- The Aztecs (7-8, 1-3) return home for a pair of games this week. On Thursday they will host Utah State (5-9, 0-4) at 6 p.m. and on Saturday they welcome in Boise State (5-9, 1-2).
- SDSU lost at New Mexico (13-4, 4-0) 75-72 last Sunday. The Aztecs nearly made a miraculous comeback, rallying from a 14-point deficit with 5:33 left to pull within three points.
- SDSU posted season-highs for total rebounds (53), offensive rebounds (24) and second-chance points (16).
- The Aztecs have held their opponent to just one second chance point over the last two games.
- The Aztecs nearly had three players with double-doubles. Kim Villalobos finished with 17 points and a career-high 11 rebounds, Mallory Adams had a career-high 21 points and nine rebounds and Asia Avinger had 10 points, nine assists and seven rebounds.
- This was Villalobos first career double-double and she is the third different Aztec to have one this year (Adams & Ramos)
- Adams (Frisco, Texas) is leading the Aztecs in scoring (14.8 ppg) and rebounding (7.3) in conference play.
- Avinger (Cerritos, Calif.) was named the Mountain West Freshman of the Week after averaging 17.0 points, 8.0 assists and 6.0 rebounds. In MW games, she has 22 assists and just seven turnovers.
- Ramos (San Antonio, Texas) enters the week with 1,300 career points, good for the 12th most in program history. She also has 356 career assists and will move up to 7th all-time with three more assists. She is currently in the top 10 in program history in five statistical categories.
- Ramos is one of three active four-year players with career totals of at least 1,300 points, 450 rebounds, 350 assists and 100 steals (Portland's Haylee Andrews & Ohio's Erica Johnson).
- Ramos is third in the nation in total minutes (5:46:53) and is in the top 100 nationally in seven statistical categories.
- SDSU has three active players in the top eight all-time in career three-point percentage. Mercedes Staples (Centerville, Utah) is fourth at 37.8 percent (51-135), Isabela Hernandez is fifth (37.2%, 54-145) and Sophia Ramos is eighth (35.6%, 128-360).
- The Aztecs are committing just 12.9 turnovers per game, the 23rd fewest in the nation.
- The Aztecs went 6-5 in non-conference play, their first time having a winning record in OOC play since the 2017-18 season.

Sophia Ramos Enters Senior Year with Sights Set on SDSU

Record Books

- Barring injury, senior guard Sophia Ramos (San Antonio, Texas) could finish her career in the top five all-time in points and assists and become the only Aztec ever with 1,500 points, 400 assists and 500 rebounds in a career. She is also one of the best free-throw and three-point shooters in program history.
- Ramos is one of three active four-year players with career totals of at least 1,300 points, 450 rebounds, 350 assists and 100 steals (Portland's Haylee Andrews & Ohio's Erica Johnson).
- Ramos recently moved into 10th place for most free-throws made in a career, which means she is in the top 10 all-time in five categories: 3-point field goal percentage, 3-point field goals made, 3-point field goal attempts, assists and made free throws.
- Career records aren't kept for free throw percentage, but she has two of the top ten single-season marks for free throw percentage. She was 85 percent from the line in 2019-20 and 83.1 percent last year.
- Ramos became the 13th Aztec to reach 1,000 points in three seasons or less and the 10th to do it in 70 or fewer games.

Asia Avinger Named Mountain West Preseason Freshman of the Year

- Redshirt freshman point guard Asia Avinger (Cerritos, Calif.) was named the Mountain West Preseason Freshman of the Year by select media and the league's coaches.
- Avinger won the award prior to last year as well but then suffered a season-ending injury.
- She is the first player to ever win the Mountain West Preseason Freshman of the Year twice.
- Avinger is the highest ranked recruit under head coach Stacie Terry- Hutson. She was one of the nation's best prep combo guards in 2020 earning a ranking of No. 56 in the nation according to espnW.
- Following her senior year, she was named the Orange County Register's Female Athlete of the Year and to the MaxPreps All-California First Team. She was also named the Trinity League MVP and the Orange County Player of the Year.
- As a senior she averaged 13.8 points, 6.3 rebounds and 4.0 assists and helped lead Rosary High School to the 2020 CIF Southern California DI Regional championship before the tournament was suspended due to COVID-19. Rosary HS won the 2019 State Championship and Avinger took home tournament MVP honors after scoring 24 points in the championship game.
- Avinger's twin brother Noah is on the Aztec football team and became the first freshman cornerback to start a game since 2009. Her older brother Lucky is also on the team.

- They are top 10 in the nation in three-pointers made per game (9.8) and in three-point percentage (.381).
- They lead the conference in points per game (75.8), field goal percentage (.456) and assists per game (16.6).
- The Lobos have four players averaging at least 12 points per game and are led by Shaiquel McGruder (13.9), who shoots a conference-best 60.5 percent from the floor.
- LaTora Duff leads the Mountain West with 6.0 assists per game.
- Her sister LaTascya Duff leads the conference and is ninth in the nation in three-point percentage (.484). She is making 3.0 three-pointers per game.
- Antonia Anderson averages a conference best 1.56 blocks per game.
- Head coach Mike Bradbury (6th season) is 106-59 (.642) all-time at New Mexico and is closing in on 300 wins for his career.

Series Notes

- New Mexico leads the all-time series 36-32.
- The Aztecs have played the Lobos more times than any other program.
- SDSU is 12-15 all-time against the Lobos at The Pit.
- New Mexico won both meetings last year, holding the Aztecs to 48 points in both games.
- Prior to last season, SDSU had won four in a row and six of seven against the Lobos.
- Their first meeting was Jan. 18, 1992, a 91-44 Aztec win. SDSU won the first 10 meetings.
- The Lobos won 19 straight meetings from 2001 to 2008.
- Sophia Ramos scored a career-high 32 points against the Lobos Jan. 29, 2020 and went a perfect 16-for-16 from the line, which is a school record for the most free throws attempted without a miss.

The San Diego State men's team has been partnered with the Jordan Brand since the beginning of the 2018-19 season.

"We are excited to be a part of this special brand," Head coach Stacie Terry-Hutson said. "We recognize that we are in elite company being one of the few women's programs to don the Jumpman logo. Jordan is one of the most popular shoes in the basketball community and this will help us market the San Diego State program."

Glover was most recently the Associate Head Coach at USC (2017-21) and brings over 30 years of coaching experience to SDSU including 15+ years at the DI level. Glover, who has spent time in the NBA, WNBA, NBA G-League and junior college, is known for being an X's and O's tactician and has an impressive track record in player development.

Glover, who attended SDSU for two years, has spent the past eight seasons as an associate head coach at the DI level. He was at USC for the last four years coaching under Mark

Trakh, who he also coached with at New Mexico State for the 2016-17 season.

That year the Aggies went 24-7 and 14-0 in the WAC and reached the NCAA Tournament.

Lewis was most recently at Colorado State (2018-21) and comes to SDSU with 17 years of DI experience, including five as the head coach at Florida Atlantic.

Lewis also spent a combined nine years at Nebraska (2007-12) and Washington (2003-17) as an assistant while also coordinating each program's recruiting efforts. In her career, Lewis has coached in the Big Ten, Big 12, Pac-12 (then Pac-10), Conference USA and Sun Belt.

During Lewis' last two years at Colorado St., the Rams were second in the nation for fewest turnovers per game. Last season, CSU went 15-6 overall and 11-5 in the Mountain West and ranked in top ten nationally in four categories (turnovers/game, assist-to-turnover ratio, three-point % and defensive rebounds/game).

Lewis coached a high-scoring offense throughout her tenure as head coach of Florida Atlantic, including the program's No. 2 all-time single-season scoring offense both by total points (2,331) and average (77.7) in 2013-14. Her teams made 195 three-pointers or more in four of her five seasons and broke the school record for threes in a season twice. The Owls sunk 264 triples in 2013-14, then 294 in 2015-16, a Conference USA record.

In addition to those single-season three-point field goal records, FAU also set the program record for highest team three-point field goal percentage (.350) in 2015-16. Among other records set under Lewis' guidance were C-USA's single-game three-point field goals record (20) and steals (33).

Terry-Hutson also announced the hiring of Mel Boscarino as the Director of Player Development. She joins the women's basketball team after working for SDSU's event management department since 2019.

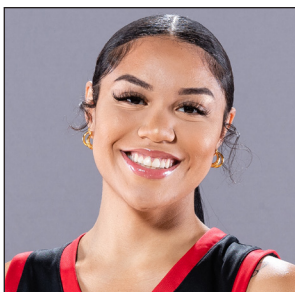

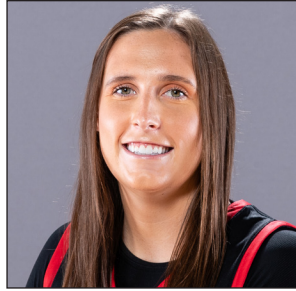
