all platforms will be available on GoAztecs.com.

> For the third straight season, San Diego State was picked first in the Mountain West Preseason Coaches Poll.

In addition, the Aztecs had three players selected to the preseason all-MW team in right fielder Jaden Fein, starting pitcher Troy Melton and center fielder Matt Rudick.

> With the Mountain West back to seven teams, the league returns to a double round-robin format for the 2021 campaign. The teams will play a 36-game conference schedule, with weekends consisting mostly of doubleheaders on Saturday and a Sunday series finale.

The MW tournament has been eliminated and the regular-season champion will receive the league's automatic NCAA Tournament bid.

> The Mountain West Network will stream 14 SDSU home baseball games this year, as well as selected road contests against conference opponents.

> In addition, the Aztecs' other home games will feature a live stream on the team's YouTube channel, with a link available on GoAztecs.com.

HEAD COACH MARK MARTINEZ

> Mark Martinez is in his seventh season as head coach of the Aztecs and 16th overall as a member of the San Diego State staff after succeeding the late Tony Gwynn on August 20, 2014. He is just the fifth head coach in SDSU history since baseball was elevated to major sport status in 1936. > During his tenure as the Aztecs' head coach, Martinez has compiled a 185-134 record (.580), highlighted by three Mountain West tournament championships in 2015, 2017 and 2018. He has also posted an 84-64 ledger (.568) in conference regular-season games.

> Since 2015, SDSU has garnered 30 all-Mountain West accolades under Martinez's tutelage, including back-to-back MW Pitchers of the Year Brett Seeburger (2017) and Garrett Hill (2018), as well as 2017 MW Player of the Year Danny Sheehan.

> Additionally, Martinez has mentored three freshman All-Americans in Chase Calabuig (2015), Casey Schmitt (2018) and Jaden Fein (2019), with the latter also receiving Mountain West Co-Freshman of the Year distinction last year.

> In 2017, Martinez recorded his 100th victory for the Scarlet and Black, becoming the fastest head coach in program history to reach the century mark in wins.

> Not to be outdone, Martinez also became the fastest head coach in Mountain West history to win three conference championships when the Aztecs captured the title in 2018.

> Martinez was hired as an assistant coach for the Aztecs in July of 2005 and served for nine years under head coach Tony Gwynn. During that time, he was promoted to the position of associate head coach.

> Since his arrival on The Mesa as an assistant coach, Martinez has witnessed 44 SDSU players get drafted into the professional ranks, with nine of those selections making the major leagues (Stephen Strasburg, Addison Reed, Justin Masterson, Bruce Billings, Quintin Berry, Lance Zawadzki,

Greg Allen, Ty France and Seby Zavala).

> Prior to his arrival at San Diego State, Martinez was an assistant coach at New Mexico for 17 seasons from 1989-2005. During his time as a hitting and infield coach, he helped develop the Lobos into one of the most prominent offensive teams in the country, with UNM ranking among the top 11 nationally in hitting over his final four seasons.

> Martinez served as an assistant at his alma mater, Mesa State College (now Colorado Mesa University) in Grand Junction, Colorado, from 1984-88. He played shortstop at the school from 1982-84, earning all-conference and all-district honors as a senior.

> Martinez graduated from Mesa State with a bachelor's degree in physical education in 1984 and completed his master's in sports administration at New Mexico in 1990.

AZTEC WEEKEND ROTATION

- San Diego State's projected pitching rotation this weekend will feature the same trio that opened the season against USD, while the starter for Sunday's doubleheader nightcap is still to be determined at press time.
- > Troy Melton (1-0, 3.86 ERA) will open the series on Friday vs. the Tritons after picking up the victory in the 2021 lid-lifter against San Diego on Feb. 19. The SDSU right-hander allowed four runs (two earned) on four hits and one walk to go with three strikeouts in 4 2/3 innings. In a shortened 2020 campaign, he shared the conference lead with three victories, which was tied for 23rd nationally, while his 26 strikeouts and .192 opposing batting average ranked second and third in the MW, respectively.
- > On Saturday, Kohl Simas (0-0, 21.60 ERA) will make his second start as an Aztec after transferring from USD. His first appearance in a Scarlet and Black uniform was brief, yielding the mound after giving up five runs (four earned) on four hits and three walks to go with a pair of strikeouts in 1 2/3 innings against his former teammates on Feb. 20. In his lone season with the Toreros last year, the Fresno native pitched four games in relief, posting the second-lowest ERA on the team (2.45) while striking out 15 batters in 11.0 innings.
- > Meanwhile, Michael Paredes (0-0, 5.40 ERA, 20.0 IP) is projected to get the call on Sunday in the first game of the doubleheader. In his first start of the 2021 campaign vs. USD on Feb. 21, the San Diego High alumnus allowed three runs on three hits and one walk to go with a pair of strikeouts before exiting after five innings. Last season, Paredes ranked among the Mountain West leaders in walks (78th 6) and earned runs allowed (79th 9). As a freshman in 2019, he made his collegiate debut against a Big West school, countering one hit and one walk with a pair of strikeouts in 2/3 innings vs. UC Irvine in a 9-3 Aztec victory.

SERIES RECORD VS. UCSD

- > San Diego State leads the all-time series, 20-3, including a 16-2 mark at home and a 4-1 ledger on the road.
- > The Aztecs and Tritons last faced each other on Feb. 20, 2002, when Mike Moat and Royce Ring combined on a one-hitter, as the Scarlet and Black completed a 3-0 shutout in front of 713 fans at Tony Gwynn Stadium.
- > In that contest, Moat fanned 14 batters, giving up just one hit and one walk in eight innings for the victory, while Ring struck out the side in the ninth for the save.
- SDSU scored all three markers in the sixth inning, highlighted by Josh Hill's two-run single, while Josh Allen drove in another with a base hit to center.
- > The two programs first squared off against one another on April 15, 1971, when the Aztecs claimed a 6-3 victory on the road.
- $>\,$ SDSU won the first 15 meetings in the series before suffering its first loss in a 7-4 setback on April 7, 1987, in La Jolla.
- > This weekend will mark the first in-season series for the two teams. The Aztecs have played multiple single games against the Tritons in the same year in 1980, 1981, 1982, 1983, 1985, 1990 and 1991.
- > SDSU has won 10 of its last 13 games vs. Big West foes and is 30-10 in its last 40 encounters against that conference, including a 7-2 triumph at home over then No. 17/17 Long Beach State on March 3, 2020.

AZTECS AMONG NCAA STATISTICAL LEADERS

- > Following their offensive bonanza against USD, the Aztecs find themselves among the NCAA statistical leaders in several categories. As of Feb. 24, SDSU ranks second nationally with a .403 team batting average and a scoring average of 15.0 runs per game. In addition, the Scarlet and Black occupies the sixth spot in on-base percentage (.477) and runs (45) while ranking eighth in doubles per game (3.00).
- > Individually, Jaden Fein is tied for seventh with 2.67 hits per game and shares the 13th position with eight hits overall, while Jacob Cruce is tied for 10th with three doubles.
- > Heading into the weekend, the Aztecs have four players among the Mountain West individual top 10 in batting averaged, with Brian Leonhardt (.538), Jaden Fein (.533), Jacob Cruce (.500), Wyatt Hendrie (.463) holding down the second through fifth slots, respectively, behind Air Force's front-runner Blake Covin (.556).
- > In addition, SDSU boasts nine of the conference's top 15 RBI producers in Leonhardt (T-1st, 7), Fein (T-1st, 7), Cruce (T-3rd, 6), Hendrie (T-3rd, 6), Mike Jarvis (T-8th, 3), Ryan Orr (T-8th, 3), Caden Miller (T-8th, 3), Cole Carrigg (T-8th, 3) and Matt Rudick (T14th, 2).

UCSD AT A GLANCE

- > The Tritons are entering their first season as members of the Big West Conference, beginning their four-year transition to the NCAA Division I level that will be completed by the 2024-25 academic year. At that time, UCSD will be eligible for conference and NCAA postseason play.
- > In their final year at the Division II level in 2020, the Tritons posted a 17-4 record, including a 12-4 mark in the California Collegiate Athletic Association (CCAA) before the remainder of the season was canceled due to the COVID-19 pandemic. UCSD was ranked No. 1 in the final poll by Collegiate Baseball magazine and third by the NCBWA.

- > The Tritons were picked ninth in the Big West preseason coaches poll, receiving 33 points, ahead of UC Riverside (29 pts) and CSU Bakersfield (18 pts.). UC Santa Barbara was pegged for a first-place finish in the poll after garnering 119 pts and all 10 first-place votes, followed closely by Long Beach State (96 pts.), UC Irvine (95 pts.) and Cal Poly (94 pts.).
- > UCSD returns four players who were named to the CCAA All-Star team a year ago, including the pitching trio of Brandon Weed, Cameron Leonard and Luke Mattson, along with first baseman Blake Baumgartner.
- > The 2019 Division II West Region Pitcher of the Year, Weed posted a 4-0 record with a 2.17 ERA and 30 strikeouts in five starts last year, while Leonard compiled a 2-0 mark with a 2.30 ERA and 29 strikeouts in six starting appearances.
- > Mattson was effective out of the bullpen, compiling a 4-0 record with a 0.78 ERA and one save while leading the squad with 35 strikeouts in 23 innings of relief
- > Baumgartner, meanwhile, started all 21 games at first base in 2020, leading the team with 21 walks and 24 runs scored to go with a .343 batting average. A redshirt junior, Baumgartner ranks 10th on the Tritons' career list with 21 home runs.
- > Also back in the mix is third baseman Everett Lau, a former Auburn transfer who hit .303 with one home run and 11 RBIs last year to an with four doubles.
- > UCSD competes at Triton Ballpark, which underwent extensive renovations in time for the 2015 campaign. Current features include a permanent grandstand with chair backs and cup holders for 500 spectators, sunken dugouts with lighting, power and signage, a press box above the grandstand with ethernet, wireless internet and phone lines, as well as a clubhouse with separate locker rooms for coaches and players, coaches' offices, player study/entertainment lounge, kitchen, patio, laundry and storage areas.
- > Between the foul lines from left to right field, the dimensions of Triton Ballpark are symmetrical at 330-385-400-385-330.
- > Eric Newman is entering his 10th season as head coach of the Triton program, compiling an overall record of 309-162 (.656). A native of Fremont, California, Newman earned three consecutive ABCA/Diamond West Region Coach of the Year honors (2017-19) and was twice named California Collegiate Athletic Coach of the Year (2012, 2019). In 2017, he directed UCSD to the NCAA Division II West Regional title and a runner-up finish in the national tournament. Prior to his arrival in La Jolla, Newman spent four years as the pitching coach at Nebraska (2008-11) and served as head coach at Dallas Baptist (2005-07) after working as the team's pitching coach and associate head coach (2002-04). He was a fifth-round pick of the San Diego Padres in 1994 and pitched professionally with four different organizations across eight seasons, including the Chicago Cubs, Arizona Diamondbacks and Los Angeles Dodgers.

JADEN FEIN NAMED MW PLAYER OF THE WEEK

- > San Diego State right fielder Jaden Fein was named Mountain West Player of the Week for his performances in helping the Aztecs win two of three games in their season-opening series vs. San Diego, Feb. 19-21. With his award, Fein garnered the first weekly conference accolade of his career.
- > Against the Toreros, Fein posted a collective .533 batting average, leading the team with eight hits while tying for the top spot with seven runs batted in. With his effort, the SDSU redshirt sophomore totaled the same number of RBIs in three games as he did in 15 appearances during the shortened 2020 campaign.
- > In addition, Fein led the Aztecs with a .727 batting average (8-11) with runners on base and hit a team-best .714 with runners in scoring position (5-7). He also topped the squad with a 75 percent success rate in advancing runners (9-12) and shared team lead with three RBIs with runners on third base with less than two outs.
- > In the series opener on Feb. 19, Fein went 3-for-5 with two RBIs and two runs scored, propelling the Scarlet and Black to a 14-7 triumph. day. During a four-run outburst in the second inning of that contest, the Simi Valley, California, native singled and scored, as the Aztecs vaulted in front for good. He also contributed an RBI double and scored during a three-run fifth, as SDSU extended its advantage to 8-4 after USD closed to within one at the top of the frame. The Aztec right fielder later added an RBI single in the sixth, helping to put the contest out of reach at 12-4.
- > The following day, Fein collected a team-high three hits and four RBIs in SDSU's 19-18 come-from-behind thriller. He helped narrow the gap with a key two-run single in the seventh during a four-run spurt that kept the Aztecs with striking distance at 17-16.
- In the series finale on Sunday, Fein went 2-for-5 with an RBI to close out the weekend.
- > Fein was named MW Co-Freshman of the Year in 2019 to go with Freshman All-America honors from Collegiate Baseball magazine. Prior to the 2021 campaign, he was selected to the preseason all-MW and was tabbed as the conference's Preseason Player of the Year by Baseball America.

RECAPPING THE USD SERIES

- $>\,$ San Diego State took two out of three from USD in its season-opening series on Feb. 19-21.
- > The Aztecs captured the first two games at Tony Gwynn Stadium, posting a 14-7 triumph in the opener before rallying for a dramatic 19-18 victory in 10 innings in game two.
- > However, SDSU was unable to complete the sweep at USD's Fowler Park in the finale, as the Toreros scored 13 unanswered runs to claim a 16-12 decision.
- > In the opener on Feb. 19, the Aztecs combined for seven runs in the fifth and sixth innings to break open a tight 5-4 contest. USD came up with three markers in the seventh, but SDSU responded with two runs in its half of that frame to close out the scoring.
- > Brian Leonhardt and Jacob Cruce drove in three runs each to lead the Aztecs, who battered seven Torero pitchers for 19 hits to notch their fifth straight victory on opening day.
- > In all, seven players recorded multiple hits for the Scarlet and Black, including Leonhardt, Jaden Fein and Ryan Orr, who finished with three apiece, while Wyatt Hendrie (2 hits) and Cole Carrigg knocked in a pair of runs, along with Fein.
- > The following day, Mike Jarvis scored on a wild pitch in the bottom of the 10th, as the Aztecs tallied seven of the game's final eight runs to overcome a 17-12 deficit.
- > With the international tiebreaker in effect for the 2021 college baseball season, Jarvis was placed on second, while Hendrie was intentionally walked before getting forced at second on a grounder by Cruce. The Toreros changed pitchers at this juncture with Jack Dolak taking over for Eddy Pelc, but the move backfired when Dolak uncorked a wild pitch, allowing Jarvis to race home.
- SDSU's sixth pitcher of the day, Tre Brown, picked up the win after tossing 2 1/3 scoreless innings, yielding just two walks and no hits, while Pelc was tagged with the hard-luck loss.
- > SDSU's sixth pitcher of the day, Tre Brown, picked up the win after tossing 2 1/3 scoreless innings, yielding just two walks and no hits, while Pelc was tagged with the hard-luck loss.
- Offensively, Fein led the Scarlet and Black with three hits and four RBIs, while Leonhardt and Caden Miller got into the act with two hits

and a trio of RBIs apiece.

- > Not to be outdone, Hendrie scored a career-high four runs, while Cruce, Jarvis, Carrigg and Matt Rudick all touched the plate on three occasions.
- > The Aztec offense kept the momentum for most of game three on Feb. 21, cranking out 12 runs on 16 hits, including three each by Jarvis and Rudick, while Hendrie, Cruce, Fein and Leonhardt finished with two apiece.
- > San Diego State's first four batters, Jarvis, Rudick, Hendrie and Cruce, hit a collective .500 for the day (10-20) with seven RBIs and eight runs scored.
- > However, SDSU was stymied by Torero reliever Ivran Romero, who allowed just one hit over the final three innings while striking out three to collect the victory..
- > Conversely, five Aztec relievers were not as fortunate, yielding 13 unanswered runs on eight hits and six walks while hitting four batters and tossing two wild pitches.

SETTING THE SCENE FOR 2021

- > San Diego State returns 20 letterwinners from last year's squad that finished with a 10-6 overall record during the 2020 season that was cut short due to the COVID-19 pandemic. The Aztecs welcome back six starting position players and three starting pitchers.
- > Between 2013 and 2019, SDSU captured five Mountain West tournament championships and made five NCAA Regional appearances. The Aztecs are also the only team in the league to have won 30 or more games six times in that stretch
- > The Aztecs were pegged for a first-place finish in the 2021 MW preseason coaches poll, attaining the status of conference favorites for the third year in a row.
- > Leading the list of returners is starting pitcher Troy Melton, who earned a spot on USA Baseball's Golden Spikes Award Preseason Watch List. The Anaheim, California, product was ranked 79th on D1Baseball.com's Top 100 List of collegiate draft prospects for 2021 and was tabbed the preseason Mountain West Pitcher of the Year by the same website, as well as Baseball America.
- > An all-conference honoree from last year, Melton was also named to the preseason all-Mountain West team, along with center fielder Matt Rudick and right fielder Jaden Fein.
- > In addition to all-league consideration, Fein was named the MW Preseason Player of the Year by Baseball America.
- > SDSU also welcomes 20 newcomers, including 13 true freshmen, four transfers from the Division I ranks and three junior college players, all of whom comprise a talented recruiting class that was ranked 22nd nationally by Perfect Game.
- > One of the new rookie is Cole Carrigg, a catcher/utility player who twice participated at the prestigious Area Code Games for the Athletics squad.
- > As a junior at Turlock High in 2019, Carrigg garnered first-team all-Central California Athletic League accolades as a utility player after leading the Bulldogs to the conference title and a berth in the CIF Sac-Joaquin Section Division I quarterfinals.
- > Another touted newcomer is catcher Poncho Ruiz, who was named the No. 1 ranked Mountain West incoming freshman by Perfect Game.

 A graduate of Mater Dei Catholic High in nearby Chula Vista, Ruiz also earned a No. 18 national ranking among catchers for the 2020 high school graduating class by Perfect Game and received a scout grade of 9.5 by the website.

AZTECS TABBED PRESEASON MOUNTAIN WEST FAVORITES

- > For the third straight season, San Diego State baseball team was picked first in the Mountain West preseason coaches poll, as announced Feb. 11 by the conference office.
- > Collectively, SDSU garnered 36 points and five first-place votes, topping second-place Fresno State (29 pts, 1 first-place vote), while New Mexico and UNLV tied for third with 23 points apiece. Rounding out the remainder of the poll were Nevada (5th, 16 pts), Air Force (6th, 11 pts) and San José State (7th, 9 pts).
- > The Aztecs were also predicted to finish first prior to the 2014 campaign.

MELTON NAMED TO GOLDEN SPIKES AWARD WATCH LIST

- > Starting pitcher Troy Melton added to his growing list of preseason accolades on Feb. 18 when he earned a spot on the USA Baseball's Golden Spikes Award Watch List, beginning the process of identifying the nation's top amateur player for the 2021 season.
- > With his nomination, Melton becomes the fourth Aztec player since 2008 to land on the preseason Golden Spikes Award Watch List, joining Casey Schmitt (2020), Michael Cederoth (2014), Addison Reed (2010) and Stephen Strasburg, who earned the top honor in 2009. In addition, Tyler Adkison landed on the GSA mid-season watch list in 2017.
- > A native of Anaheim, California, Melton garnered all-Mountain West accolades in the abbreviated 2020 campaign after posting a 3-1 record with a 3.22 ERA and 26 strikeouts. The SDSU right-hander shared the conference lead with three victories, which was tied for 23rd nationally, while his strikeouts and opposing batting average (.192) ranked second and third in the MW, respectively. He also found himself among the MW leaders in fewest hits allowed (4th 15), runs allowed (T4th 9), ERA (7th) and innings pitched (7th 22.1) while limiting opponents to a .185 batting average with runners in scoring position.
- > Last season, Melton earned Mountain West Pitcher of the Week honors after combining on the Aztecs' 6-0 home shutout of 2018 national champion Oregon State on Feb. 29, 2020. In that contest, he held the Beavers to four hits in that game while striking out a career-high nine batters against only one walk in six scoreless innings.
- > Prior to the upcoming campaign, Melton was rated 79th on D1Baseball.com's Top 100 List of collegiate draft prospects for 2021 and was heralded as the preseason Mountain West Pitcher of the Year by the same website, as well as Baseball America.

FEIN, MELTON, RUDICK LAND ON PRESEASON ALL-MOUNTAIN WEST TEAM

- > The Aztec trio of Jaden Fein, Troy Melton and Matt Rudick each earned on spot on the preseason all-Mountain West team announced on Feb. 11.
- > Fein, who earned Mountain West Co-Freshman of the Year honors in 2019 to go with Freshman All-America accolades from Collegiate Baseball magazine, recorded a team-high .348 batting average during the abbreviated 2020 season, finishing with one home run, one double, seven RBIs and seven runs scored in 16 aames.
- > The Aztec right fielder also found himself among the team leaders in on-base percentage (2nd .404), slugging percentage (3rd .435), RBIs with two outs (3rd 5), walks (T-4th 5) and RBIs (5th) and topped the squad in batting average with runners in scoring position (.571) and with two outs (.474). He hit safely in the final seven games in 2020, raising his average from .273 to .348 during that span.
- > In addition to all-conference consideration, Fein was named the MW Preseason Player of the Year by Baseball America.
- > Not to be outdone, Rudick merited all-conference distinction for the second straight year in 2020 after posting the Aztecs' third-highest batting average (.313) while leading the team in slugging percentage (.478), hits (21) and runs scored (13), with the latter tying for ninth in the league.
- > The SDSU center fielder also topped the squad with 32 total bases and tied for second in the MW with a team-high three triples, which was tied for 10th in the country.
- > In addition, Rudick was the Aztecs' leader with multiple hits in seven games and tied for second on the squad with a six-game hitting streak to open the season. He was also none of the toughest players in the conference to strike out, fanning once every 11.2 at-bats, which ranked third in the MW.
- > In the summer of 2020, Rudick was named San Diego College Baseball League Player of the Year after batting .419 in 16 regular-season games while posting four doubles, three triples, three home runs, 18 RBI and 22 runs scored for the Warriors squad. He also went 5-for-10 at the plate in two playoff games.

SUPER SENIORS

- > Head coach Mark Martinez has dubbed the trio of Ryan Orr, Mike Jarvis and Jacob Cruce "Super Seniors" after the three players took advantage of the NCAA's COVID-19 eligibility ruling, returning to The Mesa this season after their 2020 campaign was cut short due to the pandemic. All three have provided outstanding upperclassman leadership, helping the Aztec program navigate through new health and safety protocols.
- > In his first year as an outfielder in 2020, Orr was enjoying a breakout season, starting all 16 games for the Aztecs, including 14 in left field. The La Costa Canyon High alumnus posted the fifth-highest batting average on the team at .295 while tying for third with 18 hits in 61 at-bats.
- > Orr also finished fourth on the squad with 22 total bases and shared the team lead with four doubles, adding eight runs scored, seven RBIs and one stolen base. He additionally tied for fourth on the squad with multiple hits in five games and ranked fifth with a five-game hitting streak from Feb. 14-Feb. 21, 2020.
- > Jarvis started all 16 games as the Aztecs' leadoff hitter last season, including 10 in center field and six at second base, batting .273 with two home runs and seven RBIs.
- > The Clairemont High product led the Scarlet and Black with five stolen bases, which was tied for ninth in the Mountain West, and shared the team top spot in homers and doubles (4). He also found himself among SDSU's leaders in runs scored (2nd 12), hits (3rd 18), on-base percentage (5th .342) and slugging percentage (5th .424).
- > In the summer of 2020, Jarvis played for the Hooks team that captured the San Diego League championship. He received first-team all-league recognition and was named to Team Sea for the circuit's All-Star game in July.
- > Cruce, meanwhile, appeared in 13 games in 2020, making seven starts at designated hitter and three at first base. The northern California native ranked fourth on the Aztecs in batting average (.300) and slugging percentage (.425), collecting 12 hits in 40 at-bats to go with two doubles and seven RBIs with four runs scored. He strung together two three-game hitting streaks (Feb. 16-21 and Feb. 29-March 3), driving in at least one run in each of those contests.

STRIKEOUTS GALORE

- > San Diego State recorded 27 games with 10 or more strikeouts during the 2019 campaign, marking the most double-digit strikeout performances for the Aztecs in the MW era (since 2000). SDSU surpassed the previous MW record of 23 set in a 10-6 win at Fresno State on May 11, 2009.
- > During the shortened 2020 season, the Aztec pitching staff notched seven games with 10 strikeouts: vs. Virginia Tech, Cal State Fullerton, Iowa, Nebraska, at UC Irvine and twice against Oregon State. Not surprisingly, the Scarlet and Black went 6-1 in those contests.
- > Dating back to 2019, the Aztecs are 22-12 in their last 34 games when striking out 10 or more batters.

GOING, GOING, GONE

- > In San Diego State's loss to USD on Feb. 21, the Aztecs had a four-game winning halted when hitting a

TOUGH AT HOME

- > Since the start of the 2012 season, San Diego State is 158-100 (.612) when playing at home.
- > In 2018, the Aztecs set a program record with 25 home victories at Tony Gwynn Stadium (since 1997), besting the previous standard of 24 set in 1997, 2002 and 2014.

> San Diego State boasts 16 players on its current roster who are alumni of San Diego County high schools, including Tre Brown, Brian Leonhardt and Ricky Tibbett (Eastlake); Fisher Pyatt and Charlie Rhee (St. Augustine); Casey O'Sullivan and Joseph Ingrassia (Valhalla); Mike Jarvis (Clairemont); Ryan Orr (La Costa Canyon); Trevor Hazelhurst (Granite Hills), Deron Johnson (Poway); Noah Kaagan (Rancho Bernardo); Michael Paredes (San Diego); Matt Rudick (Scripps Ranch); Poncho Ruiz (Mater Dei Catholic) and Seth Urbon (Point Loma).

CRAZY TONY GWYNN PLAYER STATS

- > Tony Gwynn completed his illustrious career with a .338 lifetime batting average. Every other player who had a career batting average of at least .338 played before 1943.
- > Gwynn hit .368 over a five-year stretch between 1993 and 1997.
- > Gwynn faced Tom Glavine, Greg Maddux, Pedro Martinez, and John Smoltz a combined 323 times. He struck out three times over those at bats.
- > Gwynn never struck out more than 40 times in a season and struck out less than 20 times in six straight season. He had a career-low 15 strikeouts in 1995.
