Aztecs Notes

- After splitting its opening two matches of the 2021 season, both at the Sports Deck, San Diego State set out on the road from its first two games away from home. The Aztecs play at Saint Mary's on Thursday afternoon and are then at Stanford for a Sunday matinee.
- Laura Fuentes (Sr., MF, Newark, Calif.) scored the lone goal in the Aztecs season-opening 1-0 decision against Army West Point. She opened her season account with a 58th minute penalty kick. Fuentes is a perfect 4-for-4 in her career in PKs and has tallied one in each of her four seasons.
- The Mountain West announced on Thursday, August 19, that all conference contests which were scheduled for October 29 have been rescheduled for October 28, and that the Mountain West Championship, originally set to run from Nov. 2-6 in Boise, Idaho, will now be conducted from Nov. 1-6 in Boise.
- In a series that began in 1991, the Aztecs have played Saint Mary's seven times and are 3-4-0 in the all-time series, including a 0-4-0 mark in games played in Moraga. The teams have played only one time this millennium, a San Diego State victory, 1-0 on August 25, 2013 on the Sports Deck. The last matchup in Moraga saw the Gaels earn a 2-1 decision on Sept. 26, 1997.
- The Aztecs opened the regular season on Thursday with a 1-0 victory over Army West Point. The win improved the program's record in season openers, on its home pitch, to 15-6-1. Since 2007, when head coach Mike Friesen assumed leadership of the program, SDSU is 7-3-1 in games which opened a season on the Sports Deck. Those three losses are all to Power-5 programs, and two of those programs went on to appear in that season's NCAA Tournament (UCLA in 2016 & Texas Tech in 2019). Now in its 33rd year of competition, the Aztecs are 18-14-1 overall in season openers, regardless of location.
- In his 15th campaign leading the Mountain West's most dominant women's soccer program, head coach Mike Friesen has guided his squad to ten Mountain West championships (five tournament and five regular season), and five NCAA Tournament appearances, each the most among any current league head coach. Entering his 15th season of conference play, Friesen has an 88-27-13 record. His 88 league victories are the most by any head coach in Mountain West history (the inaugural season of the MW was in 1999).
- Friesen's 159 victories (159-95-33) since the start of the 2007 season, the year he took over the program, are the most by any current coach in the MW and rank second in league history (Jennifer Rockwood, BYU, 190 victories). Colorado College's Geoff Bennett's 145 victories in the last 14 seasons ranks second among current MW head coaches.

Player Notes

- **Laura Fuentes** (Sr., MF, Newark, Calif.), a 2020 United Soccer Coaches second-team All-Pacific Region and first-team All-MW performer leads the side with five shots (No. 7 in the MW), four shots on frame and the lone goal in a 1-0 decision against Army West Point (8/19). The tally was the fourth PK of her career and the fourth game winner. She has never missed a contest and has earned a starting assignment in each of her 52 career games.
- Striker **Emma Gaines-Ramos** (So., F, San Diego, Calif.) has tallied two shots, putting one on frame, in 109 minutes. Gaines-Ramos was a first-team All-Mountain West honoree last season after producing three assists, the second most by an Aztec true freshman in the last five years.
- In her collegiate debut, **Denise Castro** (Fr., MF, San Ysidro, Calif.) earned a start against Army West Point (8/19). In two games, both starts, she has produced two shots, both on goal, in 123 minutes of action.
- **Claire Watkins** (Jr., D, San Diego, Calif.) has started all 13 games since transferring from Oregon prior to the 2020 campaign. In 155 minutes she has produced two shots. She, along with fellow defenders **Kiera Utush** (Jr., D, Rocklin, Calif.) and **Lauren Dicus** (Sr., D, Danville, Calif.), each played 90 minutes against Army West point (8/19). With the departure of four-year starting center defender Sarah Broacha, Watkins and Utush have taken the reins as the program's center defenders.
- **Lauren Dicus** (Sr., D, Danville, Calif.) earned the 38th starting assignment of her career against Pepperdine (8/22), including the last 13 games in a row. Dicus took one shot against Army West Point (8/19) and her 58th minute attempt resulted in a hand ball in the AWP box and resulted in Fuentes' game winning PK.

- **Sarah Funk** (Fr., F, El Cajon, Calif.) produced one shot in her collegiate debut vs. Army West Point (8/19) and along with Castro are the two freshman to have started each of the first two matches of 2021.
- In total, seven freshmen saw field time in the Aztecs season opener. In addition to Castro and Funk, **Trinity Coker** (Fr., D, Poway, Calif.) played 45 minutes and attempted one shot. **Hope Paredes** (Fr., MF, Irvine, Calif.) produced a shot in 27 minutes and **Nicholette Palomo** (Fr., F, Cerritos, Calif.), **Alexys Ocampo** (Fr., F/MF, Upland, Calif.) and **Carlin Blake** (MF, Overland Park, Kan.), played 17, 24 and 53 minutes, respectively.
- Against Pepperdine (8/22), nine newcomers saw playing time, including the seven freshman who played vs. Army West Point (8/19). Transfers Lily Davis (So, D, San Diego, Calif.) and Olivia Sekimoto (So., MF/F, Chula Vista, Calif.) played 25 and nine minutes, respectively vs. Pepperdine. Davis transferred from Indiana while Sekimoto arrived on The Mesa after a season at American University.
- 2020 Mountain West Newcomer of the Year and first-team All-Mountain West performer **Anna Toohey** (Sr., F, Winston-Salem, N.C.), was on the field against Army West Point (8/19) for 73 minutes and attempted one shot. Versus Pepperdine (8/22) she played 62 minutes.
- **Alexa Madueno** (Fr., GK, Woodland, Calif.) played every minute of the teams first two games and every minute of her college career (1,185 minutes). Against Army West Point (8/19) she recorded the fourth clean sheet of her college career in a 1-0 decision. Madueno made four saves, three in the final 10 minutes to secure the Aztecs victory. She went 8-3-0 last year, had a .714 save percentage (35-of-49) and surrendered 14 goals in 1,005 minutes (1.25 GAA). She was included on the Mountain West All-Newcomer team and was a second-team All-MW performer. Madueno is the first true freshman keeper to start every game in a season for SDSU since Aubree Southwick in 2007 and is the third keeper, and only true freshman, to play every minute in a season for the Aztecs since Stephanie Pearson in 2003. The only other keeper to start and play every minute in a season for San Diego State since 2003 was Brooke Lisowski in 2019.
- **Rachelle Elve** (Jr., F, Huntington Beach, Calif.) has totaled 10 goals in the last two seasons, the highest total among returning Aztecs (Chloe Frisch, who graduated after the 2020 season, scored 11 goals in her last two campaigns). Elve returns this season as the Mountain West's top goal scorer in the last two seasons. At San Jose State (3/12/21), in the team's first foray away from home during the 2020 campaign, she tallied the program's 10th hat trick and the first since Aliyah Utush's trifecta vs. New Mexico on Nov. 4, 2017.
- Two seniors from last season have opted to utilize the extra year of eligibility offered by the NCAA due to the COVID-19 pandemic. **Malia Kaleiohi** (Sr., D, San Diego, Calif.), who has a goal and three assists in 44 career games, and **Daniela Filipovic** (Sr., MF, Laguna Hills, Calif.), who recorded the first point of her career, an assists last season, are back in 2021. Kaleiohi & Filipovic produced a shot each in the Pepperdine game (8/22) and played 90 and 75 minutes, respectively.

General Notes

- San Diego State is picked to finish in second place in the MW coaches' preseason poll. This marks the 11th time in 12 seasons the Aztecs have been picked to finish in either first or second place. The only time SDSU was lower than second place in the preseason poll in the last 12 years was in 2019, a year in which the Aztecs were predicted to finish fourth. That team went 10-9-1, shared the Mountain West regular-season title at 8-2-0, and reached the championship game of the league tournament.
- San Diego State's 2.46 goals per game in 2020 is the highest for a Mountain West team in the last 19 seasons. In 1999 and 2002 Brigham Young averaged 2.68 goals per game and BYU owns the league record of 3.46 goals per game in 2000
- Having won five of the last eight regular-season titles, not including the 2020 season in which the league was divided into two divisions and the Aztecs earned the West Division title, SDSU finds itself not the favorite in the eyes of the conference's head coaches for just the second time in the last nine years.
- The Aztecs have won nine of the last 16 MW trophies (regular season and tournament), all of which have come under the direction of head coach **Mike Friesen**. In total, the 15th-year head coach has guided San Diego State to ten conference titles.
- San Diego State has earned 11 Mountain West titles since the conference's inception in 1999. SDSU was the regular season champions in 1999, 2012, 2013, 2014, 2015 and 2019. The program was the tournament champion in 2009, 2012, 2013, 2014 and 2017, and its five tournament titles are the most among any current member of the Mountain West and the second best in the league's history (BYU, 7).
- The Aztecs 0-3 decision against Pepperdine on Aug. 22, snapped an 11-game home match winning streak. The last time San Diego State had lost on the Sports Deck prior to Sunday night came on Sept. 13, 2019, in a 0-1 decision to San Diego. The Aztecs had gone nearly two years without a home defeat.

- With the start of a new season, the Aztecs have to replace several faces who have been fixtures in SDSU's lineup. They include **Chloe Frisch** (MF, Solana Beach, Calif.), who was last year's Mountain West Offensive Player of the Year, a United Soccer Coaches first-team All-Pacific Region performer, first team All-Mountain West designee and Top Drawer Soccer's No. 79 ranked player. Frisch completed her college eligibility tied for No. 8 on the program's career assists list. **Sarah Broacha** (D, Pleasanton, Calif.), a center defender who anchored the back line, was twice an All-MW performer (first team in 2020) and started 70 of her 71 appearances as an Aztec. In addition, **Veronica Avalos** (F, (San Diego, Calif.), who had a hat trick in the final regular-season game of her career, **Jordan Girman** (D, Cotati, Calif.), who picked up the first assist and goal of her career in 2020, and **Phoebe Leitch** (D/MF, Forest Row, England), who in 60 appearances totaled seven goals and two assists, have all moved on.
- The Aztecs 20-11-5 (.625) record in the Mountain West Tournament is the best among any current member and is the second highest in the league's history (BYU, 19-4-1 - .813).
- In its lone exhibition ahead of the regular season, the Aztecs hosted the Arizona Wildcats on Aug. 10 and despite the stats being nearly identical (Arizona led 10-to-9 in shots, 5-to-4 in corners, and 4-to-1 in saves, while SDSU led 4-to-3 in shots on goal & 9-to-7 in fouls), the Aztecs dropped a 0-2 decision on the Sports Deck. **Denise Castro** (Fr., MF/F, San Ysidro, Calif.) led the side with three shots. **Alexa Maduena** (So., GK, Woodland, Calif.) played 57:28 and surrendered both Wildcat goals while **Cameron Illingworth** (So., GK, Santa Ana, Calif.) was in goal for 32:32 and did not face a shot which reached her line. In total, three freshmen earned a start vs. Arizona (**Castro**, **Trinity Coker** (Fr., D, Poway, Calif.) & **Sarah Funk** (Fr., F, El Cajon, Calif.) and a total of 10 newcomers saw minutes.

Opponent Notebook

Saint Mary's College

The Gaels are off to a 2-0-0 start after wins vs. Sacramento State (3-0) and at Cal Poly (2-1)... Pepperdine is predicted to finish in sixth place in the ten team West Coast Conference's (WCC) preseason poll... Taylor Poland (So., GK) earned inclusion on the All-WCC preseason team... Saint Mary's finished last year with a 4-4-3 record and a fifth place finish in the WCC (4-3-2)... Of the ten players who started all 11 games for Saint Mary's last year, they returns nine in 2021, and 100 percent of the goal scoring (11 total goals) and assists (9 total assists) from the 2020 campaign... Poland, who posted a 4-4-3 record, a 0.77 GAA, and .859 save percentage, led the team in minutes in goal (1,051:25) and is back after being named to the Preseason All-WCC team... The Gaels are coached by Theresa Romagnolo, who is in her second season at the helm of the program and brings a eight-year Division I career-record of 80-47-19 into the season. This will be the first time she has led a team against San Diego State.

Stanford

The Cardinal are 1-0-0 after a 2-0 victory at Cal Poly (8/19) and host CSUN on Thursday night ahead of the matchup with the Aztecs... Stanford is predicted to finish third place in the Pac-12 Conference preseason poll... Naomi Girma (Sr., D/MF) earned inclusion on the MAC Hermann Trophy (the Heisman Trophy of collegiate soccer) Watch List... Stanford finished last year with a 6-6-2 record and a fourth place finish in the Pac-12 (5-4-1)... Of the eight players who started double figure games for Stanford last year, they returns six in 2021, and 66.7 percent of the goal scoring (12-of-18 total goals) and 75 percent of its assists (6-of-8 total assists) from the 2020 campaign... Keeper Katie Meyer, who posted a 6-6-2 record, a 0.97 GAA, and .778 save percentage, led the team in minutes in goal (1,303:37) and is back for her junior campaign... The Cardinal are coached by Paul Ratcliffe, who is in his 19th season at the helm of the program and brings a 23-year Division I career-record of 381-92-38 into the season. This will be the fourth time he has led a team against San Diego State and is undefeated in his previous three matchup against the Aztecs.

SAN DIEGO — Senior Laura Fuentes scored on a penalty kick in the 58th minute against the Army West Point Black Knights to send the San Diego State women's soccer team a 1-0 victory in each team's season opener. The win improved the Aztecs record in season openers on SDSU's home field to 15-6-1.

Fuentes, a senior out of Newark, Calif., got the keeper to go left and slotted the ball low to the right to convert the PK. She is a perfect 4-of-4 in penalty kicks for her career. The attempt was set up by fellow senior Lauren Dicus, who with the ball in the Army West Point box, attempted a pass which one of the Black Knights touched with her hand. The ball was placed on the spot and Fuentes took care of the rest.

The first 45 minutes were fairly even, especially on the stat sheet. The Aztecs out shot Army West Point 5-4 and had a couple of dangerous chances which they were unable to convert.

In the 29th minute, Anna Toohey, who was just inside the left corner of the box, took a pass from Fuentes, who was at the top of the 18. Toohey showed the ball to a defender, then took it back and drove around her. She fired a shot across the face of the goal from 15 yards out which the Black Knight's keeper had no chance to stop.

Later in the period, Malia Kaleiohi got free down the right side and served the ball into the six toward a crashing Emma Gaines-Ramos. Gaines-Ramos was driving to the back post, but the ball was just out of her reach and the teams went to the intermission tied at 0-0.

"We knew Army was going to be very organized, have a plan, stick to that plan," head coach Mike Friesen said. "We were prepared for a lot of what they did in the first half, but we just didn't follow through on our game plan. One of the things they did was to step up and squeeze us and we didn't play over the top of them. That was one of the things we talked about at half time and in the first 15 seconds of the second half, we played behind them and that really opened the game up."

On the play that turned the game, center defender Kiera Utush took possession in Aztec territory and played a ball deep down the middle of the field. Sarah Funk, a freshman forward, ran onto it, laid it off for Toohey who gave it right back, but the Black Knight's keeper Sage Strohmman charged off her line and dove on the ball to smother the play.

Then in the 53rd minute, Fuentes, on the left side of the box, took a cross from Funk, settled it and then fired a shot just over the crossbar. Finally, at the 57:38 mark, her PK attempt found the back of the net for what would eventually be the game winner.

San Diego State continued to press its advantage for the next 20-plus minutes and produced 12 of the team's total of 15 shots through the first 80 minutes.

However, in the final 10 minutes, the Black Knights turned up the pressure. They took six of their seven shots in the half in that time span and forced Aztecs' keeper Alexa Madueno to make the three saves she had in the second half. None was more important than a stop at the 82:18 mark. Army West Point's Keira Vesey found the ball 10 yards out on the left side of the box and fired a shot which would have tied the game, but Madueno dove to her left and punched it over the end line to preserve the 1-0 lead.

For the game, Madueno made four saves and earned the fourth clean sheet of her San Diego State career.

SAN DIEGO — The San Diego State women's soccer team surrendered an own goal less than five minutes into its contest against the Pepperdine Waves and was never able to claw its way back into the game, falling 3-0 on Sunday evening on the SDSU Sports Deck. It was the team's first home loss since a 0-1 decision to San Diego on Sept. 13, 2019.

"I thought we played a really good game," said head coach Mike Friesen. "We had an own goal, and they scored on a defensive mistake and a PK. It (the second score) was a silly goal to give away, but nothing too special that they did. (Pepperdine) is a very experienced team and that's why we played this game, so that we know what it takes to play at that level."

The first goal came at the 4:55 mark. Pepperdine's Leyla McFarland fired off a shot from a very tight angle on the left side of the goal. SDSU keeper Alexa Madueno got a hand on the ball, but couldn't control it and it deflected into the net, staking the Waves to a 1-0 advantage.

For most of the first 45 minutes, Pepperdine (2-0-0) had the advantage in the run of play, outshooting the Aztecs 8-of-4. Malia Kaleiohi, Daniela Filipovic, Alexys Ocampo and Laura Fuentes produced the team's shots while Fuentes' attempts at the 8:50 mark the only shot on goal San Diego State (1-1-0) would get in the game. The sides went to intermission with the Waves up 1-0.

In the second half, Pepperdine got a goal in the 53rd minute from McFarland. Tori Waldeck attempted a shot, which Madueno stopped, but was unable to control. McFarland found herself in the right place at the right time and popped the ball over a sprawled Madueno to make it 2-0.

In the 60th minute, a Pepperdine player was fouled in the box and Trinity Watson scored low to her left on a penalty kick to make it 3-0, which would be the final score.

"I thought in the last 20 minutes we were fantastic," Friesen said. "This was the first time that really everybody stepped up and played the way we want to play, so that is huge to build on. I'm excited about where we can go from here, but disappointed with the result. But we play these games because they put us in a good spot to get to the postseason. This is a team (Pepperdine) that returned pretty much everyone from last year, and picked up some great transfers, etc. It was good for our team to see the experience and composure they have, the willingness to do for the team whatever it takes to get a win. I thought we grew in the game and later we were very good. We had some quality chances in the first half; we just didn't put them away."

When the final whistle blew, the Aztecs had been outshot 19-to-6 and Pepperdine put eight shots on frame to SDSU's one. Madueno (1-1-0) made six saves, one off her career high.

In addition to the first-half shots of Kaleiohi, Fuentes, Filipovic and Ocampo, Hope Paredes produced both Aztecs second half shots.

THE NOTE

San Diego State played nine newcomers, including seven true freshmen.
