Azters Notes

- After a 1-0 opening night victory over Army West Point on Thursday, San Diego State hosts its second consecutive home contests on the Sports Deck to open the 2021 campaign, a rare Sunday night match against Pepperdine.
- Laura Fuentes (Sr., MF, Newark, Calif.) scored the lone goal in the Aztecs season-opening 1-0 decision against Army West
 Point. She opened her season account with a 58th minute penalty kick. Fuentes is a perfect 4-for-4 in her career in PKs and
 has tallied one in each of her four seasons.
- The Mountain West announced on Thursday afternoon that all conference contests which were scheduled for October 29
 have been rescheduled for October 28, and that the Mountain West Championship, originally set to run from Nov. 2-6 in
 Boise, Idaho, will now be conducted from Nov. 1-6 in Boise.
- In a series that began in 1993, the Aztecs have played the Waves ten times, but are 3-7-0 in the all-time series, including
 a 2-3-0 mark in games played in San Diego. Pepperdine is undefeated in the last three meetings, including a 1-0 victory on
 Sept. 14, 2018, the last match up on San Diego State's home field.
- The Aztecs opened the regular season on Thursday with a 1-0 victory over Army West Point. The win improved the program's record in season openers, on its home pitch, to 15-6-1. Since 2007, when head coach Mike Friesen assumed leadership of the program, SDSU is 7-3-1 in games which opened a season on the Sports Deck. Those three losses are all to Power-5 programs, and two of those programs went on to appear in theat season's NCAA Tournament (UCLA in 2016 & Texas Tech in 2019). Now in its 33rd year of competition, the Aztecs are 18-14-1 overall in season openers, regardless of location.
- In his 15th campaign leading the Mountain West's most dominant women's soccer program, head coach Mike Friesen
 has guided his squad to ten Mountain West championships (five tournament and five regular season), and five NCAA
 Tournament appearances, each the most among any current league head coach. Entering his 15th season of conference
 play, Friesen has an 88-27-13 record. His 88 league victories are the most by any head coach in Mountain West history
 (the inaugural season of the MW was in 1999).
- Friesen's 159 victories (159-94-33) since the start of the 2007 season, the year he took control of the program, are
 the most by any current coach in the Mountain West and rank second in league history (Jennifer Rockwood, BYU, 190
 victories). Colorado College's Geoff Bennett's 145 victories in the last 14 seasons ranks second among current MW head
 coaches.

Player Notes

- Laura Fuentes (Sr., MF, Newark, Calif.), a 2020 United Soccer Coaches second-team All-Pacific Region and first-team All-MW performer led the side with four shots, three shots on frame and the lone goal in a 1-0 decision against Army West Point (8/19). The tally was the fourth PK of her career and the fourth game winner. She has never missed a contest and has earned a starting assignment in each of her 51 career games.
- Striker Emma Gaines-Ramos (Sr., F, San Diego, Calif.) tallied two shots, putting one on frame, in 57 minutes against Army West Point (8/19). Each were one off her single-game career best of three shots and two shots on goal.
- In her collegiate debut, Denise Castro (Fr., MF, San Ysidro, Calif.) earned a start against Army West Point (8/19). She produced two shots, both on goal, in 60 minutes of action.
- Claire Watkins (Jr., D, San Diego, Calif.) has started all 12 games since transferring from Oregon prior to the 2020 campaign. Against
 Army West Point (8/19) she took two shots, one from equaling her single game career best. She, along with fellow defenders Kiera
 Utush (Jr., D, Rocklin, Calif.) and Lauren Dicus (Sr., D, Danville, Calif.), each played all 90 minutes. With the departure of four-year
 starting center defender Sarah Broacha, Watkins and Utush have taken the reins as the program's center defenders.
- Lauren Dicus (Sr., D, Danville, Calif.) earned the 37th starting assignment of her career, including the last 12 games in a row. Dicus
 took one shot against Army West Point (8/19) and her 58th minute attempt resulted in a hand ball in the AWP box and resulted in
 Fuentes' game winning PK.
- Sarah Funk (Fr., F, El Cajon, Calif.) produced one shot in her collegiate debut and along with Castro were the two freshman on the

Head Coach: Mike Friesen, 15th Season Assistant Coach: Chassion Griggs, Fifth Season Assistant Coach: Cole Schmit, Fifth Season side who started against Army West Point (8/19).

- In total, seven freshmen saw field time in the Aztecs season opener. In addition to Castro and Funk, Trinity Coker (Fr., D, Poway, Calif.) played 45 minutes and attempted one shot. Hope Paredes (Fr., MF, Irvine, Calif.) produced a shot in 27 minutes and Nicholette Palomo (Fr., F, Cerritos, Calif.), Alexys Ocampo (Fr., F/MF, Upland, Calif.) and Carlin Blake (MF, Overland Park, Kan.), played 17, 24 and 53 minutes, respectively.
- 2020 Mountain West Newcomer of the Year and first-team All-Mountain West performer Anna Toohey (Sr., F, Winston-Salem, N.C.), was on the field against Army West Point (8/19) for 73 minutes and attempted one shot.
- Alexa Madueno (Fr., GK, Woodland, Calif.) played 90 minutes against Army West Point (8/19) and recorded the fourth clean sheet of her college career in a 1-0 decision. Madueno made four saves, three in the final 10 minutes to secure the Aztecs victory. She went 8-3-0 last year, had a .714 save percentage (35-of-49) and surrendered 14 goals in 1,005 minutes (1.25 GAA). She was included on the Mountain West All-Newcomer team and was a second-team All-MW performer. Madueno is the first true freshman keeper to start every game in a season for SDSU since Aubree Southwick in 2007 and is the third keeper, and only true freshman, to play every minute in a season for the Aztecs since Stephanie Pearson in 2003. The only other keeper to start and play every minute in a season for San Diego State since 2003 was Brooke Lisowski in 2019.
- Rachelle Elve (Jr., F, Huntington Beach, Calif.) has totaled 10 goals in the last two seasons, the highest total among returning Aztecs
 (Chloe Frisch, who graduated after the 2020 season, scored 11 goals in her last two campaigns). Elve returns this season as the Mountain West's top goal scorer in the last two seasons. At San Jose State (3/12/21), in the team's first foray away from home during the
 2020 campaign, she tallied the program's 10th hat trick and the first since Aliyah Utush's trifecta vs. New Mexico on Nov. 4, 2017.
- Two seniors from last season have opted to utilize the extra year of eligibility offered by the NCAA due to the COVID-19 pandemic.
 Malia Kaleiohi (Sr., D, San Diego, Calif.), who has a goal and three assists in 43 career games, and Daniela Filipovic (Sr., MF, Laguna Hills, Calif.), who recorded the first point of her career, an assists last season, are back in 2021.

General Notes

- San Diego State is picked to finish in second place in the MW coaches' preseason poll. This marks the 11th time in 12 seasons the
 Aztecs have been picked to finish in either first or second place. The only time SDSU was lower than second place in the preseason
 poll in the last 12 years was in 2019, a year in which the Aztecs were predicted to finish fourth. That team went 10-9-1, shared the
 Mountain West regular-season title at 8-2-0, and reached the championship game of the league tournament.
- San Diego State's 2.46 goals per game in 2020 is the highest for a Mountain West team in the last 19 seasons. In 1999 and 2002 Brigham Young averaged 2.68 goals per game and BYU owns the league record of 3.46 goals per game in 2000
- Having won five of the last eight regular-season titles, not including the 2020 season in which the league was divided into two divisions
 and the Aztecs earned the West Division title, SDSU finds itself not the favorite in the eyes of the conference's head coaches for just
 the second time in the last nine years.
- The Aztecs have won nine of the last 16 MW trophies (regular season and tournament), all of which have come under the direction of head coach Mike Friesen. In total, the 15th-year head coach has guided San Diego State to ten conference titles.
- San Diego State has earned 11 Mountain West titles since the conference's inception in 1999. SDSU was the regular season champions in 1999, 2012, 2013, 2014, 2015 and 2019. The program was the tournament champion in 2009, 2012, 2013, 2014 and 2017, and its five tournament titles are the most among any current member of the Mountain West and the second best in the league's history (BYU, 7).
- Following the Aztecs 1-0 decision over Army West Point on Aug. 19, its riding an 11-game home match winning streak. The last time San Diego State lost on the Sports Deck came on Sept. 13, 2019, in a 0-1 decision to San Diego. That is more than two years without a home defeat.
- With the start of a new season, the Aztecs will have to replace several faces who have been fixtures in SDSU's lineup. They include Chloe Frisch (MF, Solana Beach, Calif.), who was last year's Mountain West Offensive Player of the Year, a United Soccer Coaches first-team All-Pacific Region performer, first team All-Mountain West designee and Top Drawer Soccer's No. 79 ranked player. Frisch completed her college eligibility tied for No. 8 on the program's career assists list. Sarah Broacha (D, Pleasanton, Calif.), a center defender who anchored the back line, was twice an All-MW performer (first team in 2020) and started 70 of her 71 appearances as an Aztec. In addition, Veronica Avalos (F, (San Diego, Calif.), who had a hat trick in the final regular-season game of her career, Jordan Girman (D, Cotati, Calif.), who picked up the first assist and goal of her career in 2020, and Phoebe Leitch (D/MF, Forest Row. England), who in 60 appearances totaled seven goals and two assists, have all moved on.

- The Aztecs 20-11-5 (.625) record in the Mountain West Tournament is the best among any current member and is the second highest in the league's history (BYU, 19-4-1 .813).
- In its lone exhibition ahead of the regular season, the Aztecs hosted the Arizona Wildcats on Aug. 10 and despite the stats being nearly identical (Arizona led 10-to-9 in shots, 5-to-4 in corners, and 4-to-1 in saves, while SDSU led 4-to-3 in shots on goal & 9-to-7 in fouls), the Aztecs dropped a 0-2 decision on the Sports Deck. Denise Castro (Fr., MF/F, San Ysidro, Calif.) led the side with three shots.

 Alexa Madueno (So., GK, Woodland, Calif.) played 57:28 and surrendered both Wildcat goals while Cameron Illingworth (So., GK, Santa Ana, Calif.) was in goal for 32:32 and did not face a shot which reached her line. In total, three freshmen earned a start vs.

 Arizona (Castro, Trinity Coker (Fr., D, Poway, Calif.) & Sarah Funk (Fr., F, El Cajon, Calif.) and a total of 10 newcomers saw minutes.

The Waves defeated No. 14 Southern California 2-0 on Thursday on the Trojans home field... Pepperdine is predicted to finish third in the West Coast Conference (WCC) preseason poll... Two players, Joelle Anderson and Trinity Watson, earned inclusion on the All-WCC preseason team... The Waves finished last year with a 6-5-1 record and a fourth-place finish in the WCC... Pepperdine returns seven starters, 19 letterwinners and 76% of the goal-scoring, including its top goal scorers in Watson, Leya McFarland & Tori Waldeck from the 2020 campaign...McFarland and Anderson led the team with three assists each... Keeper Zoe Cleverly, who posted a 6-3-1 record, a 0.94 GAA, and .692 save percentage led the team in minutes in goal (769:03) and is back for her senior campaign... The Waves are coached by Tim Ward, who is in his 24th season at the helm of the program and brings a Division I career-record of 262-134-60 into the season and a 7-1-0 record against San Diego State.

SAN DIEGO — Senior Laura Fuentes scored on a penalty kick in the 58th minute against the Army West Point Black Knights to send the San Diego State women's soccer team a 1-0 victory in each team's season opener. The win improved the Aztecs record in season openers on SDSU's home field to 15-6-1.

Fuentes, a senior out of Newark, Calif., got the keeper to go left and slotted the ball low to the right to convert the PK. She is a perfect 4-of-4 in penalty kicks for her career. The attempt was set up by fellow senior Lauren Dicus, who with the ball in the Army West Point box, attempted a pass which one of the Black Knights touched with her hand. The ball was placed on the spot and Fuentes took care of the rest.

The first 45 minutes were fairly even, especially on the stat sheet. The Aztecs out shot Army West Point 5-4 and had a couple of dangerous chances which they were unable to convert.

In the 29th minute, Anna Toohey, who was just inside the left corner of the box, took a pass from Fuentes, who was at the top of the 18. Toohey showed the ball to a defender, then took it back and drove around her. She fired a shot across the face of the goal from 15 yards out which the Black Knight's keeper had no chance to stop.

Later in the period, Malia Kaleiohi got free down the right side and served the ball into the six toward a crashing Emma Gaines-Ramos. Gaines-Ramos was driving to the back post, but the ball was just out of her reach and the teams went to the intermission tied at 0-0.

"We knew Army was going to be very organized, have a plan, stick to that plan," head coach Mike Friesen said. "We were prepared for a lot of what they did in the first half, but we just didn't follow through on our game plan. One of the things they did was to step up and squeeze us and we didn't play over the top of them. That was one of the things we talked about at half time and in the first 15 seconds of the second half, we played behind them and that really opened the game up."

On the play that turned the game, center defender Kiera Utush took possession in Aztec territory and played a ball deep down the middle of the field. Sarah Funk, a freshman forward, ran onto it, laid it off for Toohey who gave it right back, but the Black Knight's keeper Sage Strohman charged off her line and dove on the ball to smother the play.

Then in the 53rd minute, Fuentes, on the left side of the box, took a cross from Funk, settled it and then fired a shot just over the crossbar. Finally, at the 57:38 mark, her PK attempt found the back of the net for what would eventually be the game winner.

San Diego State continued to press its advantage for the next 20-plus minutes and produced 12 of the team's total of 15 shots through the first 80 minutes.

However, in the final 10 minutes, the Black Knights turned up the pressure. They took six of their seven shots in the half in that time span and forced Aztecs' keeper Alexa Madueno to make the three saves she had in the second half. None was more important than a stop at the 82:18 mark. Army West Point's Keira Vesy found the ball 10 yards out on the left side of the box and fired a shot which would have tied the game, but Madueno dove to her left and punched it over the end line to preserve the 1-0 lead.

For the game, Madueno made four saves and earned the fourth clean sheet of her San Diego State career.
