- The Aztecs (9-8, 3-3) play at Nevada (11-4, 3-0) Wednesday evening at 6:30 p.m. It will be Nevada's first game since Jan. 2 after having three games postponed due to COVID-19 issues within the Wolf Pack program.
- SDSU notched a couple of home wins last week, beating Utah State 80-63 and Boise State 66-45.
- This was the first time SDSU has won two straight MW games by 17 points or more in Stacie Terry-Hutson's tenure (9th year).
- Asia Avinger (Cerritos, Calif.) took home her second straight Mountain West Freshman of the Week award. She scored 30 points on 10-for-12 shooting against Boise State to become the first Aztec freshman to score 30 or more points in the Mountain West era. She is just the fourth Aztec in the last 20 years to make at least 10 field goals on 12 or less attempts.
- Mallory Adams (Frisco, Texas) also scored a career-high against Boise State. She poured in 25 points with seven made threes, tied for the second-most in a game in program history. Adams leads SDSU in scoring and rebounding in conference play and has the most made three-pointers in conference play in the Mountain West.
- This was just the fourth time in the MW era that the Aztecs have had two players score at least 25 points in the same game.
- Sophia Ramos (San Antonio, Texas) is one of three active four-year players with career totals of at least 1,300 points, 450 rebounds, 350 assists and 100 steals (Portland's Haylee Andrews & Ohio's Erica Johnson). She is currently in the top 10 in program history in five statistical categories.
- Ramos is second in the nation in total minutes played and is in the top 100 nationally in six statistical categories.
- Adams and Ramos are closing in on 500 career rebounds. Ramos has 499 and Adams has 470.
- Kim Villalobos (Van Nuys, Calif.) is averaging 10.0 rebounds over her last three games.
- SDSU has three active players in the top 10 all-time in career three-point percentage. Mercedes Staples (Centerville, Utah) is fourth at 37.8 percent (51-135), Isabela Hernandez is sixth (35.9%, 55-153) and Sophia Ramos is 10th (35.3%, 131-371).
- The Aztecs are committing a conference low 9.5 turnovers per game in Mountain West games.
- SDSU is holding its opponents to 30.1 percent shooting from three, the second-lowest rate in the conference.
- The Aztecs have already surpassed their win total from last year.
- SDSU is 7-3 at home, the first time they've won seven of their first 10 home games under Stacie Terry-Hutson (9th year)
- The Aztecs went 6-5 in non-conference play, their first time having a winning record in OOC play since the 2017-18 season.
- SDSU officially joined the Jordan Brand family this season, becoming just the ninth women's basketball program in the Jordan lineup.

Sophia Ramos Enters Senior Year with Sights Set on SDSU Record Books

- Barring injury, senior guard Sophia Ramos (San Antonio, Texas) could finish her career in the top five all-time in points and assists and become the only Aztec ever with 1,500 points, 400 assists and 500 rebounds in a career. She is also one of the best free-throw and three-point shooters in program history.
- Ramos is one of three active four-year players with career totals of at least 1,300 points, 450 rebounds, 350 assists and 100 steals (Portland's Haylee Andrews & Ohio's Erica Johnson).
- Ramos is in the top 10 all-time in five categories: 3-point field goal percentage, 3-point field goal 3-point field goals made, 3-point field goal attempts, assists and made free throws. She is 11th in career points.
- Career records aren't kept for free throw percentage, but she has two of the top ten single-season marks for free throw percentage. She was 85 percent from the line in 2019-20 and 83.1 percent last year.
- Ramos is the 13th Aztec to reach 1,000 points in three seasons or less and the 10th to do it in 70 or fewer games.

Asia Avinger Named Mountain West Preseason Freshman of the Year

- Redshirt freshman point guard Asia Avinger (Cerritos, Calif.) was named the Mountain West Preseason Freshman of the Year by select media and the league's coaches.
- Avinger won the award prior to last year as well but then suffered a season-ending injury.
- She is the first player to ever win the Mountain West Preseason Freshman of the Year twice.
- Avinger is the highest ranked recruit under head coach Stacie Terry- Hutson. She was one of the nation's best prep combo guards in 2020 earning a ranking of No. 56 in the nation according to espnW.
- Following her senior year, she was named the Orange County Register's Female Athlete of the Year and to the MaxPreps All-California First Team. She was also named the Trinity League MVP and the Orange County Player of the Year.
- As a senior she averaged 13.8 points, 6.3 rebounds and 4.0 assists and helped lead Rosary High School to the 2020 CIF Southern California DI Regional championship before the tournament was suspended due to COVID-19. Rosary HS won the 2019 State Championship and Avinger took home tournament MVP honors after scoring 24 points in the championship game.
- Avinger's twin brother Noah is on the Aztec football team and became the first freshman cornerback to start a game since 2009. Her older brother Lucky is also on the team.

Opponent Notebook (Nevada)

- The Wolf Pack are 11-4 and 3-0 in conference.
- This will be their first game since Jan. 3 due to COVID-19 issues within the Nevada program.
- They are 7-2 at home.
- They have won their three conference games by an average of 20.3 points.
- They have a NET ranking of 166, seventh in the Mountain West. The Aztecs are sixth at 145.
- They are fifth in the nation in free throw percentage (.794) but attempt just 12.9 a game (271st).
- They commit just 12.3 turnovers per game and have the best turnover margin in the conference (+6.33).
- Kylie Jimenez, the preseason Mountain West Newcomer of the Year, has the second-best assist-to-turnover ratio in the nation (3.46).
- Audrey Roden is shooting 41.9 percent from three, the second-highest percent in the conference.
- Da'Ja Hamilton leads the team with 13.9 points per game.
- Head coach Amanda Levens (5th season) helped lead Nevada to a first round bye in last year's Mountain West Tournament after being picked to finish 10th in the preseason poll.

Series Notes

- The series is also tied at 9-9 since Nevada joined the Mountain West.
- The Aztecs are 3-9 all-time in Reno.
- SDSU has lost six of their last seven games at Nevada.
- The teams split their two meetings last year, which were both played in Reno. The Aztecs won the first one 59-43 before falling 66-59. Tea Adams averaged 18.0 points in those games.
- Neither team has ever won more than three in a row in the all-time series.
- Their first meeting was Jan. 2, 1984, a 90-44 Aztec win.

Aztecs Partner with Jordan Brand

The San Diego State women's basketball program is the newest member of the Jordan Brand family.

Beginning this season, the team will wear the latest Jordan Brand footwear and all on-court apparel including uniforms, practice gear and travel attire will be Jumpman branded.

SDSU is the ninth women's basketball program in the Jordan lineup, joining Florida, Georgetown, Houston, Marquette, Michigan, North Carolina, Oklahoma and UCLA. The Aztecs are one of just two programs on the West Coast to be partnered with the brand.

The apparel will feature San Diego State's official color scheme of red and black elements and will sync with Jordan Brand's iconic colors.

The San Diego State men's team has been partnered with the Jordan Brand since the beginning of the 2018-19 season.

"We are excited to be a part of this special brand," Head coach Stacie Terry-Hutson said.

"We recognize that we are in elite company being one of the few women's programs to don the Jumpman logo. Jordan is one of the most popular shoes in the basketball community and this will help us market the San Diego State program.

Glover, who attended SDSU for two years, has spent the past eight seasons as an associate head coach at the DI level. He was at USC for the last four years coaching under Mark Trakh, who he also coached with at New Mexico State for the 2016-17 season. That year the Aggies went 24-7 and 14-0 in the WAC and reached the NCAA Tournament.

Lewis was most recently at Colorado State (2018-21) and comes to SDSU with 17 years of DI experience, including five as the head coach at Florida Atlantic.

Lewis also spent a combined nine years at Nebraska (2007-12) and Washington (2003-17) as an assistant while also coordinating each program's recruiting efforts. In her career, Lewis has coached in the Big Ten, Big 12, Pac-12 (then Pac-10), Conference USA and Sun Belt.

During Lewis' last two years at Colorado St., the Rams were second in the nation for fewest turnovers per game. Last season, CSU went 15-6 overall and 11-5 in the Mountain West and ranked in top ten nationally in four categories (turnovers/game, assist-to-turnover ratio, three-point % and defensive rebounds/game).

Lewis coached a high-scoring offense throughout her tenure as head coach of Florida Atlantic, including the program's No. 2 all-time single-season scoring offense both by total points (2,331) and average (77.7) in 2013-14. Her teams made 195 three-pointers or more in four of her five seasons and broke the school record for threes in a season twice. The Owls sunk 264 triples in 2013-14, then 294 in 2015-16, a Conference USA record.

In addition to those single-season three-point field goal records, FAU also set the program record for highest team three-point field goal percentage (.350) in 2015-16. Among other records set under Lewis' guidance were C-USA's single-game three-point field goals record (20) and steals (33).

Terry-Hutson also announced the hiring of Mel Boscarino as the Director of Player Development. She joins the women's basketball team after working for SDSU's event management department since 2019.

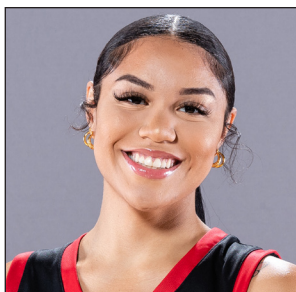
