WHAT'S ON TAP FOR AZTEC BASEBALL

> San Diego State opens its 21st season of Mountain West baseball competition this weekend when it plays host to Fresno State in a three-game series, March 6-7, at Tony Gwynn Stadium.

> The Aztecs and Bulldogs will square off in a doubleheader on Saturday, starting at 11 a.m. PT, before locking horns for a single game on Sunday, beginning at 1 p.m.

> In accordance with state, local and university guidelines, fans will not be permitted to attend SDSU home baseball games at Tony Gwynn Stadium during the 2021 season.

However, Saturday's doubleheader will be streamed live via the Mountain West Network, with audio simulcast over the airwaves on XTRA Sports 1360 AM. Meanwhile, Sunday's finale will feature a unique split-screen four-camera video stream. Links to all platforms will be available on GoAztecs.com.

SETTING THE SCENE

> San Diego State (5-2, 0-0 MW) took three of four games last weekend vs. UC San Diego, splitting two encounters at Tony Gwynn Stadium before sweeping a doubleheader at Triton Ballpark in La Jolla.

S As of March 4, the Aztecs rank third nationally with a .352 batting average and a scoring average of 11.1 runs per game. In addition, SDSU occupies the fourth spot with 101 hits overall and is eighth with 78 runs scored overall.

addition, SDSU occupies the fourth spot with 101 hits overall and is eighth with 78 runs scored overall. > Individually, Jaden Fein collected his second straight Mountain West Player of the Week award after leading the team with a .526 batting average, 10 hits, 15 total bases and seven runs scored against the Tritons while tying for the top spot with seven RBIs and four doubles.

> With his performance, Fein finds himself ranked No. 1 in the country with 18 hits on the season and an average of 2.57 hits per game entering the weekend, while his 14 RBIs is tied for ninth, along with teammate Brian Leonhardt.

Fresno State (2-2, 0-0 MW) won two of three games at home in its season-opening series vs. CSU Bakersfield, Feb. 26-28, before falling to San Francisco, 7-6, in a single road matchup on Tuesday.

HEAD COACH MARK MARTINEZ

> Mark Martinez is in his seventh season as head coach of the Aztecs and 16th overall as a member of the San Diego State staff after succeeding the late Tony Gwynn on August 20, 2014. He is just the fifth head coach in SDSU history since baseball was elevated to major sport status in 1936. > During his tenure as the Aztecs' head coach, Martinez has compiled a 185-134 record (.580), highlighted by three Mountain West tournament

championships in 2015, 2017 and 2018. He has also posted an 84-64 ledger (.568) in conference regular-season games. > Since 2015, SDSU has garnered 30 all-Mountain West accolades under Martinez's tutelage, including back-to-back MW Pitchers of the Year Brett Seeburger (2017) and Garrett Hill (2018), as well as 2017 MW Player of the Year Danny Sheehan.

> Additionally, Martinez has mentored three freshman All-Americans in Chase Calabuig (2015), Casey Schmitt (2018) and Jaden Fein (2019), with the latter also receiving Mountain West Co-Freshman of the Year distinction last year.

> In 2017, Martinez recorded his 100th victory for the Scarlet and Black, becoming the fastest head coach in program history to reach the century mark in wins.

> Not to be outdone, Martinez also became the fastest head coach in Mountain West history to win three conference championships when the Aztecs captured the title in 2018.

> Martinez was hired as an assistant coach for the Aztecs in July of 2005 and served for nine years under head coach Tony Gwynn. During that time, he was promoted to the position of associate head coach.

> Since his arrival on The Mesa as an assistant coach, Martinez has witnessed 44 SDSU players get drafted into the professional ranks, with nine of those selections making the major leagues (Stephen Strasburg, Addison Reed, Justin Masterson, Bruce Billings, Quintin Berry, Lance Zawadzki, Greg Allen, Ty France and Seby Zavala).

> Prior to his arrival at San Diego State, Martinez was an assistant coach at New Mexico for 17 seasons from 1989-2005. During his time as a hitting and infield coach, he helped develop the Lobos into one of the most prominent offensive teams in the country, with UNM ranking among the top 11 nationally in hitting over his final four seasons.

> Martinez served as an assistant at his alma mater, Mesa State College (now Colorado Mesa University) in Grand Junction, Colorado, from 1984-88. He played shortstop at the school from 1982-84, earning all-conference and all-district honors as a senior.

> Martinez graduated from Mesa State with a bachelor's degree in physical education in 1984 and completed his master's in sports administration at New Mexico in 1990.

FOR OPENERS (MW EDITION)

> Since the balance of the 2020 campaign was canceled due to the COVID-19 pandemic, San Diego State will be playing a Mountain West regular-season game for the first time since May 18, 2019, when it dropped a 7-4 decision to New Mexico at home in the final tune-up before the conference tournament that year.

> For the third straight season, the Aztecs were picked first in the Mountain West preseason coaches poll, finishing with 36 points and five first-place votes, topping second-place Fresno State, which totaled 29 points and one first-place vote.

> In addition, SDSU had three players selected to the preseason all-MW team in right fielder Jaden Fein, starting pitcher Troy Melton and center fielder Matt Rudick.

> Since the first year of MW baseball action in 2000, the Aztecs have compiled a 13-7 record in conference openers, including a 10-2 mark at home.

> During that span, San Diego State has captured 14 opening series against league opponents — 15 if one includes a four-team round-robin event in 2006 when the Aztecs went 3-1.

> As MW rivals, SDSU has twice faced Fresno State in a conference opener, falling by a narrow 1-0 count in Fresno in 2013 before dropping a 3-2 decision in 10 innings at Tony Gwynn Stadium in 2016. The Aztecs rebounded to win the final two games of the series in 2013, but were not as fortunate in 2016, salvaging a victory in the series finale to avoid a sweep.

2021 SCHEDULE AT A GLANCE

With the Mountain West back to seven teams, the league returns to a double round-robin format for the 2021 campaign. The teams will play a 36-game conference schedule, with weekends consisting mostly of doubleheaders on Saturday and a Sunday series finale.

The MW tournament has been eliminated and the regular-season champion will receive the league's automatic NCAA Tournament bid.

> The Mountain West Network will stream a total of 14 SDSU home baseball games this year, as well as selected road contests against conference opponents. In addition, the Aztecs' other home games will feature a live stream on the team's YouTube channel, with a link available on GoAztecs. com.

> XTRA Sports 1360 AM has also added 10 games to its lineup this spring, including this Saturday's doubleheader vs. Fresno State. Future broadcasts will feature the twin-bill vs. Nevada (April 10), as well as complete series vs. San José State (May 8-9) and Air Force (May 22-23)

AZTEC WEEKEND ROTATION

> San Diego State's projected pitching rotation this weekend will feature a pair of hurlers who made consecutive starts vs. USD and UCSD, while the starter for Sunday's finale is still to be determined at press time.

> Michael Paredes (0-0, 4.09 ERA) is expected to get the call in game one of Saturday's twin-bill after a strong performance in his last start at UCSD on Feb. 28. The Aztec redshirt sophomore struck out five batters in six innings, allowing just two runs and no walks while scattering eight hits. He exited with SDSU in front 5-2 but did not figure in the decision after the Tritons rallied to tie the score in the eighth. In his first start of the 2021 campaign vs. USD on Feb. 21, Paredes yielded three runs on three hits and one walk to go with a pair of strikeouts in five innings of work before the Toreros stormed back following his departure from the game. Last season, the San Diego High alumnus ranked among the Mountain West leaders in walks (T8th – 6) and earned runs allowed (T9th – 9). > Troy Melton (1-0, 5.79 ERA) is projected to start game two of the doubleheader vs. the Bulldogs after striking out a season-high seven batters in 4 2/3 innings of work his last start vs. UC San Diego on Feb. 26. The SDSU right-hander gave up all four Triton runs that day on three hits and four walks, exiting the game before the Aztecs scored a combined 10 runs in the sixth and seventh innings. Melton also started the 2021 season opener against San Diego on Feb. 19, allowing four runs (two earned) on four hits and one walk to go with three strikeouts in 4 2/3 innings en route to the victory. In a shortened 2020 campaign, the Anaheim, California, native shared the conference lead with three victories, which was tied for 23rd nationally, while his 26 strikeouts and .192 opposing batting average ranked second and third in the MW, respectively.

SERIES RECORD VS. FRESNO STATE

> Fresno State holds a narrow 103-102 lead in the all-time series, which dates back to 1939.

> The Aztecs have faced the Bulldogs more than any other team in program history.

> SDSU is 49-52 against Fresno State in San Diego, 46-48 in Fresno and 7-3 on neutral fields.

> The Aztecs posted a 2-4 record in two series against the Bulldogs the last time the two programs met in 2019.

> In the last series at Tony Gwynn Stadium, SDSU raced to an 11-6 victory in the finale on March 31, 2019, after dropping the first two games of the weekend set.

> Five current Aztecs saw action in that contest, including Jaden Fein, who went 3-for-4 with a homer and three runs scored.

> In addition, Matt Rudick (1-4) crossed the plate on three occasions, while Michael Paredes tossed 2 2/3 innings of relief, giving up two runs (one earned) on four hits and no walks. He also helped his own cause with a run-scoring double.

> Elsewhere, Mike Jarvis singled and stole a base, while Casey O'Sullivan pitched the final 1 2/3 innings, striking out three batters against two hits and one unearned run.

> The Aztecs never trailed in that contest, as former SDSU All-American Casey Schmitt started on the mound and picked up the victory, allowing three runs (one earned) on four hits and one walk to go with four strikeouts.

> Clinging to a slim 4-3 lead, the Aztecs added a run in the fourth before breaking open the game

> Since Fresno State joined the Mountain West for the 2012-13 academic year, SDSU has compiled a 22-19 record against the Bulldogs, including a 9-9 mark at Tony Gwynn Stadium.

AZTECS AMONG NCAA STATISTICAL LEADERS

> Following their offensive bonanza during the first two series against USD and UCSD, the Aztecs find themselves among the NCAA statistical leaders in several categories. As of March 4, SDSU ranks third nationally with a .352 team batting average and a scoring average of 11.1 runs per game. In addition, the Scarlet and Black occupies the fourth spot with 101 hits overall and is tied for fifth with seven sacrifice flies while occupying the eighth spot with 78 runs scored.

> Individually, Jaden Fein leads the country with 18 hits overall and 2.57 hits per game while sharing the ninth position with 14 RBIs, along with teammate Brian Leonhardt, who is also tied for the top spot with three sacrifice flies. Additionally, Jacob Cruce is tied for sixth nationally with 13 runs scored and 1.86 runs per game.

SDSU IN MW RANKINGS

> Heading into the weekend, Jaden Fein leads the Mountain West in batting average (.529) and hits (18) while sharing the top spot in RBIs (14) with Brian Leonhardt, who is tied for second in hits (13) and ranks eighth in batting average (.433).

> Not to be outdone, Fein enters weekend ranked fifth in slugging percentage (.706) and sixth in on-base percentage (.528), while Leonhardt occupies the eighth slot in slugging percentage (.633).

> The Aztecs boast seven players among the league's top 10 in runs scored, including Jacob Cruce (1st - 13), Matt Rudick (2nd - 12), Wyatt Hendrie (3rd - 11), Fein (4th - 10), Mike Jarvis (T-5th - 8), Leonhardt (T-5th - 8) and Cole Carrigg (10th - 6).

> In addition to Fein and Leonhardt, the Aztecs have three other players among the MW leaders in hits, including Rudick (T-4th - 12), Jarvis (T-6th - 11) and Cruce (6th - 11).

> Likewise, three more SDSU players find themselves on the league's top-10 list in RBIs after Fein and Leonhardt, including Cruce (4th - 9), Hendrie (T-5th - 6) and Carrigg (T-5th - 6).

> Elsewhere, Rudick leads the MW with six walks and is tied for the top spot with four stolen bases while ranking eighth with a .474 on-base percentage.

> On the mound, Troy Melton is tied for third in the league with 10 strikeouts, while Michael Paredes ranks eighth with seven.

> With huge production throughout the lineup, unsurprisingly San Diego State leads the conference in numerous offensive categories as a team this week, including batting average (.352), hits (101), runs (78), RBIs (70), total bases ((135), doubles (15) and on-base percentage (.408).

In addition, the Aztecs rank second in the MW with a collective .470 slugging percentage and a combined 63 strikeouts by their pitching staff.

FRESNO STATE AT A GLANCE

> The Bulldags were picked second behind the Aztecs in the 2021 Mountain West preseason coaches poll, with infielder/outfielder Ryan Higgins, pitcher Nikoh Mitchell and catcher Zach Presno earning a spot on the preseason all-conference team.

> Fresho State returns all nine starting position players and two starting pitchers from last year's squad that finished with a 9-7 record overall during the 2020 campaign that was cut short due to the COVID-19 pandemic.

> The Bulldags are off to a 2-2 start this season after falling to San Francisco on the road Tuesday by a 7-6 count. Fresno State scored all of its runs in the top of the fifth, while the Dons responded a pair of markers in their half of the frame before adding a five-spot in the sixth to account for the final margin.

> In that contest, third baseman Andrew Kachel matched his career high with three hits to lead the Bulldogs, while right fielder Nate Thimjon and left fielder Dylan Johnson had two apiece.

> Previously, Fresno State took two out of three games vs. CSU Bakersfield in its season-opening series last weekend, Feb. 26-28. The Bulldogs emerged victorious in the first two contests by scores of 13-2 and 9-6 before dropping a 9-4 decision in the finale.

> After four games, second baseman Josh Lauck finds himself among the MW leaders in batting average (T-2nd - .500), on-base percentage (T-2nd - .647), doubles (T-2nd - 3) and runs scored (T-7th -7), while Kachel ranks second in slugging percentage (.800), fifth in batting average (.467) and is tied for sixth in RBIs (6).

> Elsewhere, Thimjon ranks third in conference with a .778 slugging percentage and occupies the sixth spot with a .444 batting average, while Presno shares the league lead with two home runs.

> Saturday's game one starter Jamison Hill was victorious in the Bulldogs' 13-2 win over CSU Bakersfield on Feb. 26, giving up just one earned run on six hits and two walks, while striking out six in six innings. The following day, Jake Dixon was triumphant on the hill for Fresno State, scattering four hits and walk while striking out four in six scoreless innings, as the Bulldogs held on for a 9-6 victory. Dixon is scheduled to started game two on Saturday.

Mike Batesole is in his 19th season as head coach at Fresno State compiling a record of 594-450-1 (.569) with the Bulldog program, highlighted by an NCAA College World Series title and National Coach of the Year honors in 2008. A native of Anaheim, California, Batesole guided Fresno State to Mountain West regular-season titles in 2016 and 2019 to go with a conference tournament crown in 2019. Prior to the Bulldogs joining the MW, he also directed Fresno State to five regular-season WAC championships and six tournament titles in that league. Before his arrival in the Central Valley, Batesole was the head coach at Cal State Northridge for seven years from 1996-2002, amassing a record of 256-158-1, including a pair of NCAA tournament appearances and two conference championships. He also was named National Coach of the Year in 1998 by Collegiate Baseball magazine. Batesole played collegiately at Oral Roberts from 1983-85 before spending four seasons in the Los Angeles Dodgers' farm system from 1985-88, appearing in the Florida State League All-Star Game in 1987. He returned to school to earn his bachelor's degree (1990) and master's degree (1992) from Cal State Fullerton. In all, Batesole has coached 64 first-team all-conference selections, 39 All-Americans and nine freshman All-Americans during his career, while 85 of his players have been selected in the MLB Draft.

JADEN FEIN REPEATS AS MW PLAYER OF THE WEEK

San Diego State right fielder Jaden Fein collected his second straight Mountain West Player of the Week award for another set of
outstanding performances in helping the Aztecs take three out of four games in their series vs. UC San Diego last weekend, Feb. 26-28.
 With his accolade, Fein became the first Aztec repeat winner since Tyler Adkison accomplished the feat between March 20 and March 27,
2017.

> Against the Tritons, Fein recorded a team-best .526 batting average (10-19), leading the Scarlet and Black with 10 hits, 15 total bases and seven runs scored while tying for the top spot with seven RBIs and four doubles.

> In addition, the SDSU redshirt sophomore topped the squad with a .789 slugging percentage and a .500 on-base percentage, posting a

perfect 1.000 average (5-5) with runners in scoring position while notching a team-high .600 batting average (6-10) with runners on base. > Not to be outdone, the Simi Valley, California, native registered a 63.6 percent success rate in advancing runners (7-11) and shared the team lead with two RBIs with runners on third and less than two outs. He was also successful on both of his stolen bas attempts for the weekend.

> In SDSU's 10-4 series-opening win on Feb. 26, Fein totaled 2 RBIs and a run scored, lifting a sacrifice fly during a three-run fourth inning that helped the Aztecs cut the deficit to 4-3. He also contributed a run-scoring single with two outs as part of a seven-run seventh inning that propelled SDSU to a big lead it would not relinquish.

> In a 9-3 setback the following day, Fein accounted for all of the Aztecs' scoring with a three-run homer, his first of the year, finishing 2-for-4 on the afternoon.

> In Sunday's doubleheader at UCSD, Fein led SDSU with four hits (4-6) and three runs scored, propelling the Aztecs to a 7-5 win in the opener in 11 innings. He belted a key run-scoring double with two outs in the third that tied the game at 2-2 and later singled, stole second and scored in a three-run fifth inning, helping the Scarlet and Black gain a 5-2 advantage. Then in the pivotal 11th, Fein doubled once again with two outs and scored one of the two go-ahead runs.

> In the night cap, Fein tied for the team lead with three hits (3-5) and two runs scored in SDSU's 13-6 victory. He led off with a single and scored during a three-run second inning that put the visitors in front for good. The right fielder additionally contributed an RBI single and scored as part of a five-run sixth inning that gave the Aztecs an insurmountable 13-5 lead after the Tritons narrowed the gap to 8-5.

RECAPPING THE UCSD SERIES

> San Diego State captured its second straight series after winning three of four games vs. the Tritons, Feb. 26-28.

> The Aztecs split the first two games at Tony Gwynn Stadium, posting a 10-4 come-from-behind victory in the opener before dropping a 9-3 decision on the second day.

> The scene shifted to Triton Ballpark in La Jolla, where the Scarlet and Black completed a doubleheader sweep, notching a 7-5 triumph in 11 innings in game one before closing out the weekend in style with a 13-6 conquest in the nightcap.

> SDSU had eight different players record multiple hits at least once in the series, including Jaden Fein, who accomplished the feat in three games over the weekend. In addition, Brian Leonhardt, Ryan Orr, Caden Miller, Matt Rudick and Jacob Cruce recorded two multi-hit contests during the set, followed by Mike Jarvis and Cole Carrigg, who finished with one each.

> Similarly, seven Aztecs registered multiple RBIs at least once in the series, including Fein and Leonhardt with two games apiece, while Carrigg, Cruce, Orr, Jarvis and Poncho Ruiz had one each.

> In the series opener, San Diego State erupted for seven runs in the bottom of the seventh to highlight its 10-4 victory, as the Aztecs finished with 12 hits and capitalized on six Triton errors.

> SDSU once again shared the offensive wealth as four players totaled two hits apiece, including Leonhardt, Carrigg, Miller and Cruce, who also drove in a pair of runs to share team-high honors with Fein.

> The Aziecs were kept off the scoreboard through five innings, as UCSD maintained a 4-0 advantage. However, SDSU narrowed the gap with a three-spot in the sixth before catapulting into the lead for good with seven runs on seven hits, two errors and two wild pitches in the seventh, as the Scarlet and Black sent 12 batters to the plate in the frame.

> Despite four walks, reliever Christian Winston (1-0) picked up his first victory of the season on the strength of three scoreless innings without a hit, adding three strikeouts after entering for Troy Melton with two outs in the fifth. Ricky Tibbett came in to get the final four outs, allowing just one hit in his appearance.

> The following day, SDSU came up short for the first time in four home games, falling 9-3, as the Aztecs were plagued by three errors and left 10 runners on base, including two each over the final three innings, which derailed any comeback hopes.

> Fein accounted for all of SDSU's scoring with a three-run homer in the bottom of the fourth, which cut the margin to 4-3. However, the Aztecs were unable to gain the upper hand.

> Stung, San Diego State responded in a big way with a doubleheader sweep across town to close out the series.

> Fein posted a team-high seven hits and five runs scored in the twin-bill, while Rudick combined for four hits and crossed the plate on three occasions, along with Leonhardt and Cruce.

> In game one, Leonhardt provided the winning margin with a clutch two-run single with two outs in the top of the 11th, scoring Wyatt Hendrie and Fein.

> The Aztecs broke a 2-2 tie in the fifth when Poncho Ruiz crushed the first pitch over the left field fence for a two-run homer, plating Rudick, who led off with a single. It was the first collegiate hit for Ruiz, a Mater Dei Catholic High graduate who was making his first career start.

> SDSU increased the margin to 5-2, but UCSD tied the game on a three-run homer in the eighth.

> With one out in the 11th, Hendrie dove headfirst to beat out a grounder to shortstop and later advanced to third on Fein's double to left following a pop up in the infield. Leonhardt then stepped to the plate for the eventual game-winning hit.

> Tre Brown (1-0), who previously gave up the game-tying homer, remained in the game for the Tritons' last at-bat, striking out the final two hitters to pick up the victory after yielding a single and hitting a batter.

> In game two, the Aztecs eventually built an 8-2 advantage, as Leonhardt smacked a two-run homer to right in the third and later added a sacrifice fly in the fifth. In addition, Miller and Jarvis aided the Scarlet and Black cause with consecutive doubles in the fourth, while Rudick soon followed with sacrifice fly of his own.

> After UCSD trimmed the margin to 8-5 in its half of the fifth on an RBI single and a two-run homer, SDSU put the game essentially out of reach with a five-run sixth inning, as nine batters were sent to the plate. Leonhardt drilled an RBI double, while Cruce, Fein and Carrigg contributed run-scoring singles.

> Despite giving up the trio of Triton runs in the fifth, Leonhardt (1-0) picked up the victory, striking out four while issuing one walk in 2 1/3 innings in relief of starter Aaron Eden, who went the same distance, allowing one earned run on five hits and three walks to go with three strikeouts.

SETTING THE SCENE FOR 2021

> San Diego State returns 20 letterwinners from last year's squad that finished with a 10-6 overall record during the 2020 season that was cut short due to the COVID-19 pandemic. The Aztecs welcome back six starting position players and three starting pitchers.

> Between 2013 and 2019, SDSU captured five Mountain West tournament championships and made five NCAA Regional appearances. The Aztecs are also the only team in the league to have won 30 or more games six times in that stretch

> The Aztecs were pegged for a first-place finish in the 2021 MW preseason coaches poll, attaining the status of conference favorites for the third year in a row.

> Leading the list of returners is starting pitcher Troy Melton, who earned a spot on USA Baseball's Golden Spikes Award Preseason Watch List. The Anaheim, California, product was ranked 79th on D1Baseball.com's Top 100 List of collegiate draft prospects for 2021 and was tabbed the preseason Mountain West Pitcher of the Year by the same website, as well as Baseball America.

> An all-conference honoree from last year, Melton was also named to the preseason all-Mountain West team, along with center fielder Matt Rudick and right fielder Jaden Fein.

> In addition to all-league consideration, Fein was named the MW Preseason Player of the Year by Baseball America.

> SDSU also welcomes 20 newcomers, including 13 true freshmen, four transfers from the Division I ranks and three junior college players, all of whom comprise a talented recruiting class that was ranked 22nd nationally by Perfect Game.

> One of the new rookie is Cole Carrigg, a catcher/utility player who twice participated at the prestigious Area Code Games for the Athletics squad.

> As a junior at Turlock High in 2019, Carrigg garnered first-team all-Central California Athletic League accolades as a utility player after leading the Bulldogs to the conference title and a berth in the CIF Sac-Joaquin Section Division I quarterfinals.

> Another touted newcomer is catcher Poncho Ruiz, who was named the No. 1 ranked Mountain West incoming freshman by Perfect Game.

A graduate of Mater Dei Catholic High in nearby Chula Vista, Ruiz also earned a No. 18 national ranking among catchers for the 2020 high school graduating class by Perfect Game and received a scout grade of 9.5 by the website.

AZTECS TABBED PRESEASON MOUNTAIN WEST FAVORITES

> For the third straight season, San Diego State baseball team was picked first in the Mountain West preseason coaches poll, as announced Feb. 11 by the conference office.

> Collectively, SDSU garnered 36 points and five first-place votes, topping second-place Fresno State (29 pts, 1 first-place vote), while New Mexico and UNLV tied for third with 23 points apiece. Rounding out the remainder of the poll were Nevada (5th, 16 pts), Air Force (6th, 11 pts) and San José State (7th, 9 pts).
> The Aztecs were also predicted to finish first prior to the 2014 campaign.

MELTON NAMED TO GOLDEN SPIKES AWARD WATCH LIST

> Starting pitcher Troy Melton added to his growing list of preseason accolades on Feb. 18 when he earned a spot on the USA Baseball's Golden Spikes Award Watch List, beginning the process of identifying the nation's top amateur player for the 2021 season.

With his nomination, Melton becomes the fourth Aztec player since 2008 to land on the preseason Golden Spikes Award Watch List, joining Casey Schmitt (2020), Michael Cederoth (2014), Addison Reed (2010) and Stephen Strasburg, who earned the top honor in 2009. In addition, Tyler Adkison landed on the GSA mid-season watch list in 2017.

> A native of Anaheim, California, Melton garnered all-Mountain West accolades in the abbreviated 2020 campaign after posting a 3-1 record with a 3.22 ERA and 26 strikeouts. The SDSU right-hander shared the conference lead with three victories, which was tied for 23rd nationally, while his strikeouts and opposing batting average (.192) ranked second and third in the MW, respectively. He also found himself among the MW leaders in fewest hits allowed (4th - 15), runs allowed (T4th - 9), ERA (7th) and innings pitched (7th - 22.1) while limiting opponents to a .185 batting average with runners in scoring position.

> Last season, Melton earned Mountain West Pitcher of the Week honors after combining on the Aztecs' 6-0 home shutout of 2018 national champion Oregon State on Feb. 29, 2020. In that contest, he held the Beavers to four hits in that game while striking out a career-high nine batters against only one walk in six scoreless innings.

Prior to the upcoming campaign, Melton was rated 79th on D1Baseball.com's Top 100 List of collegiate draft prospects for 2021 and was heralded as the preseason Mountain West Pitcher of the Year by the same website, as well as Baseball America.

FEIN, MELTON, RUDICK LAND ON PRESEASON ALL-MOUNTAIN WEST TEAM

> The Aztec trio of Jaden Fein, Troy Melton and Matt Rudick each earned on spot on the preseason all-Mountain West team announced on Feb. 11.

> Fein, who earned Mountain West Co-Freshman of the Year honors in 2019 to go with Freshman All-America accolades from Collegiate Baseball magazine, recorded a team-high .348 batting average during the abbreviated 2020 season, finishing with one home run, one double, seven RBIs and seven runs scored in 16 games.

> The Aztec right fielder also found himself among the team leaders in on-base percentage (2nd - .404), slugging percentage (3rd - .435), RBIs with two outs (3rd - 5), walks (T-4th - 5) and RBIs (5th) and topped the squad in batting average with runners in scoring position (.571) and with two outs (.474). He hit safely in the final seven games in 2020, raising his average from .273 to .348 during that span.

> In addition to all-conference consideration, Fein was named the MW Preseason Player of the Year by Baseball America.

> Not to be outdone, Rudick merited all-conference distinction for the second straight year in 2020 after posting the Aztecs' third-highest batting average (.313) while leading the team in slugging percentage (.478), hits (21) and runs scored (13), with the latter tying for ninth in the league.

> The SDSU center fielder also topped the squad with 32 total bases and tied for second in the MW with a team-high three triples, which was tied for 10th in the country.

> In addition, Rudick was the Aztecs' leader with multiple hits in seven games and tied for second on the squad with a six-game hitting streak to open the season. He was also none of the toughest players in the conference to strike out, fanning once every 11.2 at-bats, which ranked third in the MW.

> In the summer of 2020, Rudick was named San Diego College Baseball League Player of the Year after batting .419 in 16 regular-season games while posting four doubles, three triples, three home runs, 18 RBI and 22 runs scored for the Warriors squad. He also went 5-for-10 at the plate in two playoff games.

SUPER SENIORS

> Head coach Mark Martinez has dubbed the trio of Ryan Orr, Mike Jarvis and Jacob Cruce "Super Seniors" after the three players took advantage of the NCAA's COVID-19 eligibility ruling, returning to The Mesa this season after their 2020 campaign was cut short due to the pandemic. All three have provided outstanding upperclassman leadership, helping the Aztec program navigate through new health and safety protocols.

> In his first year as an outfielder in 2020, Orr was enjoying a breakout season, starting all 16 games for the Aztecs, including 14 in left field. The La Costa Canyon High alumnus posted the fifth-highest batting average on the team at .295 while tying for third with 18 hits in 61 at-bats.

> Orr also finished fourth on the squad with 22 total bases and shared the team lead with four doubles, adding eight runs scored, seven RBIs and one stolen base. He additionally tied for fourth on the squad with multiple hits in five games and ranked fifth with a five-game hitting streak from Feb. 14-Feb. 21, 2020.

> Jarvis started all 16 games as the Aztecs' leadoff hitter last season, including 10 in center field and six at second base, batting .273 with two home runs and seven RBIs.

> The Clairemont High product led the Scarlet and Black with five stolen bases, which was tied for ninth in the Mountain West, and shared the team top spot in homers and doubles (4). He also found himself among SDSU's leaders in runs scored (2nd - 12), hits (3rd - 18), on-base percentage (5th - .342) and slugging percentage (5th - .424).

> In the summer of 2020, Jarvis played for the Hooks team that captured the San Diego League championship. He received first-team all-league recognition and was named to Team Sea for the circuit's All-Star game in July.

> Cruce, meanwhile, appeared in 13 games in 2020, making seven starts at designated hitter and three at first base. The northern California native ranked fourth on the Aztecs in batting average (.300) and slugging percentage (.425), collecting 12 hits in 40 at-bats to go with two doubles and seven RBIs with four runs scored. He strung together two three-game hitting streaks (Feb. 16-21 and Feb. 29-March 3), driving in at least one run in each of those contests.

STRIKEOUTS GALORE

> San Diego State recorded 27 games with 10 or more strikeouts during the 2019 campaign, marking the most double-digit strikeout performances for the Aztecs in the MW era (since 2000). SDSU surpassed the previous MW record of 23 set in a 10-6 win at Fresno State on May 11, 2009.

> After posting single digits in strikeouts during the opening series vs. USD, the Aztecs surpassed the double-digit plateau in that category in all four games against UC San Diego, including a season-high 13 in the first game of the doubleheader on Feb. 28.

> During the shortened 2020 season, the SDSU pitching staff notched seven games with 10 strikeouts: vs. Virginia Tech, Cal State Fullerton, Iowa, Nebraska, at UC Irvine and twice against Oregon State. Not surprisingly, the Scarlet and Black went 6-1 in those contests.

> During back to 2019, the Aztecs are 25-13 in their last 38 games when striking out 10 or more batters, including a 3-1 mark this season.

GOING, GOING, GONE

> In San Diego State's loss to USD on Feb. 21, the Aztecs had a four-game winning halted when hitting a home run.

> Still, SDSU has captured 25 of its last 34 games dating back to 2019 when launching one out of the park.

> The Aztecs went 17-5 during the 2019 campaign when going yard, 5-2 in 2020, and are 3-2 this season.

OTHER TRENDS

> The Aztecs are 71-12 in their last 83 games when scoring five or more runs, including a 5-1 record already in 2021 after posting a 6-2 mark last year.

> San Diego State is 49-19 last 68 games following a loss.

> The Azters had their 29-game winning streak snapped when leading after six innings in the series finale against USD on Feb. 21.

> Conversely, SDSU put the brakes a 41-game losing streak when trailing after seven innings the previous day on Feb. 20.

TOUGH AT HOME

> Since the start of the 2012 season, San Diego State is 159-101 (.612) when playing at home.
> In 2018, the Aztecs set a program record with 25 home victories at Tony Gwynn Stadium (since 1997),

besting the previous standard of 24 set in 1997, 2002 and 2014.

LOCAL HEROES
